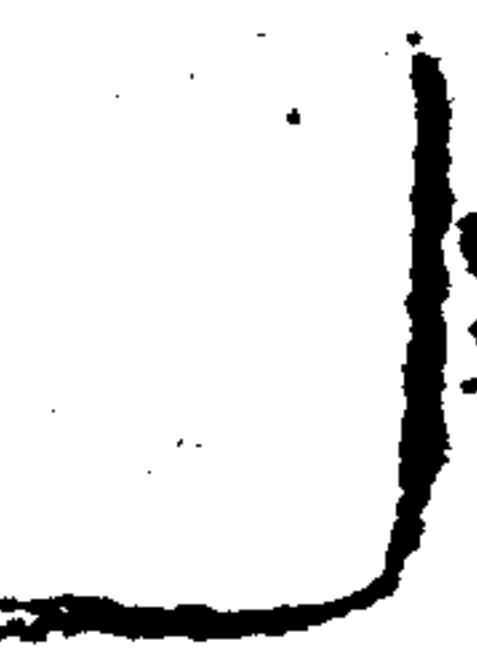

POWELL, Manager, Customer Services, Continental Airlines, San Antonio, Texas, International Airport, displayed a passenger manifest on November 29, 1963, reflecting that on December 22, 1962, a passenger named CAMPBELL, first name not recorded, was aboard Continental flight 59, which departed San Antonio at 8:00 pm, 160 minutes late, for Los Angeles, California. No manifests are maintained on incoming flights, according to POWELL.

JANICE KEY HORNSBY, 786 Clearview, San Antonio, re-called on November 29, 1963, that ELIZABETH CAMPBELL arrived at San Antonio from Sacramento, California, on or about January 2, 1962, aboard an American Airlines airplane. She met Miss CAMPBELL at the airport.

C. WADE HORNSBY, JR., and C. WADE HORNSBY, III, San Antonio, also recalled the arrival of ELIZABETH CAMPBELL from Sacramento, California, at San Antonio on or about January 2, 1963, however they did not recall which airline she arrived on.

G. M. PENCE, Chief, Airport Services, American Airlines, San Antonio, Texas, International Airport, advised on November 29, 1963, that in January 1963 American Airlines flight 59 departed Dallas, Texas, shortly after 8:00 pm, and arrived at San Antonio at about 9:12 pm. He advised that no manifests were available on incoming flights. He added that American Airlines tickets are filed at the American Airlines Treasury Department, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York.
