Re Jacksonville airtel to Bureau dated 5/25/76.

On 5/21/76 [redacted] (White Male, DOB 4/19/39, SSN [redacted] telephonically contacted the RA, Tallahassee, Florida and stated he was the individual who contacted the Jacksonville Office of the FBI on 5/20/76.

[redacted] related how he does not have possession of a "Document 700 to 800 pages in length" which is "incriminating evidence" as it has a listing of persons and their locations on the date of President Kennedy's assassination". He said 10,000 copies of the document were printed up in Belgium by persons unknown and sent to a junk shop on Bloor Street in Toronto, Canada. He said the key to this whole matter is locating a REBECCA VOGEL, aka Rick Vogel, White Female, late 30's, 165 pounds who is arrested in Ottawa, Canada in the fall of 1973. [redacted] contends REBECCA VOGEL is a federal fugitive, U. S. Citizen who fled to Canada. She was also involved in "gunrunning to Cuba" and he last saw her in the summer of 1973.

[redacted] stated, REBECCA VOGEL attorney (name unknown), in Toronto, Canada, has a copy of the incriminating document; however, [redacted] does not know if this document is authentic in any way.

[redacted] states he can get the document if "the FBI will give the protection and the necessary funds to get the job done"; however, he "is being followed now" by persons who are preventing him from obtaining employment.

[redacted] stated that an attempt was made on his life on November 13, 1975 when he was shot and treated at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital. [redacted] stated he did not know who shot him and the case was worked by a [redacted], Leon County Sheriff's Office, Tallahassee, Florida.

[redacted] stated he is a psychologist with a master's degree from Middle Tennessee State University, Murphreesboro, Tennessee and has one year towards his doctorate.

[redacted] stated he has a Deputy Sheriff's commission in Anderson County, Tennessee.

[redacted] said he "has no local address as I have to move around to stay alive".

On 5/21/76 [redacted], when informed of [redacted] said "He's a liar, believes he's mentally ill and sleeps anywhere he can". [redacted] said [redacted] was a bar tender at a local bar in Tallahassee, Florida and was "involved in a really mixed up situation on November 13, 1975". He stated the operator of the bar [redacted] shot [redacted] in the shoulder during a discussion over shortage of receipts. [redacted] was taken to Tallahassee Memorial Hospital for treatment and [redacted] presented [redacted] identification. [redacted] said the shooting was accidental and shortly later [redacted] shot himself in the leg. [redacted] said prosecution was never instituted in the case.

On 5/21/76 a meeting took place at the Grayhound Bus Station in Tallahassee, Florida between [redacted] and Special Agent [redacted]. [redacted] appearance could be described as bizarre. [redacted] had his hair dyed very light blond (or white) a [redacted]-colored beard and an unkempt appearance in general. [redacted] related his information again concerning the document involved in this matter always glancing about "for persons following him". [redacted] said if the FBI would not furnish him funds to locate REBECCA VOGEL he would do it on his own. When [redacted] departed, he walked away and his mannerism indicated he felt threatened.

On 5/24/76 [redacted] Clinical Psychologist, 327 Office Plaza, Tallahassee, Florida [redacted] of the Apalachee Mental Health Clinic formally [redacted] the Leon County Mental Health Clinic advised [redacted] was under his supervision as a counselor from five or six years ago and termed [redacted] work as "professionally irresponsible". Further [redacted] has used [redacted] as a reference on various [redacted] and [redacted] admitted he has "black-balled [redacted]". [redacted] stated that some eight months ago [redacted] returned from Canada and gave the impression he was "intoxicated or high on something". He stated [redacted] rambled on until [redacted] just got up and left the office in order to terminate the interview. [redacted] had inquiries from several counseling services regarding [redacted] seeking employment and heard that [redacted] gave the impression he was intoxicated during interviews.

In general, [redacted] said he feels [redacted] needs "psychiatric help, suspects [redacted] is an alcoholic and has a sexual identity problem".

On May 20, 1976, Mr. Chuck Green, City Editor, The Denver Post, Denver, Colorado, made available a letter and envelope received at the Denver Post on that date. The envelope was postmarked at Dallas, Texas, May 18, 1976, bearing the return address, "XYZ & Q, Dallas, Texas" and is addressed "To the editor, the Denver Post Newspaper, P. O. Box 1709, Denver, Colorado 80201". The enclosed typewritten letter was dated May 17, 1976. A copy of the envelope and the typewritten letter follows:

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency. It and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

Dear Editors:

I killed Kennedy and I'm getting fucking tired of that creep getting the credit for a job I done and got paid for.

Mr. Green had no explanation as to why the letter was sent to the Denver Post and had no information concerning its background. Green advised this letter was handled by himself and Isabelle Holmes who was assigned to the letters to the Editor Department. Upon receipt of the letter by Ms. Holmes, she immediately took it to Mr. John Rogers, the managing editor, who delivered the letter to Mr. Green.

On May 21, 1976, the foregoing described letter and envelope were forwarded to the Federal Bureau of Investigation Laboratory.

The files of the Dallas Office contain no information concerning "Independents", "E-DP", or "XYZ & Q".

Under date of June 1, 1976, the FBI Laboratory advised as follows:

No watermarks, indented writings or other significant features were noted which would indicate the immediate source of Q636 and Q637.

The typewriting on Q636 and Q637 most closely resembles a Laboratory standard for an L. C. Smith pica style of type spaced ten letters to the horizontal inch.

The submitted evidence was photographed and will be returned separately.

No information identifiable with [redacted] located in FBIHQ files.

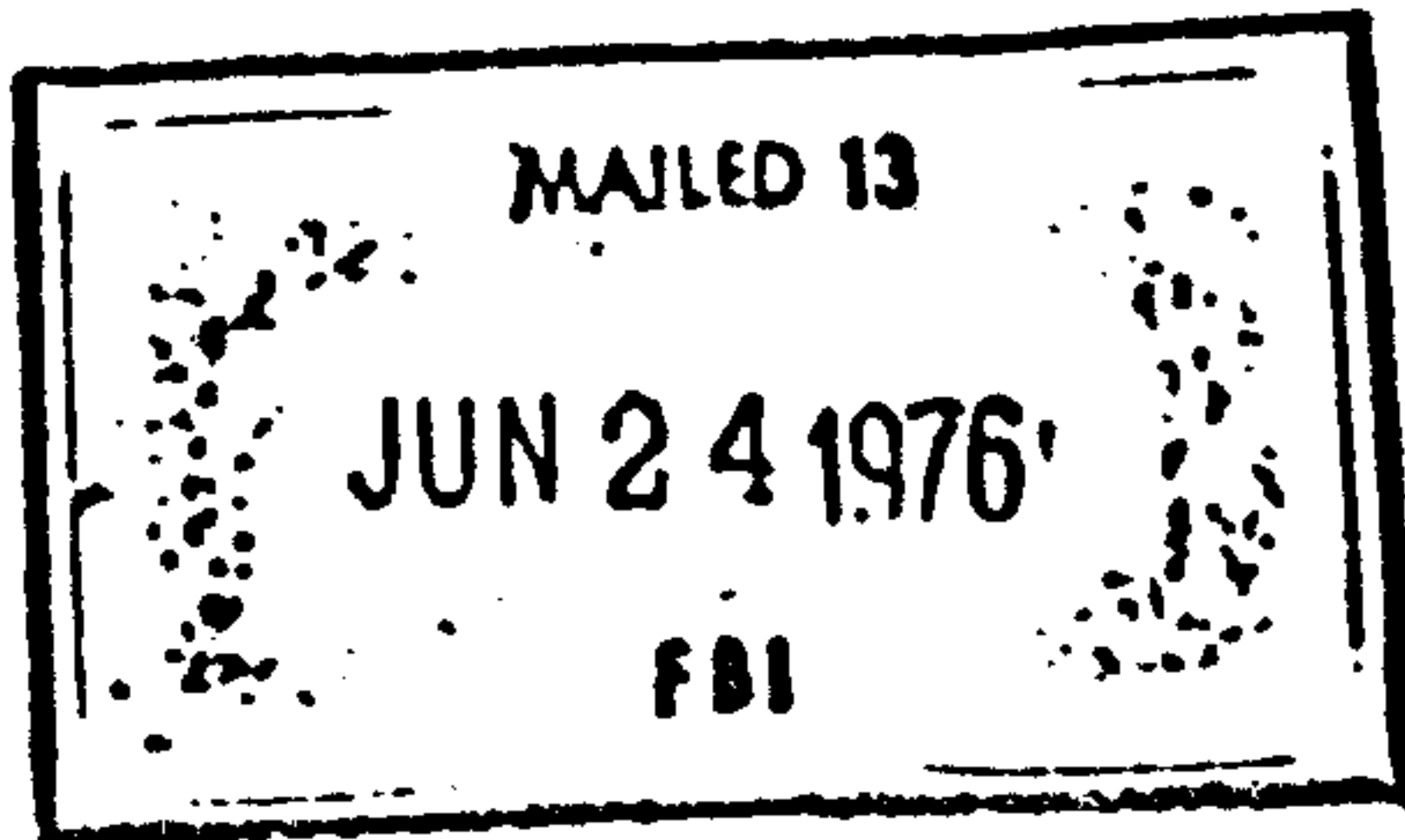

Mr. Director Kelly,

Because I was told by Leigh H. Oswald's group that agents were involved in the planned murder of President John F. Kennedy and after the agents who came to see me from the white house tried to put names in my mind concerning where and who Oswald went to make arrangements with in Florida, I decided in a fraction of time to not reveal names - and agreed with the name they were trying to implant, knowing at the time the suggested name was probably an associate of theirs or etc. And when I refused to give names they let me be. That was when Johnson took over later. However, I did tell them about the wiretaps, buggings, bombs, burglarizing, and armories that would be taken into for explosives and weapons to protect their plan later if need be. So you now understand Mr. Director why I held back information. Two reasons. One, I had been warned to remain silent or suffer death. Two, I had a previous argument with the Navy Dept about schooling, shipping over bones, and my child^{ST 115} accompanying me. When I like any good American fought for my God given and constitutional rights, I was declared 100% disabled. And the names, business, and etc, that I will reveal would have caused the Federal government to put me under St. Elizabeths probably. yet I notice that over 200 sailors were granted their rights from the Navy just last year to the tune of over (\$4,000,000) ^{Because} through I fought alone I was deceived by the Navy and U.A.. So you see the scales of justice are unbalanced as hell. And you probably won't believe me now.

The names and how they were mentioned are as follows. Ex vice president Nixon, Senator Ford, Sec the Connally, vice president Johnson, Mayor of Dallas Johnstons

and one democratic Senator that I know as good as my own name. yet its blocked out of my mind. Also the rich person in Florida. then they mentioned agents but did not give names. Only that one wrote books on intelligence and trained others. And that they would train me in explosives, electronics, and etc. that they wanted ex service men with a grudge against the government and ex cons. that at that time they were 7500 strong and growing. And that if any of us got caught or in trouble our families would be cared for by big business and some of the smartest attorneys in the country. then they stated that before any democrat got in office they would commit mass murder if necessary.

I gave them my answer as follows. I dont want any part of you people. I fight my own battles. Not like a damn coward over a rifle barrel, or with explosives unless they are used against me. Leave Mr. Kennedy alone. But as far as the U.A. and Navy and superior court Los Angeles are concerned I dont give a damn if you blow them from the face of the earth. then I got up to leave and was then searched and ordered to remain silent. I left immediately for Puerto Rico and stayed untill a month after Kennedy was killed. Then when the warren comission declared Oswald was solo I started to tell, as you know. but the questions put to me made me mad as hell, so I reversed the psychology. All they wanted to know is if I could shoot a rifle and what I learned of explosives in the military. As if I were the damn crook. they acted like they werent a bit interested in the buggings, wiretapping, bombs and armories. And then when the one agent tried to take pictures of me in my skivvies, that was the last straw. So in a flash of an eye I changed my mind and knew if I agreed to the name of the person in Florida

They kept trying to implant in my mind they would probably leave. Which they did. I knew when I wrote President Johnson that they would have my navy history of my fighting for my rights against the liars in government and that I lost and was declared w/o disabled. And I knew who they would consider me an idiot because of the prognosis the Navy stopped me with to cover their lies and blunders.

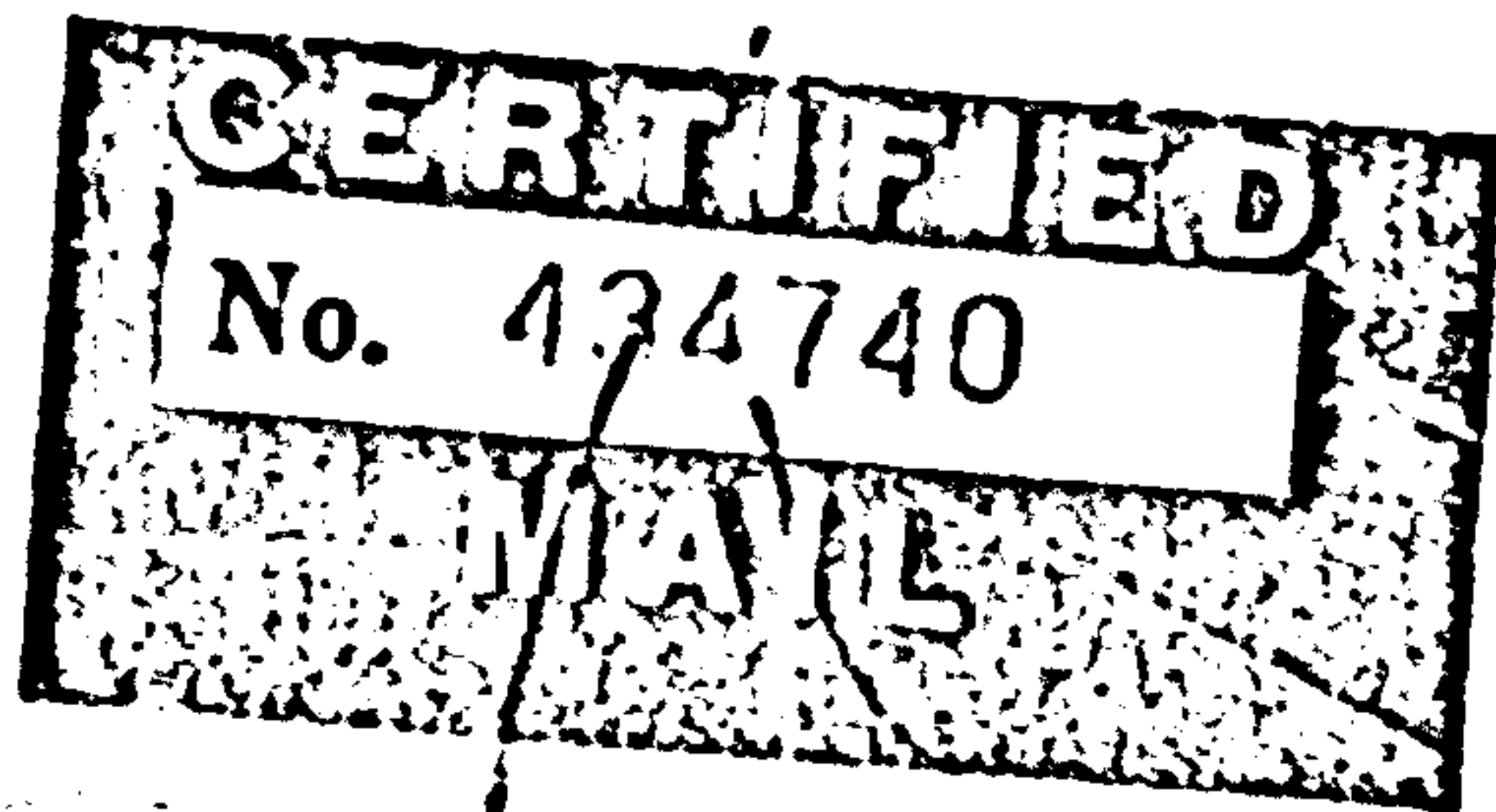
Now I don't know if those people were correct in telling me big business, with its vice president, and an agent who writes book and other agents, and who had the backing of a Senator Ford and a democratized Senator are guilty. But that is your duty. And it is my duty to inform you and ask for an investigation of treason and murder, against our President and country. I demand equal protection of the law also since I was threatened with death.

Meanwhile I am going to the U.G. Hospital and have this letter witnessed. Then I am going to ask the doctors aid for my service connected disability. I will also ask them for serum, hypnosis, or polygraph to verify I speak the truth. There were four men and a girl who swore to kill the Kennedys if Oswald missed. So you see the Warren commission was full of bull. And I might add that the closest one to the truth (since I was told what would happen) was that lawyer in Louisiana. But he sure was quieted down fast. And I met and talked with those people in North Mobile just after I left Bayou La Batre. That's where they showed me the route President Kennedy would take. They got them from the group in Texas. It was a 4x6 drawing of the routes. They also mentioned an oil co in Texas, Chemical Co, and a Milk Cooperation and others. Now I can't understand if those business's are backing them why they

are going to destroy business, (Maybe its because they're
supporting democrats.) And Mr. Nilly they sure hate democrats.
If you had heard them like I did you wouldn't have believed
you were in the U.S.A. Mr. Director they can even get to
you if they wanted. You people say I'm sick, but they can
destroy whole cities if they wish. And its your people's
own fault for not listening to me when Johnson took
over & he sent agents. Why didn't they listen? Now it may
be too late. I have sent certified copies to Congressman
Allen Anderson, and The San Pedro News pilot. If they
publish it, I know I'll be visited. But regardless I
have made my peace with the Almighty God.

Enclosed for the Bureau is the original and one copy of a typewritten note, dated "11/1/63", which reads as follows;

"would the one who fines this not please git a holt of the fbi as i am bein held in whiteSlary by a bayd of jipsies. They ar planin to kill the Presedant as thet ar also comunists. My unkle is one of them.

/s/ Sandra Ruby

On May 20, 1976, [redacted], [redacted] Arlington, Texas, telephone [redacted] appeared at the Ft. Worth Resident Agency and furnished the above described note to SA [redacted]. He stated he had found this note inside a bolt of cloth at the Reese B. Davis Company, Forest Park Boulevard at the West Freeway, Ft. Worth, Texas, on March 29, 1972 while he was employed there. He advised that because of recent publicity concerning captioned matter, he felt the note might have some significance and that was the reason for contacting the FBI at this time. He stated the note was between layers of fabric and approximately halfway through the bolt when he found it. The fabric was being sold by the yard and the note fell out as the fabric was being unrolled. He

took the note home and discussed it with his wife, [redacted] but neither of them took it seriously and did not consider reporting it at the time.

[redacted] stated the note was misplaced and he did not locate it until a few days ago when he was moving from his residence and found it in some personal papers. [redacted] is a Missionary with the [redacted] in Ft. Worth and is in the process of moving to Monterrey, Mexico.

[redacted] advised that as best he can remember, the bolt of cloth contained the number B 5800, which he made a note of on the reverse side of the note and he also noted the date as March 29, 1972. The bolt of cloth was from Seneca Textile Mills, which is possibly located in South Carolina. He described the material as sheer dacron in an off white and stated the note was folded double when it was found. The note is typewritten on a portion of a sheet of unlined bond paper. [redacted] furnished his forwarding address as [redacted] Monterrey, Nuevo Leon Mexico.

Dallas indices negative on SANDRA RUBY.

Bureau is requested to examine the enclosed note in an effort to determine if the paper can be determined to have been of more recent manufacture than November, 1963 and for any other information that would discredit the authenticity of this note. The Bureau may retain the original note. Upon receipt of the results of FBI Laboratory examination, such results will be included in a letterhead memorandum.

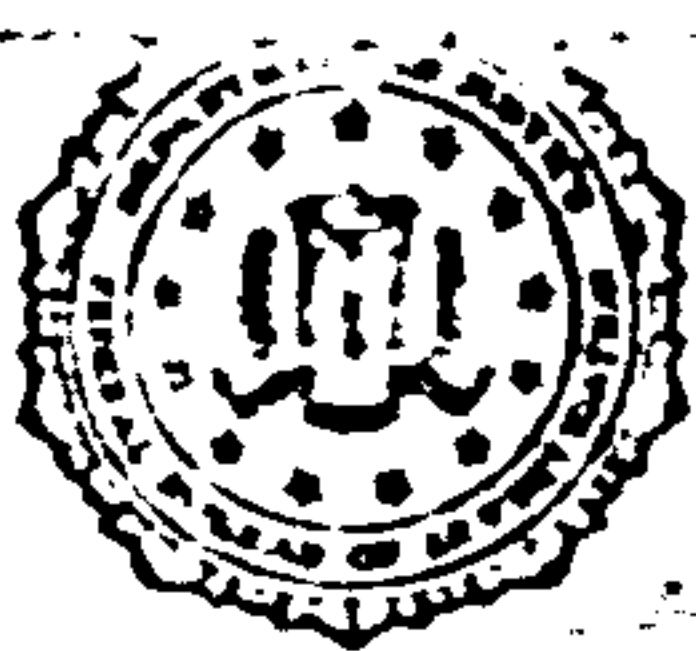

JAMES E. BEAIRD, 1478 South Main Street, advised that in 1955 to 1957 he resided in the Houston, Texas, area and sold automobiles for a dealer in Houston, Texas. During that time he became acquainted with many people in the area of Seabrook and Kemah, Texas. He had some friends that he played poker with in the Kemah, Texas, area; one of those friends was JACK RUBY who shot LEE HARVEY OSWALD. He explained that JACK RUBY was, at that time, involved in the business of selling guns to FIDEL CASTRO in Cuba. He further explained that, during the middle-1950's, the United States was not too concerned with FIDEL CASTRO inasmuch as CASTRO had not gained control of Cuba, and it was not known at that time that CASTRO had Communist connections.

Mr. JAMES E. BEAIRD advised that JACK RUBY stored guns and ammunition in a two-story house between the waterfront and railroad tracks in Kamah, Texas, and would take the guns and ammunition to Cuba, mostly on weekends. He related that he personally saw many boxes of new guns, including automatic rifles and handguns, stored in the two-story house and placed on a boat for shipment. He related that JACK RUBY had a boat about 50 feet long which appeared to be government surplus, similar to a military landing craft or LST. He stated that each time that the boat left with guns and ammunition JACK RUBY was on the boat.

Mr. BEAIRD advised that he had recently returned from Kamah, Texas, where visiting and noticed that the area in which the old two-story house stood is now built up with new buildings. He advised that he did not remember names of persons with whom JACK RUBY was in business at the time and thought nothing of the matter until after President KENNEDY was shot. Since the assassination of President KENNEDY there has been so much speculation as to possible foreign connections and he thought it better not to mention his knowledge of JACK RUBY in Kamah, Texas. He advised that he could not remember any specific dates regarding this associations with JACK RUBY nor dates that JACK RUBY transported guns and ammunition to CASTRO in Cuba.

The files of the Dallas Office of the FBI reflect in 1955 Jack Ruby was operating the Vegas Club at Dallas, Texas. In 1956, he opened another club called Hernando's Hideaway at Dallas, Texas, which he operated for only approximately three months. In 1956, he took a trip, which lasted several weeks to New York; Joplin, Missouri; Tulsa, Oklahoma; and Chicago, when he was attempting to promote a young Negro tap dancer and drummer named Nelson, also known as "Little Daddy."

During the investigation it was established that Ruby's only trip to Cuba was in August, 1959, when he went to Havana, Cuba, at the invitation of one, L. C. McWillie.

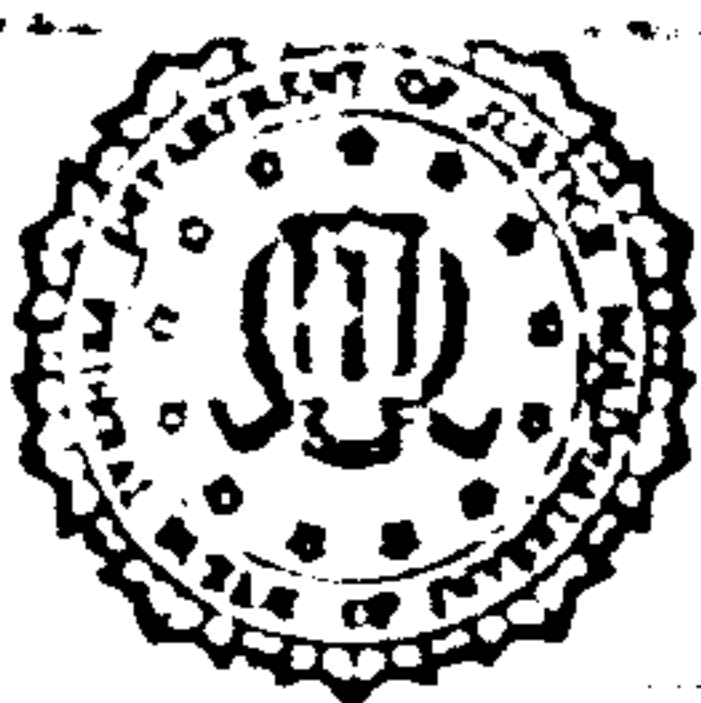

 was contacted at her residence where the identity of the interviewing Agent, as well as the nature of the inquiry were made known to her. [REDACTED] thereafter furnished the following information:

[REDACTED] said about three years ago her daughter, [REDACTED], married [REDACTED] who everybody calls [REDACTED]. While they were all living at [REDACTED] in Charlotte, North Carolina, at that time, [REDACTED] started talking about President KENNEDY's death and told her the ones responsible for his death were LYNDON JOHNSON, JACQUELINE ONASSIS and "JOHNNY" ONASSIS. [REDACTED] told her they all wanted KENNEDY dead; JOHNSON, because he wanted to become President and ONASSIS because he wanted to marry KENNEDY's wife. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] told her he set up the plans for KENNEDY's death, [REDACTED] location unknown to [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] told her OSWALD did not do it; however, he did not tell her who did kill KENNEDY, except that it was four men (names, et cetera, unknown) with revolvers.

[REDACTED] said [REDACTED] told her all of his people [REDACTED] were dirt and he was born into the Mafia. She said [REDACTED] told her some of the men who killed KENNEDY came from South America and "came in" through the docks at Savannah Beach, Georgia.

[REDACTED] said [REDACTED] told her LYNDON JOHNSON was the one who paid him \$50,000 for setting up the plans to kill President KENNEDY, and all this happened long before he knew [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] said [REDACTED] cries a lot and prays to a picture of a young girl on his wall, who he says reminds him of his daughter who was shot at a carnival. She said she does not know any details of the eleven men [REDACTED] said he killed before coming to North Carolina.

[redacted] advised [redacted] drinks a lot and takes all kinds of pills, uses filthy, obscene language all the time and she does not know what to do to get rid of him, asking if the FBI could help her out. She said [redacted] has pawned everything he can lay his hands on and steals money from her for his drinking.

She said [redacted] recently told her he needed to get some money so he could get the four men who killed KENNEDY back to the United States from South America and [redacted] and his wife went to Savannah, Georgia, on Mother's Day to see that the four men got off the ship. She said [redacted] attempt to commit suicide a few years ago was "a fake." She said she believes everything [redacted] has told her is true.

[redacted] described [redacted] as a white male, age 56 or 58 or 45, date of birth unknown, height 5'9", weight 145 pounds, brown hair, wears glasses, employed at a "barrel place."

[redacted], age 17, grandson of Mrs. [redacted] was contacted at [redacted] residence, [redacted] where the identity of the interviewing Agent as well as the nature of the inquiry were made known to him. [redacted] in the presence of [redacted] furnished the following information regarding [redacted] also known as "[redacted]" who lives at their residence with his wife, [redacted].

[redacted] said "[redacted]" is a drunk and an alcoholic who has a different story almost every night. He said [redacted] drinks constantly and this morning for breakfast he had a quart of Pabst Blue Ribbon beer. [redacted] said [redacted] besides drinking beer, whiskey and a lot of "Mad Dog 20-20" wine, takes pills (uppers and downers).

[redacted] then related some of the following information that [redacted] has told him:

U S: // [redacted] said that the people responsible for President KENNEDY's death were LYNDON JOHNSON, JACQUELINE KENNEDY ONASSIS and "JOHNNY" ONASSIS. [redacted] told CHAMBERS LYNDON JOHNSON paid him \$50,000 to set [redacted] plans to kill KENNEDY, no details ever furnished to [redacted]. [redacted] said [redacted] told him four men with revolvers were the ones who killed KENNEDY; however, only three of them got shots at him.

[redacted] said "[redacted]" told him he was in the Mafia under the name of FRANK ANGELINI (phonetic) and besides killing JOE VALACHI, he also killed 52 other men (no details furnished to [redacted]). [redacted] told [redacted] he got out of the Mafia after killing VALACHI.

[redacted] said "[redacted]" told him he was once in the gas chamber in California for killing a man; however, Governor WARREN excused him from the gas chamber.

[redacted] S said [redacted] cries a lot and prays in front of a framed, painted picture of a young girl who [redacted] says reminds him of his dead daughter, who was shot in the back at a carnival, location unknown, by individuals who were trying to kill him.

[redacted], according to [redacted] once told him he was going shark hunting in a scuba diving outfit and threw an explosive device at a boat sitting at a dock, and a bunch of kids and FBI Agents got killed.

[redacted] said [redacted] tried to commit suicide a couple of years ago with a knife and was in the Veterans Administration Hospital in Salisbury, North Carolina. [redacted] said [redacted] told him he was in the Navy during World War II and [redacted] recalled [redacted] being on parole at one time under the supervision of a FRANK BIVENS.

[redacted] S said [redacted] steals money from Mrs. [redacted] and stays up all night cursing and drinking.

[redacted] then asked the interviewing Agent to accompany him to another room where [redacted] advised that his grandmother, Mrs. [redacted] has got a mental problem as well as several physical problems.

[redacted] described [redacted] as a white male, about 50, 5'9" tall, 135-140 pounds, brown hair (thinning in front), wears dark horn-rimmed glasses, employed at [redacted] Charlotte, North Carolina, as a laborer; tattoos of a sailor with "Buddy" underneath on right lower arm and "Maria" on left arm.

[redacted] does not own a car or possess a driver's license according to [redacted].

[redacted] S described as a white male, age 12, date of birth September 19, 1963, at Little Rock, Arkansas, height 5'4", weight 120 pounds, hair brown, eyes blue.

Mr. [REDACTED] North Carolina Department of Correction, Parole Office, East Trade Street, was apprised of the identity of the interviewing Agent as well as the nature of the inquiry. [REDACTED] thereafter located a file for [REDACTED] white male, date of birth October 28, 1928, at Savannah, Georgia, and furnished the following information from the file:

[REDACTED] said [REDACTED] was originally placed on probation on January 31, 1972, for failure to pay a motel bill of \$475.44. He was given a 90-day sentence, suspended, put on probation for two years, and fined \$50, ordered to make restitution and pay \$16 in court costs. [REDACTED] was removed from probation on May 20, 1974, and his probation officer was [REDACTED], who is no longer with the Probation Department.

[REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] at the time of his probation in 1972 admitted to being an alcoholic and needing help with his problem.

[REDACTED] recalled [REDACTED] inasmuch as he and [REDACTED] were in the hospital at the same time for back operations. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] cried a lot and was a "real worrier," constantly talking about his problems.

[REDACTED] recalled [REDACTED] wife had a serious mental problem and was confined to the psychiatric ward at Memorial Hospital at one time.

[REDACTED] said [REDACTED] record shows he was drinking quite heavily just prior to his release from probation and had separated from his wife on several occasions. The record also showed, according to [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] told his probation officer that someone was trying to kill him and thereafter moved from a boarding house to the Salvation Army.

[REDACTED] provided an undated newspaper clipping of a mini poll taken by a newspaper regarding capital punishment in which [REDACTED] was quoted as saying, "As far as I'm

concerned, if you do away with capital punishment, you're legalizing murder."

[redacted], Arlington, Texas [redacted], appeared at the Ft. Worth Resident Agency of the FBI and furnished a note found inside a bolt of cloth at the Reese B. Davis Company, Forest Park Boulevard at the West Freeway, Ft. Worth, Texas, on March 29, 1972, while he was employed there. [redacted] advised that because of recent publicity concerning the Kennedy Assassination he felt that the note may have some significance, and that was his reason for contacting the FBI at this time. [redacted] went on to explain that the note was between layers of fabric and approximately halfway through the bolt when he found it. He further advised the fabric was being sold by the yard, and the note fell out as the fabric was being unrolled. [redacted] stated that at the time he found the note, he took it home and discussed it with his wife, [redacted] but that neither took it seriously at that time, and he did not consider reporting it to the FBI.

[redacted] stated the note was misplaced, and he did not locate it until a few days ago when he was moving from his residence and found it in some personal papers. [redacted] states he is a missionary with the [redacted] in Ft. Worth, and he is in the process of moving to Monterrey, Mexico. He stated he and his wife were in the process of cleaning their former residence and moving when they found the note.

[redacted] advised that as best he can remember, the bolt of cloth contained the number B-5800 which he made a note of on the reverse side of the note, and he also noted the date as March 29, 1972. [redacted] advised the bolt of cloth was from Seneca Textile Mills which is possibly located in South Carolina. He described the material as sheer dacron in an off white and stated the note was folded double when it was found. The note is typewritten on a portion of a sheet of unlined bond paper and is dated November 1, 1963.
