Communist ignorance pollutes the stream of life because it springs from a cesspool. Their material science acquires intelligence from the morgue as they kill all life on earth.

What value, communism which guides humanity to nothingness and leaves them bewildered and fearful. Great problems indeed! When communism wishes to be king and the people are hoodwinked into the acceptance of communism, there are great problems.

When the value of authority is in its power, not in its intelligence, this absurdity creates great problems. Justice yields to power. Truth, integrity, honor, and all things yield to power determining its own value, which being worthless, bankrupts the world.

The communist call to life echoes in a vacant temple, a form without intelligence. Contentiousness over worthless forms is like quarrelling over a corpse. We are a people who know that Khrushchev and communism are the abuse of liberty, disrespect for law and political bandits, undermining the foundation of all life. Behind their benevolent paternalism is concealed the purpose of maintaining the value of political authority by subordinating all principles.

Dearest Brother Jack:

I hope and pray that this letter finds you physically well and spiritually uplifted with time.

The weather has been quite unusual this week, and the previous weeks it was quite cold — dipping to the zeros and below.

Do you remember away back in 1933 or 1934 when we had one of those terrific rain storms (maybe it was a hurricane) and during the night when you got up to close the windows in your room and happen to look outside and there was our back porch sailing away from the building and what a screaming went on. I know I must of hid in that closet in the hall, at 624 Independence Boulevard.

Well, last Sunday we experienced a similar storm. But this was just a terrific wind — fifty miles per hour — and not by automobile either. Being so close to the lake — the sand blew through every crack and crevice. We have sand on the dishes, on furniture and in every corner. The wind just forced the transom down and after many efforts to keep it closed, I had to nailed it in place, and waittill the manager of the apartment building see it, with all its nail holes. I will try and paint over them. The next morning when I walked down the street to take the elevated to work, there was sand all the way to Sheridan Rd. 
