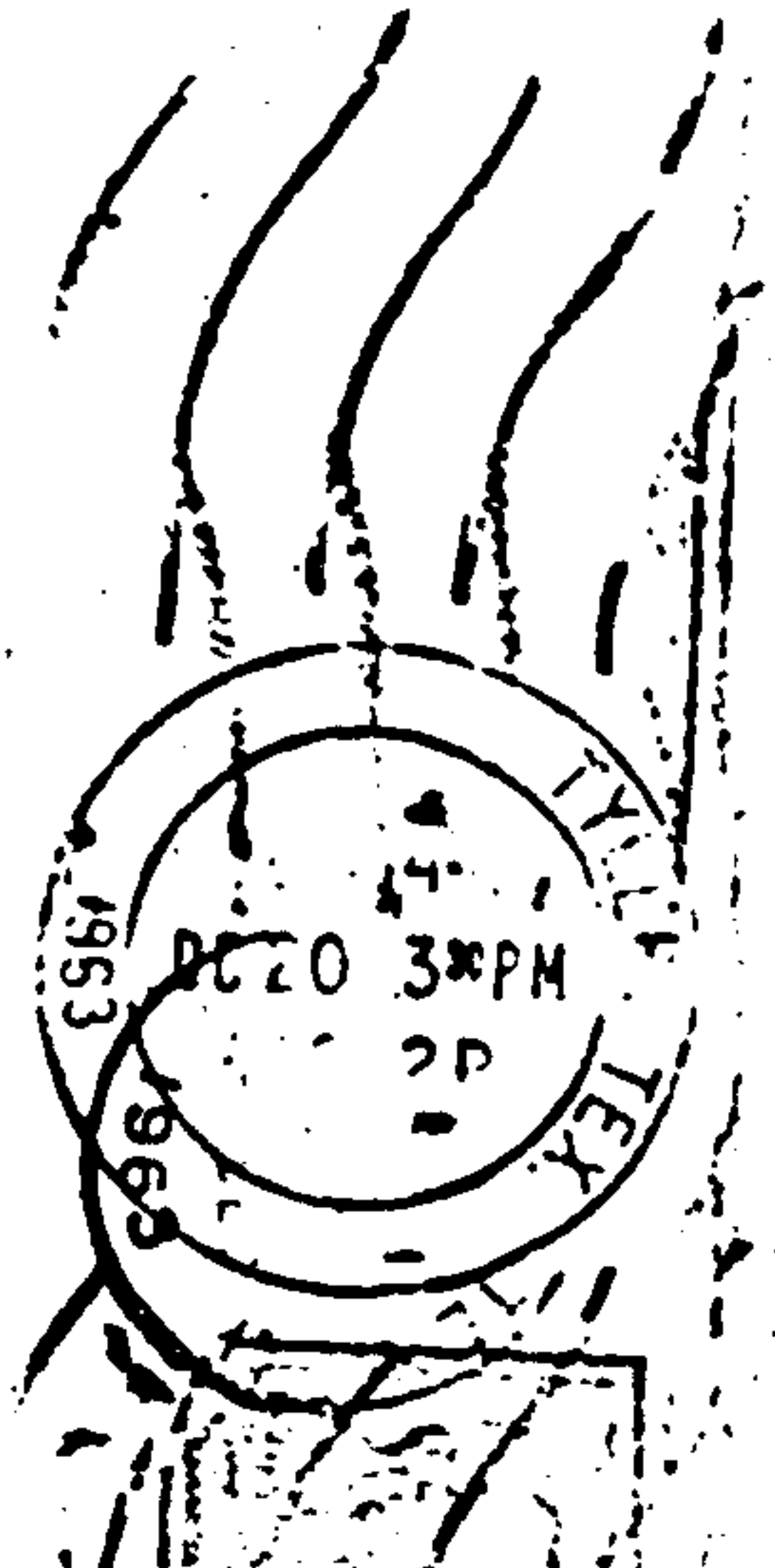

7. And Philip said, if thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest and he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

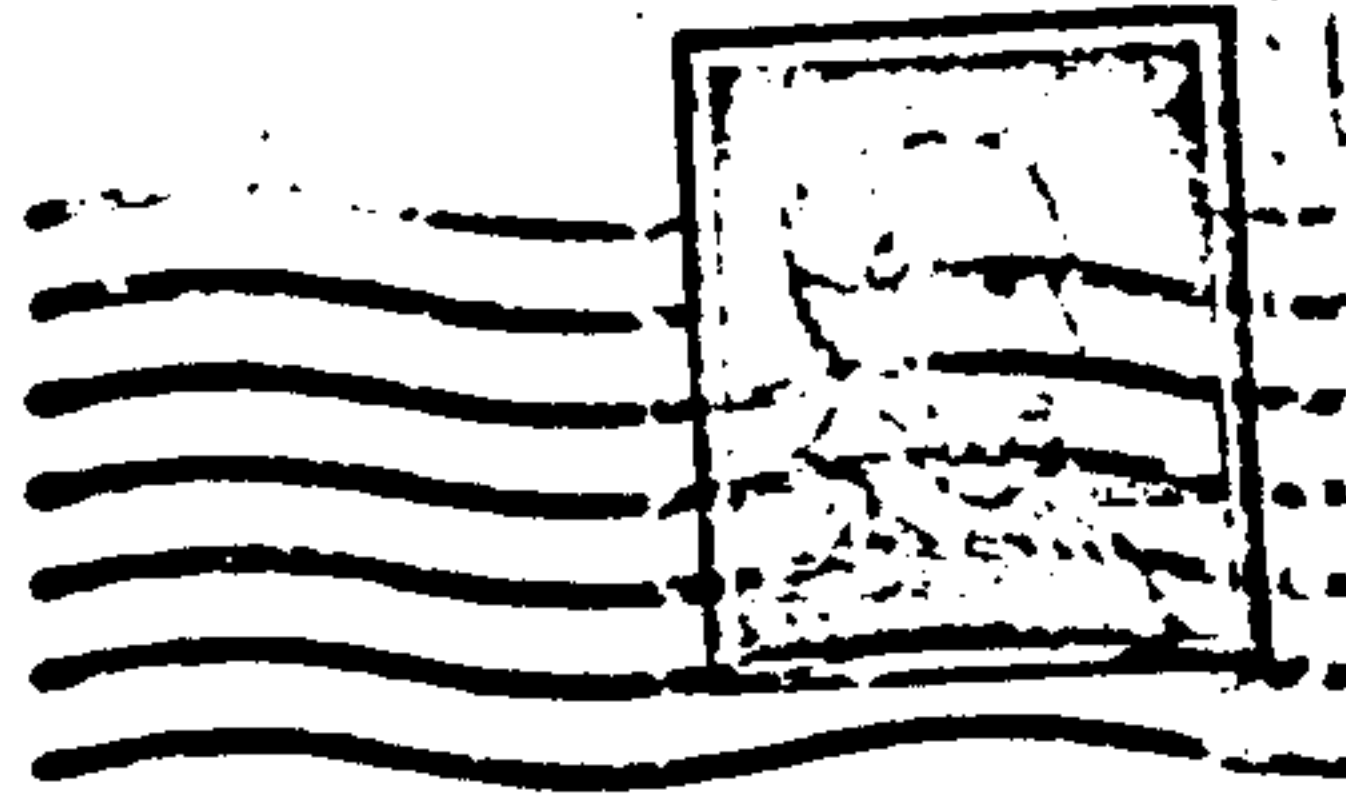
