On 2/13/64, a check of the current Mexico City telephone directory revealed that there is no one named CAMORGO listed in this directory; however, there are many persons with the last name of CAMARGO listed. A check of all of the persons named CAMARGO listed in the current directory revealed that Mexico City telephone number 14-96-28 (this number listed previously as 14-9628, but Mexico City numbers actually listed as given above) is not listed to anyone named CAMARGO in Mexico, D. F.

On 2/13/64, a call to Mexico City number 14-96-28 revealed that this number is listed to ADOLFO DORFSMAN, Calle Tamaulipas #55, Apartment 601, Mexico D. F., and this listing was subsequently verified through a check of the Mexico City telephone directory.

ADOLFO DORFSMAN, an employee of the Mexican Ministry of National Property, advised that he has had Mexico City telephone number 14-96-28 for more than two years, that he knows no one named CARLOS CAMORGO or CAMARGO, and that no person by this name has had access to his telephone. DORFSMAN stated that he has, of course, heard of JACK RUBY and LEE HARVEY OSWALD, but that he does not know either personally and his only knowledge of these persons has been through newspaper and other publicity.

On 2/13/64, an additional check of the Mexico City telephone directory revealed that one CARLOS CAMARGO, Calle Mexicali #45, Mexico, D. F., has telephone numbers 14-98-94, 25-25-58, and 25-29-51.

On 2/13/64, CARLOS CAMARGO, Calle Mexicali #45, Mexico, D. F., advised he has never visited Dallas, Texas, in his life and that Mexico City telephone number 14-96-28 has never been listed to him. CAMARGO further advised that he has heard of JACK RUBY and LEE HARVEY OSWALD only through publicity given these persons in various news media and has no personal knowledge of either. CARLOS CAMARGO pointed out that his name is not uncommon in Mexico City; that his own son is, in fact, named CARLOS CAMARGO MARTINEZ, but that without the "segundo apellido" or maternal surname of such an individual, it would be very difficult, if not impossible, to determine who the pertinent CARLOS CAMARGO might be in Mexico City, which is a city of more than five million persons.

[REDACTED] furnished the following information and requested that his identity as the source of the information not be disclosed. He said that he is presently working for [REDACTED]

He explained that on June 30, 1942, he left Kelly Air Force Base, San Antonio, Texas, where he had [REDACTED] and went to work for [REDACTED]

Later, in 1943, and continuing into the fall of 1944, he was employed by [REDACTED]

He said he was [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said that while connected with this [REDACTED] in Dallas about twenty years ago, he had observed a gambling syndicate situation in existence at Dallas with a local leader named DENNY PUGH. He said he was not aware of the individual who took PUGH's place after his death, but that if JACK LEON RUBY took his place, a knowledge of the gambling setup at Dallas might explain RUBY's motive in killing OSWALD.

[REDACTED] advised that as he recalled there was an out-of-town gambling syndicate trying to move into Dallas during about 1943 and 1944, and during this period, CAT NOBLE, a Dallas hoodlum, was a victim of several car bombing attempts. He said someone conceived the idea of putting DENNY PUGH at the head of gambling in Dallas in an effort to exclude foreign interests. He described PUGH as a carnival worker, working out of Fair Park, Dallas. PUGH was given unlimited power and even had the approval for all electrical installations in Dallas and other local utility work. He was allowed to put in gambling casinos all over Dallas with no payoff to the local officers on the beat. On regular intervals, however, raids were made on these casinos and the fines collected went into the City treasury. He indicated DENNY was a moral man, however, got into some type of trouble with a carnival woman and subsequently died in a narcotics coma.

[REDACTED] continued that DENNY PUGH operated out of a small electrical shop across the street from the fair grounds. This shop was owned by CARROLL SANDS and was known as the Sands Electric Shop. During that time, Mr. HINKLE was commissioner at Dallas and had his office in the same building with DENNY PUGH.

[REDACTED] added that he did not know who succeeded DENNY PUGH after PUGH's death, but it would seem to him, WHITNEY, that if this method of operation has not stopped and if there is a line of succession that would reach RUBY, then RUBY may be the man in control of the gambling syndicate at Dallas.

He said the only people he knew who could describe the system subsequent to the death of DENNY PUGH would be:

1. Mrs. EMMA RIED who was formerly secretary and bookkeeper for Sands Electric Shop and worked for PUGH. He said she is now manager of the South and East Dallas Chamber of Commerce whose offices recently moved from the fair grounds.
2. CARROLL SANDS would know if he is still alive.
3. His ex-wife, Mrs. CARROLL SANDS, also known as A. Z. or AZEY, would know about the syndicate.
4. Reverend RAY MORELAN who was formerly at the Northside Baptist Church, Baytown, Texas, and has now moved from this address with forwarding address unknown. MORELAN was formerly an engineer for North American Aviation, Ft. Worth, who knew all the gamblers in North Richmond Hills, a suburb of Ft. Worth.
5. Criminal District Judge BYRON MATTHEWS, Ft. Worth, would know the entire situation as he formerly represented various gamblers and knew the inner workings of the syndicate. He indicated that MATTHEWS had connections with TRUJILLO of the Dominican Republic.

Examination of prospective jurors to serve in "the State of Texas vs. Jack Rubenstein, alias Jack Ruby, No. E 4010J," Criminal District Court No. 3, Dallas County, Texas, was begun on February 17, 1964, Judge JOE B. BROWN presiding. RUBY was represented by Attorneys MELVIN BELLI of San Francisco, JOE H. TONAHILL of Jasper, Texas, and PHIL BURLISON, Dallas, Texas. The State was represented by District Attorney HENRY WADE and Assistant District Attorneys WILLIAM F. ALEXANDER, A. D. JIM BOWIE, and FRANK WATTS. Jury selection was completed on March 3, 1964. *Texas*

Testimony was begun on March 4, 1964, and completed on March 13, 1964, followed by the charge of the court and arguments to the jury. The prosecution asked for the death penalty for Murder With Malice; the defense asked for acquittal on the basis of temporary insanity. Arguments were concluded at 1:05 a.m., March 14, 1964.

After deliberating from approximately 9:10 a.m., to approximately 11:30 a.m., March 14, 1964, the jury returned a verdict of guilty of Murder With Malice and assessed the death penalty at 12:23 p.m., March 14, 1964.

The trial of RUBY was observed by SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS.

Dallas newspapers reported on March 19, 1964, that RUBY had dismissed MELVIN BELLI as his attorney by letter on March 18, 1964. The newspapers reported Attorneys TONAHILL and BURLISON had on March 20, 1964, filed application for a new trial. Coincidentally, it was announced PERCY FOREMAN, Houston, Texas, attorney, had been retained as Chief Defense Counsel.

Newspapers on March 24, 1964, announced that FOREMAN had quit the RUBY defense on the previous day on the basis of conflicts regarding direction of the case. On March 25, 1964, newspapers

reported Dr. HERBERT WINSTON SMITH, Professor of Law and Legal Medicine and Director of the Law-Science Institute, University of Texas, had been retained as Chief Defense Counsel. The question of whether Dr. SMITH can pursue this matter while still acting as a full professor at the University of Texas has been the subject of press speculation and it is reported the question is currently pending before the Board of Regents of the University.

Mrs. MARY LAWRENCE, Executive Director, Jewish Childrens Bureau, 1 South Franklin, Chicago, Illinois, provided the following information concerning records in her possession relating to JACOB RUBENSTEIN, also known as JACK RUBY, and his family:

All actual records relating to the RUBENSTEIN family in possession of her office have been destroyed because of age, with the exception of a face sheet and several copies of Circuit Court of Cook County Juvenile Court records.

Mrs. LAWRENCE advised that because of the passage of time the face sheet reflecting contacts with the RUBENSTEIN family was the only actual record her office still maintained. The face sheet she had in her possession was for JOE and FANNY RUBENSTEIN and their children: HYMAN, date of birth December 21, 1901; ANNA, date of birth May, 1904; MARY, date of birth June 3, 1906; EVA, date of birth 1909; JACOB (JAKE), date of birth April 25, 1911; SAM, date of birth December 25, 1912; ISADORE, date of birth May, 1914; and IDA, date of birth July 11, 1917. Mrs. LAWRENCE advised that the Cook County, Illinois, Juvenile Court docket numbers for the RUBENSTEIN children were as follows:

Mrs. LAWRENCE stated that the Cook County Juvenile Court records in her possession relate to scheduled hearings November 21, 1924, and another hearing scheduled December 8, 1924, before Judge VICTOR P. ARNOLD. Mrs. LAWRENCE advised that the court documents in her possession, and which are mentioned above, provide no information relating to the disposition of the hearings. She further stated that all of the court documents in her possession for each of the RUBENSTEIN children were similar in nature and bore the same dates.

Mrs. LAWRENCE made available for copying the original face sheet she had in her possession concerning the RUBENSTEIN family, along with the Circuit Court of Cook County juvenile records also relating to the RUBENSTEIN family. She requested, however, that these records not be sent out of Chicago, but that they be copied in Chicago and be returned to her before the close of business March 13, 1964.

On review of the reverse side of the face sheet of the RUBENSTEIN family, which she had in her possession, Mrs. LAWRENCE stated that she could not interpret all of the notations appearing thereon. She stated that in spite of the fact she has been connected with social work in the Jewish community in Chicago, Illinois, for over 40 years, she could not identify all the notations on the face sheet.

With regard to the requests by the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy for reports on the RUBENSTEIN family entitled as follows: "JFE 11-25-32, JSSB C 3-32, Rest Haven 8-11-30, JFE 7-13-29, WL 6-30-27, JHFS 2-15-26, MTS Racine 2-25-24, IJR 43-76 7-6-22," Mrs. LAWRENCE advised as follows:

The initials JFE could possibly relate to the Jewish Free Employment Bureau, now called the Jewish Vocational Service headed by WILLIAM GELMAN, second floor, 1 South Franklin, Chicago, Illinois. The initials JSSB probably relate

to the Jewish Social Service Bureau, now known as the Jewish Family and Community Service, 1 South Franklin, Chicago, Illinois, headed by Mr. SIDNEY BERKOWITZ. The name Rest Haven is the former name for the Schwab Rehabilitation Center at California and 16th Streets, Chicago. The executive director of the Center is IRA GOLDBERG. The initials WL probably relate to the Women's Loan Association, which is now a part of the Jewish Family and Community Service above. The initials JEFS relate to the Jewish Home Finding Service, which was the parent agency of the Jewish Childrens Bureau headed by Mrs. LAWRENCE herself. The initials and name MTS Racine undoubtedly, in Mrs. LAWRENCE'S opinion, relate to the Chicago Municipal Tuberculosis Sanitarium, Racine Avenue Branch. The initials IJR in the opinion of Mrs. LAWRENCE relate to the Institute for Juvenile Research at Chicago, Illinois.

At this point, Mrs. LAWRENCE advised, as she had previously, the only significant information which she felt appeared on the face sheet of her office's record in relation to the RUBENSTEIN family was the notation relating to IJR as, "I.J.R. 7-6-22 Exam Number 4376 Jake."

With regard to the Cook County, Illinois, Juvenile Court records in her possession concerning the RUBENSTEIN children, Mrs. LAWRENCE said none of them related to HYMAN RUBENSTEIN, Juvenile Court Docket Number 60011.
