Result of examination:

The typewriting on Q638 was compared with the material in the Anonymous Letter File but no identification was effected. A photograph of this typewriting will be added to this file.

No watermarks or other significant features were noted in the paper comprising Q638 which would indicate the source of this paper or the date of manufacture.

The typewriting on Q638 most closely resembles a Laboratory standard for an L. C. Smith pica style of type having a horizontal spacing of ten letters to the inch. This particular style of type has been used since 1946.

Obliterated writing appears on Q638 and a photograph showing this obliterated writing is being forwarded to your office herewith. This obliterated writing could not be definitely determined except the last line appears to be the notation "U. S. Court House". Q638 was photographed and will be returned separately.
