SERGEI FLEEGERS, A COMMENTATOR FOR THE MUTUAL BROADCASTING COMPANY (MBC), ON NOVEMBER TWENTYFOUR, LAST, MADE REFERENCE TO THE MOVEMENTS OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD IN AND OUT OF THE SOVIET UNION. HE ALSO INDICATED CERTAIN TRAINING ALLEGEDLY RECEIVED BY OSWALD. THE COMMENTS BY FLEEGERS WERE REPORTEDLY BASED UPON "VIENNESE INTELLIGENCE SOURCES." A COPY OF THE TAPE HAS BEEN FURNISHED TO THE BUREAU.

Miss Zimmerman appeared to furnish this information in a distraught manner and appeared to be high strung and a highly nervous individual.

Miss Zimmerman stated that she had never seen this individual, but that she had heard him practically nightly from the time the apartment was first occupied until approximately three or four months ago. She advised that this individual was loud, noisy and profane and that most of his conversations were early in the morning which lead her to believe that this individual worked nights.

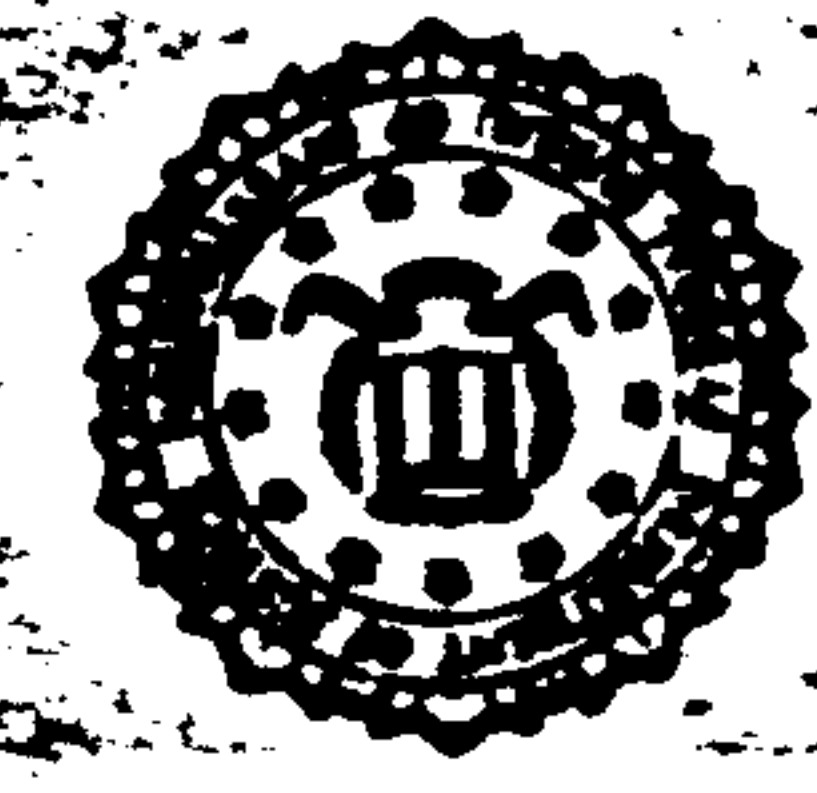

On November 23, 1963, James E. Gadberty, Manager, 1134 Chestnut Avenue, Apartment 1, advised that Matthew Bezevich had been the first occupant of the apartment pointed out by Miss Zimmerman, Apartment 15.

He advised Bezevich moved to 7651 KI Chaco, Buena Park, California in late June, 1963. He stated Bezevich occupied Apartment 15 with his mother and worked the night shift as a leadman for an electronics subsidiary of North American Aviation Corporation in Downey, California. Gadberty stated that Bezevich was a quiet, intelligent individual about whom he had had no complaints and whom he had considered to be an excellent tenant. He stated that he had conversed at length with Bezevich on current events and while Bezevich had expressed no opinions, from his general conversation he deduced Bezevich to be a 100 percent loyal American. Gadberty advised that he had never heard Bezevich discuss the President in any respect.

George C. Woodmansee, 2161 West 25th Street, San Pedro, California, Referee, Unemployment Insurance Appeals Board for the State of California, advised that he had occupied Apartment 10 at 1120 Chestnut Street, Long Beach until September 30, 1963. He stated that he had heard no loud talks or opinions or conversations such as described by Miss Zimmerman during his tenancy at the Chestnut Street address and that the only disturbing neighbor was the one to the south of him where there had been much brawling and disturbances. (The apartment south of Woodmansee's is that occupied by Miss Zimmerman and her family.)

It should be noted that a distance of 60 feet separates the window of the former apartment of Mr. Bezevich and the residence of Miss Zimmerman, and that the former apartment of Mr. Woodmansee lies on a direct line between the former apartment of Mr. Bezevich and the residence of Miss Zimmerman.

On November 23, 1963, a Special Agent of the FBI attempted to contact Matthew Bezevich at 7651 KI Chaco, Buena Park, California, with no success.

Re: MATTHEW BEZVEICH

Mr. and Mrs. Robert Stratford, 7641 El Chaco,

were contacted and they advised that Bezveich has lived

at the above address about six months. Mrs. Stratford

stated she saw Bezveich physically at 3:30 p.m., November

22, 1963 getting into a car to go to work. She stated he

works at Autonetics in Compton and that he returns home

between 1:00 and 2:00 a.m. each morning. She said no

statement he has ever made has indicated that he is sympathetic

to the Communist Party, but advised that he is a Yugoslavian

National.

They could not advise the whereabouts of Bezveich

and numerous attempts to contact him telephonically on

November 23, 1963 were unsuccessful.

On November 24, 1963, Special Agents contacted

Matthew Bezveich who advised that his name is spelled

Bezveich and that he is also known as Matthew Blazevic.

He stated he was born September 23, 1932, Dalmatia, Yugoslavia,

and he was observed to be described as male, white, 5'8"

175 pounds, blue eyes, brown hair, ruddy complexion, medium

build, pin operator, Autonetics, Compton, California.

7641 El Chaco, Compton, California. PARK, CALIF

Bezveich advised he entered the U. S. from

Yugoslavia August 4, 1952 and was naturalized as U. S.

citizen February 21, 1958 at the U. S. District Court,

Los Angeles.

Bezveich stated he was employed the entire

day November 22, 1963, that is from the time he left home

at 3:30 p.m. until about 2:00 a.m. the morning of

November 23, 1963.

He stated that until he left Yugoslavia in 1952

he had never participated in or joined any communist

organization as he is a Roman Catholic and that his family

suffered because of this. He stated he has never known or

associated with any members of the Communist Party since

arriving in the U. S. He stated he never made any

statement regarding the President's going to be shot since

he denied having any such knowledge.

Re: MATTHEW BEAZEVICH

He advised further that he is willing to cooperate in any way to protect his American citizenship and that he has no reason to lie about any statement of this nature.

Beazevich advised that he resided 1134 Chestnut, Apartment 15, Long Beach from November, 1962 until July, 1963.

Mr. William Foley, First Assistant, Criminal Division, Department of Justice, advised this afternoon that Assistant Attorney General Miller's office had received a telephone call from Walter Moeller, former Congressman from Ohio. Mr. Moeller advised that while traveling from Washington to Boston over the weekend he overheard a conversation concerning the assassination of President Kennedy, which he thought was most interesting and worthy of being passed along. He requested that he be interviewed concerning this conversation. According to Mr. Foley, Mr. Moeller has an office in the Universal Building, Washington, D. C.

ACTION:

Mr. Foley was advised that this information will be immediately forwarded to the Washington Field Office in order that an Agent could interview former Congressman Moeller this afternoon. Supervisor Grant Nanna, Washington Field Office, was furnished the above information and requested to have an Agent talk to Mr. Moeller this afternoon and advise the Bureau of the results.

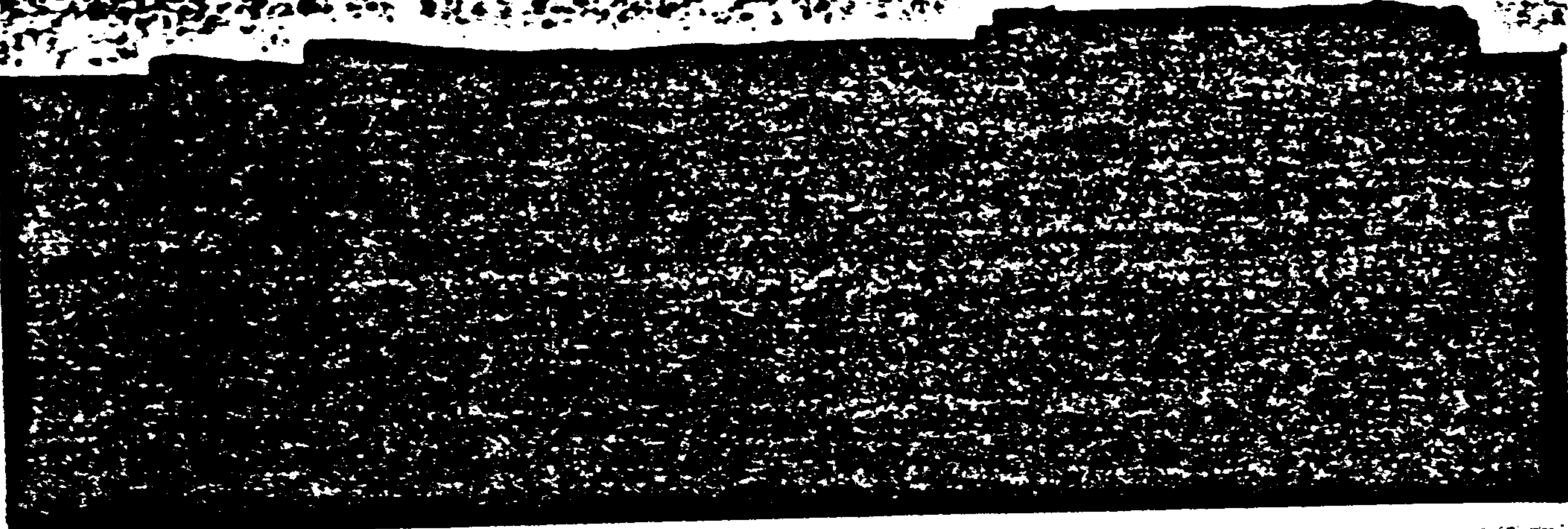

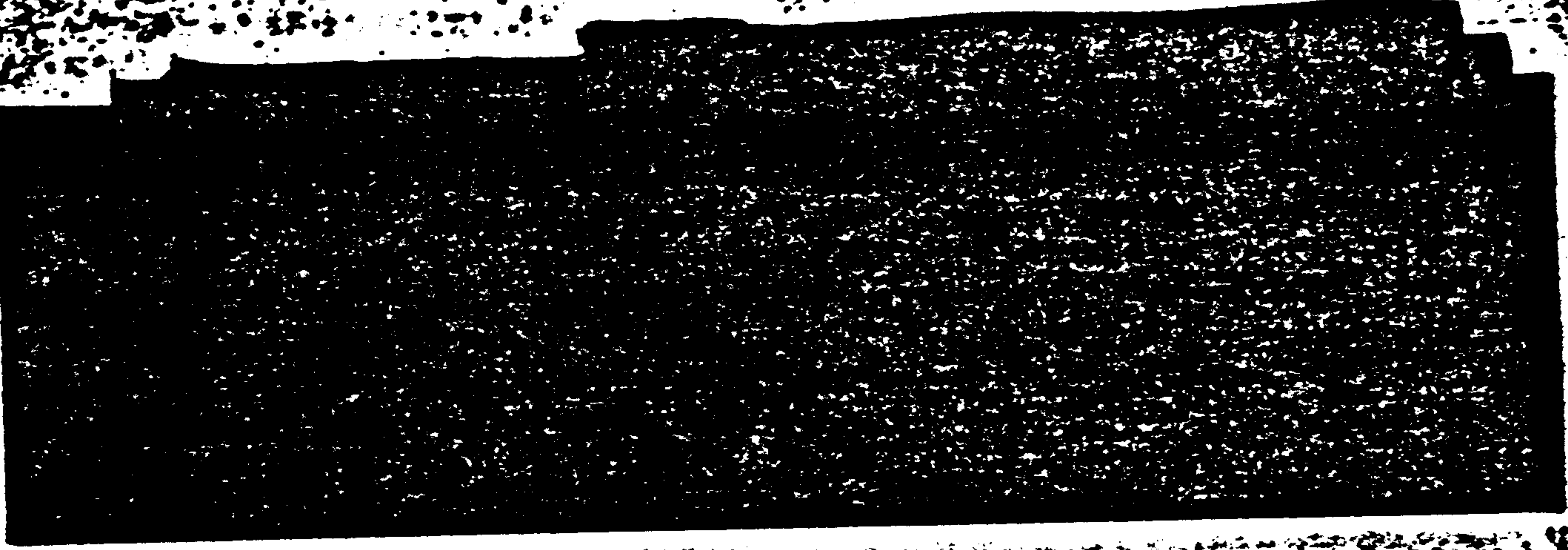

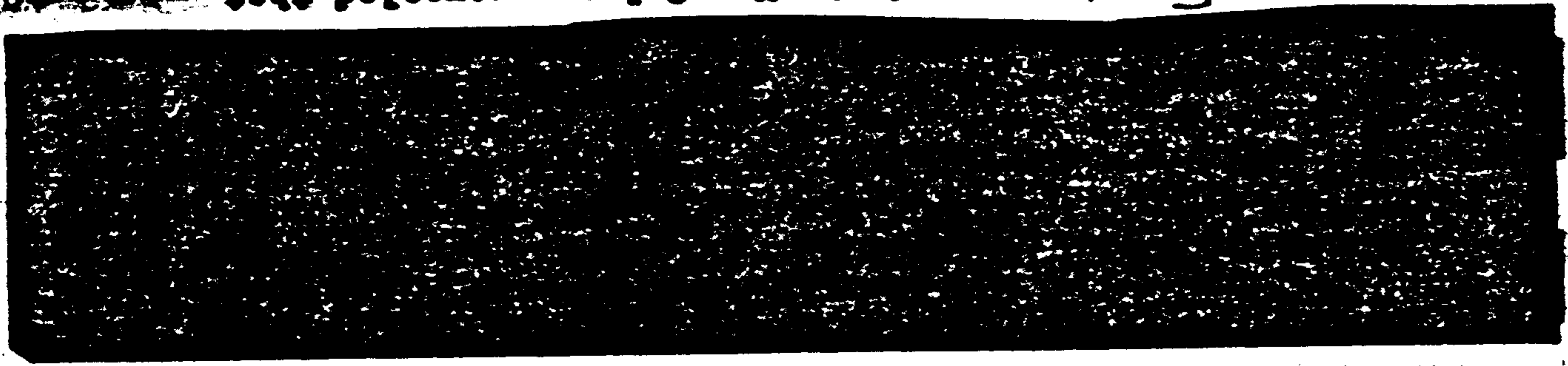
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Mrs. FUZZETT stated she was furnishing this information because she heard on television that OSWALD had been in New Orleans and used to be seen near the Trade Mart. She thought the above incident of possible assistance she added that she was employed by Captain KEVILL LAY.

She stated that on Wednesday, 11/20/63, at about 11:50 AM, while she was on her way to church, she saw a man whom she thinks may have been LEE OSWALD. This man was walking on Camp Street toward the Trade Mart in the direction of Poydras Street. He was alone, and she described him as about 24 years of age, small build, 5'8", sandy-colored, curly hair, and appeared feminine. "Like many of those you see in the French Quarter, New Orleans." She added he had a tanned complexion, dark eyebrows, was unusual looking, and was dressed in a green plaid shirt, short sleeves, brown trousers, brown shoes, and was not carrying anything, for his hands were in his pockets.

"I, Virginia Barbier Ruzette, make the following statements to Regis L. Kennedy and Lester G. Davis, who have identified themselves as Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. These statements are given freely and voluntarily and without threats or promises. I have been advised I do not have to make any statement and that there may be used against me in a court of law. I have also been advised I have the right to consult an attorney.

On 11/30/63, Mrs. RUZETTE was interviewed concerning the allegation that she made statements indicating she was an informant for the FBI, and she furnished the following signed statement:

At 6:11 PM the same date, 11/25/63, Mrs. RUZETTE again telephoned the New Orleans Office and advised SA THOMAS H. GIST at this time that she had just seen a photograph of OSWALD in the newspaper and one on television and that the man she saw on Camp Street on 11/20/63 was not OSWALD.

"On another occasion, about 1948, I wrote a letter to the R.B.I. advising that Christina Poplica, who lives in Buras, La., and who sometimes stayed in New Orleans, had married a Russian. I can't recall his name."

"On a recent occasion, I telephoned the R.B.I. and advised that I thought I had seen Oswald, who was suspected of killing President Kennedy, a few days earlier on Camp Street in New Orleans. 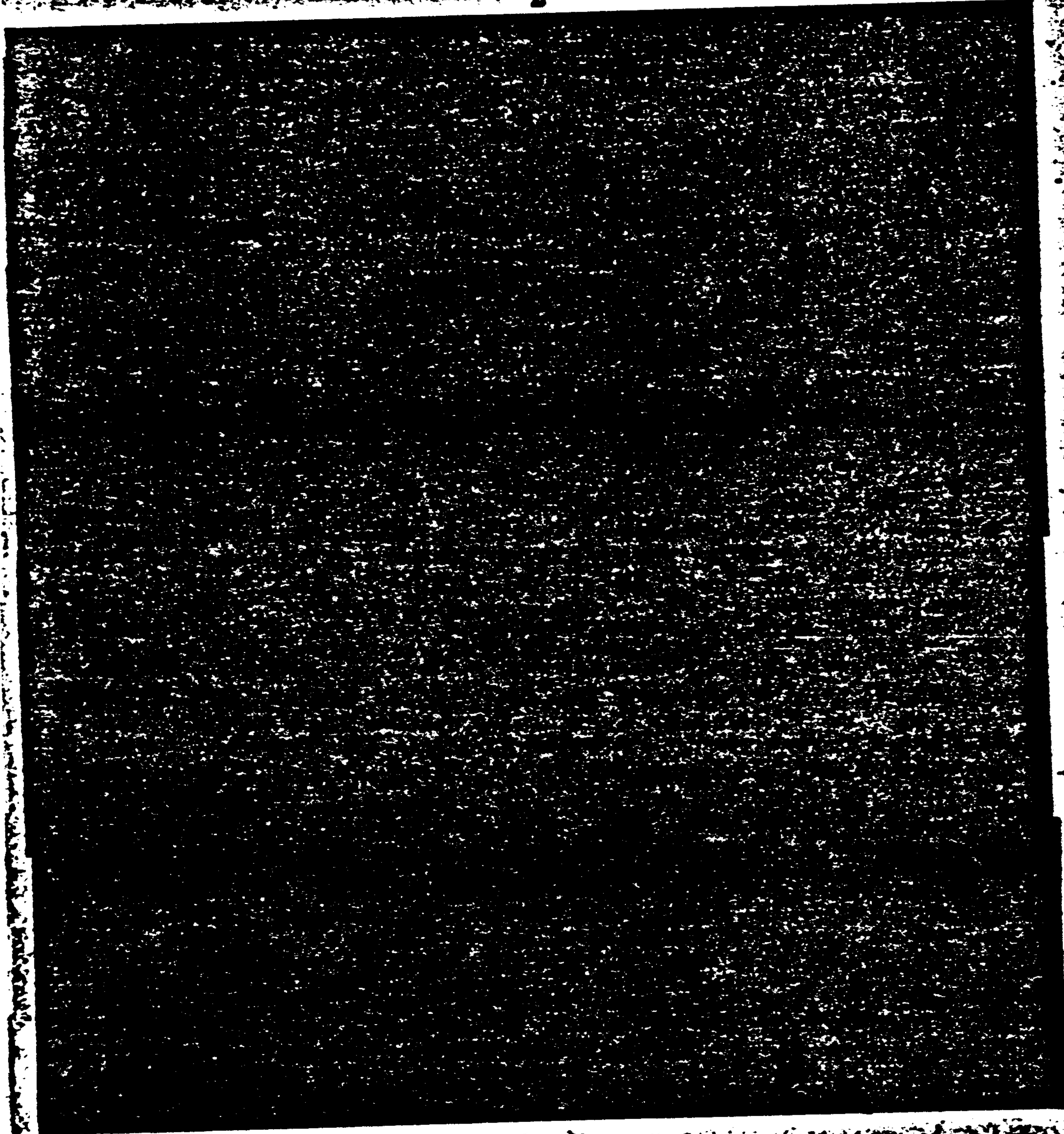

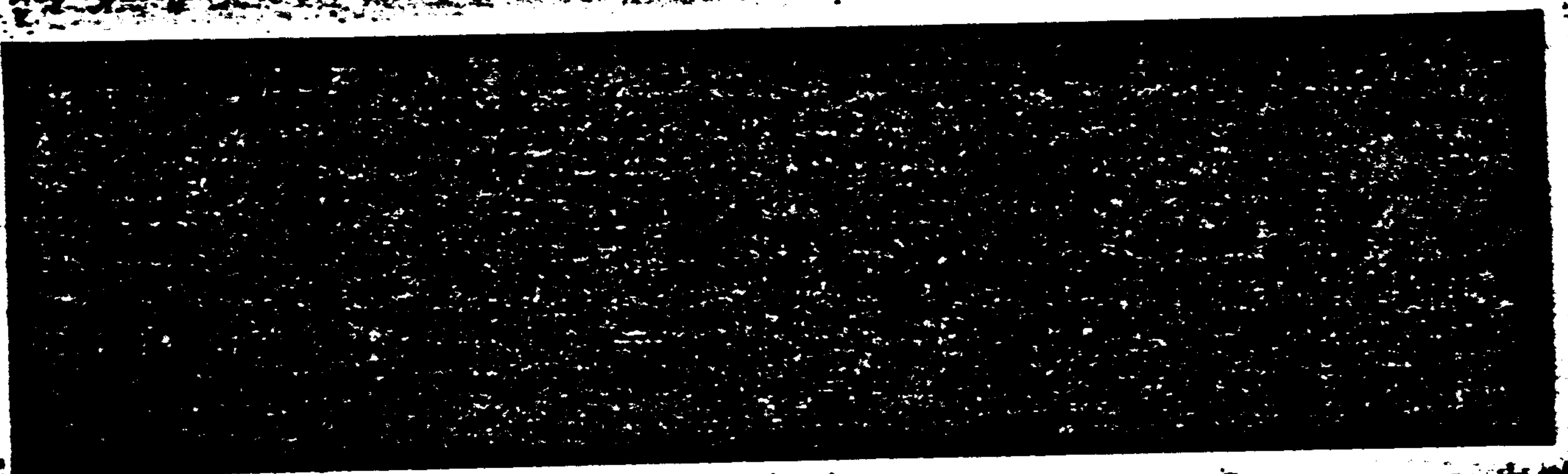
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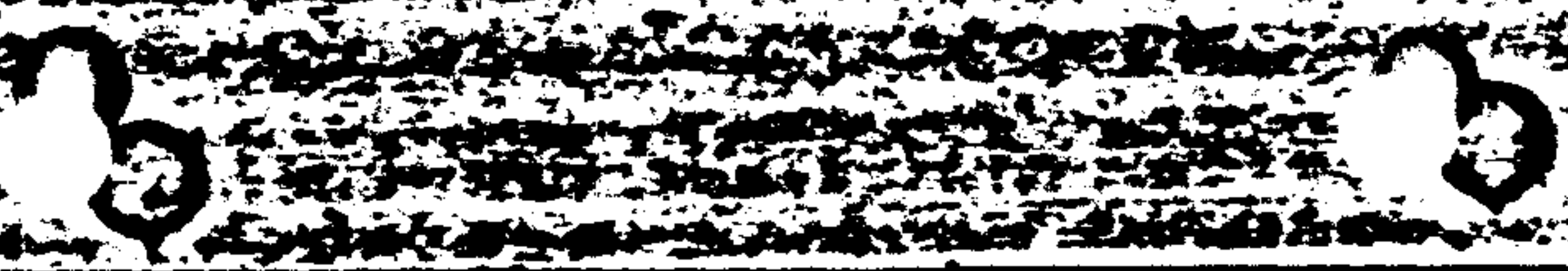
