HIM THAT OSWALD HAD BEEN SEEN IN ONE OF THE CLUBS OWNED OR OPERATED BY RUBY, SOMETIME DURING THE PREVIOUS WEEK, PRIOR TO PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION. HIS SON TOLD HIM THAT HE WAS WATCHING THE PRESIDENTIAL PARADE ON TELEVISION AT THE TIME OF THE PRESIDENT'S ASSASSINATION, AND HIS SON TOLD HIM GENERALLY OF WHAT HE HAD HEARD ON THE RADIO AND TELEVISION CONCERNING THE ASSASSINATIONS OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND OSWALD. HIS SON ALSO TOLD HIM THAT A FRATERNITY MEMBER HAD TOLD HIM OF THE PRESIDENT'S CONDITION UPON ARRIVAL AT THE HOSPITAL, AS APPARENTLY THE FRATERNITY MEMBER WAS DATING A NURSE WHO WAS PRESENT AT THE HOSPITAL WHEN THE PRESIDENT WAS BROUGHT TO THE HOSPITAL. AFTER TALKING FOR A FEW MINUTES, HIS WIFE, SHEILA MACDONALD UHLHORN, TALKED TO HIS SON FOR A FEW MINUTES, AFTER WHICH THE CONVERSATION WAS TERMINATED. UHLHORN WAS LAST IN DALLAS TO SEE THE SOUTHERN METHODIST TEXAS UNIVERSITY FOOTBALL GAME, AT WHICH TIME HE STAYED AT THE CABANA HOTEL, DALLAS, AND DEPARTED THE NEXT DAY FOR HARLINGEN, TEXAS, WHERE HE VISITED TWO OTHER CHILDREN WHO LIVE WITH HIS FIRST WIFE, FROM WHOM HE IS DIVORCED, JACQUELINE WALSH, AGE 40, WHO RESIDES AT 1006 OR 8 EBONY DRIVE, HARLINGEN. HIS PRESENT WIFE, SHEILA MACDONALD UHLHORN, IS AGE 32, AND IS FROM ELIZABETH, NEW JERSEY, WHERE SHE IS PRESENTLY VISITING HER PARENTS, N. N. MACDONALD, MAPLEWOOD, NEW JERSEY. 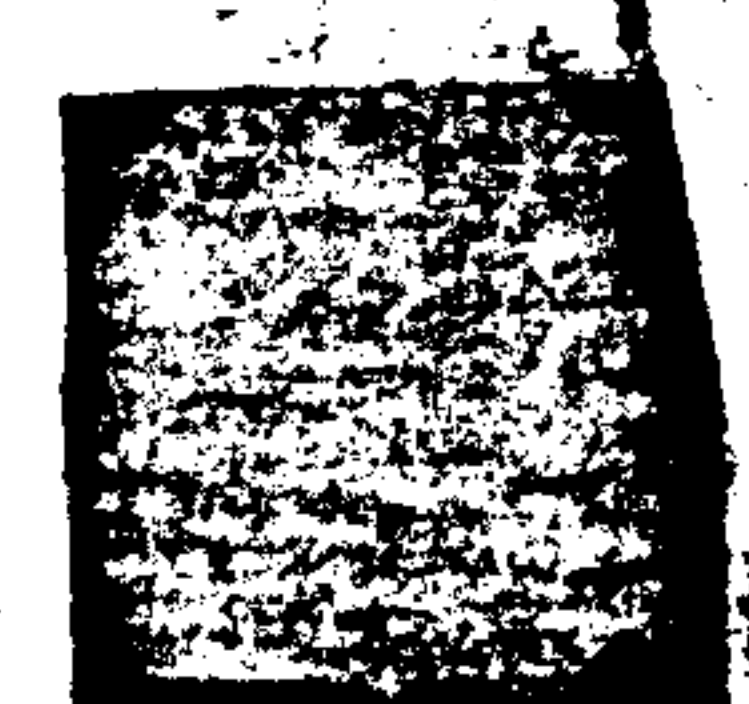

Shanklin was instructed to locate the bullets that hit the President and Governor Connally so that they might be compared with the gun that was found. If these bullets passed through the bodies of the President and/or the Governor, the President's automobile should be checked and the area around where the automobile was located when the shots were fired. We have instructed the Baltimore office to make arrangements to get hold of the bullets in the event they were not removed from the President's body, as this would be done at Bethesda Hospital.

I reiterated that if he needed additional personnel he should let us know. He said that after it is ascertained whether Oswald is the individual who shot the President, if he is not the individual Dallas will need additional manpower, and this should be resolved in the near future through the interview with Oswald.

Shanklin said that Secret Service does not appear to be doing much; that the majority of them have gone back to Washington with the Vice President and others. I told Shanklin that he should make sure that all possible investigative steps are being taken; for example, that the gun which is in the possession of the police is being checked for fingerprints; that the whereabouts of the suspect, Oswald, during the day is checked out; that the location in the building and on the stairs where the shots were fired and the gun was found is being carefully examined. I told him to be sure and not assume that the police are going to handle this properly; that we must conduct vigorous and thorough investigation to come up with the answer.

I talked with SAC Shanklin, Dallas, at 5:10 p.m. He said our agents are interviewing the suspect Oswald, along with the police; that the agent who handled the security case on Oswald, and another good criminal agent, are in with the police, interviewing Oswald. I told Shanklin if there was any question that a polygraph might be productive, he should go right ahead and use the polygraph.

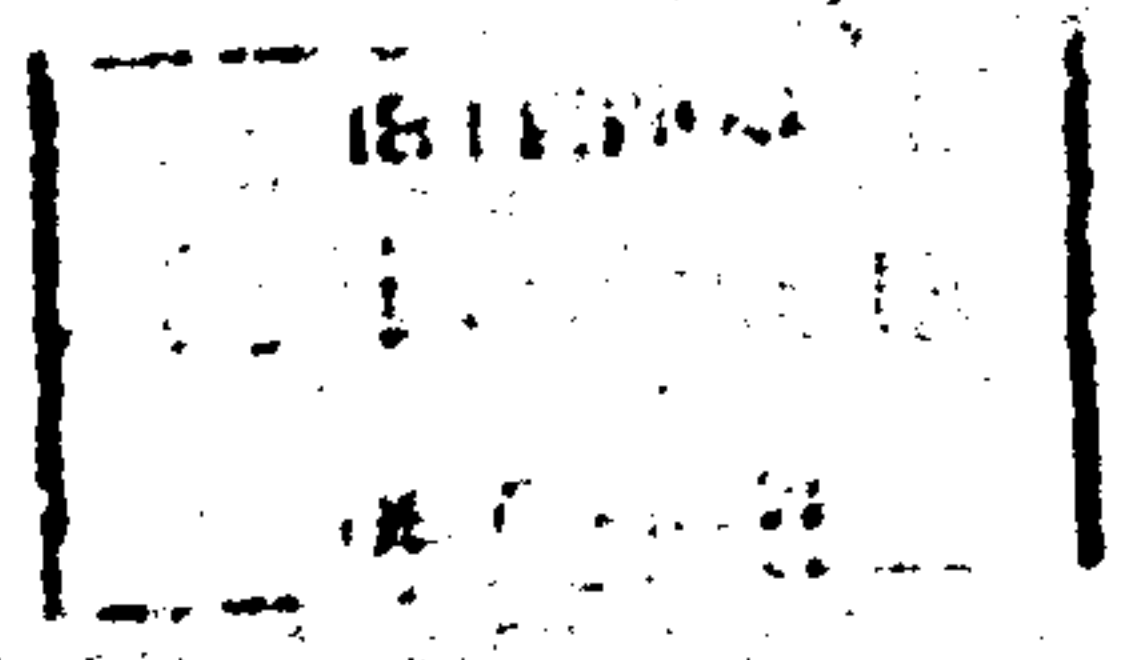

I noticed something several weeks ago which may be of some limited value to you.

On November 9, I stopped for lunch at Dawson's Drive In Restaurant, 1/4 mile beyond the turn-off to Ft. Washington and 3 to 4 miles north of the Woodrow Wilson bridge on Maryland route 210. On the back wall of the bathroom which is furthest from the city (there are two adjacent ones) was printed: I will kill JFK and RK for a price (presumably John F. Kennedy and Robert Kennedy). It had been partly erased and no name was signed.

Today I went back to make sure of the wording and to get the name of the place. The printing was still there but may have been less legible.

I think that printing statements like that is bad, because crackpots may take the suggestion seriously. I wonder if such things aren't being promoted systematically by the John Birch group or one of its affiliated organizations. I think I've noticed another such case, but I can't remember for sure.

I'm sorry that I didn't write to you when I first noticed this. I am deeply sorry about the death of President Kennedy.
