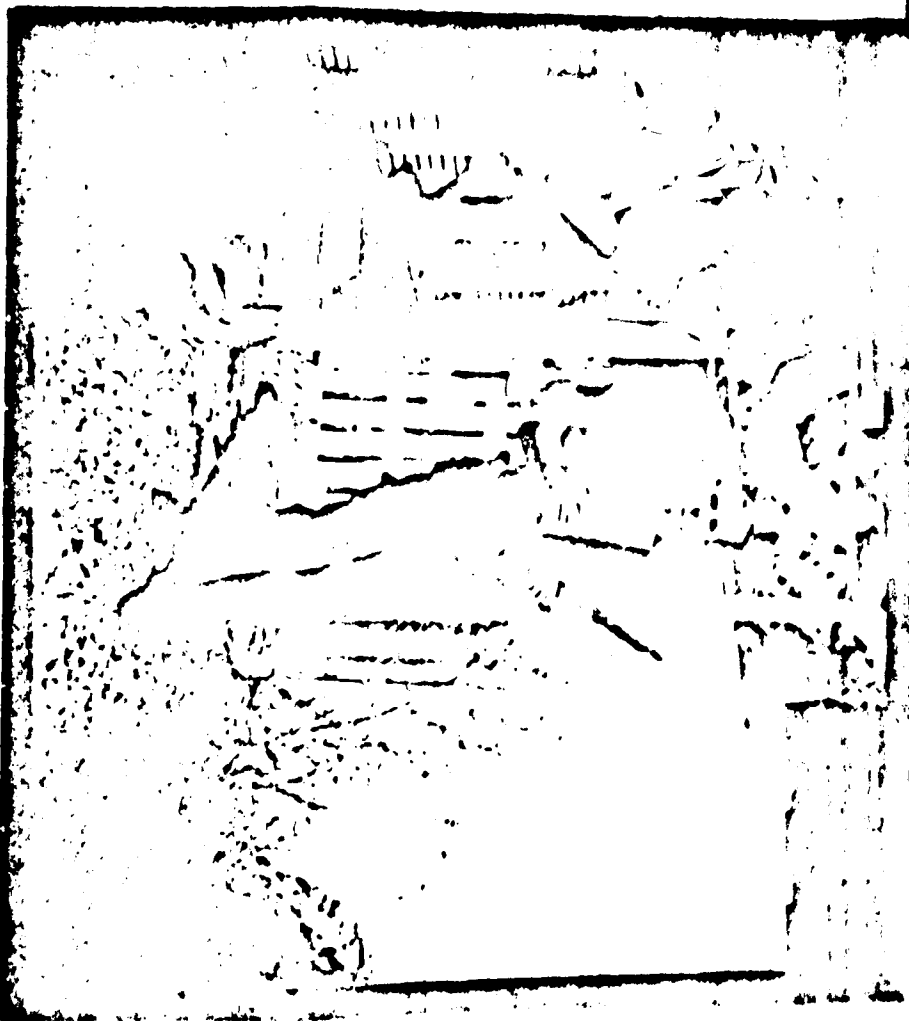

## *Lecture topics:*

### "EUROPE AFTER HELSINKI"

In 1975, in the capital of Finland, European nations plus Canada and the United States signed a declaration (Final Act of Helsinki) which represents the groundwork for a "modus vivendi" in political and economic relations between the two halves of Europe - the western democracies and the socialist states of the East. Oltmans reviews concrete and realistic possibilities about developments in Europe during the late seventies and early eighties.

### "USSR IN 1990"

Between 1971 - 1976, Oltmans made ten long journeys throughout the Soviet Union. His aim was to study the creation of what the Kremlin calls, "A New Marxist Man." Oltmans presents an objective view of a European, born and raised in the west (he studied at Yale University Political Science in the class of 1950) of the first Marxist-Leninist social laboratory in the world.

Since 1956, Oltmans, then stationed in the capital of Indonesia, has reported on developments in Asia. He recently held lengthy conversations with Mrs. Indira Gandhi, and he met with Prime Minister Kakuei Tanaka in Japan, Prime Minister Lee Kuan Yew in Singapore and President Subarto in Indonesia. In early 1977 he visited Taiwan. His twenty years of inside information on the most densely populated area of the planet will present audiences with the valuable and unique experience of sharing with the author the information he has collected over the years from his unique vantage point.

William Oltmans is celebrating his 25th year in international journalism with a return-performance on the lecture-platform where he has an enviable record of repeat engagements.

American audiences first came to know the young Dutch journalist and author, then, in his early thirties. Since his first tours, he has much learned and gained, not only in conceptual understanding of the international situation, but in his widening personal contacts and experiences on all five continents. His national and international top-notch contacts and personal friendships, built over a period of a quarter of a century of reporting, will be shared with his audiences in his personalized inside-story presentation of world scene as seen through a reporter's eye.

... important story and I think you might as well have it on tape. And I'm looking for no kind of extra-carefulness. I will not be precise if I can't be sure that when I just talk with "intelligence" I feel better about it.

I tell you what happened. I appeared for the committee of assassination on the 11th of February at the request of the committee who had heard that I had done for television a lot of research on the Kennedy assassination and done a lot of television films with Jim Garrison, and Hall and ... and all these people. So I came on the 11th of February and I listened to them for an hour. In the chair was deputy chief counsel Robert Tammann with four others, ... Klein and some others. Spague was not there. In annex two. I sort of felt my way. What is this committee and what do they want to know and I didn't want to tell them too much. I was on my way to Dallas, anyway and I had the feeling that something was going to happen there. So I shut up a little bit. And I came to Dallas on the 23rd of February to address the Mary Craig club, it's one of those classy ladies' clubs, and it was a repeat performance. And I called the lawyer of Mr. George B. deMohrenschildt. You'll find him in the ... 2 500 pages, a Russian count and petroleum engineer, <sup>in</sup> emigrated to the U.S., <sup>before the war,</sup> became a citizen in 1949, worked for some of the big oil companies and was Lee Harvey Oswald's closest friend.

Q: A friend of Marina, too.

A: A friend of Marina, too.

Q: A member of the Dallas Russian Community.

A: Right.

So I'll tell you what happened. In 1966, I went to talk to the Mary Crain class in Dallas, and flew from Kennedy to Dallas on an American Airlines plane and who was on the flight - ... Oswald, the mother. So I said to ... I went to her and I said "May I sit with you" and she said, "How do you know who I am." I said, "The whole world knows you," and so that started nicely and I talked for two and a half hours <sup>during</sup> the flight with her. And that set me off on, well maybe Oswald was not alone. It started ... because I'm a ... journalist, I'm 25 years working with United Nations headquarters. I went to the Kennedy funeral, I thought it was a very sad affair but I accepted more or less the Warren report and I'm not in that kind of reporting at all. But ... Oswald planted with me a seed of maybe something is ... So I

clearly...

may have been... the large circle of the Kennedy assassination... any do... street and... office... deMohrenschildt has something to do with it and I'm going to phone him and I need protection. My television station wants me to report it to them... and maybe Bobby has an idea.

Rosa Kennedy... at 1 o'clock... in the...  
Made a... told him. Rosa Kennedy picked up the phone and called Edgar Hoover. She put the chief of the criminal division on the job. At 4 o'clock that same afternoon that Monday... the end of April, 1963, three months before the Kennedy assassination. Then the FBI came to my house... They stayed for two hours asking questions and I played dumb and said, ask my boss in the... I'm only a messenger boy. They said you are from now on... The next evening I drive on West Side Drive and I... had an automobile accident and... and a car is next to me and at a certain moment I had the wrong reflex the car cut me off and I hit the island my car was totally demolished. I went to the hospital... story, I leave the country. I said this is not kosher, I'm going. The day after I asked the FBI. So after a year I filmed George... show, 35 minutes in Dallas, this is live in Dallas. It was half a year later, it was Oct. 15, 1968. And then in 1969, I liked him, but I knew instinctively he was full of shit. So in 1969 I went again to... and taped in the CBS studio in Dallas 9 hours Mr. and Mrs. de Mohren on the entire world affair from beginning to end. One of the tapes is now with the commission they sent for it and I gave it to them. I also gave them a complete... television film... all the films I did the Kennedy assassination. Over the years till this year I have visited DeMohrenschildt at least twice or three times a year.

Q: How bold is he//

A: BS. I became very very pleasant friends with them. And I have a correspondence of some hundred letters in long hand from deMohrenschildt and me to Holland and back. I left Dallas in November of last year... from the West coast and I called routinely to the

he has had the best shock treatment anybody can get, but I said "Fate, this man I've known for ten years, winning all the tennis cups in Dallas, [REDACTED] jogging everyday for three miles always something, how could this happen, how can this man from one day to the next go into a mental hospital?" He said well it's a very strange thing we don't know exactly what happened but suddenly one day he was crazy. Now this is what happened. [REDACTED] George de Moreschild started to write a book about [REDACTED] world affair and the book was ready the first week of June last year 1976. He wrote me in January 1976 and said that he was writing the book and doing two pages on me and he sent me the pages and asked that I agree to the pages. I sent him ten pages back because I said your pages are very bad because there is so much more on it and here is the whole story. And he wrote me back and said that I am amazed that you write so well and that I would be included in the book. In June the book was ready.

Q: Who published it?

A: The manuscript was ready. His wife read it and hit the ceiling, if you publish this book, you'll go to jail. Because it linked into the assassination. He mentioned names of CIA and FBI people from beginning to end. This book is apparently something that is very unpleasant for a number of people. So he now says that the moment that book was finished, his wife read it. One day he felt terrible and he felt [REDACTED] sure he was drugged. After a few weeks he was absolutely sure that he was drugged with LSD or [REDACTED] he was drugged and he became incoherent and then was brought to a mental hospital. There he stayed for three months. He was treated by a doctor called by the name of Mendoza. Now I don't know and I was in the process of working on it but the Hospital --- he has disappeared from the U.S. in the meantime so I couldn't get the story in the meantime.

A: So he was in ~~the~~ hospital and I came on the 23rd of Feb. to Dallas for the . . . George is out of the hospital, his wife left him for good, he's in California, he is getting one hour a day French ~~lessons~~ ~~lessons~~ in ~~French~~ Dallas, and he is still very, very nervous, but he's here or less all night. I said can I have lunch with you? And he said yes - ~~well~~ we will have lunch at 12:30 at the . . . club on the 23rd of Feb., and I'll see if George wants to join us. And damnit, I came there and there was George, Mr. Russo, a friend of Mr. Russo and me. Now, when I saw this guy, ~~I simply~~ ~~couldn't~~ believe my eyes. From one year to the other, he was a totally different person. He was scared, frightened, strange man. I was absolutely - it was UNBELIEVABLE. And he said to me in French, during the lunch, he whispered, he talked very slowly, softly, that he had been waiting for me to show up and that he needed to talk to me immediately. Now ~~????~~ wasn't too anxious for me to take off with George. I don't know why. ~~/////~~ in this affair is still an enigma to me, he does not speak much. Anyway, he had set it up so I would ~~as~~ his friend sightseeing at the zoo in Dallas, or some idiotic thing, and I didn't give a damn, so I went to George. So for 11 years I told the guy, I knew he was lying, at least keeping for possible that Oswald loved Kennedy and would have never shot Kennedy and Oswald was - I always listened to him, I never wrote those years a single line. I kept working, I shut up. I said no, I waited. I waited, I waited. And damnit, He dragged me to Bishop College on the afternoon of the 23rd of Feb., and we sat down in the library. And the opening statement was the following: How would it hit the media if I came out and said that I feel responsible for Oswald's behavior? I said, in other words, what Oswald did? and I said to him shot or not shot but he was involved in the shooting. You got links here to the shooting of the president of the United States. He said, I realize that and I don't want to incriminate myself directly. But I ~~am~~ ~~am~~ convinced and I know that Oswald, what Oswald finally set up ~~we~~ completely we completely agreed upon. I said, but you were in Haiti at the day of the assassination. He said, ~~EE~~ yes, and he laughed about that. And then we talked for ~~about~~ one and a half hours. I was asking questions but - you see, here was a guy very cleverly saying, look, of course Oswald, I knew exactly what Oswald was going to do and I have proof of it. I said, but how - well, because, we both hit on America. This society is going down, Kennedy was a symbol

before, Mr. [redacted] I said Carlo, it takes 13 years but he starts talking. What shall I do? He's very nervous, he's off his knocker, but even crazy persons have clear ~~present~~ moments, you know. It At least it seemed to me for the first time that this nervous situation was much more. For 15 years you bullshitted about it. So he said yes, I want to R, I want to. They injected me the "indecision drug", things like that ..... Then I left for Houston. I continued my trip. Then from Houston I called him and he said, well, I ~~will~~ still want very much to talk to you. I won't go to Holland but I still want to talk to you very much. So I called / / / television and . . . . waste of time, but . . . . go back. So I flew back on the 27th of February to Dallas and checked into the Daily Plaza

As I have bought paintings at the Bishop College and a girl and  
Negro boyfriend of mine and my apartment is empty. We'll pack and we'll  
go to Holland now to Bishop and we dragged my . . . to Houston to  
. . . I said, okay. I'll drive because I don't trust you driving.  
So we drove in his car to Bishop College and from 1715, picked up the  
luggage, drove all night to Houston, checked into the Holiday Inn,  
I called for the tickets and we flew on Eastern Airlines first class  
at noon to Kennedy. Bought the damn tickets, something was wrong. I  
was so mad I checked into the Waldorf Astoria and he changed t  
very much then on the way we left Dallas and he became like the man I had  
known. He relaxed. He became the . . . friends of mine in New  
York for dinner and we flew the next morning at 10 o'clock Pan  
Am Jumbo jet at London. We arrived at 9 in the evening and stayed  
at the Britannia Hotel, we had dinner with friends of mine. He relaxed  
some more and we arrived in Amsterdam on Mar. 3 at 1:30 in the afternoon.  
In the evening we had the first meeting he stayed at my house in  
Amsterdam, with the head of Dutch Television, and he ~~confirmed~~ confirmed

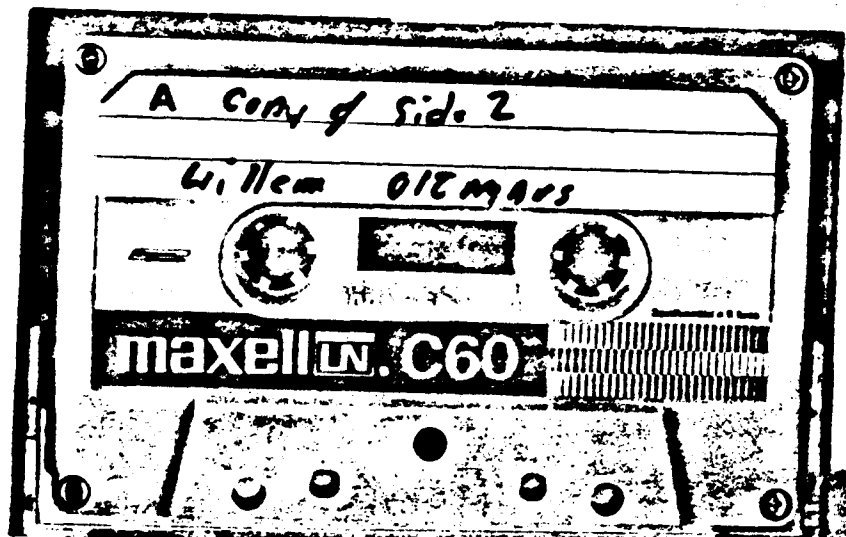
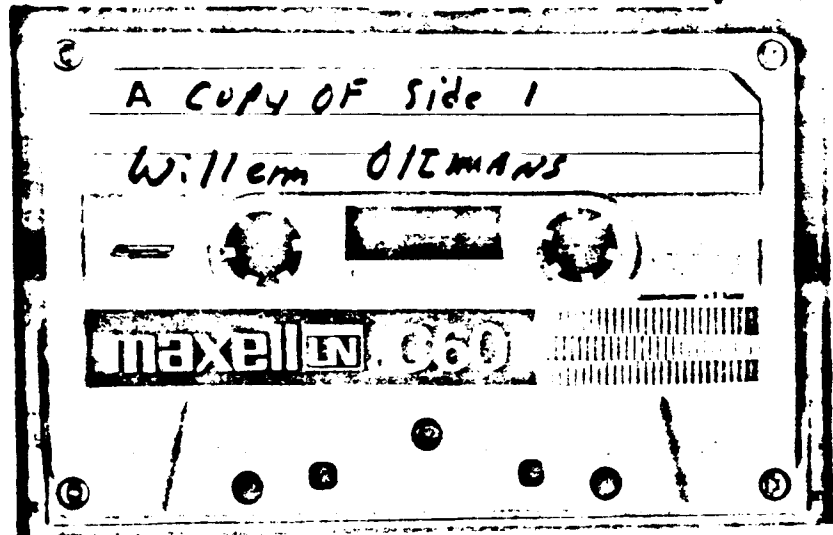

We did a good interview with Lester, and would like to know a little more about his discovery. Unfortunately, he didn't weigh or photograph the bullet he found.

According to the Washington Post, the House Assassinations Committee has forbidden the National Archives to loan the test bullet from the Warren Commission investigation to the FBI Lab for comparison with Lester's bullet. This makes no sense at all, since the test bullets aren't primary evidence in the case.

We'd like to use the Lester interview, but the story is incomplete. Could you let us have a photo of the bullet, with a description of its weight and rifling characteristics? We could then show these to Colonel William H. Hanson, of San Antonio, who seems to be the most responsible assassination student in this area, and get his opinion.
