Based upon his discussions with Lee Rankin, counsel of the Commission, Inspector Malley has requested that Liaison check with all Government agencies except State Department and Secret Service who might logically have pertinent information concerning Lee Harvey Oswald and Jack Leon Ruby. Specific reference is made to a check with Defense Department, Office of Naval Intelligence, Office of Special Investigations Air Force, and Assistant Chief of Staff for Intelligence Army, to determine if any action was taken by those agencies with regard to Oswald's trip to Russia in 1959-62. It was noted that we have previously reviewed the U.S. Marine file on Oswald and have summarized it for the Commission; therefore, it will be unnecessary to obtain any information from that file. However, any other information in possession of ONI would be desirable.

Inspector Malley also requested that we obtain through Liaison copies of income tax returns filed by Oswald, Ruby, Ruby's brother Earl R. Ruby, his sister Eva L. Grant, and Oswald's associates Ruth and Michael Ralph Paine from 1955 to date.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended Liaison make the appropriate contacts with Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and other Government agencies in accordance with Inspector Malley's request. For the assistance of Liaison and for delivery to IRS attached are memoranda pertaining to these individuals.

The following communication was noted on December 20, 1963, in connection with a review being made of correspondence received for JACK RUBY at the Dallas County Jail, Dallas, Texas. RUBY is presently being held by Dallas County authorities, charged with the murder of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, accused assassin of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. The communication directed to RUBY reads as follows:

"Jack

"Don't worry we will get you out even if we have to blow up the whole city. We will be there the 9th be ready don't be a fool like Lee. We have all the connections and as far as Prest. Johnson it will be done right this time. We are in Ft. Worth now, if any one reads this don't talk. You have done a good job so far. we will go to Mexico when this is over.
