PURSUANT TO BUREAU INSTRUCTIONS, ED MONTGOMERY, SAN FRANCISCO EXAMINER, CONTACTED TODAY BY SAC AND CATEGORICALLY DENIED THAT HE HAD BEEN IN TOUCH WITH ATTORNEY HAROLD W. TOEIN, SAN FRANCISCO, OR ANYONE ELSE CONCERNING THIS CASE. HE STATED HE HAS NOT BEEN ASSIGNED TO WORK ON THIS CASE AND HAS NO STORY OF ANY KIND REGARDING ANY PHASE OF THIS MATTER.

ATTORNEY HAROLD W. TOEIN, TWO NINE ONE GEARY STREET, SAN FRANCISCO, CONTACTED TODAY BY SAC AND ADVISED THAT HE HAS NOT MADE ANY TRIP TO DALLAS IN CONNECTION WITH THE ABOVE MATTER. STATED THAT, FOLLOWING ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND SUBSEQUENT KILLING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, HE UNDERSTOOD THAT RUMORS HAD OCCURRED IN THE DALLAS AREA INDICATING THAT LEGAL COUNSEL HIRED BY RUDY MIGHT ALSO BE IN DANGER OF ASSASSINATION. IN VIEW OF THESE RUMORS, WHICH HE WAS UNABLE TO SUBSTANTIATE IN ANY WAY, HE SENT A TELEGRAM TO DALLAS TO RUDY AND HIS ATTORNEY VOLUNTEERING HIS SERVICES SHOULD THEY BE NEEDED TO INSURE DUE PROCESS OF LAW. HE STATED THAT ON NOVEMBER

TWENTYSEVEN, NINETEEN SIXTY THREE, HE HAD OCCASION TO SPEAK WITH A

COOK, VICE PRESIDENT WITH THE HEARST CORPORATION IN SAN FRANCISCO CONCERNING SOME PRIVATE LEGAL MATTERS AND, DURING THIS CONVERSATION, TOBIN MENTIONED THAT IT HAD COME TO HIS ATTENTION AS THE RESULT OF A CONVERSATION WITH A GARAGE ATTENDANT THAT RUBY MIGHT HAVE LIVED IN SAN FRANCISCO MANY YEARS AGO. LATER THAT DAY HIS OFFICE RECEIVED A CALL FROM A SAN FRANCISCO EXAMINER REPORTER, WHOSE NAME HE DOES NOT RECALL, ASKING FOR FURTHER DETAILS, AND HE DIDN-T RETURN THE CALL BECAUSE HE DIDN-T HAVE ANY FURTHER DETAILS TO GIVE THE NEWSPAPER OTHER THAN WHAT HE HAD DISCUSSED WITH MR. COOK. TOBIN STATED HE HAD NO PERSONAL KNOWLEDGE REGARDING RUBY OR LEE HARVEY OSWALD. HE HAS NO PERSONAL KNOWLEDGE CONCERNING RUBY-S ALLEGED RESIDENCE IN SAN FRANCISCO. IN RESPONSE TO A SPECIFIC QUESTION, TOBIN STATED HE HAD NOT BEEN IN CONTACT WITH ANY FLI OFFICE OR FBI PERSONNEL REGARDING THIS CASE. REVIEW OF SAN FRANCISCO FILES SUBSTANTIATES TOBIN-S STATEMENT THAT HE HAS NOT BEEN IN CONTACT WITH THE SAN FRANCISCO OFFICE OF THE FBI CONCERNING THIS CASE. AS BUREAU AWARE, DETAILS OF RUBY-S RESIDENCE AND ACTIVITIES SAN FRANCISCO AREA APPROXIMATELY TWENTYFIVE YEARS AGO ASCERTAINED BY SAN FRANCISCO OFFICE AND PREVIOUSLY FURNISHED DALLAS AND BUREAU.

ELSEWHERE ARTICLE STATES SEVERAL EXPENSIVE CAMERAS AND ROLS OF FILM FOUND IN OSWALD-S ROOM IN OAK CLIFF BY SHERIFFS OFFICE AND TURNED OVER TO FBI. IT QUOTE UNNAMED FEDERAL INTELLIGENCE SOURCE STATING NEGATIVE OF BLANK SELECTIVE SERVICE CARD QUOTE WOULD BE INVALUBLE UNQUOTE TO ANYONE INVOLVED IN ESPIONAGE WORK AND THEN GIVES EXAMPLES OF USE OF SELECTIVE SERVICE CARDS IN ESTABLISHING IDENTITY. 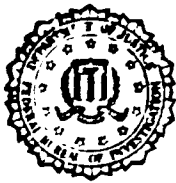

Mr. REINHART stated that he is not aware of anyone connected with the Fair Play for Cuba Committee or the Quebec-Washington-Guantanamo Walk for Peace having been on the Red Benson Show during the past summer. He advised that the Red Benson Show is an interview-type program carried over radio station WPEN from 11:30 p.m., to approximately 1 a.m. He advised that people expressing viewpoints from the ultra-right to the ultra-left are permitted to expound their views on the program and an endeavor is made to give everyone a chance to air his ideas. He stated at times panel discussions and debates are held between persons holding opposing viewpoints. He added that there have been one or more representatives of the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FPCC) on the program at times past but that because of unpleasant past experiences, these persons have been avoided for the last year or more. Detective FRANK MORRIS, Intelligence Unit, Philadelphia Police Department, 7th and Race Streets, Philadelphia, Pa., made available his file on the Quebec-Washington-Guantanamo Walk for Peace. The peace walkers came through Philadelphia en route to Cuba and spent August 13 through 16, 1963, in Philadelphia, departing early August 17, 1963, for Wilmington, Del.

The peace walkers were sponsored by the Committee for Non-Violent Action, with headquarters in New York City, and their stated goals were universal peace and non-violent solutions to the Cuban conflict and opposition to all military power, including nuclear weapons and all other forms of mass destruction.

The Police Department file on the peace walkers and numerous photographs taken by the Police Department of the peace walkers at several rallies held in Philadelphia, plus pictures taken as they marched into the city, were reviewed on December 3 and 4, 1963. Numerous individuals, including BRANFORD LITTLE, who claimed to be the leader of the group, were interviewed and/or identified by the police department. A careful review of the photographs taken failed to identify LEE OSWALD as being a member, participant, or on-looker of the demonstrations put on by the peace walkers. Further, the review of the file failed to mention anyone identifiable with LEE OSWALD and likewise failed to identify anyone with the initials "JHC."

Inspector PHILIP CELLA, Fairmount Park Guard, Philadelphia, Pa., advised that a review of Park Guard records reflects that the only affair held in Rittenhouse Square during the summer of 1963 which could in any way pertain to Cuba, the Cuban situation, or the Fair Play For Cuba Committee, was a demonstration on August 15, 1963, put on by the Quebec-Washington-Guantanamo Walk for Peace. He noted that this Walk for Peace was sponsored by the Committee for Non-Violent Action (CNVA) with headquarters in New York City. The demonstration was led by one ROSS ANDERSON, a white male, 63 years of age, from Albany, Ga., and a member of the CNVA.

According to the Park Guard records, other members of the CNVA participated, plus DENNIS JAMIESON of the Friends Peace Committee, 1500 Race Street, Philadelphia, Pa.

Inspector CELLA advised that the demonstration took place in Rittenhouse Square from 12 noon to 2:15 p.m., on August 15, 1963. The records failed to reflect any further identifying information.

ADMINISTRATIVE DATA

A review of Philadelphia file 105-9421, entitled "Quebec-Washington-Guantanamo Walk for Peace" reflects that this Walk for Peace was sponsored by the Committee for Non-Violent Action (CNVA), 325 Lafayette Street, New York 12, N. Y.

The peace walkers were in the Philadelphia Division twice during the summer of 1963. On the first occasion they were crossing from north central to northeast Pennsylvania en route to New York City. On the second occasion they were en route from New York south and stopped in Philadelphia from August 13 to the early morning of August 17, 1963. They held a rally at Rittenhouse Square on August 15, 1963. Their route of march was from Quebec, Canada, to the U. S. Naval Base at Guantanamo, Cuba, and stated purposes were to develop non-violent solutions to the Cuban conflict, help forestall future crises and to oppose all military power, East and West, and to oppose all nuclear weapons and all other forms of mass destruction.

A review of the file, names of members of the peace march who were identified, and review of the photographs taken failed to effect any identification of LEE HARVEY OSWALD as having been a member of the march, a participant of any of their rallies and demonstrations, or as a bystander who might have been included in the photographs. Likewise, a review of the file failed to reflect the identity of anyone with the initials "JHC."

A number of confidential informants of the Philadelphia Office who are familiar with some phases of pro-CASTRO Cuban activities and related matters in the Philadelphia area, have advised on various occasions that there have been no meetings, rallies or other activities of the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FPCC) in the Philadelphia area since early spring 1963. They have further noted that the FPCC has fallen into complete inactivity and that all efforts of the only two motivating persons in Philadelphia to reestablish interest in the Philadelphia Chapter of the FPCC have met with negative results.

The only activity in which the FPCC participated during the summer of 1963 was the maintenance of a booth at the Sixth Annual Bucks County World Peace Fair, August 24, 1963, at Newtown Square, Pa., as reported by confidential informants and established sources.

These informants have further advised that LEE HARVEY OSWALD is unknown to them and to the best of their knowledge, has not been in Philadelphia nor participated in local FPCC affairs, the Sixth Annual Bucks County World Peace Fair, or the Quebec-Washington-Guantanamo Walk for Peace.

These informants have further advised that they are not acquainted with anyone formerly associated with the FPCC, the July 26th Revolutionary Movement (7/26 RM), the Socialist Workers Party (SWP), or the Young Socialist Alliance (YSA), with the initials "JHC."

Attached are the two reports we have prepared concerning the assassination of the President and the subsequent killing of the assassin, Lee Harvey Oswald, by Jack Ruby.

ASSASSINATION REPORT

This report, in Part I, briefly relates the assassination of the President and the identification of Oswald as his slayer. Part II sets forth the evidence conclusively showing that Oswald did assassinate the President. Part III is in two sections, the first setting forth what the FBI knew about Oswald prior to the assassination; and the second section setting forth the results of our investigation of Oswald's background, activities, associates, et cetera, subsequent to the assassination.

Three sets of exhibits accompany this report. The first sets out evidence tying Oswald in with the assassination of the President; the other two set out documents relative to Oswald's contacts with the Soviets, the Communist Party, et cetera.

We are continuing to receive leads concerning Oswald, and consequently at the end of the report we state that investigation will continue until every piece of relevant evidence has been developed and examined.

The Dallas Office has read and approved the first two parts of the Assassination report. The third part of the Assassination report was sent to Dallas for reading after completion during the early morning hours of December 5, 1963.

REPORT OF KILLING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD

The report on the killing of Oswald by Jack Ruby covers the actual killing; the information developed concerning Jack Ruby; the interview of Ruby; Ruby's whereabouts from 11/22 to 11/24/63; and the investigation by the Bureau under the Civil

Rights Statutes to determine whether there was any conspiracy involved in the killing.

Attached to this report are two exhibits, one a photograph of the actual killing, and the other a diagram of the police department building basement where the killing occurred.

Due to the fact that no records were kept of the police officers or news media representatives in the basement at the time of the killing, we have not been able to identify, locate and interview all persons who were present when Ruby killed Oswald. We state in the report that persons identified to us have been or are being interviewed. We have interviewed 88 Dallas police officers, and are attempting to identify any others who were in the basement and interview them. An estimated 150 news media representatives were in the basement. We have been able to identify and interview 36 so far, and leads are set out throughout the country to identify and locate others who may have been present. We have no reason at this time to believe that the stories of these people, when we locate them, will be at variance with the facts developed so far, but we do want to locate them so that all possible questions can be resolved.

We say at the end of this report that the investigation will continue until every possible source of pertinent information has been exhausted.

The Dallas Office has read and approved this report on the Killing of Lee Harvey Oswald.

[redacted] a columnist for the "Dallas Morning News," who writes an [redacted] column captioned [redacted] was in touch with one of the Dallas Agents today and advised on a confidential basis (with the understanding no release would be made of this information) that he had received a telephone call from Ruby this afternoon. He advised that according to Ruby, he is permitted to make one telephone call per day from the Dallas County Jail and that Ruby talked to [redacted] for approximately thirty minutes. [redacted] stated there was considerable going in circles but the general drift of the conversation was concerning the reasons that he shot Oswald. [redacted] advised that reducing the conversation to his actual purpose, Ruby stated he shot Oswald to show the world the "Jews" had a love for Kennedy. Ruby did not believe any Jew would have the nerve to go to bat for Kennedy and felt he, Ruby, had to do this for the Jewish people.

[redacted] asked Ruby what was his last thought before and after shooting Oswald. Ruby told [redacted] that he would consider answering but would first want to talk to his attorney. [redacted] asked Ruby if he came over to the jail with a photographer would Ruby talk to him and permit photographs. Ruby stated he would.

[redacted] advised the Dallas Agent that he, [redacted] was contacting Sheriff Decker to see if he would be permitted to interview Ruby. [redacted] states that if he is successful in interviewing Ruby today and obtaining photographs, he will give the results of the interview that he is planning for this afternoon, as well as photographs, to other news media because Sheriff Decker would not permit such an interview unless he furnished the information to other news media.

[redacted] again stated, however, that he did not want the information as to the reasons Ruby shot Oswald disclosed, and that he did not intend to print this information. [redacted] also advised that before furnishing anything as a result of his contemplated interview today he would furnish the Dallas Office any information he obtains from Ruby. X-105

Just for info

On afternoon of December 6, Deputy Attorney General Katzenbach advised that CIA representatives had looked at our report on the assassination of President Kennedy and the report on the Ruby killing of Oswald and that CIA concurred fully with the report, said it was accurate according to any information they had and were complimentary of the report. State Department representatives had looked at the report and agreed with it. Secret Service representatives were coming over to look at the report.

Mr. Katzenbach said he had talked to Mr. Sorenson at the White House who had talked to the President, and the President wants the report transmitted direct to the Presidential Commission headed by Chief Justice Warren. Katzenbach wanted to know whether the Bureau wanted to transmit the report and I told him that we had given it to the Department and if the President wanted it to the Commission, the Department should handle. He said he would furnish it personally to Chief Justice Warren on December 7 with a very short cover note merely transmitting the report.

Mr. Katzenbach said that he was not in favor of making any statement regarding the report at this time but the President wants a statement, therefore, he has drawn one up which he would like to have approved by Chief Justice Warren and the White House and would like any views of the FBI. Mr. DeLoach and I looked over the proposed statement which set forth that a preliminary report had been rendered by the FBI and then went on to relate the findings of the report including the statement that Oswald was not involved with anyone else, there was no foreign country

influence and that Ruby had operated by himself in the killing of Oswald.

Mr. DeLoach and I talked to Mr. Katzenbach regarding this and advised him that the Director felt that basically the first paragraph was all that was necessary merely relating that the report had been submitted. We recommended that the word preliminary be stricken as this was more than a preliminary report. We pointed out that it is basically dangerous to make statements beyond that contained in the first paragraph because continued allegations are being received and we are continuing to run them out and this is a situation where the fewer comments that are made the better.

Mr. Katzenbach called Mr. Sorenson at the White House and advised of the Director's feelings on this and stated that he agreed that any report should be limited to the first paragraph plus a sentence to the effect that the Bureau was continuing investigation. Mr. Sorenson felt that it was desirable to show that at least so far there was no indication of involvement of a foreign country in this matter. We reiterated to Mr. Katzenbach our feeling that the less said the better and we did not object to saying that the FBI was continuing investigation but otherwise we thought the statements should be limited to the first paragraph. I told Mr. Katzenbach we had expressed our views and the rest was up to the Department. Mr. Katzenbach said that any statement made would be made by the White House.

I furnished Mr. Katzenbach a new set of reports and exhibits inasmuch as we had added a preface and had included an index to the reports. We had numbered the reports and the set furnished the Department is number two. I brought back the reports we had previously given the Department and they have been returned to Mr. Rosen's Office.

EDWARD TUBACH, Rancher, 152 "G" Street, voluntarily contacted the FBI to state he did know a "JACK" whom he might have mentioned to those individuals set forth in the anonymous letter. He identified "JACK" as JACK HOLFORD, 4835 Vista Del Monte, El Paso, Texas, a salesmanager for Proctor and Gamble.

TUBACH has known HOLFORD since they were both boys. HOLFORD formerly resided with his parents near TUBACH in Orange County, California. TUBACH remained in contact with HOLFORD and has visited with HOLFORD on an average of once a year, the last visit at El Paso, Texas, being in about July, 1953.

About three and a half to four years ago, HOLFORD visited TUBACH at Brawley, California. During this visit, TUBACH took HOLFORD to Mexicali, B.C., Mexico. MARIA LUISA GARCIA SILVA had been in an auto accident and was in a hospital in Mexicali. TUBACH and HOLFORD visited her there at which time HOLFORD was introduced to her. HOLFORD did not meet any of the other individuals in Mexicali.

TUBACH said it was quite possible he had mentioned HOLFORD to the others in Mexicali since he was quite fond of HOLFORD.

TUBACH again stated the only individual whom he believed might have written a spite letter and who would know of the identities of all mentioned in that letter would have been SILVIA GARCIA VARGENES. He again denied knowing JACK RUBY, or having anything to do with the assassination of the President or the subsequent killing of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

LLOYD MORAL, Irrigation Foreman, EDWARD TUBACH Ranches, was advised he did not have to make any statement but any statement made could be used in a court of law against him, and that he had the right to have an attorney, by SAs ARNOLD C. DOLDE and JAMES W. PRICE who identified themselves as Special Agents of the FBI.

MORAL said he was acquainted with REMECIO AGUILAR, whom he knew as the owner of cattle shipping yards in Mexicali, B.C., Mexico; NOFAM GUTIERREZ as the "girlfriend" of AGUILAR; IRMA GUTIERREZ as his, MORAL's, "girlfriend"; MARIA LUISA SILVA as MARIA LUISA GARCIA SILVA, the "girlfriend" of EDWARD TUBACH, and EDWARD TUBACH as his employer.

MORAL first became acquainted with GARCIA SILVA at the El Prado Bar, Margal Street, Mexicali, where she was employed as a manager about four years ago. He had frequented this bar previously and had become acquainted with the former manager, whom he knew only as "TONY". "TONY" introduced him to GARCIA SILVA. About a month later he introduced TUBACH to GARCIA SILVA. At that time GARCIA SILVA was residing in Pueblo Nuevo, Mexicali, where he and TUBACH attended social parties. At one of these parties, MORAL became acquainted with NORMA GUTIERREZ.

Sometime later, TUBACH rented an apartment on Ave. Compuertas in Colonia Alamos, Mexicali, where GARCIA SILVA established her residence.

In about the first part of 1963, he met SILVIA GARCIA VIRGENES at a party at GARCIA SILVA's and commenced a relationship with her which lasted about three or four months. He dropped her when her money demands became too much and shortly afterwards began a relationship with IRMA GUTIERREZ, whom he had also met at GARCIA SILVA's. When GARCIA VIRGENES learned of this relationship, she became angry and threatened to have both MORAL and TUBACH expelled from Mexico.

MORAL had become acquainted with REMIGIO AGUILAR at one of the parties about a year ago but had not become closely acquainted.

MORAL stated he knew JACK HOLFORD of El Paso, Texas, a friend of TUBACH and was aware that TUBACH had introduced HOLFORD

to GARCIA SILVA on one occasion sometime ago. He said that HOLFORD had never been to one of their parties and was not known to others in Mexicali.

HORAL indicated GARCIA VIRGENES might have written a "spite" letter because of his dropping her but added it was possible that GARCIA SILVA might have written such a letter since she was angry with him. He had attempted to convince TUBACH to terminate his relationship with GARCIA SILVA in that GARCIA SILVA was too demanding with respect to money and was not being "true" to him. GARCIA SILVA had learned of his attempts.

HORAL indicated it appeared that the JACK mentioned in the anonymous letter referred to JACK RUBY of Dallas, Texas. He said JACK RUBY was unknown to him personally and the only information concerning him had been obtained from the news media. HORAL specifically denied having ever met with JACK RUBY or having anything whatsoever to do with the assassination of the President or the subsequent killing of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

Further, she related to [REDACTED] that after viewing a television show regarding espionage she came to the conclusion that a bent frozen orange juice can lid that she found at the Shaw Hall Dormitory restaurant was in reality a miniature recording device.

Previous interviews of EARL R. RUBY, Southfield, Michigan, brother of JACK L. RUBY, and review of Dallas report reveals no indication that JACK RUBY or LEE HARVEY OSWALD were ever in Michigan.

In view of the above, no further investigation is being conducted by the Detroit Division.

Mrs. NONA HELEN ALEXANDER, 2614 LaSalle Gardens Boulevard, Lansing, Michigan, was interviewed and she furnished the following information:

She advised that she is the Senior Clerk at the Shaw Hall Men's Dormitory, Michigan State University (MSU), which hall is divided into two units--Shaw Hall East and Shaw Hall West--each having it's own Head Resident Advisor, Assistant Advisors, and Reception Desk. Both units are supervised by Mr. PEER G. HOLTEAMP, 1731 Linen Street, East Lansing, Michigan, Manager of Shaw Hall, in whose office she is employed, together with Mrs. NORMA E. JOHNSTON, 3257 Hepfer Drive, Lansing, Senior Department Secretary, She has been so employed for some twelve years.

She related that she had been absent from her position during the period October 2, 1963, to November 4, 1963, recuperating from a serious surgical operation for a female disorder performed on October 3, 1963, and that on her return to work on November 4, 1963, or a day or two later she noted the name "LEE OSWALD" written in NORMA JOHNSTON's handwriting on the corner of her (Mrs. ALEXANDER's) desk blotter. She asked Mrs. JOHNSTON what it meant and Mrs. JOHNSTON said that Mr. HOLTEAMP wanted to know if OSWALD was a student or former resident of the hall. Mrs. ALEXANDER searched the records back to 1954 but found no record.

She then tore off the corner of the blotter with the name on it, changed blotters and stuck the torn slip under the new blotter.

She could not state why she retained the slip but a few days later she located it again and asked Mrs. JOHNSTON why Mr. HOLTEAMP had inquired about the name. Mrs. JOHNSTON said that OSWALD had come to visit with a friend and Mrs. ALEXANDER believes that Mrs. JOHNSTON indicated that the "friend" was a student residing in Room G-035, East Shaw Hall, but she cannot be certain.
