The following is a chronological summary of the where-abouts, movements, and activities of JACK L. RUBY, as obtained by review of investigation conducted in this case, beginning in January, 1963, with particular attention to the period November 22-24; 1963, inclusive. RUBY has been indicated as definite in connection with the particular entry.

For the information of the Bureau and interested offices, the following entries in the above-mentioned chronology bear references to the Dallas case, serial and page(s) (44-1639-644, page 10, etc.; 44-1639-1809, page 10, etc.; 44-1639-2144, page 10, etc.), so that greater detail of any particular entry can be readily found. Serials 1644, 1809, and 2144 in the Dallas file are Dallas reports of SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS, dated November 30, 1963, December 11, 1963, and December 14, 1963, respectively.
