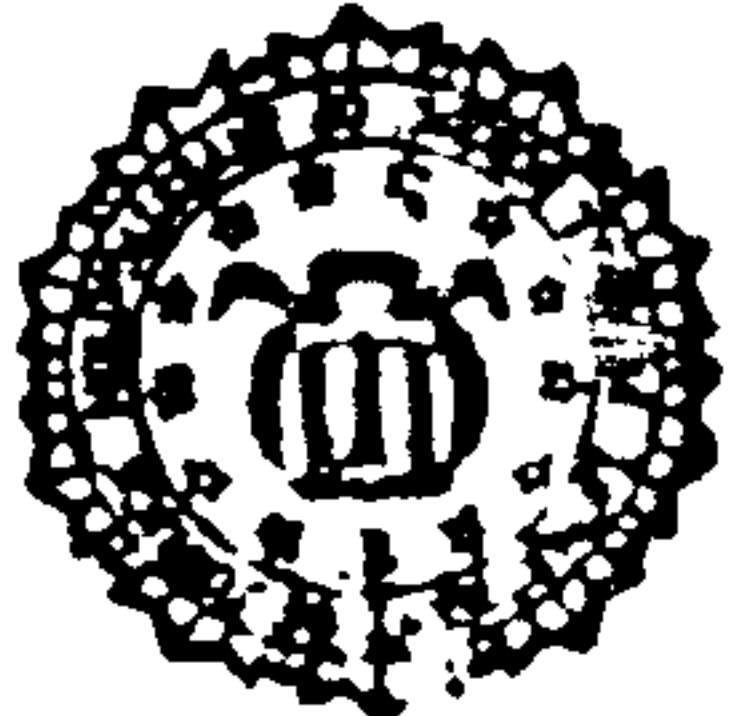

[redacted] Austin, Texas, employed by Texas Highway Department in travel and Information Division on December 2, 1963, advised he was formerly employed until June 1, 1963, by WJDX-WLBT radio and television station, Jackson, Mississippi, of which [FRID, BRARD] was general manager.

[redacted] recalls in about March, 1963, hearing [BRARD] make a remark to the effect "We are living under a dictatorship and they (the KENNEDY's) are nothing but an Irish mafia and if they are re-elected the only way to get them out of office would be to kill them all." [redacted] recalls this remark was made in the coffee shop area of WJDX-WLBT radio and television station, Jackson, Mississippi, and believes [DAVE MEHRER] and [redacted] another employee of the [redacted] radio station was present with [BRARD] and [redacted] at the time.

[These remarks were made while a discussion was taking place relative to a secret meeting between Governor BARNETT of Mississippi, Governor WALLACE of Alabama and BRARD.]

[The meeting allegedly referred to possibilities of having unpledged electors represent the Southern states in the next presidential election in order to create a dead-lock and force election of a Southerner as President.]

[redacted] does not have any information linking the above statement to the Assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY but felt it should be called to the attention of the FBI.

MARJORIE HEIMBECKER, Nurse, St. Christopher's Hospital, home address 3619 North Marshall Street advised she had attended nursing school and high school with an individual named CRISTINA SUAREZ, who is now Mrs. CRISTINA S. DE TORANO who resides at 7841 Southwest 29th Street, Miami, Fla. She said CRISTINA's father, as she recalled, had been a chief of police and business man in Cuba during the Batista Regime. He now resides in New York City. Her brother, MIGUEL SUAREZ, Miss HEIMBECKER thought, had attended a military academy in Cuba and he was also believed to have fought at the Bay of Pigs for the CASTRO forces. She said she thought he was still in Cuba. Miss HEIMBECKER learned only recently from Mrs. DE TORANO that about two years ago her brother (MIGUEL) had said that President JOHN F. KENNEDY would be killed by Castros.

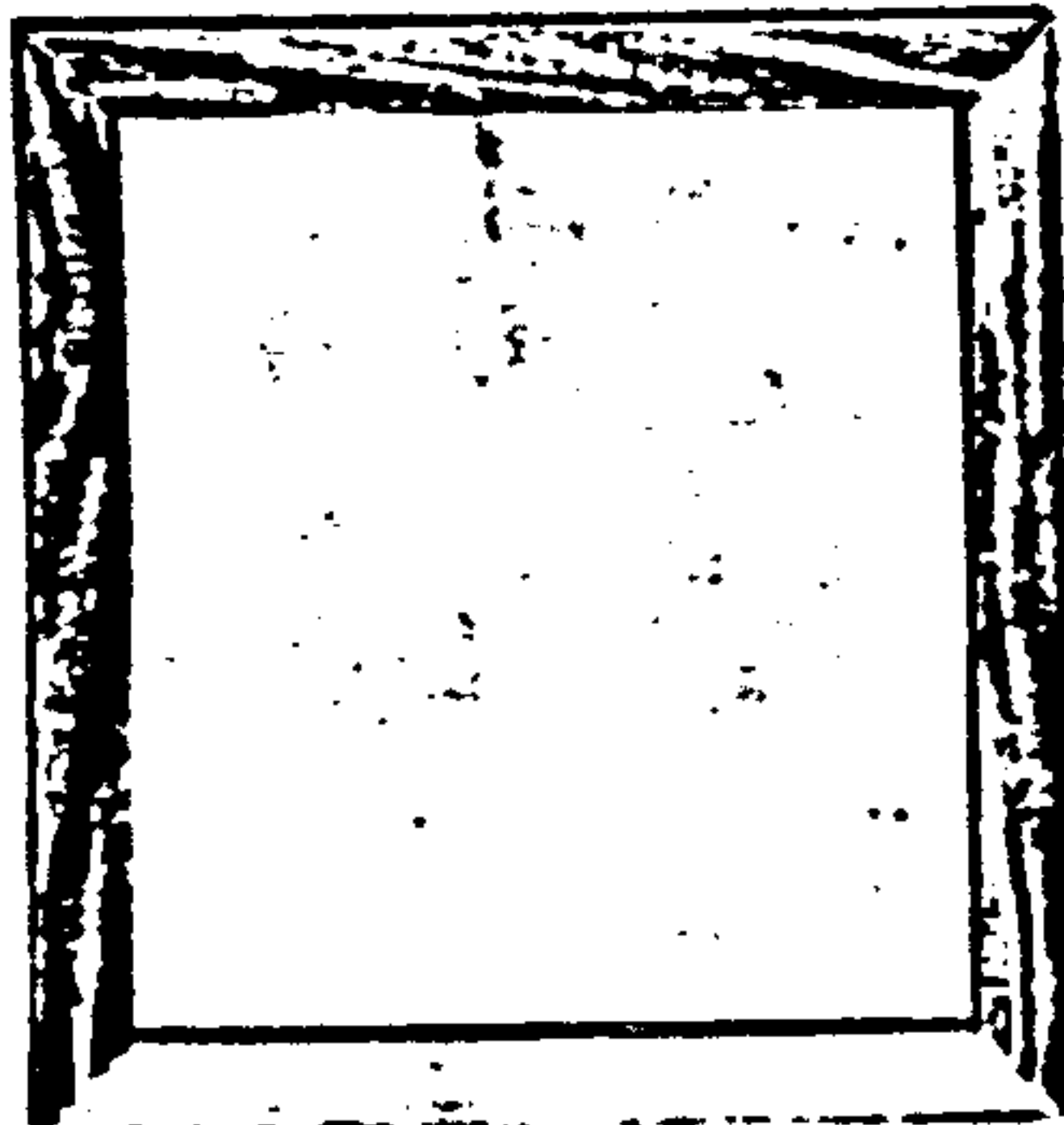

The report on the killing of Oswald by Jack Ruby covers the actual killing; the information developed concerning Jack Ruby; the interview of Ruby; a subpoena from November 22 to November 24, 1963; and the investigation by the FBI under the Civil Rights Statutes to determine whether there was any conspiracy involved in the killing.

Report of Killing of Lee Harvey Oswald

We are continuing to receive leads concerning Oswald and, consequently, at the end of the report we state that this investigation will continue in order to resolve them.

Three sets of exhibits accompany this report. The first sets out evidence tying Oswald in with the assassination of the President; the other two set out documents relative to Oswald's contacts with the Soviets, the Communist Party, et cetera.

This report, in Part I, briefly relates the assassination of the President and the identification of Oswald as his slayer. Part II sets forth the evidence conclusively showing that Oswald did assassinate the President. Part III is in two sections, the first setting forth what the FBI knew about Oswald prior to the assassination; and the second section setting forth the results of our investigation of Oswald's background, activities, associates, et cetera, subsequent to the assassination.

Assassination Report

Attached are two reports which we have prepared at the direction of President Johnson, concerning the assassination of President Kennedy and the subsequent killing of the assassin, Lee Harvey Oswald, by Jack Ruby. These are being transmitted to you in compliance with your request so that you may examine them before they are transmitted to President Johnson.

You will note our statement at the end of this report that the investigation will continue until every possible source of pertinent information has been exhausted.

Attached to this report are two exhibits, one a photograph of the actual killing, and the other a diagram of the police department building basement where the killing occurred. Due to the fact that no records were kept of the police officers or news media representatives in the basement at the time of the killing, we have not been able to identify, locate and interview all persons who were present when Rudy killed Oswald. We state in the report that persons identified to us have been or are being interviewed. We have interviewed 88 Dallas police officers, and are attempting to identify any others who were in the basement and interview them. An estimated 150 news media representatives were in the basement. We have been able to identify and interview 81 of them, and leads are set out throughout the country to identify and locate others who may have been present. We have no reason at this time to believe that the stories of these people, when we locate them, will be at variance with the facts developed so far, but we do want to locate them so that all possible questions can be resolved.

On the evening of 11/22/63, Mr. William Taylor, United States Commission on Civil Rights, advised the Liaison Agent of the following:

Mrs. Nertin Meyers, wife of the local representative of the American Friends Service Committee, has since Wednesday, 11/20/63, been receiving threatening telephone calls from an unidentified person. Shortly after the announcement of the President's assassination, Mrs. Meyers received a telephone call from an unidentified person whose voice appeared to be identical to previous unidentified callers. The person advised Mrs. Meyers that "we got the President and now we are going to get you."

In addition to the above, a cross was burned at the residence of Mrs. Meyers on the evening of 11/21/63. According to Taylor, the above information has been referred to the Montgomery County Police Department and Detective Sergeant Day of the Montgomery County Police is handling the case.

Taylor advised that he was not making any request of the Bureau and was furnishing this to us for our information and for any use we might consider appropriate.

This matter was discussed with Supervisor Rogge of the General Investigative Division. Rogge instructed that above information be furnished to our Resident Agent in Silver Spring, Maryland, for appropriate handling. In accordance with Rogge's request, the Liaison Agent telephonically contacted SA Charles M. Fleury of the Silver Spring, Maryland, Resident Agency and advised him of the above facts. Fleury was instructed to promptly obtain all the facts in this matter and advise the Bureau of the results.

On November 23, 1963, George James Curtis, also known as Jim, 1962 Havana, S.R., Grand Rapids, Michigan, advised Special Agent Edwin John Lange that for one month in approximately June - July, 1963, he was employed at the Happy Food Tank, a frozen meat locker establishment owned by Charles Lewis, in Happy, Texas. [Bureau File 1930-1933]

During the time he was employed, Lewis talked at length about politics, especially racial problems, and was strongly opposed to President Kennedy for his support and program for the Negroes. Curtis recalls Lewis making comment upon in substance as to the effect that if anyone organized a group to kill President Kennedy he would be one of the first to assist the organization.

Curtis stated he feels although Lewis' strong anti-Kennedy he really did not mean what he said although statement made in serious rather than joking manner. Curtis does not know of any organizations Lewis is a member of that might be considered radical.

Curtis described Lewis as white male, early thirties, 5'3", 170 pounds, slender build, brown eyes, wears glasses, resides Happy, Texas, attended Texas Tech College.

On 11/23/63 a U. S. Information Agency (USIA) employee, Bernard Welsman, furnished the Bureau a four-page memorandum concerning the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FPCC) in which Welsman raised a question as to whether Communist China was possibly involved indirectly in the assassination of President Kennedy by Lee Harvey Oswald. Welsman indicated he was making copies of his memorandum available to USIA and State Department.

The memorandum contained public source data regarding Oswald; Vincent Theodore Lee, National Director of the FPCC; Richard Gibson, former head of the FPCC; Conrad Lynn, communist attorney who has made trips to Cuba; Bureau fugitive Robert F. Williams who fled to Cuba and visited Communist China this fall; William Worthy, the controversial Negro newspaperman who has appealed his conviction for violating United States regulations pertaining to Cuban travel; and Milton Rosen, who was expelled from the Communist Party for disruptive activities which included following some Communist Chinese ideologies. It showed that some of them had associated themselves with the Communist Chinese "line" as regards race relations in the United States.

Referring to Oswald's disillusionment with the Soviet Union, his recent activities in connection with the FPCC and the fact that he still reportedly held Marxist ideas, the memorandum indicated that President Kennedy's assassination could have at least advanced the interests of Communist China.

While there is no question that some of the individuals named are sympathetic to Communist China, Welsman's document contains nothing but speculation concerning the possibility that Communist China was behind Oswald's act. It appears he was interested in getting his theory down on paper as quickly as possible and was attempting to attract some attention to himself during a crisis.
