DIGGING IN DEEP . . . An Italian writer and former member of the Italian counterpart to our FBI has been doing his own investigation of the Kennedy assassination. His views, at variance with published reports, are the following:

That Jack Ruby knew Lee Harvey Oswald and the Dallas policeman, J. D. Tippit; that Oswald was supposed to have been killed in the warehouse and because he got out unscathed the timetable was upset and he became a threat to the plotter's security.



That Tippit was not assigned to the police beat on which he discovered Oswald, and that Tippit's own beat was actually on the other side of town on Nov. 22; that Oswald had no fear when he was called over to the patrol car but panicked when Tippit got out of his car with a drawn gun, because Oswald then knew he had been double crossed.

That Oswald requested security in transfer from the police lockup to the city jail; that the gun scope was put on the gun at Klein's and sold as a unit; the scope was not put on by a Fort Worth gunsmith as claimed.

That meetings were held in January, February, and March by a militant group from Cuba who posed as dissatisfied exiles; that the rivalry between the FBI and secret services was well known to the Dallas police, and as a consequence they did not give either organization any pre-parade cooperation.

This Italian informant is convinced by his investigation that there was a plot and that the roots are very deep. He plans to cover the trial in February because he is convinced it is going to be mishandled in Ruby's favor.

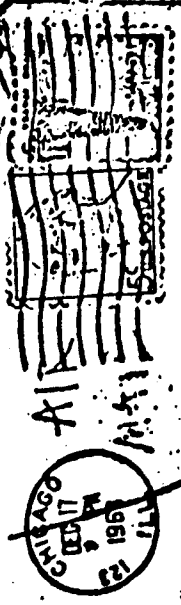

A Sort of Backhand Public Service

I THINK IN RETROSPECT, but while the shock waves from President Kennedy's assassination are still part of the universal American emotion, that the almost immediate murder of the President's killer by a more or less anonymous underworld and nightlife figure has more obvious explanations than the dark and devious motivations being ascribed by pundits and deep thinkers to the enigmatic Jack Ruby.

Ruby put into immediate and very practical effect a sentiment that in the minds of scores of millions of Americans was second only to revulsion at the assassination itself, the fear that somehow the murderer would not receive adequate punishment for his crime. The notorious, and in some States successful, activities of the enemies of capital punishment, although they have never made much headway in Texas, have made the inevitability of justice highly suspect. The cynical disbelief in the availability of swift and absolute retribution for a crime that outraged all but the most barbarous nations of the entire world was voiced in the Los Angeles bar where this reporter was following the assassination.

When the arrest of Oswald was announced in the broadcast from Dallas an outraged patron announced in carrying tones: "You can lay even money some damned humanitarians will get this s.o.b. off and that he'll be making night club appearances within a year."

"Why did they take him alive?" asked another.

These somewhat intemperate expressions mirrored in only slightly distorted dimension a universal sentiment. Already the forces of leftist subversion had tipped their hand and were sending threatening telegrams to Republican officeholders who were somehow held responsible for the death of the President.

★ ★ ★

THE NAKED VENOM of leftist treason which had no hesitation in attributing the death of the

enlisted in a defense which would be translated from the realm of simple criminal justice to a monstrous political confrontation. Oswald, they foresaw, would become, in the hands of lawyers for the ACLU no longer a simple criminal on trial for murder, but a symbol and rallying point for humanitarians and subversives everywhere.



The State of Texas would find itself on trial, not Oswald. The blame for the death of President Kennedy, through the agency of practiced shyster technique, would be shifted from his assassin to that nebulous and always available entity known as "society." The implication would be invoked that, although he may well have been 2000 miles away, the hand of Robert Welch

somehow aimed the fatal rifle.

The Oswald case would have become a legalistic carnival in which everybody would have been on trial, as is the hallowed American custom, except the man charged with murder. And it would have gone on and on, a field day for sensationalism, bad journalism and emotional opportunism to the peril of national unity and the perpetuation of distrust and hatred wherever this could be accomplished by the enemies of society masquerading as "justice."

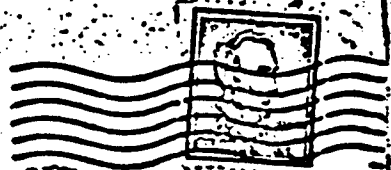
THE DOING AWAY WITH OSWALD, while it did violence to the ethical concept of justice, at least assured a cynical world that justice of an informal sort had been achieved. It obviated once and for all the inevitable bleats of "police brutality" and "violation of Constitutional rights," which are the shabby stock in trade of any legal casuist in the employ of the Civil Liberties Union.

His shooting did away with the emotional hysteria that would be paraded by breast-beaters of every hue and the tumults in foreign capitals protesting "American imperialism." It eliminated the opportunity for the tearful exploiting of sympathy for his wretched wife and dismal

Shift 2 Cops Involved In Patrol Car Killings

Two patrolmen involved in the fatal shooting of two prisoners during a gun battle in a patrol car on Nov. 15 yesterday were transferred from the W. 100th St. station to the Bronx in a move designed to ease neighborhood tension on the upper West Side.

33 Military Bases Listed In \$ Cutback

Washington, Dec. 12 (New Bureau) — Defense Secretary Robert McNamara today unwrapped details of a three-year plan to close or reduce operations at 33 military installations at an eventual saving of \$108 million a year. Seven of the installation are in New York State.

Half the bases will be shut down completely, including seven in foreign countries.

McNamara estimated that the curtailment will bring a reduction of 16,300 jobs and the transfer of 25,000 government employees.

"Every employe whose job is eliminated," McNamara said, "will be offered another job opportunity. If the new job requires a move, the expense in the case of career employes and their families will be borne by the government."

None of the 11 naval shipyards was on the curtailment list but some may be added later. The U. S. Naval Shipyard, Brooklyn, has not been considered in the cutback studies.

The list includes 14 Army, 12 Air Force and seven Navy installations.

The New York cutbacks: Brooklyn Army Overseas Supply Agency at the Army Terminal, closed by July, 1964.

Fort Tilden, Long Island, inactivated except as Reserve training center; Nike missile site to be moved to Camp Hero, Montauk Point and Lido Beach by December, 1966.

Army Miller's Field, Staten Island, activities relocated at Lakehurst, N. J.; Naval Air Station, property retained for Reserve training.

Fort Washington, Navy training device center to be put on

Patrolman Arlis J. Edmondson Jr., 33, will report for duty today at the Ryer Ave. station and Patrolman Ronald G. Wilson, 36, will report at the Bronx station.

Spurred Demonstrations

The incident which led to the transfers brought mass demonstrations against the two policemen outside the W. 100th St. station. A departmental inquiry found the actions of the men "unfortunate but necessary under the circumstances."

Police gave this account: Edmondson and Wilson, on radio car patrol, were halted by Samuel Stein, 66, of 677 West End Ave. He said he had been pushed by two men as he entered his lobby and he was afraid of them.

The cops picked up Maximino Solero, 34, and Victor Rodriguez, 34, both of 312 W. 93d St., and put them in the back seat of the patrol car.

Interfered With Driver

En route to the station house, Solero leaned over the back rest, interfering with Edmondson's driving. Edmondson told his partner he was going to stop the car because he didn't like the way the prisoners were acting.

He halted in an underpass at 96th St. and Riverside Drive. Rodriguez drew a gun and fired a shot which whistled between the two cops and ripped into the dashboard. Edmondson then fired four shots which killed both prisoners.
