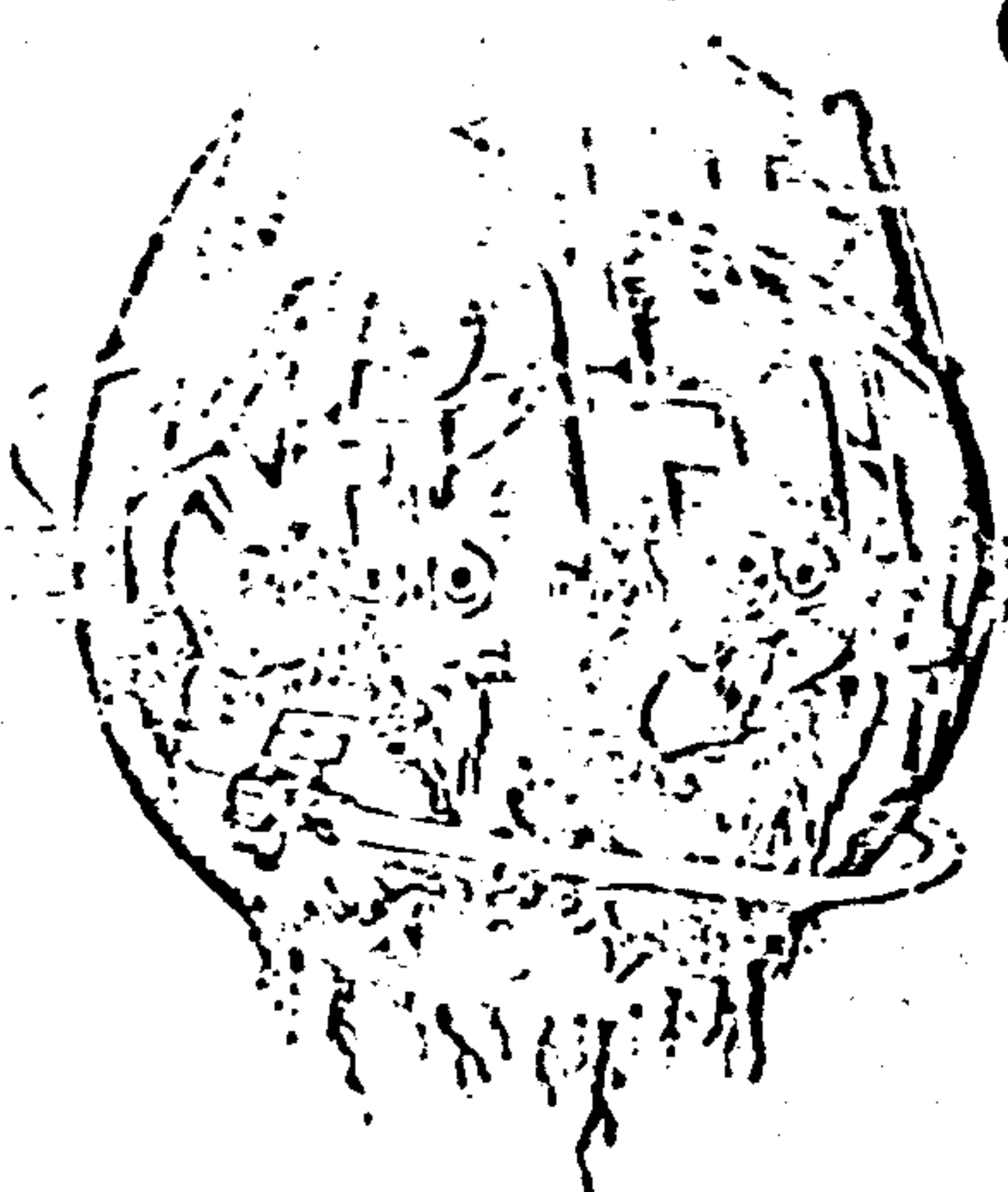

Gentlemen--

Here at KPFT Radio we're doing a show on the JFK assassination, and we've become interested in the bullet found by R.D. Lester in the Dealey Plaza area and turned in to your Dallas office last November.

We did a good interview with Lester, and would like to know a little more about his discovery. Unfortunately, he didn't weigh or photograph the bullet he found.

According to the Washington Post, the House Assassinations Committee has forbidden the National Archives to loan the test bullets from the Warren Commission investigation to the FBI Lab for comparison with Lester's bullet. This makes no sense at all, since the test bullets aren't primary evidence in the case.

We'd like to use the Lester interview, but the story is incomplete. Could you let us have a photo of the bullet, with a description of its weight and rifling characteristics? We could then show these to Colonel William H. Hanson, of San Antonio, who seems to be the most responsible assassination student in this area, and get his opinion.

Enclosed is one copy of an undated communication received from Mr. Leon Day, Research Director, KPFT Radio, Houston, Texas.

Contact Mr. Day, acknowledge his letter and advise him that the FBI would like to be of assistance to him, but as the matter is still under investigation, the FBI cannot furnish him with photographs or other information concerning the evidence furnished the Bureau by Mr. R. D. Lester.

For your information, Lester furnished a metal fragment allegedly found in the vicinity of the JFK assassination site, Dallas, Texas, and furnished it to the Bureau on 12/1/76. Attempts by the Bureau to obtain the Oswald rifle test bullets, which are in the custody of the National Archives and Records Service (NARS) for comparison with this fragment have been unsuccessful due to an agreement between the Chief Counsel of the House Select Committee On Assassinations (HSCA) and NARS which at this time has prevented the Bureau access to the fragments. It is expected this matter will be resolved in the near future.

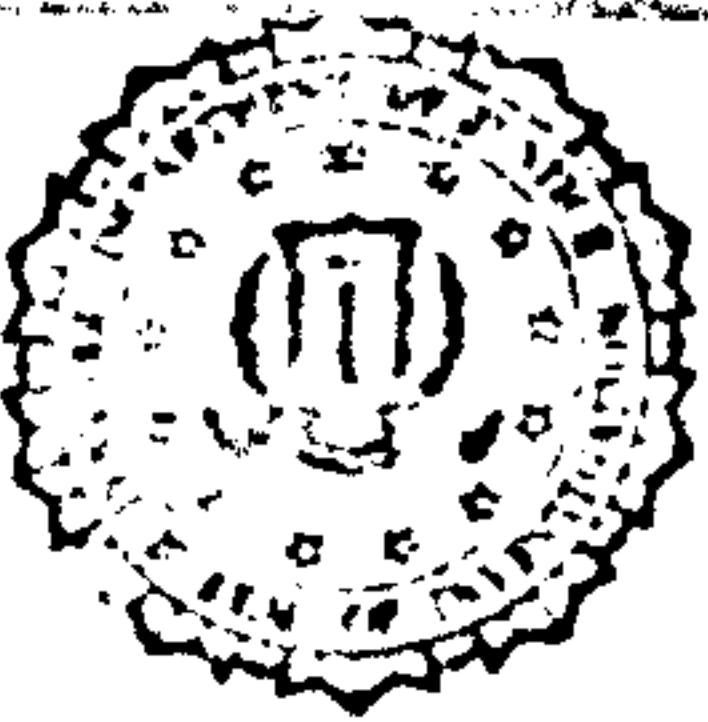
[redacted] saw at the Atlanta Airport over the weekend of April 2 and 3, 1977, who may be the pilot to whom he gave the film showing OSWALD and RUBY together taken in the summer of 1962.

ADDENDUM

The Bureau is requested to note the following information regarding [redacted] which was furnished previously by Miami airtel to the Bureau dated 8/25/76, under same caption:

On 8/19/76, [redacted] Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), Key West, Florida, was contacted and advised he has known [redacted] for 20 years or more and considers him a close friend. [redacted] advised, however, that several years ago, [redacted] sustained a broken neck and is currently suffering from high blood pressure and a bad heart. [redacted] stated he feels that [redacted] is prone to exaggeration, and although not intentionally, [redacted] has been known to fabricate stories and tell them because he believes in his own mind that they are true. [redacted] was asked specifically if any Cuban Transport planes could have come into Key West to pick up passengers in late summer of 1962 or 1963 and he stated that to his knowledge they did not as the United States had broken diplomatic relations by that time. [redacted] stated he would not accept any story put forth by [redacted] without hard evidence to substantiate it.

Also on 8/19/76, [redacted] Major, Monroe County Sheriff's Office, Key West, Florida, advised in his opinion he has never known [redacted] to tell an outright lie, however, he does feel that [redacted] is prone to exaggeration and making more of an incident than there is to it.

On April 12, 1977, [redacted] was  
contacted at [redacted]  
to clarify certain statements he had made during interview  
on March 30, 1977, and provided the following information:

[redacted] stated that to the best of his recollection  
a large group of individuals (40 to 50) had gathered at the  
Key West International Airport in the summer of 1962, which  
drew his undivided attention. [redacted] said this group, known  
as "Fair Play for Cuba" caught his attention for two reasons:

First, [redacted] was aware that travel agreements  
between the United States and Cuba had been severed and  
secondly he believed the group, by virtue of its announced  
belief, to be communist oriented. For these two reasons,  
[redacted] felt that filming this group would be worthwhile  
and of interest to the FBI.

[redacted] stated that a roll of 35 millimeter film,  
which he had taken of this group, was given to a National  
Airlines pilot, correcting the statement he had made on  
March 30, 1977, stating the film was given to an Air Sunshine  
pilot. This pilot was to forward the film to FBI, Miami,  
en route to FBI Headquarters. The Key West Resident Agency  
was not contacted regarding the transporting of this film  
because [redacted] did not see any advantage to do so.

To date, no documentation or passenger manifest  
has been located to confirm [redacted] statements, although  
[redacted] advised such papers did exist at one time.

This document contains neither recommendations nor  
conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is  
loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be  
distributed outside your agency.

[redacted] further advised that during a recent business trip, he had occasion to pass through Atlanta, Georgia. During a layover in Atlanta, on the weekend of April 2 and 3, 1977, he was approached by a National Airlines pilot whom he thought could possibly be the one to whom he gave the 35 millimeter film taken in 1962 of the "Fair Play for Cuba" group. [redacted] stated that this possibility came to mind after he had departed Atlanta, Georgia. The only information which [redacted] could provide that might help in locating this pilot, is as follows:

[redacted] stated that this pilot did fly for National Airlines and the individual had only seven years remaining before retirement which would make him 53 years old and that on the weekend of April 2 and 3, 1977, this pilot was assigned to stand-by duty for Los Angeles and San Francisco, on flights utilizing a DC10 aircraft.

On April 12, 1977, [redacted] Secretary in the Chief Pilot's Office, National Airlines, Miami International Airport, was requested to attempt to determine the identity of the National Airlines pilot [redacted] said he had seen at the Atlanta Airport on the weekend of April 2 and 3, 1977. [redacted] stated that based on the information concerning the pilot, it would be a very difficult task to identify him but that they would attempt to do so and would advise FBI Miami when this is done.

On April 5, 1977, [redacted] Secretary for Airport Manager, Key West International Airport, advised as follows:

[redacted] stated that she was familiar with papers belonging to [redacted] which might substantiate through passenger manifest the presence of the group known as "Fair Play for Cuba" in the summer of 1962. To the best of [redacted] knowledge, these documents have been destroyed or thrown away resulting from an effort to reorganize the airport management offices. [redacted] could provide no other information of a positive nature to help locate questioned documents.

On April 13, 1977, [REDACTED], 1215 South Street, Key West, Florida, advised as follows:

[REDACTED] stated that he had worked as a custodian at the Key West International Airport from 1966 until the present. [REDACTED] recalls reorganizational efforts in the management offices of the airport and stated that whatever documents of questionable value that existed have since been destroyed or thrown away. [REDACTED] was unable to provide any other information which might help to locate questioned documents, for example passenger manifest.

On April 13, 1977, [REDACTED], Present Manager of Key West International Airport, was interviewed at his office and provided the following information:

[REDACTED] stated that he was familiar with records kept by [REDACTED] which might substantiate the presence of the group "Fair Play for Cuba" in the summer of 1962 at the Key West International Airport, but his knowledge of the disposition of these documents was simply that they have been either destroyed or thrown away. [REDACTED] could provide no other information which might help locate these documents.

On April 5, 1977, [REDACTED], Manager for Avis Car Rental, Key West International Airport, was contacted at his place of business and advised as follows:

[REDACTED] stated that he had been employed at the airport with Avis Car Rental since 1956. [REDACTED] advised that he could not recall any gathering of individuals at the Key West International Airport, for example the "Fair Play for Cuba" group, during the summer of 1962.

Enclosed for the Bureau are two xerox copies  
summarizing a visit on 4/14/77 of National Inquirer  
Reporter, HARRY LONGMUIR, at which time he posed certain  
questions to SAC WARREN C. DE BRUEYS.

I should reiterate that all of the questions  
posed by Mr. LONGMUIR related to what I had said or had  
not said during interview by CBS Representative BRUCE  
HALL in San Juan, Puerto Rico, in preparatory for the  
November, 1975, CBS documentary on the presidential  
assassination. As set forth in my account of stated  
interview, I explained to Mr. LONGMUIR that I was restricted  
by the Secrecy Agreement but had been released to respond  
fully to CBS Representative BRUCE HALL concerning my  
knowledge of events in New Orleans prior to the assassination.  
Later it was stipulated by the Bureau that I could respond  
to any news media inquiry based on the CBS documentary.  
I informed Mr. LONGMUIR that I was restricted from  
discussing any aspect of the Bureau's investigation of  
the assassination in Dallas, Texas.

At approximately 9:30 A.M., Thursday, 4/14/77,  
a Mr. HARRY LONGMUIR, a Reporter for the National Inquirer,  
formerly with the Daily Mail, Northcliffe House, London  
E.C.4 England, called in person at the El Paso Division  
and spoke to me.

Mr. LONGMUIR did not possess any specific  
credentials showing him to be with the National Inquirer  
but he did show his credentials with the Daily Mail.  
He said he only recently had gone to work with the National  
Inquirer. He gave me the name of WILLIAM DICK, Editor,  
of the National Inquirer, Lantana, Florida, 00463,  
telephone number (305) 586-1111, and suggested that I  
may wish to speak with Mr. DICK to verify his present  
status with the National Inquirer as a Reporter. I told  
him I didn't think that it was necessary and that I would  
wait on his questions to make a determination whether I  
would respond or seek further verification of his status  
as a Reporter.

Mr. LONGMUIR indicated that someone by the name  
of ORESTES PENA in New Orleans had some time ago indicated  
that he had seen me in the presence of LEE HARVEY OSWALD  
prior to the assassination. I explained to Mr. LONGMUIR  
that I had been released from the Secrecy Act for an  
interview by a CBS Reporter in late 1975. I had been  
advised that I could respond to any other press inquiry  
having to do with questions asked and answers given by  
me in that CBS documentary. For that reason, I would be  
limited in my responses. Mr. LONGMUIR referred to the  
CBS documentary and inquired had not that question come  
up in the CBS documentary, speaking of the statement made  
by Mr. PENA. I advised him that the question had arisen  
and that I had categorically denied ever having known LEE

HARVEY OSWALD personally or ever having knowingly seen him or knowingly have talked to him.

I explained that after viewing the CBS documentary on the Assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY, I had been left with the distinct impression that anyone viewing that documentary conceivably could have been disposed to believe that possibly I had known OSWALD and that possibly OSWALD had been my informant. I explained to Mr. LONGMUIR that because of that conjecture on my part, I had in late 1975 or early in January, 1976, requested my Headquarters (FBI) to obtain permission from the Church Committee for me to testify under oath before that Committee that I did not know OSWALD personally and had never knowingly met or spoken to him. I mentioned that I did in effect appear before the staff of the Church Committee and responded to questions by the staff and by Senator RICHARD S. SCHWEIKER for approximately 3½ hours. I mentioned that I believed that the questioning took place in late January, 1976. I specifically commented that sometime after the questions had commenced, I estimate after a half hour or 45 minutes of questioning, I asked that I be permitted to state under oath that I did not personally know OSWALD, that I had never knowingly spoken to him, or knowingly seen him in person. I also advised Mr. LONGMUIR that I made the suggestion to Senator SCHWEIKER and to the staff of the Church Committee that they may want to consider giving Mr. PENA the opportunity to make his comments under oath to the effect that he had seen me in the presence of OSWALD prior to the assassination. I explained also that the rest of the responses which I freely gave under oath to the staff of the Church Committee had to do with other matters about which I was not free to make comment. I also explained to Mr. LONGMUIR that my release from the Secrecy Act given me by the former Attorney General of the United States was limited to responses to questions concerning any aspect of the OSWALD investigation in the New Orleans area. I was not given any release to discuss any aspects of the FBI investigation in the Dallas area. Accordingly, I told him I would decline to answer any such questions. I did state, however, that I would be most happy to give candid responses to any questions where given permission by the Attorney General of the United States. I stated that I had nothing to hide and that I thought that some of my comments perhaps could clarify some areas previously considered cloudy based on false rumors and irresponsible statements made by various people verbally or in the many books that may have been written on the assassination.

Mr. LONGMUIR asked me about OSWALD's arrest in New Orleans when he was a resident prior to the assassination. I explained to Mr. LONGMUIR that based solely on memory after the passage of almost 14 years, I was able to recall that OSWALD was arrested on Canal Street in New Orleans

because of some altercation he had gotten into with some anti-Castro Cuban or Cubans. I also recall that he had given out some pamphlets for the Fair Play for Cuba Committee in New Orleans, as best I could recall, about almost the same time that he was arrested for his altercation on Canal Street. Mr. LONGMUIR mentioned that he wasn't quite certain but believed that OSWALD had been interviewed by an FBI Agent in the local jail after his arrest in New Orleans for the aforementioned altercation. I told Mr. LONGMUIR that I was not the Agent who interviewed OSWALD. Mr. LONGMUIR brought up the comments that there was an allegation that OSWALD had asked to talk to an FBI Agent. I responded something to the effect that it was not unusual for persons arrested on local charges to ask to speak to an FBI Agent if some Federal aspect was involved. I did not recall specifically on what basis OSWALD may have asked to speak to an FBI Agent. I explained to him that while I cannot be certain that I received the results of such an interview of OSWALD in the First District New Orleans Police Jail, I am almost certain that anything he said at that time would have been channelized to the Fair Play for Cuba Committee case that I was investigating as OSWALD, to my knowledge, at that time was trying to form a chapter of the FPCC. In essence, I indicated that I didn't think it necessarily unusual for OSWALD to have spoken to an FBI Agent while in jail on local charges. I was unable to recall whether the Agent who spoke to him was at that time assigned to liaison with the First District Police Station and would logically have been the one to interview OSWALD or whether possibly the Agent who did interview him simply happened to be in the New Orleans Office when the First District Police Station called for an Agent to possibly interview OSWALD. In any event, I did not feel that such an interview would necessarily be unusual or significant.

I also mentioned that I recalled that I made a determination that OSWALD was the only member of the New Orleans Chapter of the FPCC. I did indicate that I recalled that on some of the pamphlets or material of the FPCC there was a name of HIDEEL. Subsequent investigation by me caused me to conclude that HIDEEL was not a real person. I mentioned that I recalled that OSWALD's widow, MARINA, had indicated that to be the case and that OSWALD had used the name HIDEEL, a fiction, because he thought it rhymed with FIDEL, the first name of FIDEL CASTRO.

All of the above questions were posed by Mr. LONGMUIR in the light of what may have been said by me in the CBS documentary. I told him that if he wanted to ask more extensive questions that he would have to first get approval through my Headquarters of the Attorney General.

I did indicate my complete willingness to openly answer any questions that he or any other reporter may have to pose. However, I reiterated my limitations were that I could only respond to questions designed to clarify CBS' inquiry of me in November, 1975, as well as my responses thereto in November, 1975. Questions posed by LONGMUIR had to do either with answers given by me to CBS interviewer in November, 1975, or whether such questions were posed to me at that time and what my answers were.

[redacted] further stated that her ex-husband, [redacted] admitted [redacted] as being in San Antonio, Texas, at the time of the assassination, but never made any mention of an acquaintance with LEE HARVEY OSWALD or JACK RUBY. [redacted] then stated that her husband always spoke disparagingly against JOHN F. KENNEDY and many times stated "JFK, he got what he deserved."

[redacted] described her ex-husband as a pathological liar and an alcoholic, an extremely unstable person, who is an extreme right winger, and who also spoke very highly of the KKK, but never openly admitted to being a member of the Klan.

[redacted] stated that her ex-husband had no friends so to speak of and could not provide any names which might be helpful in this matter.

[redacted] further stated that her ex-husband lived in [redacted] at the time of the assassination, and was married to a [redacted]. She also stated that her ex-husband admitted to her of having intelligence background but would not say anything more about. He also admitted [redacted] of making numerous hunting trips to a Mexican town about 100 miles southwest of Del Rio, Texas, but would not divulge anymore information concerning it; but she implied that it is possible that they were connected with his intelligence background.

[redacted] stated her last known contact was in [redacted]

[redacted] stated that her ex-husband's family still lives in [redacted] but doubts sincerely that they would know his whereabouts because he openly admitted to her that he hated his family and has never spoken to them in recent years.

Nothing in any of this material gave any indication of contacts or connections with LEE HARVEY OSWALD or the HUNT family.

On 2/16/77, Mrs. BETTY DOUTHIT, 631 South Inman Road, West Covina, California, advised that in 1964 and 1965 her former deceased husband, ROBERT KENNETH YOUNG, was manager of the Club Vegas, 3508 Oak Lawn Avenue, Dallas, Texas. At the time they found various business records and what appeared to be personal address books belonging to JACK RUBY the former owner of the Club Vegas. DOUTHIT further advised that she recently read an article in a collector's magazine in which a signature of LEE HARVEY OSWALD was being offered for sale for \$2,000.00. She further advised that she planned to offer for sale the various signatures on records she had found at the Club Vegas. She stated that prior to offering these records for sale she wanted the FBI to review them so that she would not later be accused of withholding or destroying evidence. She advised she and her husband left the Dallas area in June of 1967, when he was transferred to the Santa Fe Springs office of the Mobile Oil Company where he was employed as a Geophysicist. At that time they brought the records with them to the California area and they have been in storage ever since. She advised that while the records were in her possession they were never reviewed by either the Dallas Police Department, the FBI, or any other governmental agency or commission.
