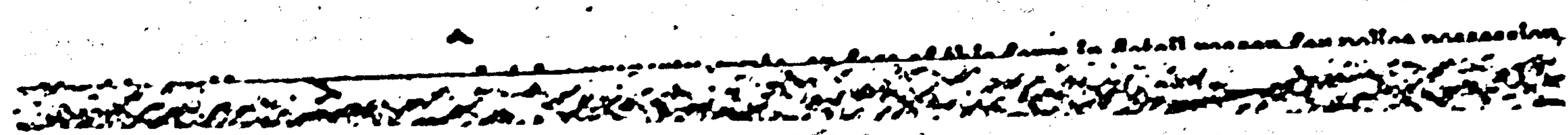

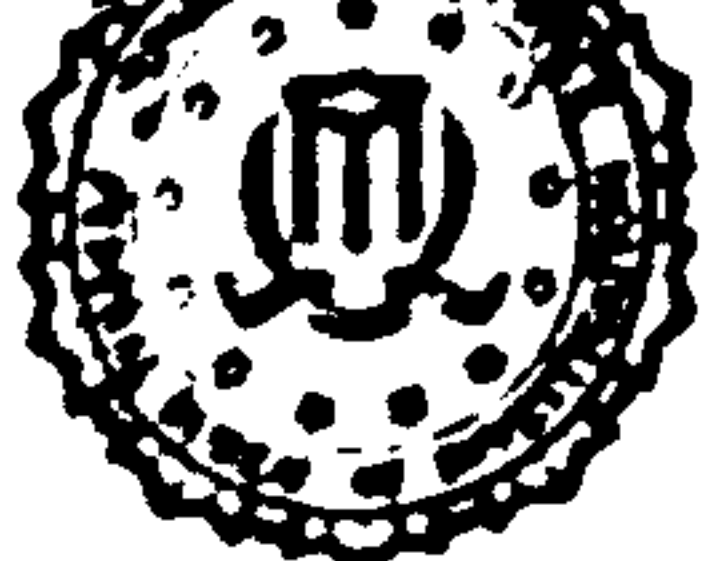

Elliott Newton Lacy, 5353 Hazeltine Avenue, Van Nuys, California 91401, was interviewed at his place of employment, California Institute of Technology, 1201 East California Street, Pasadena, California, where he is employed as Head Cataloguer at the Library. Lacy furnished the following information:

Lacy related that he has known Frank MacCallum of 1517 Rio Grande, El Paso, Texas, since about 1960 and that they became acquainted through a mutual interest of collecting player piano rolls. Lacy indicated that he probably had about eight personal contacts with MacCallum and they have had correspondence over the years.

Lacy said that during the years of their acquaintanceship, their discussions were generally concerning music; that he, Lacy, did not care to engage in discussions of politics and religion. Lacy said that MacCallum is a resourceful, creative, conservative type person and had never given any indication of possessing violent tendencies. Lacy said that he was not aware of MacCallum's feelings toward the Kennedy administration and did not recall MacCallum ever referring to it as the Kennedy dynasty or ever using the word assassination.

Lacy stated that he received the impression that MacCallum felt the country was leaning toward communism and that MacCallum was hopeful the trend would be averted from such leanings; that Mac Callum once mentioned that he had been shot at in Texas during a Mexican land settlement several years ago and that his car had been hit, but he did not furnish any particulars concerning the incident. Lacy indicated

that MacCallum felt that the United States should not have given any land to Mexico. Lacy could not furnish any other information concerning this.

Lacy advised that Mac Callum was a chemist by profession and retired near the end of 1967; that MacCallum has resided in El Paso, Texas, since they have been acquainted and that he, Lacy, is not aware of MacCallum ever being in Dallas, Texas. Lacy said that he had high regard for MacCallum's honesty and integrity and did not recall MacCallum being in California a short time prior to the assassination. Lacy commented that after the assassination, he wrote to MacCallum and mentioned it and MacCallum answered this letter and commented upon the terrible nature of the crime.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

Attached teletype states that Fredrick Beckham complained he is being harassed by New Orleans District Attorney Garrison's Office. Fredrick Beckham is the brother of Thomas E. Beckham, the latter being recently subpoenaed by Garrison as a witness in the investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy for allegedly being in contact with Lee Harvey Oswald or Jack Ruby. Our investigation of the assassination disclosed no information that Thomas Beckham knew either Oswald or Ruby.

By letter dated 1-3-68 the White House and Attorney General were advised that the name of Thomas Beckham never appeared during our investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy. No investigation into the alleged threat is being conducted.

# OBJECTION MADE TO ORLEANS TRIP

## Howard Wants to Give Deposition in Calif.

Lawyer Howard Jr. of Los Angeles, Calif., being sought as a material witness in District Attorney Jim Garrison's investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy, is seeking to avoid coming to New Orleans.

Howard, 32, appeared in Los Angeles Superior Court on a show cause hearing why he should not be ordered to New Orleans, and told the court the trip would impose a hardship on him and on his family.

The hearing was continued to Jan. 26. Howard's attorney, Bruce P. Wolfe, said the Los Angeles district attorney does not object to his client's move to avoid returning to New Orleans.

Wolfe said the subpoena for Howard's return does not require his appearance in New Orleans until the first week in February.

Howard urged in court that Garrison send a deputy to take his deposition. But he told the court that he has no special information he could provide Garrison toward the investigation.

According to Wolfe, Garrison has very "subtly" labeled Howard a conspirator in the killing of President Kennedy, although he was subpoenaed as a material witness only.

In an affidavit accompanying the subpoena, Garrison claims that Howard was an associate of David Ferrie, Lee Harvey Oswald and Jack Ruby, according to Wolfe.

Wolfe said he is afraid Howard would be indicted for something if were to appear in New Orleans.

Howard added he does not have any information to give Garrison but said he would give him a deposition in a court of law under oath if Garrison would come to Los Angeles.
