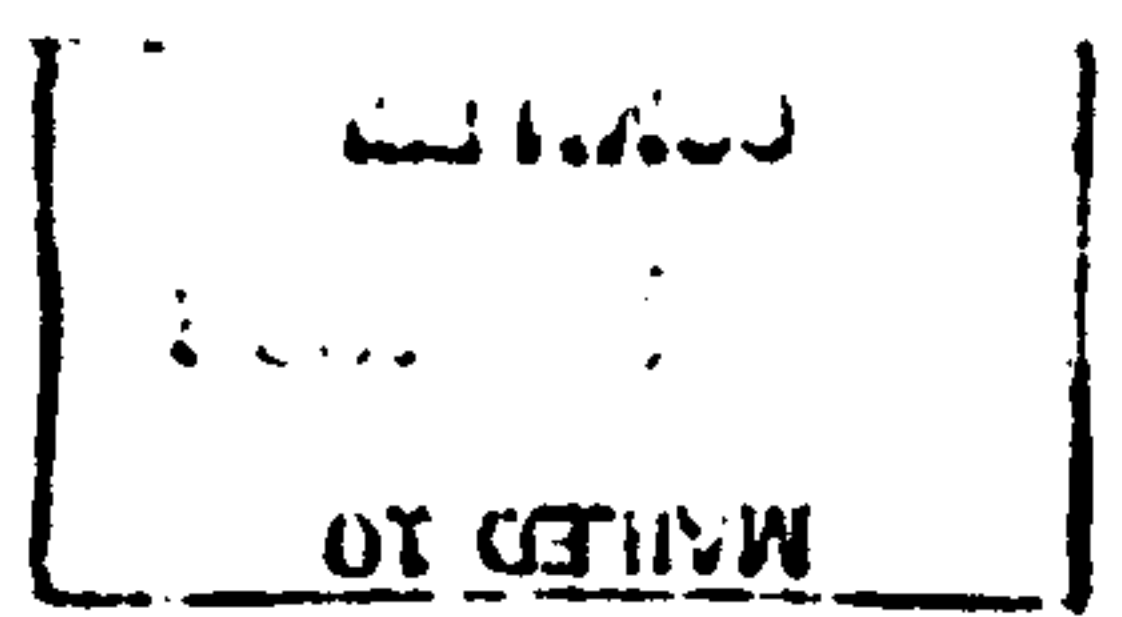

At this time in the Nation's bereavement, I am disturbed by your unfounded accusation of negligence and feel it necessary to inform you that the protection of the President and his immediate family is the responsibility of the Secret Service of the United States Treasury Department and not the FBI. Secret Service Agents were with the President at the time he was assassinated, and they, as any reasonable person would realize, are particularly grieved over this tragedy and need support rather than criticism during this trying time.

At times of stress, individuals are quick to find fault. More often than not they speak without any knowledge of the facts. Unfortunately your telegram of November 23, 1963, indicates unfamiliarity with our jurisdiction.

Bureau files contain no information identifiable with Mr. White.

At approximately 7:00 p. m. on instant date captioned individual called and requested to speak to the Director. He talked to Duty Supervisor Carl W. Spillers of the Special Investigative Division. Mr. White stated that he did not want to be nosey but would like to have some information as to why the Dallas, Texas, Police Department paraded suspect Oswald through a line of people in order to move him from one jail to another. He stated that in his opinion this was foolish and the same could have been accomplished by backing a van up to a door and escorting Oswald into the van, which would have prevented the killing of Oswald. Mr. White advised that he had no information to offer but after watching television most of the day he could not resist registering his feelings concerning the manner in which the Dallas Police Department had handled this case.

The Boston Office, by pretext, discreetly determined that on November 22, 1963, Riccardo left Needham, Massachusetts, at 7:00 a.m. to go to Nashua, New Hampshire, where he worked at Hilton Homes until noon. He then proceeded to Merrimack, Massachusetts.

On September 27, 1962, he executed an application for a United States passport at the American Embassy, Moscow. Embassy officials stated that it appeared certain that he had expatriated himself, however, they permitted him to make application for a new passport. During the visit to the American Embassy he stated that he had been trying to move his family to Czechoslovakia. He did admit that he had received a regular Soviet internal passport. The Department of State by memorandum December 5, 1962, advised the American Embassy, Moscow, that his application for a passport was disapproved. Passports were issued to Riccardo's wife and three children. He re-entered the United States June 28, 1963, on a nonquota immigrant visa. His wife and three children preceded him to the United States.

On November 22, 1963, 11:07 p.m., Adam Yarmolinsky, Special Assistant to the Secretary of Defense, suggested by telephone call that other defectors with similar backgrounds to that of Lee Harvey Oswald might have been in Dallas, Texas, November 22, 1963, and might have been involved in the assassination of the President. One of the names he furnished was that of Libero Piccardelli. This undoubtedly refers to Libero Riccardo. Our files show Riccardo was born June 18, 1917, at Needham, Massachusetts. He served in the U. S. Air Force from 1943 until 1947 when he was separated as a captain. He served in the U. S. Air Force Reserve from June 1947 until September 1957 when he was retired for physical reasons as a major. On September 30, 1958, he obtained a passport for himself, his wife and three children for a three-month pleasure trip to Russia and in February 1959 they traveled to Russia. On July 19 and 20, 1959, a story was carried in the Washington Capitol News Service that the subject had written an open letter announcing his desires to stay in Russia and requesting Soviet citizenship.

Your telegram of November 24th has been

It is certainly understandable that you should be highly disturbed by the report that the FBI had the alleged killer under surveillance prior to the brutal assassination of President Kennedy. I share your great concern and want to make it perfectly clear that there is absolutely no truth whatsoever to this unfounded and thoughtless allegation of negligence on the part of this Bureau.

As you may know, the protection of the President and his immediate family is the responsibility of the Secret Service. Nevertheless the full facilities of the Federal Bureau of Investigation were immediately deployed to assist that agency, and the President has instructed the FBI to conduct a full investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy and the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald. I can assure you that this Bureau will discharge its responsibilities in this regard with the same thoroughness and dispatch that have characterized our investigations in the past.

Dear Mr. Simister:

I have received your telegram of November 25th regarding the assassination of President Kennedy and can understand the concern prompting your statements.

Although the primary responsibility for the safety of the President and his family is the duty of the Secret Service, the FBI has made all of its facilities available to that agency and the local authorities. In addition, the President has instructed the FBI to conduct a full investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy and the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald. I can assure you that this Bureau will discharge its responsibilities in this regard with the same thoroughness and dispatch that have characterized our investigations in the past.
