RUBY CLAIMS HAD GUN IN RIGHT FRONT POCKET OF TROUSERS AND NOT IN COAT POCKET. STATES DID NOT HAVE HANDS IN POCKET WHEN HE WALKED DOWN RAMP. CLAIMS HE DID NOT SPEAK TO ANYONE IN BASEMENT PRIOR TO SHOOTING VICTIM AND DID NOT RECOGNIZE ANYONE IN BASEMENT PRIOR TO SHOOTING. HAD NO PRESS OR LAW ENFORCEMENT IDENTIFICATION OF ANY KIND AND EXHIBITED NOTHING TO ANYONE EITHER PRIOR TO OR AFTER ENTERING BASEMENT.

RUBY DENIES ANY CONSPIRACY BETWEEN DANIELS, VAUGHN, OR ANY OTHER PERSON. RUBY STATES THAT NO ONE SPOKE TO HIM WHILE HE WAS IN BASEMENT OR AFTER HE ARRIVED IN BASEMENT UNTIL AFTER HE SHOT OSWALD.

RUBY STATES HAS HAD NO HEALTH PROBLEMS, DOES NOT HAVE STEEL PLATE IN HEAD. STATES MOTHER WAS IN INSANE ASYLUM PRIMARILY DUE TO FAMILY SITUATION INVOLVING ALCOHOLIC FATHER AND CHANGE OF LIFE PERIOD. STATES IN NINETEEN FIFTYTWO HE WENT BROKE IN DALLAS NIGHT CLUB BUSINESS, WAS MENTALLY DEPRESSED AND QUOTE "HIBERNATED" UNQUOTE FOR THREE OR FOUR MONTHS IN DALLAS, REFUSING HUMAN COMPANIONSHIP.

RUBY STATES BORN IN CHICAGO WHERE LIVED UNTIL NINETEEN THIRTYTHREE, SPENT SHORT TIME IN LOS ANGELES, THEN WENT TO SAN FRANCISCO SAME YEAR. RETURNED TO CHICAGO NINETEEN THIRTYSEVEN WHERE REMAINED UNTIL NINETEEN FORTYONE. IN NINETEEN FORTYONE WAS QUOTE "ON THE ROAD" UNQUOTE IN

INTERVIEWS WITH POLICE AND NEWS MEDIA

The following information is submitted in an effort to clarify the figures submitted as to the number of police officers and news media representatives interviewed who were either present at or stationed near the scene of RUBY's shooting of OSWALD, November 24, 1963.

Sixty officers have been interviewed who were in the immediate area when OSWALD was shot. These persons were in the immediate area of the shooting or were on the ramps leading from the basement, or were guarding doors to the immediate area.

Fortyseven additional officers have been interviewed who were in the basement area and had left on other assignments shortly before the shooting, or were stationed in the basement but not in close proximity to the actual shooting. This figure also includes personnel assigned to other duties than guarding or transporting OSWALD, but who were in the general basement area.

NEWS MEDIA

Fortyeight news media representatives who were either in the basement or in the immediate area at the time of the shooting have been interviewed. An additional 27 representatives have been interviewed who had been at the police department prior to the shooting, but were outside or had left the area at the time of the shooting. It also includes a few individuals who were initially believed to have been present, but upon interview were found not to have been.

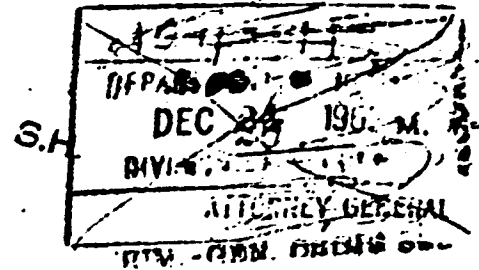

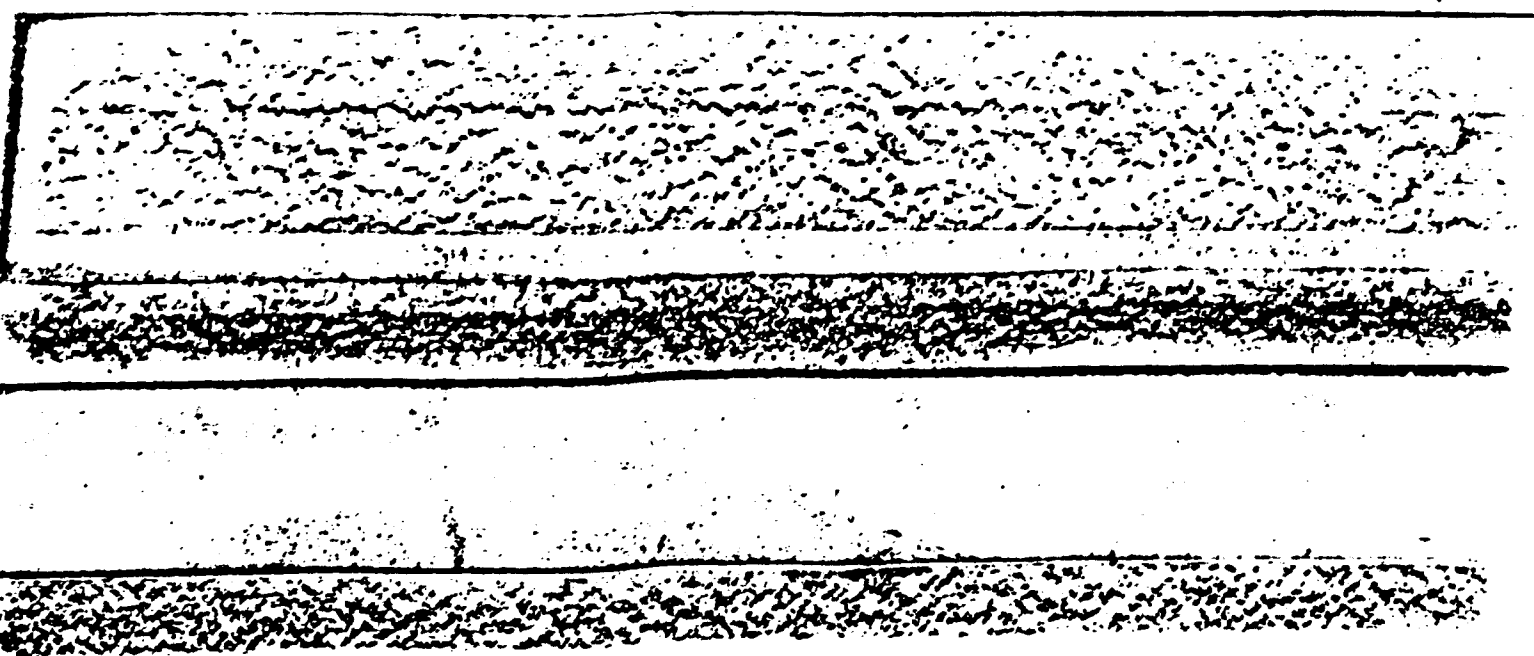
