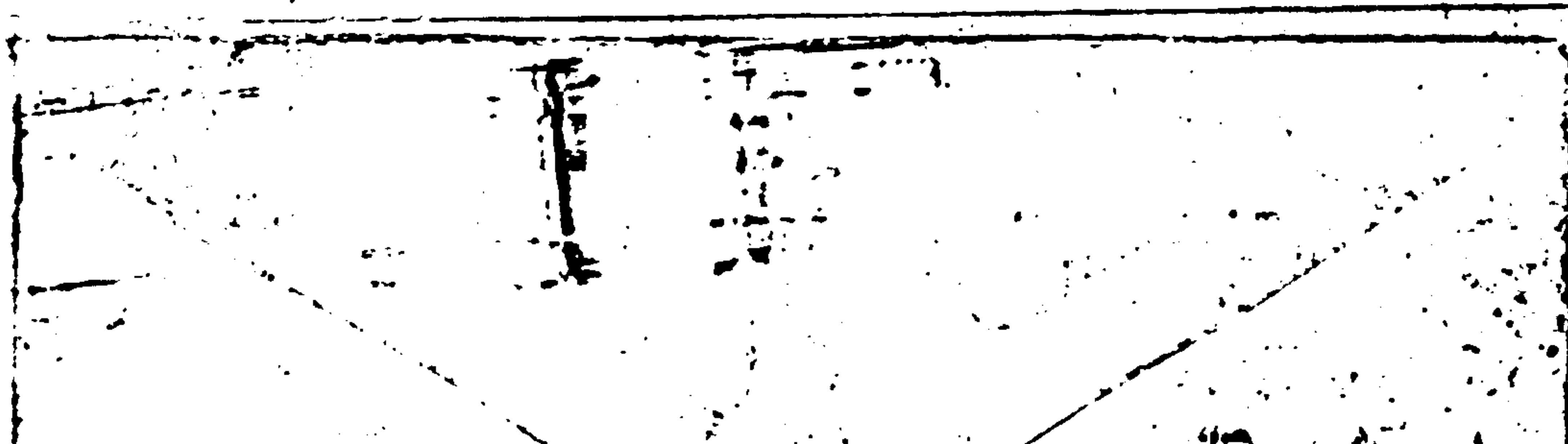

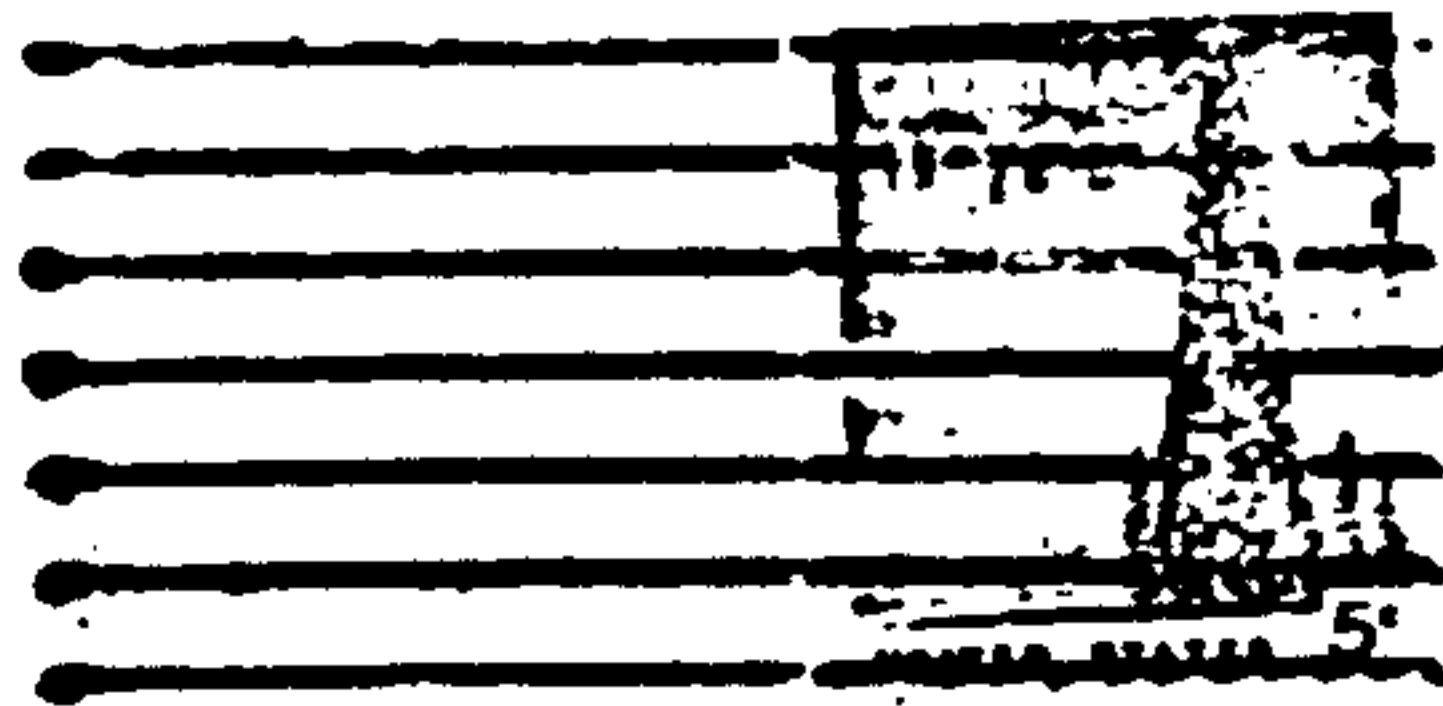

Dear Mr. Ruby:


I am sorry you are now in an unpleasant situation and hope, God willing, that it will not turn out too hard for you. The good Lord led me to write you this morning and so here it comes.

I am enclosing a copy of a letter which I sent to Senator Olin D. Johnston on the margin of which I inked a little note this morning. This letter to the Senator contains some Scriptural ideas which your lawyer may be able to use in your defense. If you must suffer the supreme punishment, I would like to see you first, God willing, get a defense that will shake the whole United States.

But though we should live to be a thousand and then die and go to the wrong place, what would the profit be after a few billion years in a place of torment which God, who never lies, speaks of in His Word? Accordingly, I am sending you some Christmas literature, which I hope will be a blessing to you and to others.

If I can be of any further help to you, God willing, please write to me.

Dear Senator Johnston:

I noticed in "The Anderson Independent" that you are co-sponsoring an "Assassin Death Law." After prayer, I was led of the Lord to write you and so here it is. You know far more than I do in the area of legislation and Man's laws; but this letter will show you that I am behind you, and if it contains any ideas which you can fire as ammunition in the fight for the right, please feel free to use them.

Let me say here that our fine President Kennedy was only three months older than I, and his death hurt me badly. I would have been willing to take the bullets for him that he might live and serve.

I congratulate you on your stand on that new assassin law. If the good President Kennedy had been treacherously shot down like a mad dog in some of our states, his heinous assassin, as a punishment, could have gotten only life imprisonment, not pardoned, to live on as a continuous thorn against justice—a stink against organized society and worse of all—a stink reaching all the way up to God in heaven. Why not a stink? First, because capital punishment for such a crime is of God.

After the flood in the time of Noah God said, "Whoso sheddeth man's blood, his blood shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man." (Gen. 9:6) Then when God gave the Mosaic Law to the Hebrews, He loaded it with capital punishment as can be seen in such references as: Ex. 21:12, 14, 15, 16, 29; 22:18, 19, 20; Dt. 17:2; 22:21, 24; etc. Some possibly quote, "Thou shalt not kill" (Ex. 20:13) (meaning, in the sense of murder) in their stand against capital punishment. However, the same God who gave this command, in the very next two chapters gave all the Exodus references referred to above commanding capital punishment. Some might say, "That's the old Bible." But when we come over into the New Testament we find, "For rulers are a terror to the good work, but to the evil. And wilt thou have no fear of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise from the same: for he is a minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is a minister of God, an avenger for wrath to him that doeth evil." (Rom. 13:3-4) "A sword is not made to spank with, but to kill. Then some might state, "Those were barbaric times: we're too civilized to have capital punishment."

worthy of more punishment (Lk. 12:47-8). Also some might stress God's being a God of love and overlook His holiness and justice, but God pictures Himself as one "that will by no means clear the guilty" (Ex. 34:7). Then there are those who will not recognize God and His Word at all. But this does not change God's truth; and such people are adrift on the wide wide ocean without compass and anchor, where one man's idea may be just as good as another's and who is to judge the difference?

The second reason that to let such a criminal live on would be such an awful stink is that his crime is such rank rebellion against duly constituted authority and against God Himself. As the Scripture from Romans above shows, a ruler is God's minister, God's servant. To rebel against the ruler is to rebel against God. A president stands right under God in the governmental chain of command (Dan. 4:17, 25; Jer. 27:5-6; John 19:10-11). If assassinating a president doesn't merit a punishment of death, then what does—assassinating God? Absurd!

We are now living in awful times—times of great spiritual blindness and ignorance, and rebellion against God's will. And, sorry to say, much of it is found in religious circles, some of whom have opposed capital punishment. Some states, as you know, don't even have capital punishment. Right now assassinating a president, congressman, governor, etc. is just ordinary murder. In God's sight it is not. Senator Johnston, possibly the only critic I would have of your bill is that in my opinion it doesn't go nearly far enough. Why don't you include the president, vice-president, supreme court, congress, governors, etc., and every law enforcement officer? If the states refuse to do their duty before God in this very important matter, then should not the Federal Government take over? If the states had handled themselves properly in the matter of civil rights, the Federal Government would not have had to step in.

According to God's Word, and I believe it, we are heading into "grievous times" (2 Tim. 3:1-5) and it seems we are already in them. What happened to our beloved President is possibly a dark shadow of coming events. When the horse starts bucking is no time to loosen the reins but to tighten them. I respectfully suggest that Congress extend your bill to take more slack out of the reins.

And while taking slack out of the reins, perhaps some committees should be set up to try to conceive of means to effectively impound or deport mad dogs from our society and to improve our system of justice. There were the "spittings on," assassination and attempted assassination in Dallas, the many unsolved murders in Chicago, imported criminals, etc. Perhaps a group might visit other nations to try to learn any better ways of handling undesirables. In this area we might be able to learn a lesson from Russia. Also, our American system of justice, with its trials—retrials, "peals"—repeals, and long drawn out legal proceedings with wrangles,

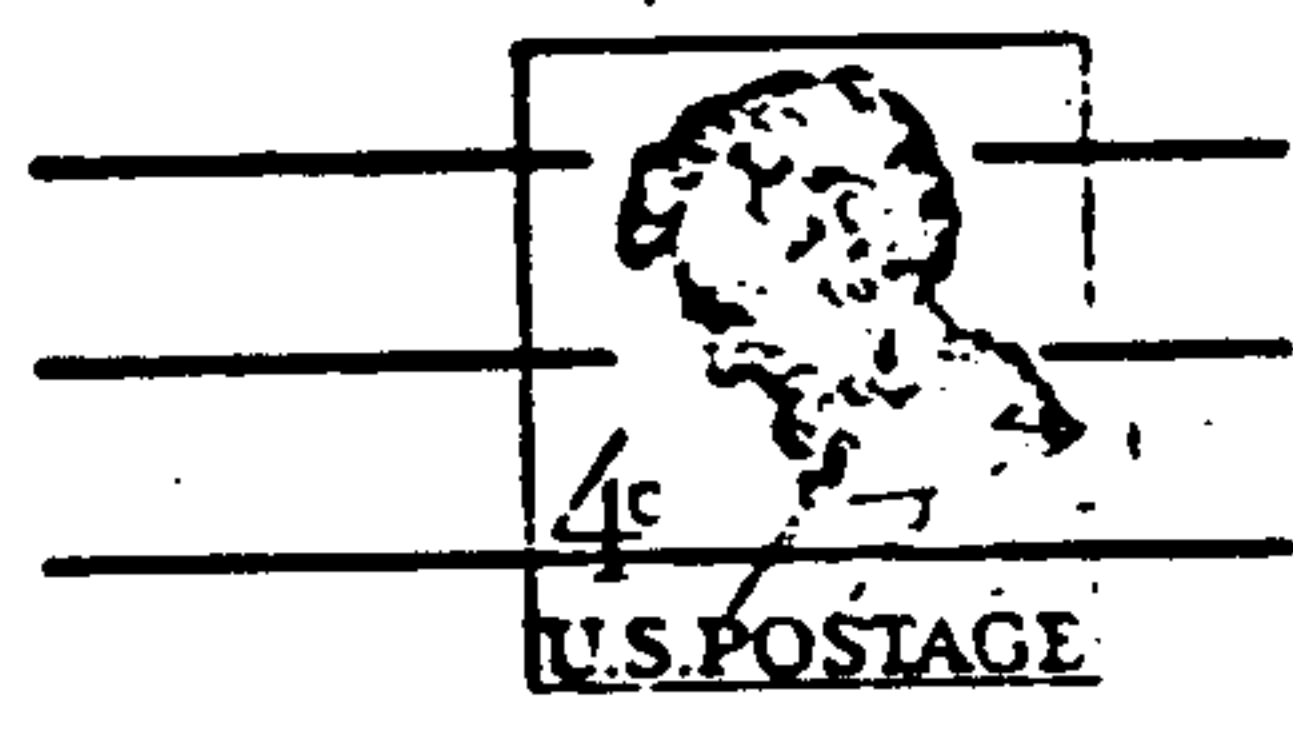
dispatched so quickly—His justice. From the Human law side I
am not saying Ruby was right. But if Oswald had been tried with
a smart lawyer and communist funds backing him up, he might have
lived to a ripe old age with American justice stinking but good,
and all of us having to eat mud in the eyes of the world while
communists just laughed. Where would Texas ever have found an
impartial jury? Twelve penguins? Perhaps laws should be chang-
ed so that service men could be drawn for jury duty from isolated
polar and other regions in an emergency. Concerning the slowness
of the American judicial system, by the time some criminals reach
the chair, many people may have forgotten the crimes they committed.
Why should not a presidential assassin, if caught red handed, be
dangling from the gallows in one or two weeks? He likely would
be in some countries. And where does the American system get the
concept that a man is innocent until proven guilty. That's little
man's idea—not God's. The Lord said, "but I say unto you, that
every one that locketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed
adultery with her already in his heart." (Mt. 5:28) When all the
evidence is in, it will possibly be apparent Ruby didn't kill a
little white lily and this, if true, should be taken into consider-
ation in his trial. We are responsible before God to do justice,
whether little man's laws exactly fit or not. Maybe what the Ameri-
can judicial system needs is for a McNamara of justice to take
hold of it, write a standard streamlined code for use in all states
and throw out the cobwebs and buggy wheels. I thank God that it
SHALL be done, when He comes whose right it is to reign forever,
Rev. 19:11-16. Then perhaps a lot of lawyers could go into other
work! No more flyspecks to pick out of the pepper!

Senator Johnston, you're a God fearing man and I hope you will
keep up the good work as long as the Lord enables you. If America
as we know it is to be saved or go forward, as President Johnson
indicated, we need action. I voted for you at the throne of God—
the greatest and most powerful poll in the universe. May God bless
you.
