ARTHUR HARRIS, <u>3606 Cleveland</u>, Dellas, Texas, employed Wicher Fish Market, 3004 Gaston, Dellas, a former employee of JACK RUBY, furnished the following information:

He was employed, as a porter, at the Vegas Club for approximately two months during late 1962.

HARRIS advised the club was managed by Mrs. EVA GRANT and as he recalls, he only saw JACK RUBY at the club on one occasion. He stated he, HARRIS, worked at the club from about 2:00 P.N. to 5:30 P.N.

HARRIS advised he knew nothing about JACK RUBY and that he had never spoken to him.

HARRIS advised he never saw LEE HARVEY OSWALD at the Vegas Club nor does he ever recall having seen him any place.
