

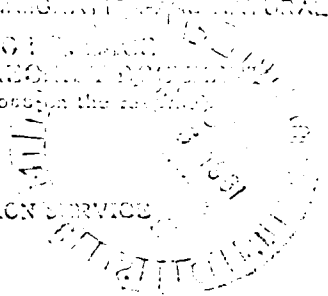

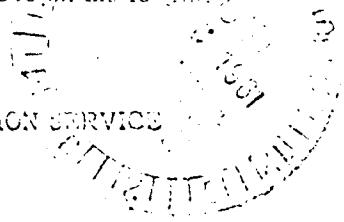

5. That this Affidavit is made for the purpose of establishing the fact of the legal entry into the United States of said ANN RUBENSTEIN VOLPERT.

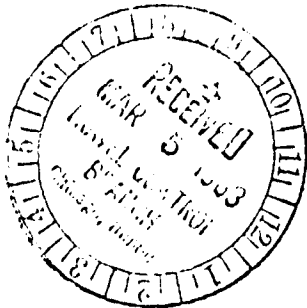

Joseph A. Glowacki, Dallas, Texas, has advised he was in the downtown area of Dallas, Texas, on the afternoon of November 22, 1963, accompanied by Krystian Barcz, a Polish National who was visiting in the United States on a State Department Study Grant. During the afternoon, Glowacki and Barcz stopped at Ritz Delicatessen for lunch and, while there, Glowacki observed Jack Ruby, whom he introduced to Mr. Barcz. Ruby engaged them in conversation concerning the tragedy of the President's assassination and the effect the incident would have on business in Dallas.

On December 2, 1963, Mr. Barcz related to Mr. Carl Sharek, Polish Desk Officer, Soviet Bloc, U. S. Information Agency, Washington, D. C., the incident of his having been in a Dallas, Texas, restaurant on November 22, 1963, and having met an individual referred to as "Jack." "Jack" commented on the horrible thing that had happened, and that Dallas and Texas would be blamed for the assassination. Mr. Barcz was subsequently amazed to learn that Jack L. Ruby, who killed Lee Harvey Oswald, President Kennedy's assassin, on November 24, 1963, was identical with "Jack," whom he had met on the afternoon of November 22, 1963.

The President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy has requested re-interviews with Mr. Joseph A. Glowacki, above, and with Mr. Barcz, if he can be readily located, to determine as precisely as possible the time at which they saw Ruby in Ritz Delicatessen on the afternoon of November 22, 1963. It was further requested Mr. Barcz be asked for any additional information he has regarding Ruby's conduct at the time.

Files indicate Mr. Barcz returned to Warsaw, Poland, and is connected with radio and television in that city.
