I noted in one of the newspaper stories that allegedly Jack Ruby, the individual who shot Oswald, in commenting on his motive for the killing, said he would be willing to undergo a polygraph examination by the FBI. I doubt the truth of this; nevertheless, one of the key issues in this matter is the actual motive of Ruby for the killing; whether he had help in getting into the police department; whether he is tied in with anyone else, and whether he knew Oswald. Therefore, while I do not think Ruby's attorney would allow any such polygraph interrogation, we should raise the issue.

RECOMMENDATION:

To this end, I propose

- (1) that we discuss it with the Department from a legal aspect;
- (2) that we talk with District Attorney Wade about this, on the basis that, according to a newspaper article, Ruby allegedly was willing to undergo a polygraph examination, and see whether Wade has any objections;
- (3) if Wade has no objections, suggest that Wade contact Ruby's defense attorney to see whether he would agree;
- (4) if the attorney agrees, and Wade is willing, our agents give Ruby a polygraph examination.

RUBY NOT CONSIDERED A GAMBLER AND HIS INTERESTS SEEMED TO BE IN SHOW BUSINESS. DE ANGELO CONSIDERED RUBY ARROGANT AT TIMES AND VERY TEMPERMENTAL. THIS DATE WHE WAS EMPLOYED BY RUBY AS STRIP TEASE ARTIST AT CAROUSEL CLUB IN DALLAS FOR EIGHT MONTHS IN SIXTYONE AND FOR TWO MONTHS IN SIXTYTWO. RUBY WAS QUICK TO ADMONISH EMPLOYEES FOR WRONGDOING BUT WAS JUST AS QUICK TO PRAISE THEM FOR GOOD WORK. RUBY HAD A BAD TEMPER ON OCCASIONS WHEN EMPLOYEES VIOLATED CONTRACTS OR WHEN PATRONS GOT OUT OF HAND. RUBY NEVER DISCUSSED HIS PAST BUT HAD TOLD PEOPLE HE WAS FROM CHICAGO. HE WAS A DEMOCRAT AND WAS VERY ACTIVE IN HIS SYNAGOGUE. MANY POLICE OFFICERS, BOTH IN AND OUT OF UNIFORM, PATRONIZED RUBY/S CLUBS BUT WERE NOT KNOWN TO HAVE ANY DEALINGS WITH HIM.
