INFORMATIVE NOTE

Date 9/14/67

Attorneys for Clay L. Shaw have been attempting to have a conspiracy indictment against Shaw quashed. At a pre-trial hearing on 9/12/67, validity of the grand jury which indicted Shaw was questioned. Shaw is charged with having conspired to assassinate John F. Kennedy.

Layton Patrick Martens, referred to in attached, has previously furnished information in this matter to the New Orleans Office. He is a former roommate of David W. Ferrie, deceased, who was named by Jim Garrison as one of Shaw's co-conspirators in the Kennedy assassination.

Jack S. Martin, referred to in attached is an alcoholic who has been described as a part-time private detective and courthouse hanger-on who had known David W. Ferrie for years. Secret Service has reported that Martin has reportedly called Garrison's office with his wild tales several times while on a drinking spree.

Pertinent information from Martens will be furnished to the Department upon receipt of memorandum from New Orleans.

For the purpose of this report, the following information was obtained from a confidential source who has been indicted for perjury in connection with the arrest of Percy James Garrison's assassination. This confidential source was contacted at the New Orleans Office of the FBI on September 14, 1937 and advised he had just obtained a copy of a book which had just been released on the assassination probe entitled "Plot of Assassination" which was published by the Dallas, Texas, Morning Star newspaper. This confidential source informed that a section of this book contained a search of Ferris's residence in L. I. which stated that the search of Ferris's residence netted only several copies and a mention and maps of Cuba. Martens said the only maps of Cuba to his knowledge in Ferris's residence were maps he had in a brief case left at Ferris's residence. Martens surmised that these maps of Cuba were either in the hands of some official of Jackson Parish or were in the possession of District Attorney Garrison.

Martens also stated that he has been in contact with Jack S. Martin, a private investigator, and that Martin had advised he is responsible for the Garrison assassination probe.

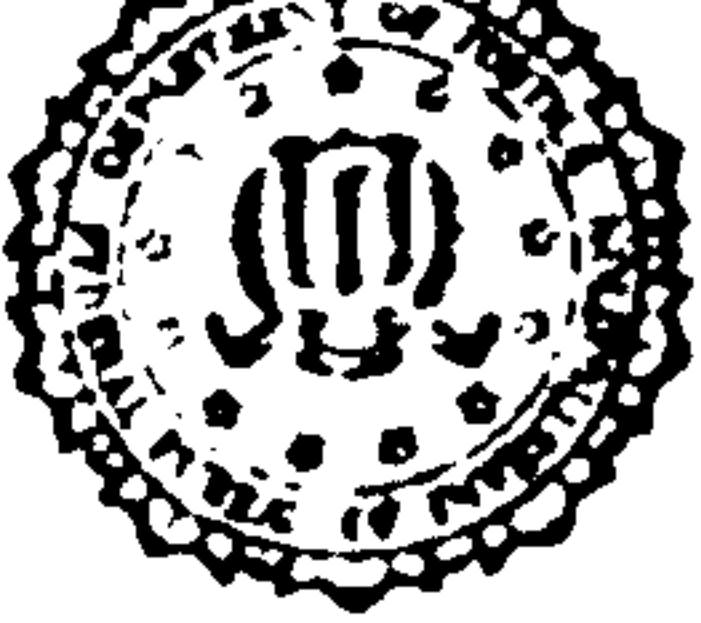

On September 13, 1967, [REDACTED] was interviewed at the Dallas Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). She stated she resides at [REDACTED] Dallas, Texas, and has lived at this residence for the past nine years. She stated that during this time she has had telephone number [REDACTED] continuously and that this is a private line rather than a party line and is so listed under her name in the current Dallas telephone directory.

At this point [REDACTED] was asked for any information in her possession concerning a note located in a small address book at Houston, Texas, which stated as follows:

"ORDE 1003468-DS

"Contact X-03 AT [REDACTED] Bockman Lake outpost. Return jet will leave at 8:05 AM Nov. 22 after the job is done. President will take same route as J.F.K. I am to be under viadockt at 12 noon with gun."

[redacted] emphatically stated that she had no information whatsoever concerning the above note and has no idea as to how anyone could have used her telephone number in such a note. She stated that the name [redacted] is entirely unknown to her, that she has never had a small address book bearing an advertisement for a new telephone and has actually never seen such a book in her life.

[redacted] then stated that during 1956 she was divorced from [redacted] and she has no idea as to his whereabouts since he is in the construction business and moves frequently. She stated she did not believe [redacted] could have written the above note and that she and [redacted] although divorced, are still on friendly terms. She stated that should she be able to locate [redacted] she would furnish his address to the FBI.

[redacted] stated that approximately two or three years ago she received several obscene telephone calls but at the time she did not feel it important enough and did not report the matter to either the telephone company or the Dallas Police Department. She stated that the individual calling sounded to her as if he could have been a Negro male but she has no idea as to who made the obscene calls. She stated that during the past two years she has received no such calls and had almost forgotten about the matter.

[redacted] stated that she has worked for several years with the [redacted] Accounting Firm at [redacted], Dallas, Texas, and that she has resided at [redacted], Dallas, with her three small children since approximately 1959. She stated that her oldest child, [redacted] is 15 years old and has never been in trouble in his life. She stated that she was positive that he did not write such a note as set out above. She at this point offered complete cooperation with the FBI but stated that she had no in-

formation concerning the identity of the writer of the above note and wondered if the author of the note could have written the wrong telephone number.

A review of the Cole's Criss Cross Telephone Directory for the years 1960 to 1967 verified that [REDACTED] has had telephone number [REDACTED] continuously for that period of time and that her address is listed as [REDACTED]

She stated that [REDACTED] is shown as residing for several years at [REDACTED] and employment shown with [REDACTED] Accounting Firm, Dallas, Texas. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] credit rating is shown as very good and there are no delinquent accounts. [REDACTED] stated the file also reflects [REDACTED] was divorced on November 8, 1958, but the name of her former husband is not shown.

On September 5, 1967, [redacted] who is associated

[redacted] Houston, Texas, telephonically contacted the Houston
[redacted] of the FBI and advised that his wife had found in the
back of a sofa at their home a small address book containing
a [redacted] and some writing possibly pertaining to the assassina-
tion of President Kennedy. [redacted] advised that he would
make the address book available to the FBI for their informa-
tion.

On September 6, 1967, [redacted] was interviewed
at his office and he furnished a [redacted] Northwestern Bell
Telephone Company address book which contained the following
notations:

"ORDE 1003468-18

"Contact X-03 AT [redacted] Rockman Lake
outpost. Return jet will leave at 8:05 AM
Nov. 22 after the job is done. President
will take same route as J.F.K. I am to be
under viaduct at 12 noon with gun."

[redacted] advised he presently resides at [redacted]
[redacted] Houston, Texas, telephone number [redacted] and he has
been residing in Houston since the latter part of February,
1967, when he moved to Houston from Dallas, Texas. He stated
he moved into the above residence on March 1, 1967.

[redacted] advised that prior to coming to Houston his
address was [redacted] which is located in the
[redacted] area of Dallas. [redacted] stated he had
resided in Dallas since July 1, [redacted] and prior to that time
was residing in Austin, Texas. [redacted] advised that at the time
of the assassination of President Kennedy he was residing in
Austin, Texas. [redacted] stated his wife found the address book in
the [redacted] under the sofa at their residence while cleaning.

the sofa. He stated his wife previously cleaned the interior of the couch approximately one year ago when they were residing in Dallas, Texas, and this address book was not located at that time. [redacted] stated based on this he believes the address book must have become lodged in the bottom of the sofa within the past year. [redacted] stated he has no idea as to how it could have become placed in the address book in the sofa. He stated the sofa has been in their possession during the past year with the exception of approximately one week when the furniture was in storage in connection with his move from Dallas, to Houston, Texas. [redacted] stated he is not personally acquainted nor does he have any knowledge of any persons whose names he has read in the paper as being connected with the Kennedy assassination or the Garrison assassination probe in New Orleans.

[redacted] stated the telephone number appearing in the notation in the address book appears to him to be a legitimate Dallas telephone number and he is aware that there is a Jackson Lake in the Dallas area.

On September 6, 1967, [redacted] Credit Bureau Houston, Texas, advised that [redacted] records reflect that [redacted] [redacted] Houston, was born April 5, 1912 and has been manager of Universal Underwriters Insurance Company since 1951. [redacted] advised that the records reflect that Irick transferred to Houston in February, 1967, from Dallas, Texas, and his address in Dallas, Texas, was given as [redacted]. The credit bureau records further reflected that the wife of [redacted] was listed as [redacted] and he has four minor children. His social Security number was given as [redacted] and nothing unfavorable was noted in the credit bureau records.

Dallas telephone number [redacted] was determined to be listed to [redacted] Dallas, Texas.

On September 15, 1967, [redacted] advised that she located the small address book in the bottom of her sofa at her home on September 5, 1967 while cleaning the underside of the sofa. She stated that her three year old daughter had dropped a fingernail file on the floor which became lodged under the sofa and while retrieving the fingernail file she noticed numerous

articles in the underside of the sofa caught in the dust cover under the sofa. She stated that she retrieved all the articles under the sofa including the address book, several hairpins and numerous other pieces of children's toys which she could not specifically recall. [redacted] stated that she had absolutely no information as to the origin of the address book nor did she have any information concerning who possibly may have written the notations appearing therein.

[redacted] stated that she had three children, [redacted] age 11, [redacted] age 8 and [redacted] age 3. She stated that [redacted] had inquired of [redacted] regarding the address book but [redacted] stated she had at that time no knowledge of the address book or how it may have lodged in the sofa. [redacted] stated that Randy has had minimal brain damage and could have been impossible for him to have printed the notations or spell the words appearing in the address book.

[redacted] stated that she has had the sofa for approximately eight and one half years and last had cleaned the underside of the sofa in approximately October, 1966 when she took the dust cover off the bottom of the sofa and removed all the "junk" which had become lodged in the bottom of the sofa. She stated she is positive that the address book was not in the sofa at the time she cleaned it in October, 1966.

[redacted] stated that in November, 1963 she was residing at [redacted] in Austin, Texas where they had moved in February, 1963. She stated that on July 4, 1964 they moved to Dallas, Texas and resided at [redacted] and in February, 1967 was transferred to Houston, Texas where they presently reside.

[redacted] stated that the sofa has been out of her control for approximately one week at the time they moved to Houston, Texas from Dallas, at which time the sofa was in storage at Allied Van Lines Warehouse in Houston.

[redacted] stated that she and her husband have discussed the address book on several occasions and have made every effort to determine any possible acquaintances of persons who may have possibly dropped the address book in the sofa. She stated further that she specifically questioned her daughter, [redacted] concerning her friends and determined no information that could possibly reveal how the address book

George lodged in the sofa. She went on to state that [redacted] because of his mental and physical condition does not associate with children his own age and usually plays with youngsters three or four years old. [redacted] further stated that she was not acquainted with anyone whose names she has heard as being associated with the Kennedy assassination or the Garrison probe currently going on in New Orleans. [redacted] concluded by stating that she has never observed the address book in possession of her children prior to locating it in the sofa and of her three children only [redacted] age 11, would have been capable of printing the material in the address book. Based on her discussion with Lisa and the fact that [redacted] hand printing does not in anyway resemble the printing in the address book she stated that she is positive [redacted] has no knowledge of the address book as Lisa has stated.

[redacted] also informed that she was not acquainted with [redacted] and the Dallas telephone number [redacted] was not the exchange that they utilized while living in Dallas.

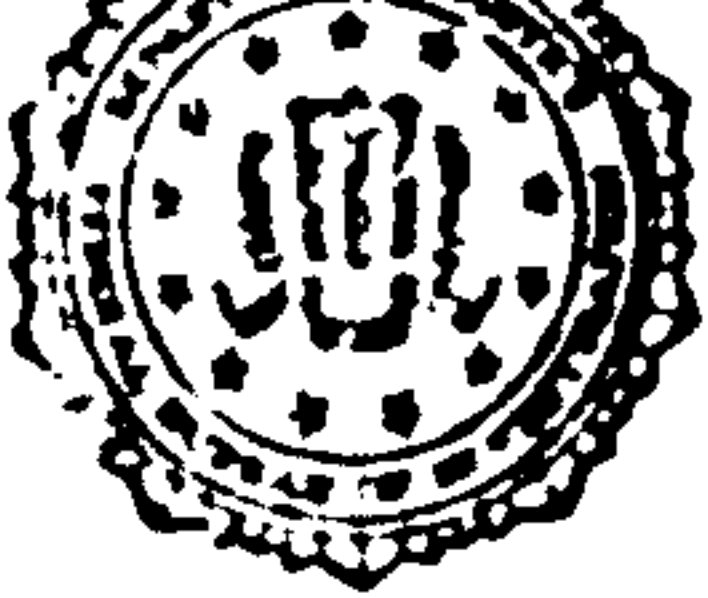

On September 15, 1967, [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] Vero Beach, Florida, was interviewed
regarding possible violation of the Impersonation Statute
by [REDACTED] in that he represented
himself as an Agent of the Central Intelligence Agency
(CIA).

[REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] had talked of leaving
the CIA because there were indications that President
JOHNSON had supported the assassination of President
KENNEDY and also since there were indications of a
possible assassination attempt on President JOHNSON.

[REDACTED] said he could not recall the exact words
used by [REDACTED] nor did [REDACTED] give any names of people
or organizations behind any possible assassination attempt.

[REDACTED] stated that he had received a letter
from [REDACTED] reflecting dates of Friday, July, 1967, and
Thursday, August 3, 1967, bearing the return address of
[REDACTED] West Berlin,
Germany.

[REDACTED] advised that he [REDACTED] was employed by
[REDACTED], Vero Beach,
Florida, and would be in the Florida Keys, exact location
unknown, for the next three weeks searching for sunken

No further action being taken.

On 9/15/67 at 6:45 p. m., a reservation agent at Delta Airlines, Dallas, received a call that a bomb was on board Delta Airlines, Flight 827. Flight 827 originated at Atlanta and was enroute to San Francisco via Dallas. A search of the aircraft failed to locate any bomb.

[REDACTED] who was boarding this flight for San Francisco made comments at Love Field, Dallas, she had conducted research on the Kennedy assassination and had been in conference with DA Jim Garrison, New Orleans, for three days. San Francisco determined that [REDACTED] in the past had expressed great alarm over the fact that the United States is becoming fascist. She is the daughter of [REDACTED] of Los Angeles. It has been reported [REDACTED] has "left-wing" leanings and is not in good favor with her father. She supports Mark Lane's book, "Rush to Judgement" and takes the view Lee Harvey Oswald was not a communist. She pictures America as controlled by conspirators in the Government which view she has stated publicly. She is writing a book on the assassination and claims the Government is withholding information on the assassination and the press is suppressing news on the investigation being conducted by New Orleans DA James Garrison. [REDACTED] is described as an author and a playwright, and due to her thinking which she has expressed publicly, Dallas and San Francisco are to incorporate information into letterhead memoranda suitable for dissemination to the Department and U. S. Secret Service.

[REDACTED] of Houston, Texas, who formerly resided in Dallas, furnished the Houston Office a small telephone number book which contained handprinting on the first page as follows:

"ORDE 1003468-DS

"Contact X-03 AT [REDACTED] Bockman Lake outpost. Return jet will leave at 8:05 AM Nov. 22 after the job is done. President will take same route as J.F.K. I am to be under viadockt at 12 noon with gun."

This address book was found by his wife under the webbing of her couch when cleaning it. The book was not in the couch a year ago when it was cleared. Both Mr. and Mrs. [REDACTED] have been interviewed and further questioned to determine whether any of their children may have prepared it, and the results were negative. It is noted the oldest [REDACTED] child is 11 years old; the others are infants. The telephone number is a legitimate number of [REDACTED] in Dallas who was interviewed. She was cooperative and could not determine how her number appeared in this book. She also indicated that the [REDACTED] of Houston are not known to her. Her son [REDACTED] should be interviewed to determine if he has any knowledge of this address book which is the last remaining logical lead. When this is completed, the information will be disseminated to the U. S. Secret Service and the Department. No further action will be taken.





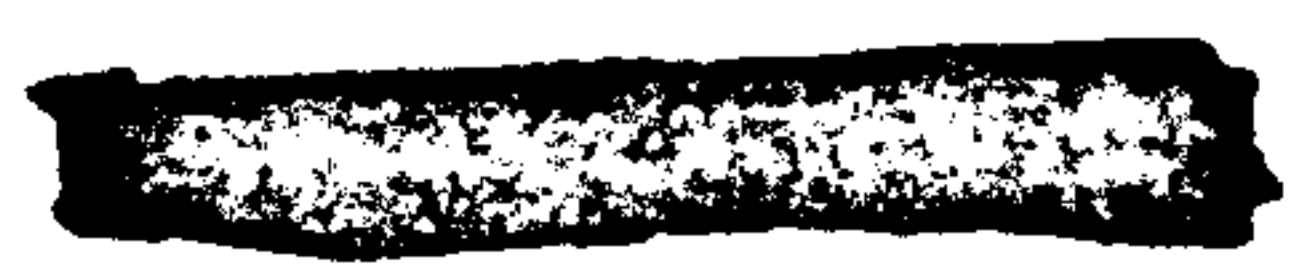

On 9/20/67 [REDACTED] Claims Agent, Claims Salvage Office, REA Express, 44 Halladay Street, Jersey City, N.J., turned over to the writer an envelope received by him on 9/19/67 which contained xerox copies of four FBI documents which are attached.

[REDACTED] stated that this envelope was sent to him on 9/19/67 for the purpose of being destroyed or otherwise disposed of.

He stated that this envelope was originally shipped via REA Air Express on 3/16/67 (Air Receipt #432262) from New York to Los Angeles, California, the sender being [REDACTED] New York City. The package was addressed to [REDACTED] in care of REA Air Express, LAX Airport, Los Angeles, California, with the notation "Hold at Airport".

He continued that the package was apparently never picked up by [REDACTED] and was held at Los Angeles under REA Receipt #2262 until 6/14/67, at which time it was returned to [REDACTED] who refused delivery on 6/29/67. He said that there was a charge of \$5.25 on same and was the only reason that he could think of as to why the package was refused by [REDACTED].

He continued the package was then held at their On Hand Department, New York City, under Number D-83647 until 9/19/67 when it was sent to him to be disposed of.

He said that he is the only one aware of the contents of the package and after determining its contents immediately advised the writer.
