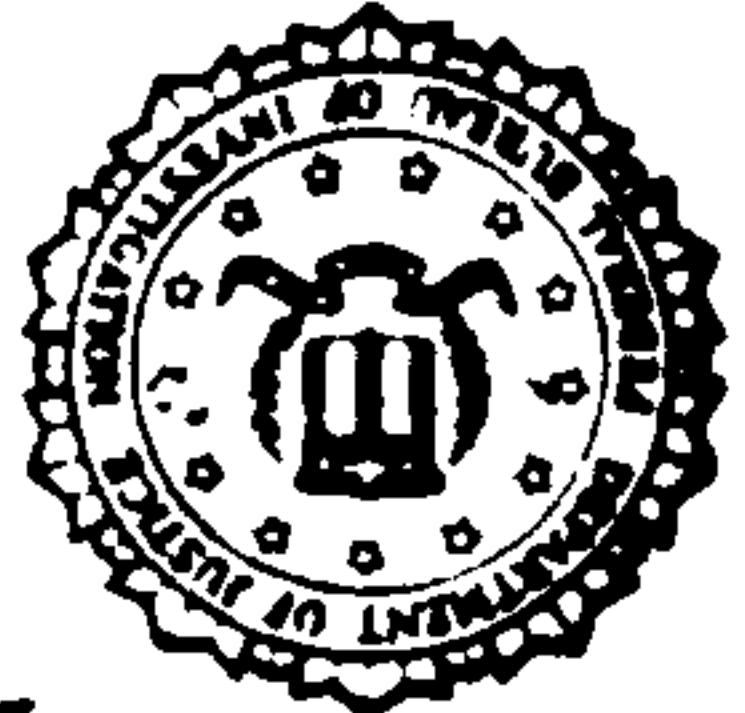

During this period FRANK engaged in conversation with handyman, name unrecalled, about 17 years old, tall, skinny, reddish hair, no glasses, who made the comment during a conversation that "1,000,000 should be raised to kill that Guy KENNEDY." FRANK did not recall the context or subject of instant conversation and recalled only this comment. FRANK does not recall this boy's name, however, JACOBSON would know same.

Upon contact, WALTER FRANK advised he and his wife vacationed at Edgewater Manor Apartments, 801 Lakeside Drive, Lake\_Oscola, Hendersonville, N.C., during the first half of September, 1963. This resort is owned by J. E. JACOBSON, Box 525, Hendersonville, N.C.

On 11/23/63 ROBERT CLAUDE BOWER, 301 N. DeLeon Street, Victoria, Texas, furnished the following information. BOWER advised that he was in the Levi Beer Tavern in San Antonio, Texas, about 10:00 PM on the evening of 11/22/63 at which time he was drinking beer with a Mexican male; and the subject of the President's assassination was brought up. BOWER advised that the individual whom he was talking to stated that he knew who assassinated the President, and he, BOWER, asked him who did it and he stated that the Mexican male would not give him any name. BOWER advised that he met this man at the bar and that they drank five or six beers a piece and were talking to one another only. He stated that the Mexican male appeared to be a stranger as he did not converse with anyone else and did not appear to be known at the bar. BOWER stated that he had never seen the subject before and that he would take him to be of Latin American descent, that he talked fairly good English but with a Mexican accent.

On 11-26-63 JAMES O. BRASHER, 714 57th, N.W., Albuquerque, New Mexico, who is employed by the Public Service Company, advised that he was formerly employed by Radio Station KFUN at Las Vegas, N.M., until 8-4-63, during which time he worked with ROBERT DOUGLAS there. He was interviewed concerning comments that some leading Texas politicians, identity not known, had reported "four men were planning to kill the President this fall." BRASHER stated he and DOUGLAS engaged in "bar room politics," discussing at length pointing out that both were Republicans; however, they differed on Republican viewpoints. He stated these discussions took place in their homes, at work and over an occasional beer; however, he emphatically denied receiving any information or making any statement which should indicate that four men were planning to kill the President this fall. He said he knows absolutely nothing concerning Texas politics and Texas politicians, and would definitely recall such a statement had he or DOUGLAS made same. He also advised he would have reported this fact immediately and feels sure that DOUGLAS would have done so.

On 11-26-63 Mr. ROBERT DOUGLAS, Route 1, Box 322, Las Vegas, N.M., advised he is an announcer and salesman for Radio Station KFUN there. DOUGLAS stated that he and JAMES

For the information of the Bureau, on 11/23/63 SJO instituted a program for verification of all SJO Detcom subjects in order to determine their whereabouts during the pertinent period. At the time of receipt of information from the Bureau regarding the filing of charges against OSWALD, the whereabouts of 40 Detcom subjects had been verified with the remainder being in the remote areas of the island. On receipt of this information this program was discontinued and results of all contacts have been placed in appropriate files.

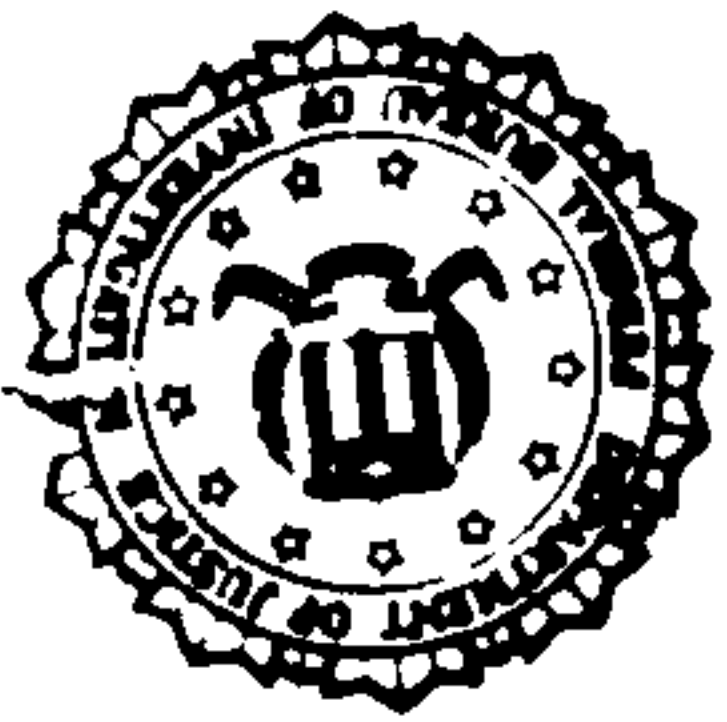



Dallas has been telephonically instructed to advise local authorities and we have sent cable to Legat, London, instructing that information be furnished to appropriate Irish authorities and have Legat promptly advise of any confirming data received.

By teletype 11-27-63 Los Angeles furnished following data received from Orange County, California, Sheriff's Office. Sheriff's Office on 11-27-63 received anonymous phone call from individual who sounded rational and well educated and stressed that this was not a practical joke. Caller claimed to have a brother who is member of Irish Republican Army (IRA). He said he had received word from a relative in Ireland advising that the IRA will attempt to get a company of IRA members into the U.S. via "Air Lingas" and, if unsuccessful by air, the members would arrive in the U.S. one by one for the purpose of going to Dallas to "commit mayhem on that city." Caller said he was unable to furnish any details.
