You know we cannot let our hands get the best of us. We have to rule over our spirit and think twice before we act.

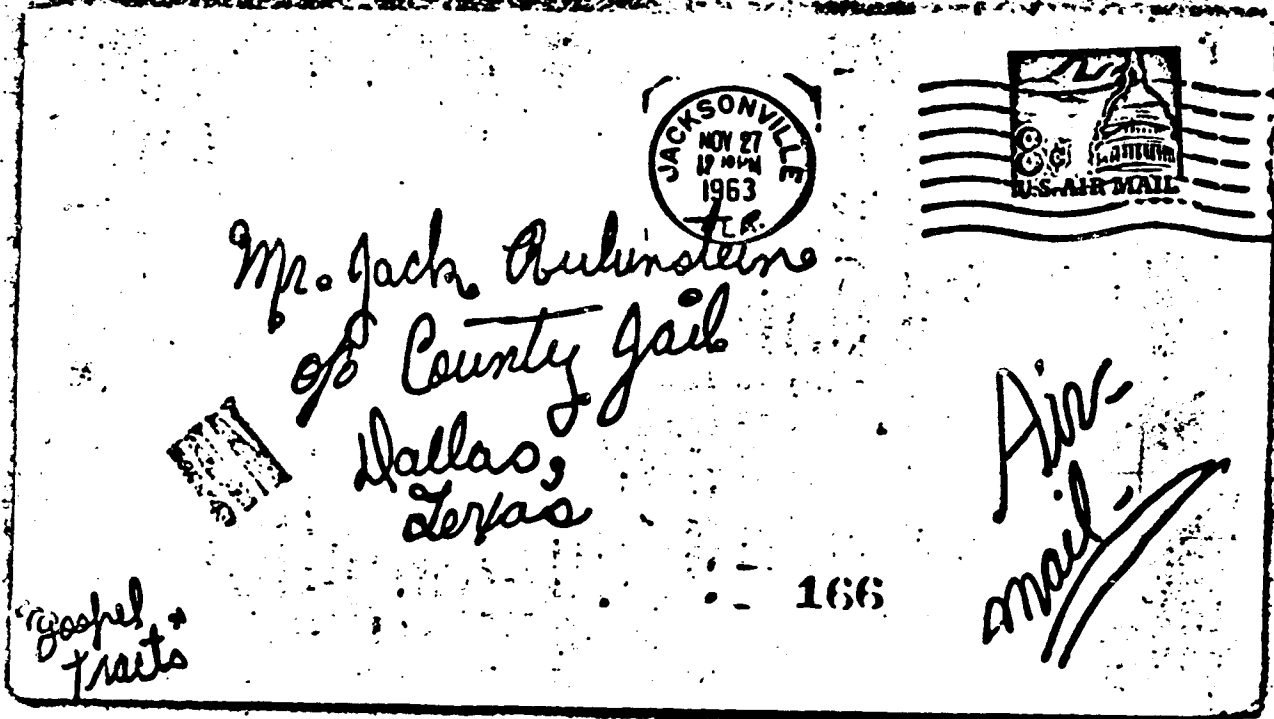
