Mr. Noeller stated, however, he did overhear the man saying something to the effect that the same thing should happen to Kennedy and his brother as happened to Mr. Noeller advised that the man departed the lounge car before arriving at Baltimore, but before leaving stopped and chatted with an elderly gentleman to whom he furnished a business card. Noeller said he later talked to this elderly gentleman who said he was a White House guard and who showed Noeller the card identifying the individual as William C. Sheppard, Kirk-Fit Door Patterns, Wrightstown, Bucks County, Pennsylvania.

Mr. Noeller advised that on November 6, 1963, he traveled from Washington, D. C., to Baltimore by Pennsylvania Railroad train, which departed Washington, D. C., at 10:20 p.m. He said shortly after departure he entered the club car where he overheard the loud and boisterous conversation of a man present. He said this individual who was apparently talking to no one in particular spoke furiously about former President Kennedy and berated the Administration in very foul language. Mr. Noeller could not recall the specific criticism, some of which was not audible, but this individual's dissatisfaction according to Mr. Noeller appeared to stem from the fact that he was a businessman.

On November 26, 1963, Mr. Walter H. Noeller, Special Assistant to National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) Headquarters, Washington, D. C., and former Congressman (D), 10th District of Ohio, was interviewed by Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation at Washington, D. C.

In addition, the President has instructed the FBI to conduct a full investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy and the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald. I can assure you that this Bureau will discharge its responsibilities in this regard with the same thoroughness and dispatch that have characterized our investigations in the past.

Your letter of November 27th has been received, and I want to thank you for giving me the benefit of your observations and comments and for your kind offer to do my portrait.

Her husband and brother-in-law were murdered, as she claims, by American schemers. I think the most vital element for your piece of the evidence are the dates of various incidents. Compare the date of the Vietnamese Revolution, the killing of her two men and... when did Oswald go to Mexico. The Communists would not need to go there, but have their conventionals here.

I think he went there because the agent of agents of Madame Nu, being Oriental, would attract the attention of intelligence witnesses. It was there that Oswald probably came for the first time in contact with those who picked him for the tool of assassination in revenge for the losing of the political power by the IV regime and the entrenched family. I think it could have been her "inspiration" to kill him who caused, in her mind, their loss of the hold of power and, at the same time, to strike vengeance into the American people. Personally, she could have aimed the blow at Mrs. Kennedy as the wife of the man who too would have to suffer. Now, reread the radiogram, sent by Madame Nu to Mrs. Kennedy, and find the edge of the dagger in the almost jeering words of the perfidious message.

I would guard Rubinstein as the most precious lead to the conspirators of the crime and subject him to all the possible methods of investigation, besides the most obvious, the Godium-Permethol and the improved "truth"-seeking injections.

Communicate with the Italian Security authorities that they spread an investigation around Madame Nu. She, being the wife of the chief of the Vietnamese Security, knew all the possible ways of assassination, against which no head of State could be safe, with the millions of windows opening on to the streets through which he is driven around, inviting his demise. I would propose that no vital personage be permitted by the Security people to ever parade the security of the National Fate like a clay pigeon.

When the war was on, I communicated with your office on a few different occasions. Since I am a sculptor (not a Modelmist), I would like to propose that some day when you are in Los Angeles, it would be good if I could do a portrait of you, not for you but for future Americans.

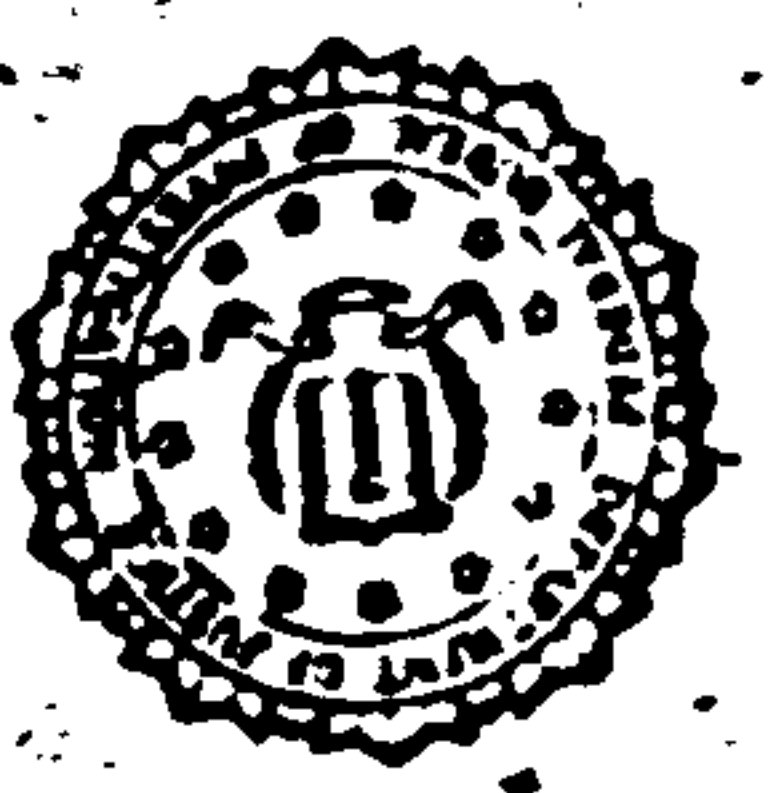

1. Mr. Hoover, if you will take the time to check with the NRA of Washington, D.C. I am sure that they will agree that I am correct in the necessity of zeroing in the rifle before any accurate shooting can be done.

2. I wonder if Oswald was left handed?

3. According to the pictures that I have seen on T.V. and in the papers of the location that the rifleman was supposed to fire from, it is my belief that the shooter was left handed, for it would be a very awkward position for a right handed person to fire at a 45 degree and fire down on a moving target at one hundred yards from a window to his right. If you would have one of your men try this cut, I am sure that he will agree with me. A left handed man would have no trouble, but a right handed person would have to shift his body to keep on the target and that would tend to spoil his aim.

4. To fire any rifle with or without scope it is first necessary that the rifle be zeroed in. That is, the rifle must be fired at a known range and the sights or scope adjusted until the rifle will shoot at approximately the same spot on the target each time. To do this it is almost impossible for one person to zero in a rifle for a hundred yards without help. I believe that there was more than one person involved in the shooting of our president for this reason.

5. Having served over sixteen years in the United States Army, thirteen of which were served in the Infantry, during which time I qualified each year as an EXCELLENT RIFEMAN and fired as a member of several rifle teams, I am most anxious to call to your attention certain facts that I believe will have a bearing on the slaying of President Kennedy.

The reverse side of Qc102 was not prepared from OSWALD'S original notice of classification or from OSWALD'S original registration certificate. In his wallet nor does the data on the back of Qc102 conform to the descriptive data on the back of OSWALD'S original registration certificate. It is noted that the reverse side of Qc102 is the form of a registration certificate and is not the reverse side of a notice of classification card. Hence, it is apparent that OSWALD had at least one other original registration certificate.

It was concluded that Qc102 is a fraudulent and counterfeit card. It was prepared from OSWALD'S original notice of classification in his name and contained in his wallet. From the original notice of classification in OSWALD'S name, at least three negatives were prepared. The three negatives are part of item 225 in the inventory submitted by the Dallas Office. These three negatives were used in preparing the face of Qc102.

It was four or five days after president Kennedy's death before I thought much of the Nov. 14, 1963, account, since then I've checked to find out what radio station he was listening to, I called him on the telephone, to ask what station he heard it on, and any further details on the matter, I made a tape recording of that phone call. He told me he'd been listening to radio station K.N.I.T. here in Abilene, Texas, he was with someone that he ask if K.N.I.T. was right, and they said again K.N.I.T. he said he had a boy employed that was a radio fanatic and he could tell any thing about it. I haven't talked with the radio fanatic, I did call the radio station, and they said they did not make the announcement, that call was today, since the radio station denies that they made the announcement, and I'm told they did, I feel its up to me to tell it to you:

The customer said he had heard it on the radio. I was shocked at the time and when he left, I turned the radio on, and heard nothing about it, I ask my wife if he had, and she hadn't. I forgot about it as a worse kind of joke, then president Kennedy was shot, causing more shock, because every radio station was telling of the tragedy.

The customer either said, "In Washington," or near the "Whitehouse,"

On November 14, I think it was, of this year, I was told by one of our customers when he came to get a starter repaired, that, as he tole me, president Kennedy "just got shot,"

An individual who identified himself as THOMAS N. COX, 1301 Adams Street, N. E., Washington, D. C., age 40, telephonically contacted SA ROBERT L. EVANS at the WFO on 12/4/63. COX stated he had told him (apparently referring to OSWALD) not to shoot the President but to shoot BOBBY. COX advised SA EVANS he knew there was no foreign element involved in the assassination and that OSWALD received his money from Atlanta, Georgia. COX further advised SA EVANS that he is a hitch hiker and has been in Atlanta, New Orleans, and Daytona, Florida. He said he had recently been arrested by the 12th Precinct, WFO, Washington, D. C., on a drunk charge. COX said he wondered what the FBI was doing when KENNEDY was shot in Dallas and insinuated that the FBI was not doing its job.

THOMAS NEAL COX, aka THOMAS NEIL COX, Apartment 4, 1301 Adams Street, N. E., Washington, D. C., was personally contacted there on 12/4/63, by SAs CHARLES L. WOOD and JOHN J. GORMAN. COX stated he was born 8/1/25 at Sanford, Florida, and has been living "on and off" at the above address for the past two years. He stated he is presently unemployed. COX said he served in the U. S. Army with # 264-247605

NAVY from 1941-45 with SN 269-03-02 and was in the U.S. Army from 1949-51 with SN 1333836. He stated he served in Korea from 1950-51 and received honorable discharges from both the Navy and the Army. His Social Security Number is 264-24-7605.

COX stated he served time in the District of Columbia Jail on an assault charge from June to October 12, 1963.

COX denied making the statement that he had told OSWALD not to shoot the President but to shoot BOBBY. He stated he is not acquainted with OSWALD. COX also denied stating that OSWALD received his money from Atlanta, Georgia.

COX said he did make the statement that he knew there was no foreign element involved in the assassination. Then questioned regarding his basis for that statement COX advised it was merely his personal opinion as formed from reading and listening to public reports concerning the assassination.

COX appeared to be in a drunken condition when interviewed and his brother, CONNIE COX, of the same address, advised that THOMAS N. COX has been on a drunk for the past four days. CONNIE COX said he is not aware his brother had telephoned the FBI and stated no credence should be placed in his remarks concerning the assassination.

THOMAS N. COX was vigorously informed the FBI is not and has not been lax in the performance of its duties. He was also told that a considerable amount of FBI Agents' time, which could be spent in valuable and productive work, is wasted in running out false allegations and information furnished by irresponsible individuals such as himself. COX was admonished against any repetition of the above and informed this incident would be made a matter of official record.
