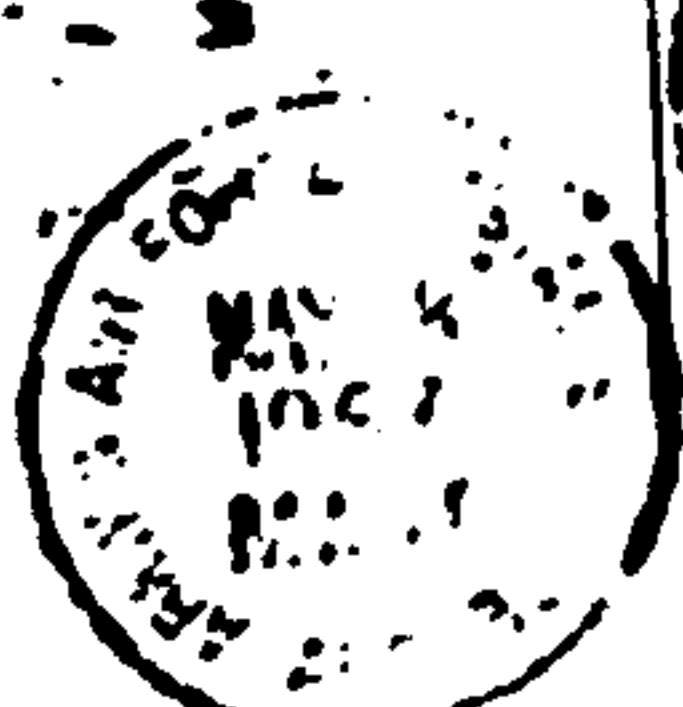

Atty. Gen. Clark Says High Court Rules Not Blocking Police Action

WASHINGTON, April 30 (AP) — Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark said Sunday that Supreme Court-imposed restrictions on police interrogation and on the use of confessions apparently have not been hampering law enforcement as some people feared they would.

Confessions apparently are being obtained at least as often as before the rulings, he said.

"We had increasing crime long before the Miranda case which has created such controversy, which is only since last June," he said, "and there is ample indication today that the Miranda really hasn't had the effect that its detractors attribute to it in law enforcement."

Clark referred to crimes under police interrogation, among them that of Ernesto A. Miranda, convicted of rape in Phoenix, Ariz.

This case, concerning confession of a crime without prior legal advice, led to the Supreme Court's controversial decision.

The 5-4 decision requires that a suspect be informed of his right to remain silent and to have counsel present; he must be warned that his words may be used against him; he must be provided with counsel by the court if he can't afford to hire it; the prosecution must prove a confession voluntary if given in the absence of counsel; and

questioning must end whenever the suspect wants it to.

Critics contend these rules tie the hands of police.

"Two surveys have indicated that confessions are coming in, after Miranda warning, at about the same rate or perhaps even higher than they were before Miranda," Clark said.

He cited a study of 2,000 cases in New York. Confessions were at issue in 275 of them, Clark said, "with only 22 cases where the defense raised the question of the legality of the confession and only two out of 2,000 where a motion to suppress the confession was actually granted, one in 1,000."

INTERVIEW

The following investigation was conducted by SA THOMAS F. CONNELLY and SA EDWARD P. MULLEN on 5/24/67:

[REDACTED] was interviewed in the presence of his father, [REDACTED] at his residence, [REDACTED] N.Y. At the beginning of this interview, it was explained to him that he was contacted in order to acknowledge receipt by the Director of his undated letter which was received by the Bureau on 5/19/67. [REDACTED] was also forcefully and pointedly informed that the FBI, at the direction of President JOHNSON, conducted a prompt, intensive, objective, and thorough investigation of the assassination of former President KENNEDY, and that all material developed by the FBI in connection with that investigation was turned over to the Warren Commission for its consideration. [REDACTED] was likewise informed that LEE HARVEY OSWALD was never an employee or "agent" of the FBI nor did he have any affiliation whatsoever with the Bureau. It was also forcefully and clearly pointed out to [REDACTED] that neither the Director nor any employee of the FBI conspired in any way to withhold any information from the Warren Commission.

It should be noted that during this interview [REDACTED] made the statement that "at the instigation of CIA-motivated actions,"

he was attended by a psychiatrist at Columbia University, which he formerly attended, and has also had "18 sessions" with a psychiatrist at a psychiatric center in Jamaica, New York.

When questioned regarding his motivation for writing to the Director, [redacted] said that it was his understanding that pressure was being put on him in various ways by his doctor and dentist, who are being paid by him but who are not properly treating him. He also said that pressure, by indirect means, is brought on him by CIA and the NSA. He believes that both CIA and NSA have a "stake-out" on the street behind his residence and that other patients whom he sees in his doctor's offices are there at the direction of the CIA.

[redacted] said that he has never been contacted by representatives of CIA or NSA but feels he has met people whom he believes to be connected with these organizations. 1904

[redacted]'s father, [redacted] explained that as a high school student his son was very brilliant, and upon graduation won several national scholarships. He attended Columbia University on a General Motors Corporation scholarship for \$1,650.00 per year. He explained that his son believed that the outstanding students throughout the country would be "tailed" by the CIA and other security organizations. The father, after reading the letter which his son sent to the Director, and which he had not previously read, considered it to be very "low" and commented to his son that he could not understand his motivation in so doing. He inquired of his son what he expected by writing the letter. The son answered him by stating that he expected nothing one way or the other. Mr. [redacted] also explained that his son is obsessed with the fact that the CIA is exerting pressure on him and he even considers his psychiatrist to be a CIA representative. Mr. [redacted] commented that he has had five years of college but his son has read more in his short lifetime than he has in his 63 years. He also explained that his son was more interested in research work at the college than he was in graduate courses and that he is attempting to "encompass all knowledge" and is impatient with the time element involved.

EVALUATION OF INTERVIEWING AGENTS

Based on statements made by Mr. [REDACTED] and statements made by [REDACTED] during the course of this interview, it is believed that [REDACTED] is undoubtedly a highly intelligent individual but his obsession with CIA appears to be uppermost in his mind, and as a result of this his thoughts are clouded and his statements tend to be rambling in nature with frequent references to the above-named organization.

For information Bureau, delay in answering referenced airtel occasioned by Agent to whom this investigative phase assigned attending In-Service Training, Washington, D. C., from 5/15/67 through 5/26/67.

For further information Bureau, Dallas airtel of 4/10/67, set out leads for El Paso and Philadelphia Divisions to conduct appropriate investigation to locate and interview JOHN SUTTON or PAUL BRIDEWELL, aka Phil Burns. These leads also set out in Dallas teletype dated 4/10/67, to Bureau, El Paso and Philadelphia.

By teletype dated 4/12/67, the El Paso Division advised it could locate no record that JOHN SUTTON had ever been at Ft. Bliss, as indicated in interview with THAYER WALDO at Mexico City. By airtel dated 4/12/67, the Philadelphia Division likewise stated it could locate no information regarding SUTTON.

For information Portland Division, the Bureau has received a letter from a Mr. LAWRENCE SCHILLER, Alskog, Inc., Los Angeles, dated 3/15/67, in which Mr. SCHILLER acknowledged receipt of a Bureau letter dated 1/21/67. SCHILLER, on 1/16/67, submitted to the Bureau a letter enclosing a transcript of a taped recording between JACK RUBY and his attorneys five days before RUBY'S death. SCHILLER has advised he is in possession of the name and location of MARK LANE'S informant who allegedly furnished LANE information he was supposedly present and overheard an alleged meeting between JACK RUBY, Dallas Police Officer J. D. TIPPIT, and BERNARD WEISSMAN, on 11/14/63. SCHILLER is willing to furnish this information to the Bureau. For further information, refer to the Commission's Report, page 297.

SCHILLER interviewed by Los Angeles, 3/22/67, and indicated that MARK LANE'S confidential informant is PAUL BRIDEWELL aka Phil Burns, and that BRIDEWELL currently located somewhere in Oregon, possibly Portland or Rainier. Exact location of BRIDEWELL is probably known to one JOHN SUTTON, who formerly was in radio business in Dallas. SUTTON allegedly now residing somewhere in Pennsylvania, in location phonetically furnished to SCHILLER as Wilshire, but SCHILLER unable to locate this town from maps or postal guide.

According to SCHILLER, MARK LANE learned of identity of BRIDEWELL and information in possession of BRIDEWELL from THEODORE (THAYER) WALDO, formerly associated with Ft. Worth, Texas, newspaper, "Sun Telegraph". Efforts to locate BRIDEWELL by SCHILLER unsuccessful.

THAYER WALDO located and interviewed, Mexico City, 4/3/67, and advised that at the time of the assassination, he was a feature editor of the Ft. Worth "Star Telegram," and was acquainted with a JOHN SUTTON, white male, about 37, born Wilkes Barre, Pennsylvania. WALDO believes SUTTON was a radio announcer employed by WFAA radio, Dallas, and he met SUTTON in 1956 when SUTTON was Information Officer at Ft. Bliss, Texas, and WALDO was working at the El Paso "Herald Post".

WALDO indicates that about a week after assassination, SUTTON asked to meet him at the Dallas Press Club and at that time SUTTON indicated he knew a man who witnessed a meeting in the Carousel Club between RUBY, Officer J. D. TIPPIT, and a BERNARD WEISSMAN, but who was reluctant to come forward with this information [REDACTED]

WALDO indicates that on or about 12/7/63, he met SUTTON at the Dallas Press Club and was introduced to PHIL BURNS, white male, age late 30's, 5'8", 145 pounds, chestnut hair, wore glasses, and employed by some advertising firm on account of one of SUTTON'S sponsors. After many assurances that identity would be protected, BURNS related that he was acquainted with RUBY. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] also that he knew Officer TIPPIT, since he had seen him in uniform at the club which apparently was on his beat. BURNS indicated he passed a table and RUBY greeted him saying, "You know J. D. here," and RUBY then introduced the other individual as BERNARD WEISSMAN from the East. BURNS described WEISSMAN as white male, 35 years, black hair, over 6' tall. BURNS allegedly returned to his table and RUBY sent him a complimentary drink.

WALDO indicated that he discussed the above matter with editors BUTLER and HITCH, but agreed not to publish this information since informant insisted on remaining anonymous. However, about a week later he met MARK LANE at a press conference in Dallas and confided this information to LANE, who was extremely anxious to contact informant. WALDO agreed to consult with SUTTON, but SUTTON upon contact refused to cooperate further and WALDO advised that he determined by calling an advertising agency that BURNS was actually [PAUL BRIDEWELL.]

WALDO stated he has had no further contact with SUTTON or [BRIDEWELL] and has no idea as to their whereabouts, except [BRIDEWELL] reportedly returned to his home in Oregon in 1964 and SUTTON also left about this time.

Referenced Bureau airtel to Dallas, 5/22/67, instructs that this matter is to receive continuous investigative attention until it is logically resolved.

It is also noted that the Bureau in its teletypes of 3/24/67 and 4/4/67, instructed Dallas and other offices that every effort be made to locate and interview JOHN SUTTON, as well as [PAUL BRIDEWELL] aka Phil Burns regarding above information. Extensive investigation at Dallas unsuccessful in locating SUTTON or [BRIDEWELL].

AT PORTLAND, OREGON. Will through sources in advertising and radio media, attempt to locate and interview [PAUL BRIDEWELL] aka Phil Burns. Will also conduct same investigation with Credit Bureau, PD, License Bureaus and any other logical sources, noting that [BRIDEWELL] (according to THAYER WALDO), left Dallas sometime in early 1964, allegedly to return to his home in Oregon. [BRIDEWELL] is described by WALDO as a white male, age now approximately 40, chestnut hair, thinning from the temples, wore glasses with metal rims but with shell earpieces, brown or hazel eyes, medium complexion, slightly cleft chin, thin mouth, quite large and prominent ears, which stood out from his head. BRIDEWELL was well and conservatively dressed, usually in a dark suit, wore a class or fraternal ring on the third finger of his left hand over his wedding band. His height was about 5'8", with weight about 145 pounds. He was well spoken, with no particular accent noted. He usually drank rum collins, and had quite deep lines on the sides of his mouth, and appeared to be quite tense and uneasy. JOHN SUTTON was described by WALDO as a white male, now about 37 years old, height about 5'9½", weight probably 160 pounds, stocky build, glasses (believed to be full shell rims), dark brown hair, brown eyes.
