

NOTE:

The Department by memorandum 4/13/64 forwarded a letter to the AG from Miss Mary Jone wherein she indicated that she had information about an attorney in Phoenix who always sends money to help Jack Ruby. The letter itself was poorly written and indicated that the writer was illiterate to some degree. Phoenix conducted extensive investigation to identify Mary Jone but she could not be identified. They obtained background data on the attorney she referred to which indicates that he is a reputable attorney in Phoenix and was a strong supporter of former President Kennedy. A letterhead memorandum setting forth Phoenix's investigation is being forwarded to the President's Commission and a copy is also being furnished to the Criminal Division of the Department.

NOTE:

Miss Riegler on 11/25/63 advised that she was at Phil's Delicatessen, Dallas, Texas, on the night of 11/22/63 in the company of Sindelar, Silberman, Nikolis, and Martin when she observed a man whom she identified as Jack Ruby. The Commission requested that we interview the companions of Riegler. Our investigation, which was reported and furnished to the Commission in the report of SA Clements dated 11/30/63, had already established Ruby's presence in the delicatessen, where he purchased sandwiches which he later furnished to the crew of the Dallas Radio Station, through interviews of the owner, other employees, and several other persons present in the delicatessen on that night. Extensive investigation was required to locate the companions of Riegler, especially Martin who was finally located in the Army at Fort Ord, California. All of the interviews relate the almost identical story as originally furnished by Riegler which is not significant in any respect except to establish that Ruby was at Phil's Delicatessen on the night of 11/22/63.

Investigation at Oakland, California, April 23, 1964, reveals that RICHARD LEE SNYDER, above address, using alias DICK RUBY, prepared a card dated April 19, 1964, and mailed at Alameda, California the same date addressed to "Mr. Harold Wallace, in c/o the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Washington, D.C., USA", on which card the writer states that he is convinced that he is a son of JACK RUBY. Mrs. FRANK B. SNYDER, above address, mother of RICHARD LEE SNYDER, advises that SNYDER is mentally retarded and has received professional help for his condition for over 15 years. She identified the handwriting appearing in the card sent to the FBI in Washington, as being the handwriting of her son. She stated her son is mentally and emotionally confused and has made statements within recent weeks indicating that he believes he is the son of JACK RUBY.

The following investigation was conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation in an effort to obtain further information concerning the Liberty Distributing Company of 328 South Jefferson, Chicago, Illinois:

Mrs. Alice ~~X~~ Dover, 6430 South Evans, Chicago, Illinois, advised on March 20, 1964, that J. J. ~~X~~ Sanders previously resided at this address but is now deceased. She stated that Sanders died a short time prior to the time she and her family moved to this address about five years ago.

Mrs. Dover described Sanders as a patent attorney, explaining that she learned this after she moved to this address as a result of mail which was delivered to this address for Sanders. Mrs. Dover stated that she did not know the location of any of Sanders' relatives. She stated that Sanders' wife reportedly left Chicago after Sanders' death.

Mr. Joseph ~~X~~ Fitzpatrick, Building Superintendent, James Igoe Building, Room 200, 328 South Jefferson, Chicago, Illinois, advised on March 20, 1964, that this building has no current records reflecting the names of tenants prior to 1946.

Mr. Fitzpatrick first stated that he had been employed in this building since 1931, but could not recall a company by the name of the ~~X~~ Shelby Printing Company. After reflection Mr. Fitzpatrick stated he did recall a company by that name which was in this

building about 1942. He stated that this company moved from this building to another address in Chicago during the early 1940s and he has had no contact with this company since that time.

Mr. Fitzpatrick stated that he does not recall a Jack Rubenstein or a Jack Ruby being connected with any company in this building at any time in the past.

Mr. Ray Carne of J. Carne and Company, 328 South Jefferson, Chicago, Illinois, advised on March 20, 1964, he had been in this building for about thirty-eight years and recalled a company known as the Shelby Printing Company which occupied space near his company in this building about twenty-two years ago. He stated this company moved during the early 1940s to Grand Avenue, Chicago, and still later moved to Joliet, Illinois, and changed the name of this company to the Shelby Crafto Company.

Mr. Carne stated that this company was owned by two brothers while it was located at 328 South Jefferson, Chicago, Illinois, but he later heard that one of the brothers left this company after they moved from this address and the other brother is still with this company in Joliet, Illinois. He did not recall the last name of the brother who is still with the company in Joliet, Illinois.

Mr. Carne stated that he did not recall a Jack Rubenstein or a Jack Ruby being connected with any company in this building at any time in the past.

Mrs. Cecile Burch, Office Manager, Shelby Craftco Corporation, 219 Maple, Joliet, Illinois, for the past twenty years, stated on March 23, 1964, this company is not identical with the Shelby Printing Company, 328 South Jefferson, Chicago, Illinois. She stated Shelby Craftco did not start business until June, 1943. The owner's name is W. B. Mendelsohn.

The letterhead memorandum enclosed with referenced airtel sets forth the statement of Mr. Ray Carne that the Shelby Printing Company had changed its name to Shelby Crafto Company and moved to Joliet, Illinois. He said that the company was operated by two brothers, one of whom was still with the company, but he did not know their last name.

It is noted that Mrs. Cecile Burch, Office Manager of the Shelby Craftco Corporation, Joliet, Illinois, stated that she had been with that company for twenty years and that it was not identical with the Shelby Printing Company. She furnished the owners name as W. B. Mendelsohn. It would appear possible that Mendelsohn could be the brother who is still with the company as referred to by Carne and that company could have been the Shelby Printing Company before its name was changed and prior to Mrs. Burch's employment there.

In order to completely eliminate these possibilities, immediately interview W. B. Mendelsohn to determine whether or not he ever had any connection with the Shelby Printing Company or knowledge of same. Submit results by letterhead memorandum within three days. Furnish copies of letterhead memorandum enclosed with your airtel of 3/25/64 and any subsequent letterhead memoranda regarding this matter to the office of origin Dallas for their information.

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NOTE:

At request of the President's Commission, we have conducted considerable investigation to identify the Liberty Distributing Company which was reportedly operated by Jack Ruby in 1942 in Chicago but the company cannot be identified. The Commission by letter 3/16/64 enclosed a copyright registration indicating that the Shelby Printing Company did printing for the Liberty Distributing Company in 1942 and requested investigation on the basis of information in the copyright registration. Chicago has not been able to identify or locate anyone connected with the Shelby Printing Company which is no longer in existence. This is to insure that all logical avenues of inquiry are exhausted before submission of the results to the Commission.

This is to confirm the telephone conversation of Special Agent J. William Hines with Mr. William E. Foley, First Assistant, Criminal Division, on April 27, 1964, wherein Mr. Foley was advised that Special Agent C. 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**NOTE:**

The information referred to above as requested by the Commission pertains to some certain allegations received in early stages of investigation (1) that Ruby participated in Communist Party meetings in Muncie, Indiana, in 1947, (2) that he was engaged in Cuban gun-running activities, and (3) that he was in the printing business in Chicago in 1942. The allegations were for the most part fully run out within a week or two after Ruby shot Oswald but as the results were completely negative and did not pertain to the civil rights aspects of the investigation they were not reported. The enclosed report has been reviewed by Mr. Belmont, Mr. Malley and the appropriate supervisor in the Civil Rights Section. A copy is being furnished to the Criminal Division of the Department. The Department has previously advised that inasmuch as the Ruby trial is completed they do not desire that we furnish further reports in this matter to USA Sanders in Dallas.

GARLAND CHRISTOPHER FERRIS, 4356 Cresthill Drive, Southwest, Roanoke, Virginia, voluntarily related that man had three definite drives, Self, Sex, and Herd. He stated that he could use the above in a mathematic formula and figure out any human problem. He stated that he was concerned over the FRANCES WOMER (phonetic), LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and JACK L. RUBY association. He related that FRANCES WOMER was the traveling manager for Western Union in Bluefield, West Virginia, this being the office through which his message was sent to KENNEDY (President) on November 19, 1963.

FERRIS stated he had gone to Bluefield and had his message to review before they realized what was going on. He stated this message was wet and he believed that WOMER had probably taken the message out to send. It was sent at 2:29 p.m. on November 19, 1963, when normally a night message would not be sent until after 5:00 p.m. He said these messages in Bluefield, West Virginia, were sent from the Matz Hotel and this hotel was a house of prostitution. He believed that WOMER was a prostitute and had brought girls with her to the hotel to work as prostitutes and this would be the Sex portion of the drive of man.

FERRIS said that OSWALD, RUBY, and WOMER were German Jews and RUBY had shot OSWALD to keep him from talking. He stated that OSWALD was a hired gun and RUBY should have known that a hired gun will never talk and probably a "lie detector" test would not have shown any emotional response.

FERRIS informed that he did not like the way "JACK KENNEDY" was shot in the back. He said that he could not reach a logical conclusion as to why OSWALD had only shot the President and the Governor of the State of Texas.

FERRIS stated that he was about to burn his brain up trying to work out the complete solution to the shooting of President KENNEDY and he hoped this would be of benefit.

On April 1, 1964, Mr. Ray Carne, J. Carne and Company, 320 South Jefferson, Chicago, Illinois, telephonically advised that he now recalls the name of the former owner of Shelby Printing. He stated this individual is named Saul Moldofsky, and he is believed by Carne to reside at 2720 Bryn Mawr Avenue, Chicago.

On April 2, 1964, Saul Moldofsky, 2720 Bryn Mawr Avenue, telephone Longbeach 1-7891, advised that he and his brother, Sidney, were in business as the Shelby Printing Company, 328 South Jefferson Street, Chicago, Illinois, from approximately 1938 to 1944. Prior to 1938, he was affiliated with the Globe Printing and Embossing Company, Chicago, Illinois.

He stated that in the latter part of December, 1941, or early January, 1942, he and Edward Schwartz came upon the idea of promoting a "Remember Pearl Harbor" plaque. Schwartz, according to Moldofsky, said that he had the right man for the distribution and sale of the plaque, namely "Sparky" Rubenstein. Mr. Moldofsky stated that Rubenstein is identical with Jack Ruby, who shot and killed Lee Harvey Oswald.

Moldofsky stated that he did not know Jack Ruby well and could recall no specific details concerning him.

He stated that there were problems in getting out the "Remember Pearl Harbor" plaque because none of the proofs were acceptable to Ruby, whom Schwartz described as a "perfectionist." He stated that it took anywhere from four to six weeks to develop a proof that was acceptable to Ruby and by that time, the market was flooded with the "Remember Pearl Harbor" idea and their promotion never materialized.

Moldofsky stated that the entire business relationship with Ruby was handled by Schwartz. This also included the filing of the copyright for the promotional idea. He said that the name Liberty Distributing Company sounded familiar to him, but he could not associate it with Jack Ruby. Moldofsky stated that he, Schwartz and the Rubensteins lived in the same general neighborhood in Chicago around Roosevelt Road and California Avenue. He said he knew nothing of Jack Ruby's personal life and only recalls meeting Jack Ruby's brother, Earl, who also was a novelty salesman in the Chicago area. He stated that he did not know enough about Earl to offer any comment on him. The only associate that he knows of Ruby is Schwartz.

In this regard, Moldofsky offered that Schwartz, who introduced him to Earl, probably could give a good insight into the background of Jack Ruby and his family. He stated that Schwartz possibly lived with the Rubenstein family for a period of time until he, Schwartz, could get himself established in the Chicago area after arriving from Canada.

Moldofsky advised that Schwartz is currently in business as the Gardena Printers, Gardena, California.

Moldofsky further advised that his brother, Sidney, is currently in business at the Howlan Printing

Company, 1845 West Carroll, Chicago, Illinois. He stated that he feels certain that his brother never had any contact with Jack Ruby.

On April 10, 1964, Sidney Moldofsky, 5638 Lee Street, Morton Grove, Illinois, telephone YO 5-5789, owner of Howlan Printers, 1845 West Carroll, Chicago, Illinois, telephone CH 3-7478, advised that he and his brother, Saul, were in business as the Shelby Printing Company from 1940 to 1947.

He recalled an Edward Schwartz being an associate of his brother during the early years of World War II. He said he did not know "Sparky" Rubenstein, reportedly a friend of Schwartz, who is also known as Jack Ruby and is the individual who shot and killed Lee Harvey Oswald. He advised that if Schwartz had any business dealings with Ruby, it might have been known to his brother but it was not known to him. He had no recollection of the name Liberty Distributing Company.
