HERTIG, BUSINESS OFFICE, SDPD, ADVISED AT NINE THIRTY TWO A.M., THIS DATE, THAT BETWEEN NINE AND NINE TWENTY A.M., THIS DATE, HE RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM AN UNKNOWN HYSTERICAL WOMAN WHO TOLD THE SDPD TO CALL PRESIDENT JOHNSON AND TELL HIM THAT HE HAD BETTER NOT ATTEND THE LATE PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S FUNERAL TOMORROW. At 9:12 PM, November 24, 1963, Mr. LOUIS BENAVIDES, Special Agent in Charge, United States Secret Service, San Antonio, Texas, advised that he had received the following information from his headquarters in Washington, D.C.

On November 23, 1963, a man identifying himself as SIDNEY GLOVER, called the FBI in Washington, D. C., and talked to a Mr. GREEN. GLOVER stated that when all world leaders convene on November 25, 1963, in Washington, D. C., the same thing would take place that took place in Dallas, Texas. GLOVER was calling from a pay station in Corpus Christi, Texas.

Mr. BENAVIDES stated that he had checked with the Office of Naval Intelligence and the Corpus Christi, Texas, Police Department, and further found that GLOVER had been employed at the Corpus Christi Naval Air Station, but was not now so employed. This employment was several months ago and GLOVER was now in San Antonio.

Mr. BENAVIDES said that he also determined from his headquarters in Washington, D. C. that shortly after GLOVER's call a man stating he was FELIX COX telephoned the Pentagon, Washington, D. C., on November 23, 1963, and said he was a Staff Sergeant in the Marines. He furnished the same or similar data as had GLOVER. He also was calling from a pay station in Corpus Christi, Texas, and said that he had insufficient money to talk longer.

On November 24, 1963, Mr. HENRY C. MUTH, 807 Bailey Avenue, San Antonio, Texas, advised that he is a retired employee of Kelly Air Force Base, and the owner of the premises at that address.

He said that SIDNEY O. GLOVER is employed as an IBM operator at Kelly Air Force Base and has been so employed for the last five years. GLOVER occupied a garage apartment in the rear of Mr. MUTH's home. Mr. MUTH said that GLOVER is a white male, single and in his 30's.

He said that GLOVER left San Antonio on November 23, 1963, to visit over Thanksgiving with his mother, a Mrs. GLOVER, first name unknown, who resides at Portland, Texas, near Corpus Christi.

SUPPORT OF KENNEDY AND DISAGREED WITH THE KENNEDY PROGRAM FROM THEN ON. HILL STATED THAT HE HAS MADE [REDACTED] DOLLARS WHILE MR. KENNEDY WAS PRESIDENT AND HAD NO PERSONAL ANIMOSITY TOWARD THE PRESIDENT AND NO REASON FROM ANY BUSINESS DIFFERENCES. HE SAID HE BECAME INTERESTED IN AN OIL DEAL WHEREBY HE WAS ATTEMPTING TO PURCHASE THE PAN AMERICAN OIL RIGHTS IN TEXAS AND WOULD THEN SELL GAS TO THE CITY OF EL PASO, BUT THIS BUSINESS ARRANGEMENT BECAME COMPLICATED WHEN THE FPC MADE NUMEROUS DEMANDS AND HE VOLUNTARILY WITHDREW UPON THE ADVICE OF HIS ATTORNEY.

HILL STATED HIS ONLY CRITICISM OF THE KENNEDY ADMINISTRATION WAS IT QUOTE APPEARED TO BE GOING SOCIALIST UNQUOTE BUT HE NEVER STATED THAT MR. Dana Robert Backus

On November 23, 1963, Mrs. Jeannette Harger, PBX Operator, Sears Roebuck, Inc. Store at Vermont and Slauson Avenues, Los Angeles, California, who resides at 1910 Orange Avenue, Anaheim, California, was interviewed by Special Agents of the FBI at the above store. She advised that at approximately 10:40 a.m. on November 22, 1963, she went to the coffee shop at the penthouse of the store, where she saw Dana Backus, an insurance agent of the All-State Insurance Company, at the store. She told Backus that she heard a report that the President was either dying or dead. Backus said "that should have taken place at 8:00." She asked Backus to repeat what he had said. Backus then said "I said that it was scheduled for 8:00." She told Backus that he must have had something to do with it. Backus just grinned and said nothing.

Mrs. Harger stated that Delphine Neathery, Manager of the coffee shop, was present when the above statements were made by Backus.

On November 23, 1963, Mrs. Delphine Neathery, Manager of the coffee shop at the penthouse at the Sears Roebuck Store at Vermont and Slauson Avenue, Los Angeles, California, who resides at 1406 West 67th Street, Apartment 200, Los Angeles, California, was interviewed by Special Agents of the FBI at her residence. She stated that at about 11:00 a.m. on November 22, 1963, in the coffee shop, in the presence of Jeannette Harger, during a discussion of the shooting of the President, she heard Dana Backus say "That was scheduled for 8:00." She then asked him what he had said, but he did not reply.

On November 23, 1963, Harold Wenger, Security Officer at the Sears Roebuck, Inc. Store at Vermont and Slauson Avenues, Los Angeles, California, who resides at 9406 - 4th Avenue, Inglewood, California, was interviewed by Special Agents of the FBI at the store. Wenger stated that on the afternoon of November 22, 1963, he mentioned to

Dana Backus that the shooting of the President was a terrible thing, that he wondered if it had to do with civil rights. Backus told him that it goes deeper than that, that there are a lot of outfits that would like to get him for selling the country down the river to the commies, that he thought it was the best thing that had happened to the country, and that he would be willing to contribute money to the "guy" who did it.

Dana Robert Backus was interviewed on November 23, 1963 by Special Agents of the FBI, at the Sears Roebuck, Inc. Store, Vermont and Slauson Avenues, Los Angeles, California. Backus stated that he has been employed as an insurance agent by the All-State Insurance Company at the Sears Roebuck, Inc. Store, and resides at 1733 Oak Avenue, Manhattan Beach, California. He said that his strong anti-communist political convictions, and his opposition to the Kennedy administration are well known by his associates, but that while he feels that President Kennedy's removal from the Presidency to be beneficial in the long run, he did not approve of the method used to remove him.

He stated that he recalled making a remark to employees in the store to the effect that the shooting of the President was scheduled for 8:00, but he was merely trying to be humorous. He also recalled saying that there ought to be a collection for the man who did it, but by this remark, he did not mean to approve or condone the shooting. He denied having any prior knowledge of the plan to assassinate the President, or being in any way involved.

Backus claimed that he was a civilian employee of the U. S. Armed Forces in the Far East, and was captured in December, 1941 by the Japanese on Corregidor, and served four years in a prisoner of war camp. From 1950 to 1962, he served as a Major in the Military Department of the State of California (California National Guard). He denied membership in the Minuteman Organization, or any extremist group, but stated that he was assigned by the California National Guard about two years ago to penetrate the Minuteman Organization and to attempt to find out if they had obtained guns from the California National Guard.

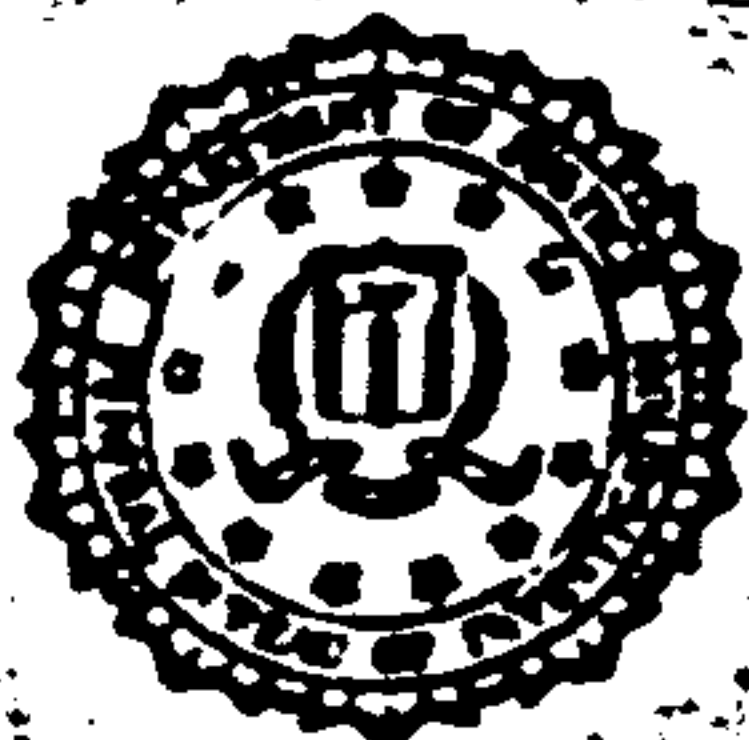

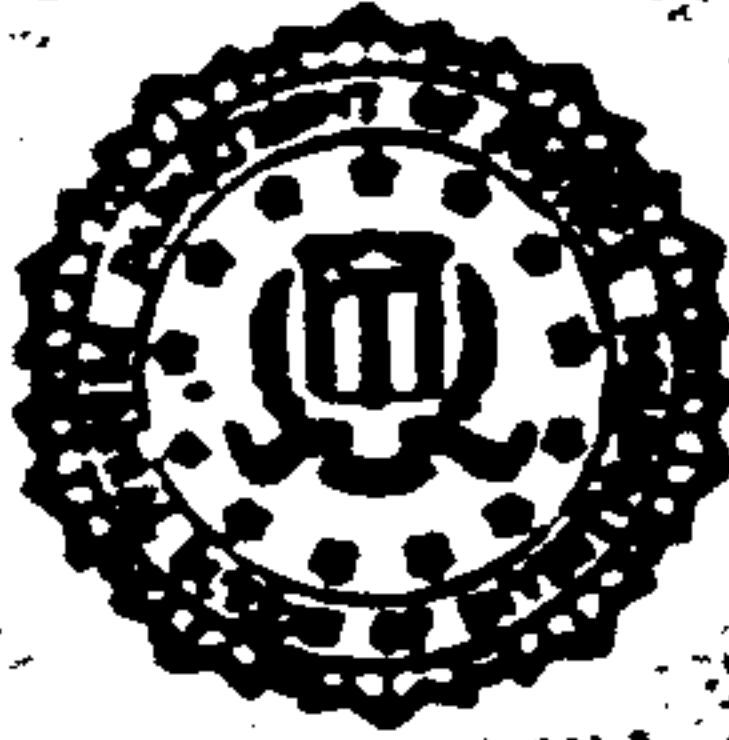

On November 22, 1963, an individual who identified himself as Jack Johnson, 2367 Madrona, Torrance, California, telephonically advised the FBI that one Bud Walsh had recently stated the President would be dead by the end of this month. Mr. Johnson stated he did not know Walsh's residence address and furnished no additional information other than to state Walsh was a City of Torrance employee.

Investigation conducted by the FBI disclosed the address 2367 Madrona, Torrance, was fictitious, and no record of a Jack Johnson could be located in the current telephone directory or Torrance city directory.

Inquiry of Detective Bureau, Torrance Police Department, disclosed that Harold A. Walsh, also known as Bud Walsh, and his wife, Marian L. Walsh, reside at 2039 West 233rd Street, Torrance; further, Walsh is the Torrance City Building Inspector and has been for a number of years. Walsh is currently under subpoena to appear before the California State Attorney General hearing into charges of corruption in the City of Torrance. The California State Attorney General hearings have been postponed from time to time, but it was ascertained that Walsh was in the City of Torrance on November 22, 1963.

On November 23, 1963, Harold Walsh was interviewed, at which time he disclosed he has been a Torrance, California, resident for the past 20 years, is currently in charge of the Torrance Police Mounted Patrol and has been a reserve officer in this organization for the past 10 years. He has also been employed by the City of Torrance for the past 10 years.

Mr. Walsh readily admitted that a week or so ago during the course of a conversation with Lieutenant Cook, Vice Officer, Torrance Police Department, and Jack Phillips

of Paramount Building Company, two of his friends for many years, that he made the statement that every 20 years during a zero series, the President in office did not finish his term. He stated that history has shown this to be a fact, and he felt President Kennedy, who was elected in 1960, if history was right, would not finish his term. The conversation became intense over this subject, and Walsh bet Mr. Phillips \$100.00 President Kennedy would not finish his term, based not only on Walsh's knowledge of history, but in view of the numerous events which had occurred in this country, all of historical importance, involving James Hoffa, the steel crisis, the Cuban situation, integration, and other such factors which aroused the public.

Walsh never realized how prophetic his statement would be, and he stated he never even thought of the statement until November 22, 1963, at which time Lieutenant Cook noted during the course of a conversation that "Bud Walsh really hit it on the nose" in his prophetic statement of a week or more ago.

Mr. Walsh stated people seemingly have no regard for human life and certainly in many instances have no respect for Government law or order. Walsh stated that he had the highest regard for President Kennedy, and the fact that the President's life was snuffed out is one of our great tragedies. He stated that he and his family are in mourning for the President. He states he now wishes he had never made a statement which turned out to be so prophetic.

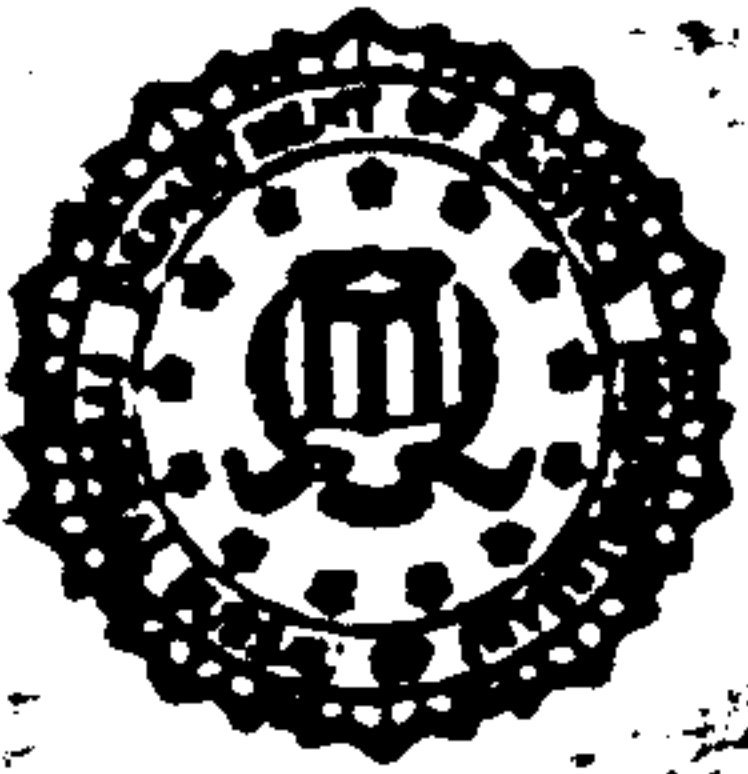

He said that he is not an admirer of President Kennedy, did not vote for him and has been critical of the Kennedy administration policies. Several years ago he changed his voter's registration to Independent as he was disgusted with both the Democrat and Republican parties, because of "communist influence." He said formerly he was a registered Republican and now considers himself a Goldwater Conservative.

He said that he was shocked at the news of the presidential assassination and would have no knowledge of any element that could be involved in this matter. He said he does not feel so strongly anti-Kennedy that he would desire the president's death.

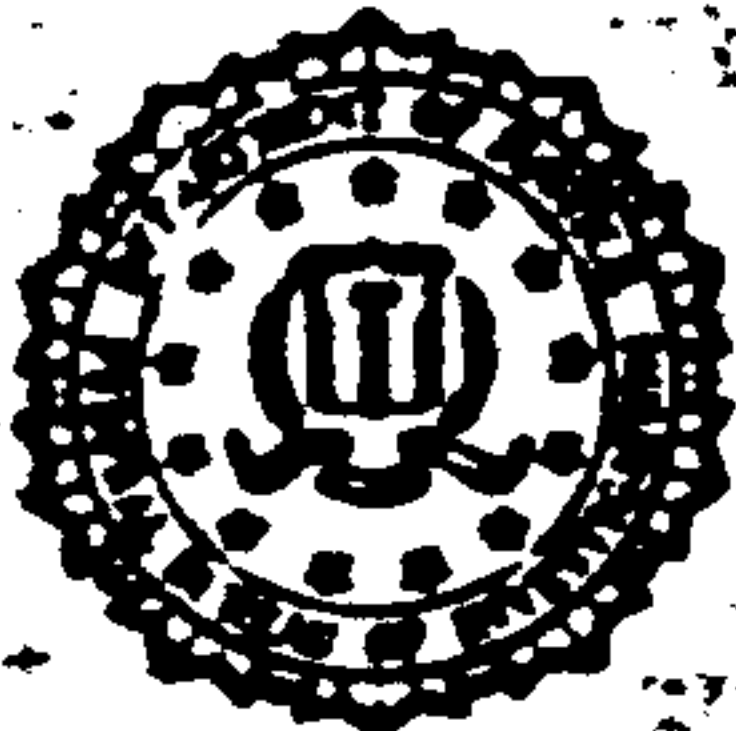

On November 22, 1963, at 1:25 p.m., Conrado Lope, who resides at 5511 Inglewood Boulevard, Culver City, California, and who is employed at the Mica Company, 4031 Klenda Street, Culver City, furnished information to a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that one Ricardo Perez, a fellow employee at the Mica Company, on November 21, 1963, told him he was going to kill President Kennedy. Perez allegedly told Lope it was President Kennedy's fault that conditions were poor in Cuba and he was not giving Castro aid.

According to Conrado Lope, Perez is very pro-Castro in his sympathies, has made pro-Castro statements, has spoken in favor of the present Cuban government, and has talked against the United States.

On November 22, 1963, Miss Cam Carlson, an office worker at the Mica Company, advised their records reflect that Perez resides at 3667 Overland Street, Culver City. She was not in possession of any additional background information concerning him. She made an appropriate inquiry in the factory, at which time she was able to determine Perez was then present and working in the factory as of November 22, 1963.

On November 24, 1963, TED MEADOWS and JOSH KING of Radio Station KLAC News Bureau, Los Angeles, telephonically advised that twice during the early morning hours of November 24, 1963, an unidentified woman called the News Bureau. She refused to give her name. She said she works at a hotel in Beverly Hills, and she possibly said the Beverly Hilton Hotel. She may have said it was the hotel where President KENNEDY stayed the last time he was in Los Angeles. (alt)

The woman said that on November 21, 1963, she was in the hotel elevator about 6:55 p.m. She was going to the top floor to her work station. A man got on the elevator with her. She inquired as to what floor he wanted and he replied he would go as far as her floor. He was reading a newspaper and she inquired, "What are the headlines?" He replied, "KENNEDY has been assassinated. KENNEDY is dead." The woman said she did not know what to make of the statement so she worked out her shift that night and went home.

The woman was awakened the next morning by a friend who told her the President had just been assassinated. She has not seen the man again but thinks she could identify him because he checked out on the morning of November 22, 1963 and there were only three persons who checked out of the hotel that morning. Also, she knows a woman who knows who the man is. She was so upset when the man made the statement to her and later became fact that she could not go back to work until November 24, 1963.

The woman also said that she is foreign born. She has a friend of Irish extraction who is a former nurse maid of President KENNEDY and was with the KENNEDY family in Ireland for several years. This woman also now works in a hotel but the calling woman would not say if it was the same hotel where she herself is employed.

The woman commented that she was certain the man in the elevator was not LEE HOWARD OSWALD.

On November 23, 1963, Mr. KENNETH DON BRAASCH,

Miss Lorraine Vargas, Granville Avenue, Malden, Massachusetts, advised Special Agents of the FBI on November 24, 1963, that while vacationing at the Pan American Hotel, 17875 Collins Avenue Miami, Florida, on September 19, 1963, she met a man named Harlan, whose first name she could not recall, and his wife, Polly, who were from Houston, Texas. Harlan was believed by Miss Vargas to own an insurance company in Houston, Texas bearing his name.

During a conversation that began in jest about the North and South relations and President Kennedy's stand on civil rights, Harlan became irate and made statements, the exact words of which she was unable to recall, but the substance of which was that he would like to see the President dead and if he knew someone who would do it, he would give him the gun or pay to have it done. Miss Vargas said she had no specific reason to believe Harlan was in any way connected with the assassination of President Kennedy, but in view of his remarks thought it advisable to report this information for what it is worth.

She described Harlan as follows:

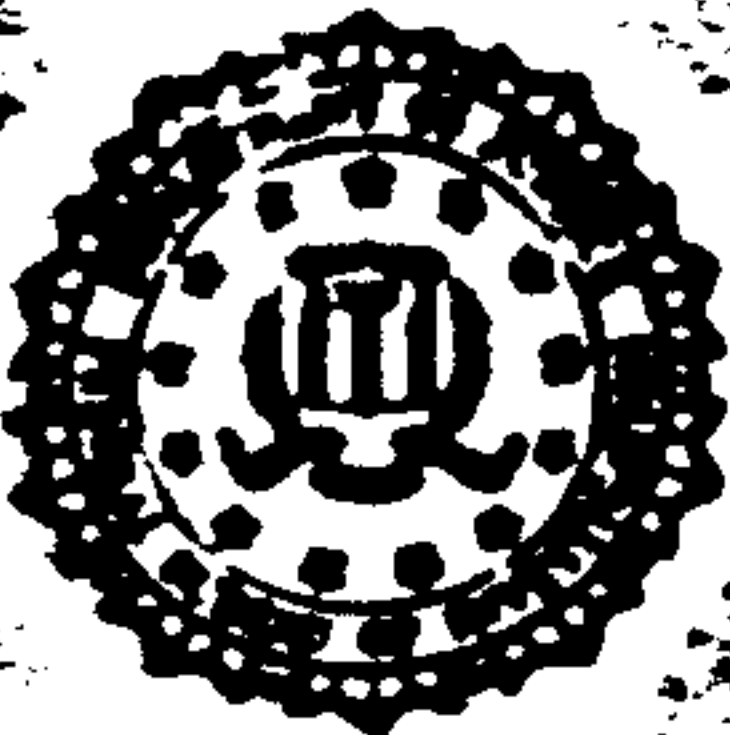

Dr. ~~BEN~~ PARKER, owner of radio station KBOP, Pleasanton, Texas, stated that one day between early mid afternoon sometime between about October 8, 1963, and October 15, 1963, to his best recollection, a white man, name not recalled, age about mid 20s, with sandy hair, 5'7-8", of rather dirty appearance, came into radio station KBOP stating that he was driving through Pleasanton and would like to obtain employment with this station. Doctor PARKER had no employment to offer this individual and therefore did not obtain any further information about him. He said he did not see any automobile that this man may have had nor did he know whether he was accompanied by anyone else. Doctor PARKER mentioned that he had seen television photographs of LEE HARVEY OSWALD and that he believed it was possible this individual who contacted him for employment may have been OSWALD. However, he said he had actually paid very little attention to the individual seeking employment and was not at all sure that they were the same and also that it was possible his own imagination has become overly active due to publicity concerning the assassination of the President.

Mrs. BEN PARKER, wife of Dr. BEN PARKER, owner of radio station KBOP, Pleasanton, Texas, said that one day about either right after noon or sometime before mid afternoon between the period October 8, 1963, to October 15, 1963, to her best recollection, she received a telephone call from a man, name not recalled, who told her he was passing through Pleasanton and wanted immediate employment if possible with KBOP. 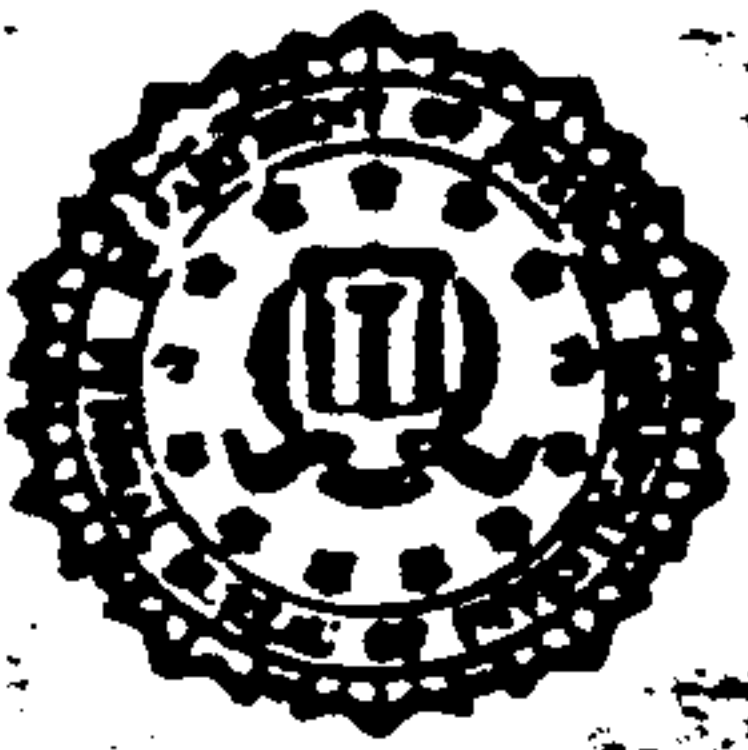

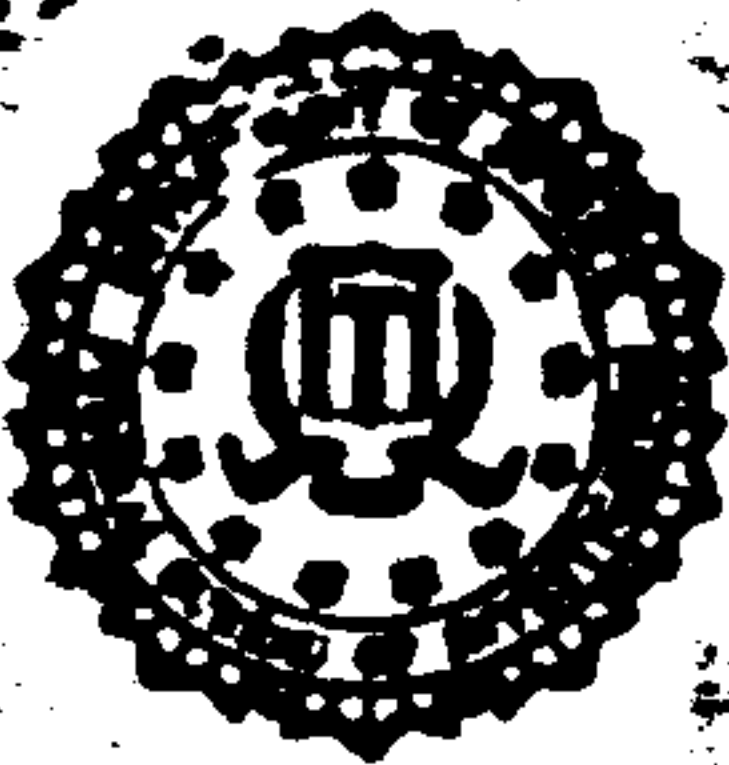

BASILA, owner of a drugstore at 620 West Houston Street,
that on November 21, 1963, while he, BASILA, was listening
to a radio newscast concerning President KENNEDY's pending
Dallas visit, a man entered his store and said in Spanish,
"KENNEY is alive today, but he will be dead tomorrow."
BASILA believed the dialect to be Cuban.

GREGORY F. BASILA, 620 West Houston Street,
San Antonio, Texas, was interviewed by an FBI Agent on
November 26, 1963, and advised that between 7:00 and 8:00 p.m.
on the evening of November 21, 1963, he was listening to
the radio newscast of President KENNEDY's pending Dallas visit.
A lone male in his store made the comment to him, "Tomorrow
KENNEDY will be killed in Dallas." He then repeated, "In
Dallas." This statement was made in Spanish in a dialect
BASILA believed to be Cuban. BASILA stated that this
individual was completely unknown to him, that he had never
seen him before and has not seen him since. BASILA stated
that although there were other people in the store, the

BASILA described the individual as Latin American, but definitely not Mexican; height, five feet, four inches; weight, 135 to 145 pounds; hair, black; complexion, medium dark; clothing, hatless, short sleeve sportshirt and dark trousers. He stated that since he was comparatively busy at the time, he did not notice if the man left in an automobile.

BASILA further stated that many people had told him that BILLY GRAHAM was trying to keep President KENNEDY from coming to Dallas.

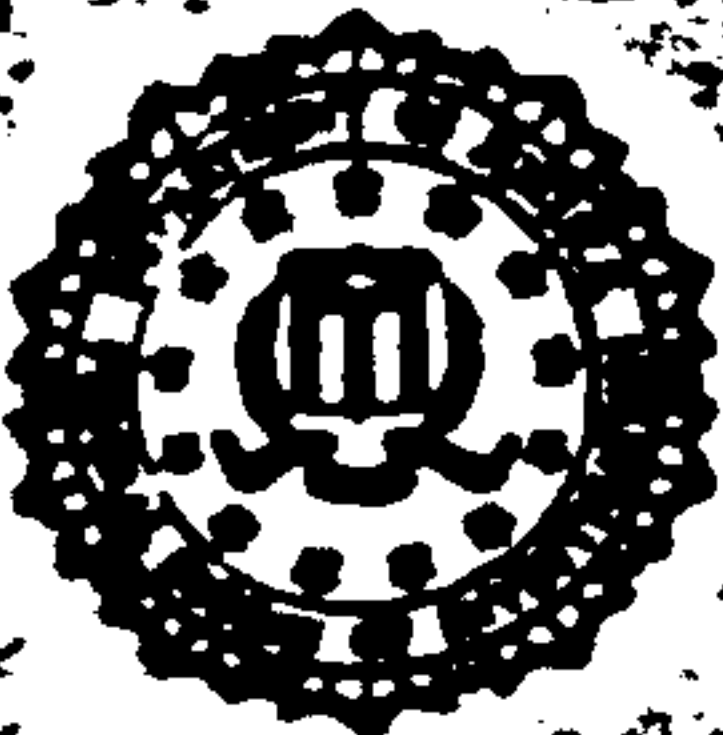

At 2:50 p.m., November 21, 1963, Mrs. ALBERT SESTAK, 411 West Baylor Street, San Antonio, Texas, telephonically advised the San Antonio Office that she and her husband were spectators when President KENNEDY and other dignitaries paraded in San Antonio on November 21, 1963.

They watched the parade at McCrory's Department Store located at Navarro and East Houston Street.

After the President and other dignitaries had passed she and her husband started to walk south on Navarro to get their automobile which was parked at a parking lot at Navarro and College Streets. At this time a Negro man who had been watching the parade said, "Have you heard what happened on Broadway? The President is gone, they shot him to death with a gun." Mrs. SESTAK stated her husband said to the Negro "You are lying." and the Negro man said "You will find out tomorrow and read about it in the paper." Mrs. SESTAK's husband replied, "You are lying." The Negro man said "You will see tomorrow. You don't believe me do you?"

Mrs. SESTAK stated that the Negro man walked along with them to College Street and she saw no more of him. She noticed there was a white man walking along close in the vicinity but she did not know whether he was with the Negro.

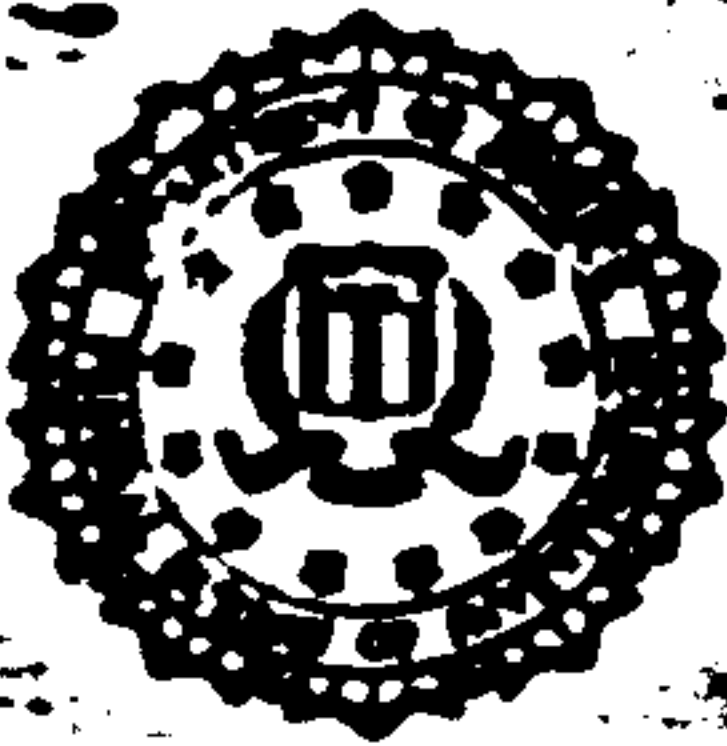

Information volunteered by Sergeant First Class ANDERSON, Fort Sill, Oklahoma, disclosed that while Sergeant ANDERSON was at Fort Hood, Texas, on temporary duty on November 15, 1963, he had planned to leave Killeen, Texas, on a three-day pass and went to the Killeen Finance Company, Killeen, Texas, to arrange for a loan. Sergeant ANDERSON advised that while waiting for the Killeen Finance Company to open at 9:00 a.m. on November 15, 1963, he walked around several blocks and at about 8:50 a.m. he entered a pawn shop to look at Army pistols. Sergeant ANDERSON states that there was one customer in the shop and that the proprietor was showing the customer a high powered rifle and scope designed for 3006 or Winchester rifles. Sergeant ANDERSON stated he left after two or three minutes and the customer was still at the shop. ANDERSON described the customer as a white, male, age in the middle 40s, 5' 8" to 5' 10", weight 170 to 175 pounds, possibly wearing glasses and wearing an old dress style felt brimed hat.

Sergeant ANDERSON further described the location of the shop as north of the Highway 190 across the railroad tracks on the street where the Ford Motor Company was located on the east side in the block between the highway and the railroad. ANDERSON continued that in the first block across the railroad the pawn shop was located on the west side of the street about the second building and that the Killeen Finance Company was around the corner

of the next street north to the left or west. He related the front door of the pawn shop was on the left side as you face the front of the building and that rifles were displayed on the rack on the right side as you enter the shop.

Mr. JESSE RAY SMITH, manager, the Arrow Loan Company, 309 North A Street, Killeen, Texas, advised on November 23, 1963, that he has been manager of the Arrow Loan Company for approximately three years, and that during this period of time he opens the loan company shop at 10:00 a.m. and with rare exception opens the shop earlier than 10:00 a.m. Mr. SMITH advised that their shop has carried no rifle scope for over a period of a year and has carried no 3006 or Winchester rifles at that store this year. SMITH continued that their store did carry a 30.40 Craig Springfield rifle and a German make 765 millimeter Mauser rifle, but both of these rifles were not sold and are currently in the store stock.

A check of the sales receipts and record of fire arms sales of the Arrow Loan Company for a period from November 1, 1963, through November 22, 1963, failed to reflect any record of a rifle sale through that store. Mr. SMITH reiterated the fact that their store definitely had carried no scope either mounted or unmounted on a rifle for over a period of a year and that he had no recollection of any individual answering the description furnished.

Mr. ERBIE ERSKIN GREEN, owner, Arrow Loan Company, 309 North A Street, Killeen, Texas, advised that only Mr. SMITH and himself possess keys to the Arrow Loan Company at the 309 North A Street, Killeen, Texas, location and that this store has not carried any 3006 rifles this year. He stated the only 3006 rifle with a scope was a Remington 3006 mounted with an eight power scope that was sold through his Western Pawn Shop Store on West Highway 190 and that the individual who purchased the weapon was a part time employee of his Western Pawn Shop Store and was currently in Killeen, Texas. Mr. GREEN stated the 3006 Remington rifle has never left the store premises although Mr. GREEN had purchased the weapon some months ago.

Mr. ~~BUD MOORE~~, owner, Bud's Gun Shop, 203 North A Street, Killeen, Texas, advised on November 23, 1963, that he generally recalled a customer being in his store at approximately 9:00 a.m. on November 15, 1963, who answered the general description as furnished and that this individual, WALKER BOREN, was a rancher who lived in Kempner, Texas, and a regular customer. Mr. MOORE stated that BOREN was a white, male, in his middle or late 40s, approximately 5' 7" to 5' 8" 170 pounds, who wore glasses and generally presented a rough appearance with old outdoor ranch wear.

B. Copperas, Kempner, Texas
Mr. MOORE stated that from his recollection that on November 15, 1963, WALKER BOREN traded a Japanese 6.5 millimeter rifle mounted with a scope, in on a Springfield M1903 30.06 rifle, Serial number 3097818. Mr. BOREN was allowed \$33.95 on the trade-in of his Japanese rifle, Serial No. 19472, against the purchase price of the Springfield M1903 30.06 rifle of \$39.95. MOORE related that he recalled some conversation with BOREN concerning the scope mounted on the Japanese rifle but no longer recalls specifically what was stated. MOORE related further that the rifle obtained by BOREN in trade definitely did not contain a scope.

Mr. WALKER BOREN, Route 1, Kempner, Texas, advised on November 23, 1963, that he had traded a Japanese rifle with a K4 Weaver Scope to BUD MOORE of Bud's Gun Shop, 203 North A Street, Killeen, Texas, on November 15, 1963. Mr. BOREN stated that he recalled that he had been in MOORE's Gun Shop at about 9:00 a.m. on November 15, 1963, and that he did enter into a dispute with MOORE concerning the fact that the scope mounted on the Japanese rifle was off center and as a result had been ineffective for accurate shooting.

Mr. BOREN exhibited the Springfield M1903 30.06 rifle and maintained that the weapon had been unused since its purchase but that he had purchased the weapon or traded the weapon for deer hunting this season.

Mr. BOREN advised that he had been into Killeen, Texas, on November 22, 1963, to visit briefly with MOORE at MOORE's gun shop but had returned to his home shortly before noon and had spent the balance of the day in or around his home and ranch property doing work. He stated,

he initially heard the information concerning President JOHN F. KENNEDY's assassination at Dallas, Texas, by radio and that much of the day was spent at his home following the progress reports of the investigation and events surrounding the President's assassination.

On November 25, 1963, a Confidential Source who is employed at Patrick Air Force Base, Florida, and who has known and worked with LOUIS J. ULLIAN, JR. for several months, reported that ULLIAN was attending a conference when it was learned that President JOHN F. KENNEDY had been shot. Among those present at this conference were Mr. CYRIL GOLUB, an engineer with Pan American World Airways, Inc.; Mr. JACK GENEAROS, a procurement officer for the Air Force; Mr. V. PAUL YALE, an engineer or project officer for the Air Force; and perhaps the secretary of Mr. GENEAROS.

This conference was being held in the office of Mr. GENEAROS in the Technical Laboratory Building at Patrick Air Force Base. According to information received by the source, Mr. GENEAROS announced he had just been informed that President KENNEDY and Vice President JOHNSON had been shot in Dallas, Texas. Mr. ULLIAN then stated, "Good, I hope he dies. I never thought very much of him anyway."

Mr. ULLIAN was reminded of the very serious nature of the news, and someone stated that he would only have to watch what happened to the stock market to see how seriously the news would be taken throughout the country. ULLIAN is said to have replied that he was lucky, since a drop in the market would not affect his municipal bonds. The source advised that ULLIAN continued to make derogatory remarks about President KENNEDY, but these further specific remarks are not recalled by the source.
