

and seemed to associate with several individuals. He continued on to say that although he was not very well acquainted with RUBY, he had for some reason gained the impression that RUBY was a nervous and emotional individual. In addition, DORSEY had always felt that RUBY was a little "queer", but could not substantiate his opinions on any particular facts. He explained that when he referred to the word "queer" he meant that RUBY gave the appearance of being a little feminine and was often referred to as a "sissy." DORSEY stated that he had never discussed politics with RUBY and could therefore not be aware of RUBY's opinions in regard to this matter.

DORSEY said that the last time he saw RUBY was approximately two weeks prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY at which time he saw RUBY at the B & B Coffee Shop, located on Oak Lawn, Dallas, Texas. He stated that RUBY was accompanied by a man whom he had never seen before and was unable to furnish a description of any kind concerning this individual. He explained that he did not have a conversation with RUBY at this time and had only said "hello" to him. He could recall that RUBY replied something to the effect, "hello old timer". DORSEY stated that RUBY apparently called him "old timer" because he had met him several years ago.

DORSEY went on to say that he definitely did not consider RUBY a close friend or associate and stated that he had visited the Vegas Club only on four or five occasions. During his visits he could never recall talking with RUBY and as a matter of fact could not recall ever seeing RUBY at the Vegas Club.

In regards to any relationship between LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK RUBY, Mr. DORSEY stated that he had never heard the name OSWALD prior to the assassination of President.

KENNEDY and has heard nothing that would connect RUBY and OSWALD since the assassination. He related that he was not aware of any of RUBY's friends or associates other than JOE BONDS.

Mr. DORSEY further advised that he could recall an individual by the name of REESE DEAN PARSONS, whom he described as being an old friend. He added that PARSONS was also employed by JOE BONDS at the Sky Club Lounge during the period of his employment with BONDS. DORSEY stated that he was under the impression that PARSONS was not a very close friend of RUBY and believed that his association with RUBY was much on the same basis as his was. Although DORSEY could not recall the exact circumstances surrounding PARSONS' employment at the Sky Club Lounge, he did state that he may have helped PARSONS obtain the job at the Sky Club Lounge. To the best of his knowledge, PARSONS had never worked for RUBY and stated that he had never made any arrangements for PARSONS to work either for RUBY or at any of RUBY's night clubs.

TOM E. CHAPOTON, JR., at Dallas, Texas:

On December 2, 1963, ~~RICHARD DRAKE~~ <sup>Texas</sup>, Ticket Agent,  
Greyhound Bus Station, advised that the owner of Hamburger  
Haven, (FNU) LEIPSEIG is acquainted with JACK RUBY.

On December 9, 1963, ~~JOSEPH LEIPSIC~~, owner Hamburger  
Haven, 5410 Harry Hines Boulevard, Dallas, Texas, advised  
SAs ALLEN H. SMITH and TOM E. CHAPOTON, JR. that approximately  
eight years ago he purchased pizza pie crusts from JACK  
RUBY who sold this type merchandise to restaurants. Since  
that time RUBY has been operating night clubs and LEIPSIC  
has only seen RUBY when RUBY has come into the Hamburger  
Haven as a customer. LEIPSIC stated that RUBY might  
possibly eat at the Hamburger Haven once or twice a year.  
LEIPSIC continued that he is acquainted with JACK RUBY  
only as a customer and that he has no knowledge of RUBY's  
associates, business dealings or activities. LEIPSIC  
does not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD and has no idea whether  
or not there was any association between OSWALD and RUBY.

## FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

CHARLES DUARTE, 1418 1/2 Congress, Houston, Texas, advised SA JAMES L. WILLIAMSON that he has resided in Houston for the past year but for the 14 years before, resided in Dallas and knew JACK RUBY during that time.

He stated he knew RUBY was from Chicago but knew of no connections with any hoodlum element in Chicago and stated he believed RUBY's night club operation in Dallas was not financed by any hoodlum element.

He stated he did not believe RUBY had any extreme political beliefs and stated RUBY was only interested in making money.

He stated RUBY had mentioned to him on several occasions that he was selling hot jewelry and furs but said he had never seen any of these items.

He advised he did not know OSWALD and did not know if he was known to RUBY.

He stated he knew of no girl friends of RUBY and said that R. D. MATTHEWS, who is employed at a Redman's Club in Dallas and who was a past member of the DELOIS GREEN Gang, is well acquainted with RUBY.

The following investigation was conducted by SA JACK T. HAZEN and SA J. HOMER THOMASSON at Danville, Illinois:

LIL ELDRIDGE, owner and operator Lil's Jockey Club, located on the outskirts of Danville, Illinois, in a community known as Belgium, Illinois, advised on November 26, 1963, that she had never met JACK RUBY of the Carousel Club, Dallas, Texas, but had heard numerous statements from various entertainers concerning him. She stated that she had heard from entertainers in the past who worked in her club that they did not care to work for JACK RUBY because of his TEXAS antagonistic personality. She stated that she had also heard from an individual by the name of BOB MITCHELL, a former emcee, who was presently working for the Ted Mack Show in New York, that JACK RUBY was a homosexual. She stated that MITCHELL had informed her in the past that he had worked for RUBY in the band at the Carousel Club. She stated that from a review of her records, MITCHELL could be located in care of his mother-in-law, 714 George Street, Owensboro, Kentucky. On November 27, 1963, LIL ELDRIDGE advised that she had engaged her singer in conversation on the night of November 26, 1963, and that the singer, by the name of JOAN GILLESPIE, admitted to her that she was a lesbian. She also advised that GILLESPIE had told her that JACK RUBY, manager of the Carousel Club, Dallas, Texas, was definitely a homosexual.

~~CHRIS~~ ELSON, Owner and Operator, Kings Club, Adolphus Hotel, Dallas, Texas, advised he could furnish no information regarding JACK RUBY except what he had heard from club owners in the Dallas area. ELSON had seen RUBY on ten or twelve occasions during the time RUBY has been in Dallas and has had only one conversation with him.

During this particular conversation, ELSON advised he told RUBY that he did not want RUBY in the Kings Club as it was a respectable club and that from the rumors he had heard RUBY could cause a disturbance. From then on, ELSON advised RUBY had not attempted to frequent the Kings Club.

She stated during this period of time she also worked part time as a model. As a result of her part-time modeling career, she became acquainted with one GEORGE SENATOR, a close friend of JACK RUBY. She advised that on one occasion while having a drink with GEORGE SENATOR at the Burgundy Room at the Adolphus Hotel, SENATOR introduced her to JACK RUBY. She stated she was never acquainted with RUBY and could furnish no information concerning his background or activities. She stated she never saw or talked to RUBY after that particular introduction. She further advised she has never lived in common law with any Detective from the Dallas Police Department and feels such information is completely false and erroneous.
