RE/ FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA

HAROLD GORDON ALDERMAN, SIX TWO THREE TWO DELORD ST., NEW ORLEANS, LA, ADVISED SA/S JOHN W. SMITH AND DEAN S. LYTLE NOV. TWENTYSIX, SIXTYTHREE THAT IN THE SUMMER OF SIXTYTHREE ANOTHER GRADUATE STUDENT AT TULANE UNIVERSITY, HUGH MURRAY, FURNISHED HIM A HANDBILL WHICH HAD REPORTEDLY BEEN DISTRIBUTED AT THE TULANE LIBRARY. THE HANDBILL WAS UNDER THE NAME OF THE FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA COMMITTEE AND CONTAINED THEREON THE STAMPED DESIGNATION QUOTE A J HIDELL, POST OFFICE BOX THREE ZERO ZERO SIX ONE, NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA UNQUOTE. ALDERMAN DID NOT FOLLOW IT UP BY CORRESPONDENCE WITH HIDELL, NOR DOES HE KNOW ANYONE WHO SAW THE PERSON WHO DISSEMINATED THE HANDBILL OR CORRESPONDED WITH HIDELL. ALDERMAN ACKNOWLEDGED SYMPATHY WITH THE AIMS OF THE FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA COMMITTEE AND ACTIVITY FOR THE FPCC IN PICKET LINES IN WASHINGTON, D. C. AND SEATTLE, WASH., ADDITIONAL TO ACQUIRING FPCC LITERATURE IN NEW YORK CITY. HE SAID, HOWEVER HE DID NOT JOIN THE FPCC COMMITTEE, BECAUSE HE CONSIDERS MEMBERSHIP OF SAME MORE MOTIVATED EMOTIONALLY THEN POLITICALLY. KNOWS OF NO ORGANIZED FPCC ACTIVITY IN NEW ORLEANS AREA, NOR DOES HE KNOW LEE HARVEY OSWALD OR JACK LEON RUBY.

HE RECALLS IT WAS TITLED QUOTE HANDS OFF CUBA UNQUOTE AND SPONSORED BY THE FPCC COMMITTEE. HE RECALLS THAT IT HAD A NAME AND BOX NO. STAMPED ON IT BUT DOES NOT RECALL THE DESIGNATION. HE SAID HE KNOWS NO ONE WHO FOLLOWED UP THE HANDBILL BY CORRESPONDENCE AND HE DOES NOT RECALL EVER HAVING MET LEE HARVEY OSWALD OR JACK LEON RUBY.

RE RUBY/S VISIT TO NEW ORLEANS, LA. LA

LEON CORNMAN, BRANCH MANAGER, AMERICAN GUILD OF VARIETY ARTISTS /AGVA/ NEW ORLEANS, ADVISED SA JAMES E. SCHMIDT, NOVEMBER TWENTYSIX CORNMAN RECALLED THAT ONE MORNING BETWEEN TWELVE O/CLOCK MIDNIGHT AND ONE AM APPROXIMATELY SIX MONTHS AGO ON BOURBON ST., NEW ORLEANS, A WHITE MALE

APPROACHED HIM AND INTRODUCED HIMSELF AS JACK RUBY. THIS INDIVIDUAL ADVISED CORNMAN HE WAS THE OPERATOR OF THE CAROUSEL IN DALLAS, TEXAS AND THAT HE WAS IN NEW ORLEANS TO ATTEMPT TO RECRUIT JADA /JEANETTE CONFORTO/, AN ENTERTAINER WHO WAS THEN PERFORMING AT THE SHO BAR, NEW ORLEANS. LA

RUBY STATED HE WAS ALSO INTERESTED IN OBTAINING GIRLS TO WORK FOR HIM AT THE CAROUSEL. AT THE TIME OF CONTACT RUBY WAS ALONE AND DID NOT GIVE ANY SPECIFIC DETAILS AS TO HAVING CONTACTED OTHER SHOW PLACES IN NEW ORLEANS NOR DID HE MENTION AT THAT TIME HIS MODE OF TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM NEW ORLEANS OR HIS PLACE OF ABODE WHILE IN NEW ORLEANS.

CORNMAN ADVISED THAT HE BELIEVED THIS CONTACT WAS MADE JUST PRIOR TO THE COMPLETION OF JADA/S CONTRACT AT THE SHO BAR, SHORTLY AFTER WHICH SHE WORKED UNDER CONTRACT FOR RUBY AT THE CAROUSEL. 7/1/53 HE SUGGESTED THE BUSINESS BRANCH MANAGER, TOM PALMER OF THE DALLAS DIVISION OF AGVA MAY BE ABLE TO GIVE AN APPROXIMATE DATE WHEN JADA BEGAN WORKING FOR RUBY AND SHOW WHEN RUBY WAS IN NEW ORLEANS.

RUBY, WHEN CONTACTING CORNMAN PRESENTED HIS BUSINESS CARD FOR THE CAROUSEL WITH THE INK NOTATION ON THE BACK OF CARD QUOTE JACK RUBY WH ONE DASH FIVE SIX ZERO ONE HOME UNQUOTE. CORNMAN INDICATED HE BELIEVED THIS WAS RUBY/S HOME PHONE IN DALLAS, TEX.

RE BACKGROUND OF JACK RUBY.

HERBERT CHARLES DAVID KELLY, UNEMPLOYED RESTAURANT MANAGER, NEW ORLEANS, ADVISED SA/S L. M. SHEARER AND FURMAN G. BOGGAN NOVEMBER TWENTYSIX, SIXTYTHREE, THAT HE WAS EMPLOYED BY JACK LEON RUBY IN DALLAS FOR APPROXIMATELY ONE YEAR DURING NINETEEN FIFTYNINE AND NINETEEN SIXTY, AS MANAGER OF KITCHEN AND FOOD OPERATIONS AT THE SOVERIGN CLUB, A HIGH CLASS MEMBERSHIP SUPPER CLUB WHICH WAS THEN OPERATED AT THE SITE OF THE PRESENT CAROUSEL CLUB.

KELLY CLAIMED HAD MET RUBY THROUGH DALLAS INDIVIDUALS IN FOOD SERVICE FIELD, KELLY HAVING BEEN FORMERLY EMPLOYED AS FOOD DIRECTOR OF EATING ESTABLISHMENTS IN TITCHES DEPARTMENT STORE, DALLAS. KELLY LEFT EMPLOYMENT WITH RUBY BECAUSE OF ILLNESS AND WAS HOSPITALIZED IN VA HOSPITAL, DALLAS, FOR PERIOD OF ABOUT YEAR FOLLOWING EMPLOYMENT. WHEN RELEASED FROM HOSPITAL KELLY DID NOT RETURN TO RUBY/S EMPLOY AS IN INTERIM RUBY HAD DISPENSED WITH SERVICE OF FOOD AT SOVERIGN CLUB.

KELLY QUESTIONED EXTENSIVELY CONCERNING RUBY/S BACKGROUND, ASSOCIATES, AND CONNECTIONS WITH DALLAS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS. KELLY CLAIMS RUBY SAID HE CAME FROM CHICAGO AREA ABOUT FIFTEEN YEARS AGO AND BELIEVES RUBY MAY HAVE BEEN ASSOCIATED WITH SOME UNKNOWN UNION IN CHICAGO AREA AND MAY HAVE LEFT CHICAGO BECAUSE OF DIFFICULTY WITH UNION. KELLY COULD NOT PIN THIS BELIEF DOWN STATING IT WAS OPINION FORMED AS RESULT OF GENERAL CONVERSATION WITH RUBY OVER ONE YEAR PERIOD.

KELLY ADVISED THAT ENTERTAINERS ~~BRECK~~ WALL AND ~~JOE~~ PETERSON, NOW APPEARING IN SHOW AT ADOLPHUS HOTEL, ENTERTAINED AT THE SOVERIGN CLUB, DALLAS, TEXAS, AND POSSIBLY HAD FINANCIAL INTEREST IN SOVERIGN CLUB. KELLY CLAIMED RUBY ONCE HIT JOE PETERSON IN ARGUMENT OVER PETERSON/S DESIRE TO SEE CLUB FINANCIAL RECORDS. LEO PAREN LNU END PAREN BARTENDER AT SOVERIGN CLUB BELIEVED BY KELLY LONG TIME ASSOCIATE OF RUBY. KELLY STATES PAUL PAREN LNU END PAREN A BANKER, APPROXIMATELY SIXTY YEARS, SHORT, MEDIUM BUILD, POSSIBLY WITH REPUBLIC NATIONAL BANK, OCCASIONALLY LOANED MONEY TO RUBY IN NINETEEN FIFTYNINE AND PAUL/S NAME APPEARED AS COUNTER SIGNATURE ON CLUB/S PAYROLL CHECKS DRAWN ON REPUBLIC NATIONAL BANK. KELLY STATES RUBY ONCE HIT KEITH ~~WILLIAMS~~, WILLIAMS OIL COMPANY PROMOTER, FOR GIVING RUBY SIXTY DOLLAR WORTHLESS CHECK.

KELLY QUESTIONED AT LENGTH RE IDENTITY OF CLOSE LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSOCIATES OF RUBY AND EXTENT OF CLOSENESS BETWEEN RUBY AND THESE OFFICERS. KELLY CLAIMED HE KNEW NONE OF THEM BY NAME ALTHOUGH RUBY/S OFFICER FRIENDS COMPRISED OF DETECTIVES, UNIFORMED POLICE OF ALL RANKS AS WELL AS SHERIFF/S DEPUTIES. KELLY CLAIMED WHILE HE WAS ASSOCIATED WITH RUBY, LATTER HAD WHAT HE CALLED QUOTE CELEBRETU NIGHT UNQUOTE EACH SUNDAY EVENING ON WHICH OCCASIONS RUBY WOULD ENTERTAIN AS MANY AS EIGHT DIFFERENT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS GIVING THEM STEAK DINNERS AND DRINKS. KELLY CLAIMS HE QUESTIONED RUBY/S PURPOSE FOR THIS DUE TO COST OF SUCH ENTERTAINMENT AND RUBY REPLIED HE LIKED POLICE OFFICERS AND THESE MEN HAD LITTLE MONEY TO SPEND FOR PERSONAL ENTERTAINMENT. KELLY CLAIMED TO HIS KNOWLEDGE RUBY NOT THEN ENGAGED IN ANY ILLEGAL ACTIVITY AND HAD NO REASON TO CULL FAVOR OF DALLAS POLICE.. KELLY COULD RECALL NO INCIDENT WHERE RUBY ENTERTAINED OFFICIALS OF DALLAS CITY GOVERNMENT, CLAIMING RUBY RESTRICTED HIS FRIENDS TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS. KELLY DESCRIBED RUBY AS QUOTE POLICE BUFF UNQUOTE, A PERSON WHO HAD A NATURAL LIKING FOR MEN IN LAW ENFORCEMENT FIELD. KELLY INDICATED THERE WERE INSTANCES

WHEN IT APPEARED THAT RUBY WAS FURNISHING CRIMINAL INFORMATION TO POLICE OFFICERS ON INFORMANT BASIS.

KELLY SAID DURING NINETEEN FIFTYNINE RUBY WAS OWNER OR OPERATOR OF VEGAS CLUB WHICH HE DESCRIBED AS QUOTE HONKY TONK UNQUOTE, PATRONIZED BY QUOTE LEVI AND BLACK LEATHER JACKET CROWD UNQUOTE. KELLY SAID RUBY EMPLOYED AN EXPOLICEMAN, NAME UNKNOWN, AS BOUNCER AT VEGAS CLUB. KELLY SAID VEGAS CLUB NOT TYPE OF BAR WHICH WOULD BE FREQUENTED BY PEOPLE OF GOOD CHARACTER, HOWEVER DENIED ANY KNOWLEDGE OF PROSTITUTION, B DRINKING NARCOTICS ACTIVITY OR GAMBLING IN THIS PLACE AND DENIED KNOWLEDGE IT MIGHT HAVE BEEN TROUBLE SPOT FOR POLICE.

KELLY SAID RUBY LIVED WITH LATTER/S SISTER WHEN KELLY ASSOCIATED WITH HIM. HE DESCRIBED RUBY AS EXTREMELY INTERESTED IN MAKING AS MUCH MONEY AS HE COULD AND RELUCTANT TO TURN LOOSE OF MONEY. CITED AS EXAMPLE THAT FREQUENTLY RUBY WOULD FAIL TO PAY EMPLOYEES AT END OF EACH WEEK SOMETIMES WAITING UNTIL FOLLOWING WEDNESDAY TO DISTRIBUTE PAYROLL CHECKS FOR NO APPARENT REASON. HE DESCRIBED RUBY AS HOT TEMPERED AND IMPULSIVE, STATING WHEN HE BECAME ASSOCIATED WITH RUBY HE HAD HEARD OF LATTERS REPUTATION OF TEMPER AND WAS SOMEWHAT GUARDED

IN HIS DEALINGS WITH RUBY BECAUSE OF THIS. IN DESCRIBING RUBY AS IMPULSIVE, KELLY SAID RUBY WOULD BECOME ANGERED OVER SOME INCIDENT AND TAKE IMMEDIATE ACTION SUCH AS HITTING A PERSON NOT THINKING OF CONSEQUENCES OF ACTION OR DEVELOPMENTS WHICH MIGHT RESULT FROM SUCH IMPULSIVE ACTION.

ONLY RELATIVE OTHER THAN RUBY/S SISTER KNOWN TO KELLY WAS RUBY/S OLDER BROTHER, NAME NOT KNOWN TO KELLY, WHO RESIDED IN CHICAGO. ON OCCASIONS RUBY MENTIONED TO KELLY THAT THIS INDIVIDUAL WAS RATHER WEALTHY AND ON ONE OCCASION WHEN FINANCES OF CLUB WERE LOW KELLY SUGGESTED THAT RUBY BORROW MONEY FROM THIS OLDER BROTHER AND RUBY REPLIED HE COULD NOT AS HE ALREADY OWED THIS BROTHER TOO MUCH. KELLY SAID RUBY HAD NO ACTIVE INTEREST IN POLITICS AND DID NOT KEEP ABREAST OF CURRENT EVENTS THROUGH READING NEWSPAPERS AND PERIODICALS. KELLY SAID HE NEVER HEARD RUBY MENTION LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND HAD NEVER SEEN OSWALD ASSOCIATING WITH RUBY. KELLY STATED BECAUSE OF RUBY/S TEMPERAMENT HE DIDN NOT BELIEVE RUBY WOULD HAVE EVER KNOWN OSWALD AND WOULD NOT HAVE ASSOCIATED WITH OSWALD IF THEY HAD MET.

MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY. THEY WERE ~~PHILLIP JASSER~~ OF JASSER-S CLOTHING STORE ON MULBERRY ST., ~~LAWSON JAFF~~, WHO OWNED LAWSON-S JEWELERS ON WALNUT ST. AND ~~MORTON STANDT~~, WHO OWNED STANDT-S JEWELRY STORE ON JACKSON ST. AND HE ALSO OWNED ROGERS JEWELERS ON WALNUT STREET. IND

ABOUT SIX MONTHS TO A YEAR AFTER I STARTED WORK FOR SAM JAFFE A GROUP OF PEOPLE CAME DOWN FROM CHICAGO AND I BELIEVE THEY WERE GOING TO HOLD A MEETING IN MUNCIE. THE GROUP I HAVE NAMED WERE GOING TO ATTEND THE MEETING, AND I BELIEVE THE MEETING HAD SOMETHING TO DO WITH THE COMMUNIST PARTY OR WITH RUSSIA. IT WAS TO BE HELD IN A UNION HALL UPSTAIRS FROM THE STORE WHERE I WORKED OR IN THE JEWISH MEETING HALL. THE SON-IN-LAW OF SAM JAFFE WAS ONE OF THE PEOPLE WHO CAME FROM CHICAGO AND HE BROUGHT WITH HIM A MAN WHO WAS INTRODUCED TO ME AS JACK RUBENSTEIN -PH- LAST NIGHT I SAW THE PICTURE OF JACK RUBY ON TELEVISION AND AT THAT TIME I DID NOT THINK ANYMORE ABOUT IT. TODAY WHILE I WAS AT WORK, IT CAME TO ME SUDDENLY THAT JACK RUBY IS THE SAME PERSON WHO WAS INTRODUCED TO ME IN MUNCIE, INDIANA, AS JACK RUBENSTEIN.

AS I REMEMBER IT, JACK RUBENSTEIN CAME TO MUNCIE, INDIANA TWICE WITH THE SON-IN-LAW OF SAM JAFFE BEFORE I WENT IN THE NAVY. BOTH TIMES THEY WERE THERE TO ATTEND A MEETING WITH THE GROUP THAT TALKED TO ME ABOUT THE COMMUNIST PARTY. I RECALL THAT JACK RUBENSTEIN WAS IN SHOW BUSINESS IN CHICAGO AS HE SHOWED ME A FEW CARD TRICKS AND READING FROM A FOLDED PAPER SOMETHING I HAD WRITTEN. HE ALSO BROUGHT WITH HIM A VERY TALL BLOND GIRL WHO WAS IN SHOW BUSINESS.

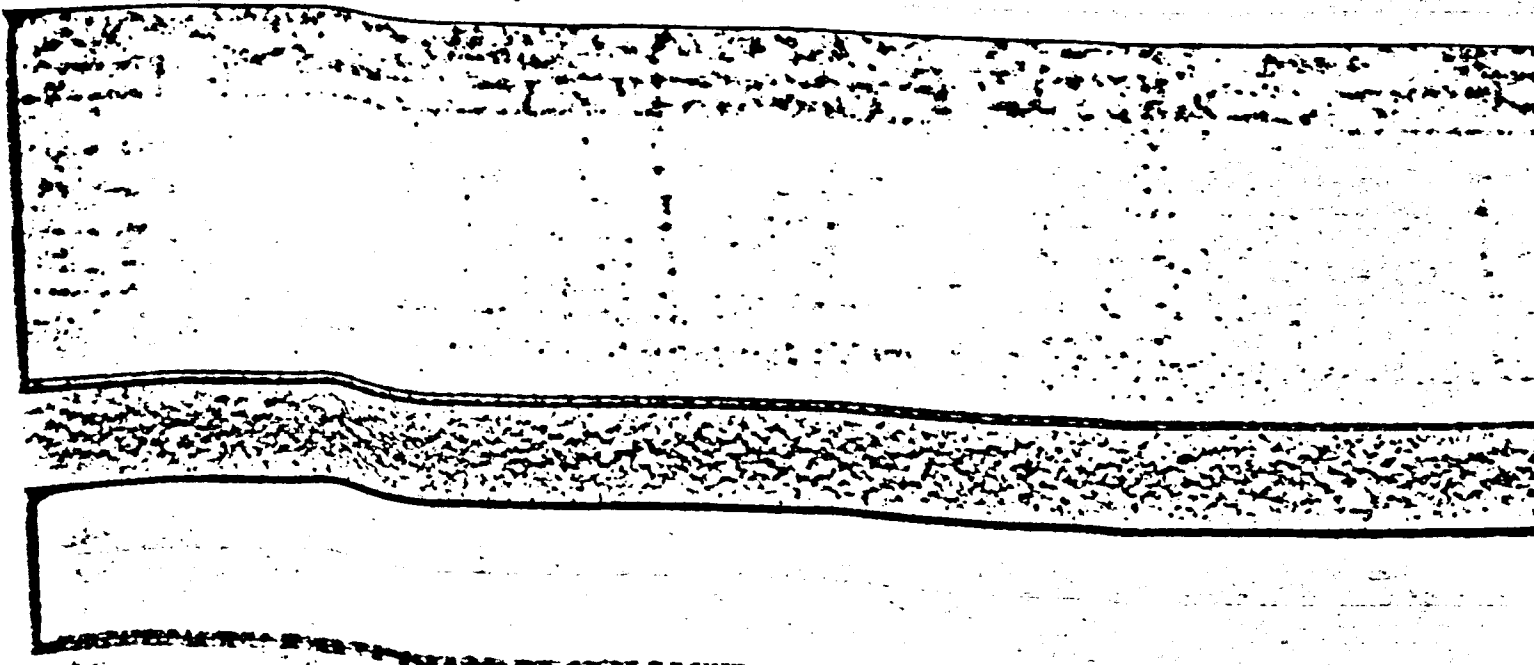

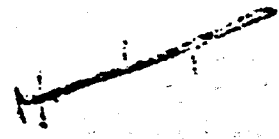

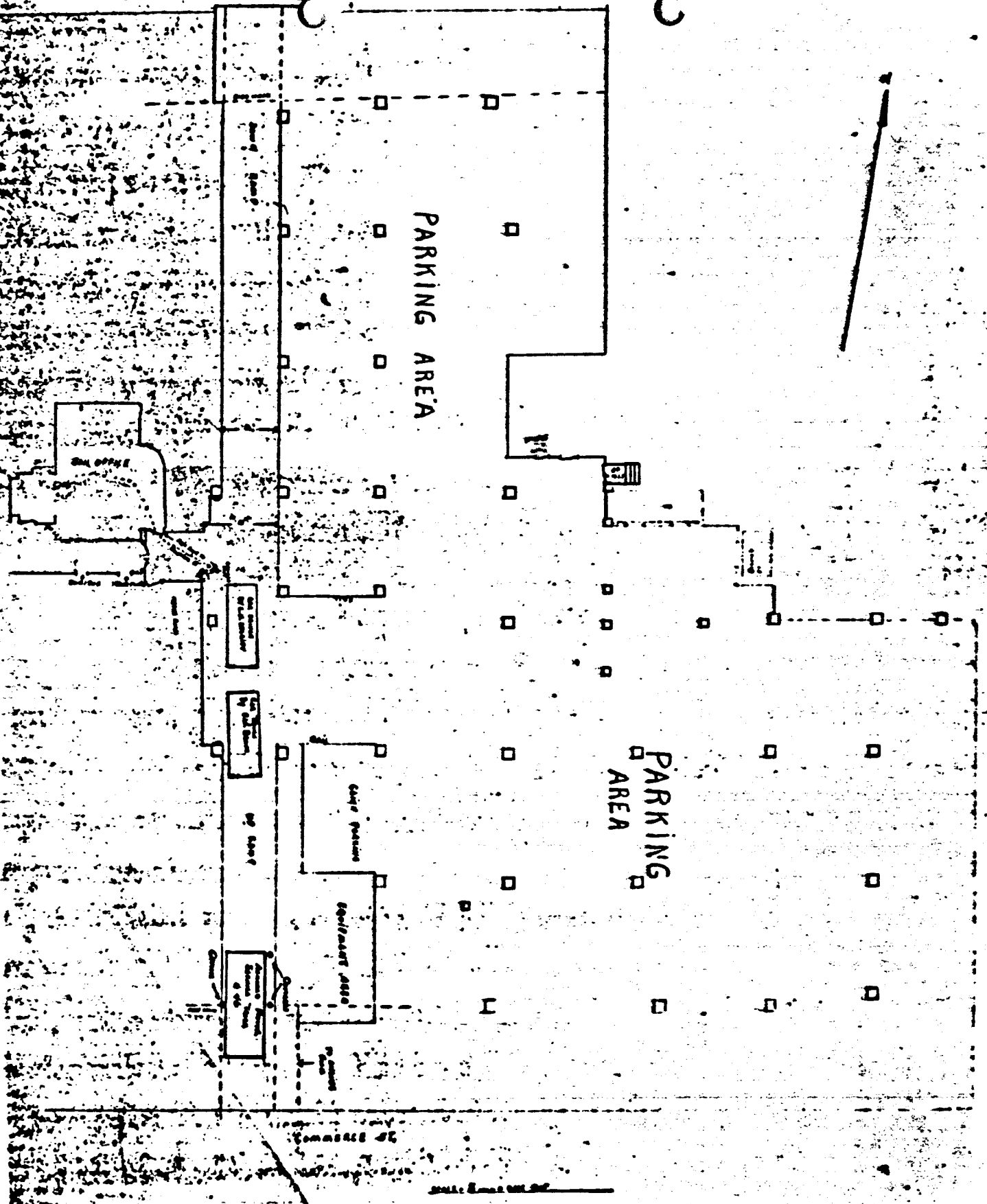

Mrs. RUTH E. BONDS, aka Mrs. Joseph Ponds, Dale Belmont, 11736 College View Drive, was interviewed at her residence. She was advised that she did not have to make a statement, that anything she said could be used against her in a court of law and she had the right to consult an attorney if she wished. She volunteered the following information:

SILVER SPRING, MARYLAND
 She said that she and her husband, JOSEPH BONDS, owned and operated the Skyview Club, also known as the Sky Club, located on Palmer Street just outside of Dallas, Texas, during the period 1948 to 1953-54 and that during part of this time she and her husband had known JACK RUBY as the owner of another night club.

Mrs. BONDS said she knew RUBY only as another club owner and that she had never worked for him as a stripper or in any other capacity. She said as a matter of fact she had never worked as a stripper but she had worked in the entertainment field and had used the name DALE BELMONT. She said that she was not an associate of RUBY and her contact with him was limited to occasional visits she and her husband made to his night club and similar visits he had made to their night club. On these visits RUBY would come to their table and talk to them usually about the night club business in general. She said she knew of no personal friends or associates of RUBY but named "happy" DOLSON, owner of Happy's Showland Club, and ABE WEINSTEIN, owner of the Colony Club in Dallas, as other club owners who could have known RUBY at least in business contacts.

Mrs. BONDS denied that she knew LEE OSWALD and stated she had never heard his name mentioned prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY on November 23, 1963.

Mrs. BONDS said she recalled that RUBY originally came from Chicago, Illinois, and that from conversations she had had with him she regarded him as very poorly educated and a very quiet man. She said RUBY reportedly was a good fighter and acted as his own club "bouncer". She had no information regarding any trouble in which RUBY might have been engaged and she would consider his mental condition normal.
