After calming down somewhat, GRUBBS alleged Agents WALSH and HUTCHISON had asked McCURE if GRUBBS' NLEC "advocated the killing of Presidents." When pinned down for specifics re his allegation, GRUBBS could not furnish same and said McCURE may have misinformed him in the matter and if he, GRUBBS, had made an unjustified complaint, he apologized. GRUBBS declined CALLAGHAN's invitation for GRUBBS and McCURE to personally come to the office to discuss the matter.

Bureau was advised by teletype of November 26, 1963, entitled "LEO E. McCLURE; RM," of this office's intention to interview McCLURE. GRUBBS is a notorious racist and segregationist of Louisville, Kentucky, approximately 78 years old and in 1929, was disbarred as an attorney. In the past, when interviews have been had with some people associated with GRUBBS, he has made similar, unfounded accusations as to the type questions asked.

SA's HUTCHISON and WALSH have advised they did not ask McCLURE the question as alleged by GRUBBS, nor did they inject GRUBBS' name into the interview with McCLURE, this having been done by McCLURE and McCLURE having also said that at one time he was an officer in the MLRC, but discontinued association with that organization as GRUBBS gave him nothing to do and then complained because he did nothing.

Above being submitted as a matter of information should GRUBBS decide to pursue his complaint and write the Bureau.

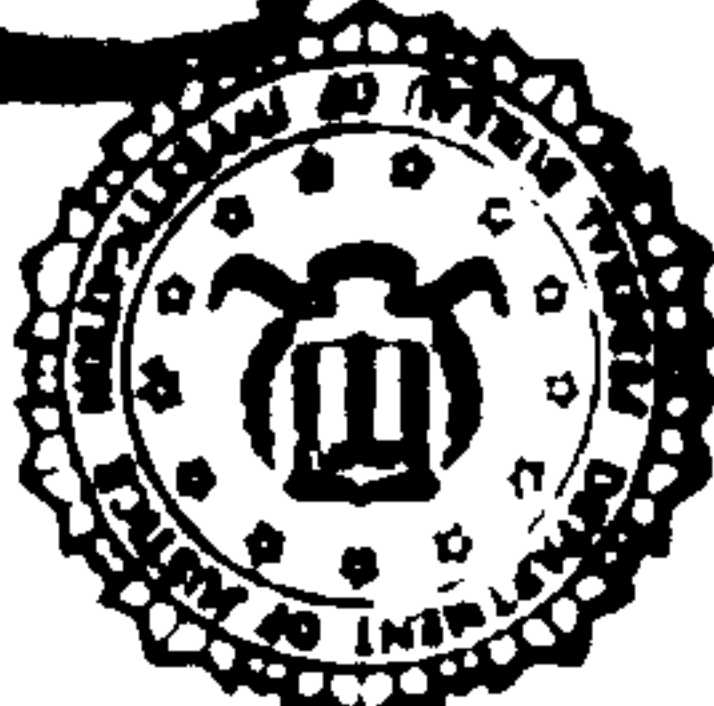

Shanklin advised that New Orleans had checked these papers and it appeared to be an account of various happenings during the period Oswald was residing in New Orleans. It mentions specifically Oswald's arrest in New Orleans and his appearance on a radio station. It also mentions a talk he had given in Mobile, Alabama, at the University's Jesuit House of Studies concerning Oswald's experiences in the USSR. Shanklin advised that while this information is probably fully known to New Orleans and Mobile, Dallas was sending a teletype to interested offices advising of the information. I told him to include in the teletype the fact that any new information should be investigated promptly and the Bureau advised.

SAC Shanklin, Dallas, called today to advise that Captain Fritz of the Dallas Police Department late last night had turned over some handwritten papers of Oswald's which the Dallas Police Department had previously obtained from a search of Oswald's residence and which inadvertently had not been turned over to the Dallas Office previously. SAC Shanklin advised that Captain Fritz had found these apparently in a desk and had turned the papers over on discovery.

Results of examination:

Specimen Q179 is a size "32" tan leather belt manufactured by "Hickok." Such belts are common and distributed and sold through numerous outlets throughout the country. Nothing of significance was noted about Q179.

Specimen Q180 is a brown and tan necktie. No labels were found in Q180 and the manufacturer is not known to the Laboratory.

The Q181 sweater is approximately a size "small" sleeveless lamb's wool sweater. No labels or markings were found in Q181. The manufacturer is unknown to the Laboratory. This sweater exhibits an average amount of wear.

Specimen Q182 is a size "small" new-appearing, olive-colored woolen sweater with white and black stripes. This sweater was manufactured by the Campus Sweater and Sportswear Company, 3955 Euclid, Cleveland, Ohio. Campus brand sweaters are sold through numerous outlets throughout the country.

Specimen Q183 is a blue, gray, black and white knit short-sleeved sport shirt. A label in Q183 indicates it was manufactured in Hong Kong. This same label also bears the name "HADSON SPORTSWEAR" which may be the name of the company distributing such shirts.

Specimen Q184 is a well-worn, red, gray and black shirt or pajama top. Two sheets of purple toilet tissue were found in the pocket of Q184. A small visible marking "55M" appears on the lower front left lining of Q184. This appears to be a manufacturer's marking; however, the significance of it is not known. No labels were found on Q184.

Specimen Q185 is a blue cotton short-sleeved sport shirt manufactured by "Arrow." Arrow brand shirts are distributed and sold nationally. A manufacturer's number, "4591B1WAY BP 588 S1P51631L," is present on the front lower right flap of the tail of Q185. The significance of this number is not known.

The Q186 blue cotton shirt exhibits considerable wear. A label indicates it was manufactured by Sedgewick

None of the fibers previously found on the KI gun could be associated with specimens Q181 through Q187. Specimens Q179 through Q187 are being retained in the laboratory.

Specimens Q180 through Q187 were examined for visible and invisible laundry and dry cleaners markings, but none were found. The Q183 through Q187 shirts all appear to have been laundered recently by hand.

The Q187 white cotton shirt is a size "15 1/2." A label present in the collar indicates this shirt was "STYLED FOR PORTER'S NEW ORLEANS." A manufacturer's marking "BANDO 67 12 152-" appears on the lower right shirttail of Q187.

Men's and Boys' Sportswear, Blue Bell, Inc., New York, New York. Specimen Q186 is a size "small."

There is a total lack of precise definition of the conditions or situations under which President Kennedy could enforce the above 10 executive orders. He could proclaim a state of "national emergency," a term that is not clearly defined. Any situation that the President sees fit could permit him to take over. These laws could be implemented if our country were to be attacked either by "overt or covert" methods, or seemingly, if we were to enter a period of economic crisis or a "civil rights" crisis.

These powers, vested in the President, could be used at his whim, to give him the authority of a Caesar. Write your Senator and Representative. Ask for the rescinding of these powers. All executive power must come from the consent of the governed, through the Congress.

From the mouth of one of the neo-Nazi leaders in the U.S.: "We are not in any way affiliated with the John Birch Society or the Minute Men, although at times our purposes bring us together. They are allies. They would like to be Nazis but don't have the guts."
WIND reporter Red Mellow, new to the staff, elicited this statement and a few others equally pregnant in interviewing Chicago members of the American Nazi Party. He noted too, in describing the interior of their meeting hall on Damen Ave., the irony of a picture of Hitler juxtaposed with one of George Washington and the American flag holding equal rank with the swastika banner at the top.

The American Nazi Party is a messy subject, and obviously a sensational one, for an electronic news feature; and while Mellow and scripter-news director Frank Goetz left many questions unanswered they more than scratched the surface in distilling the philosophical motives, the objectives, the methods and the scope of the neo-Nazi movement, not only in the Windy City but in the U.S. and Europe as well.
Several of the interviewees coldly stated that they joined "to protect the rights of the white man" and insisted that they were a political party rather than a military organization. The report made note that the "party" could get on the ballot (they expect to take over by 1972) if it met the requirements of a given state and that it could not be considered subversive, technically, unless it were an agent of a foreign power or advocated the forcible overthrow of the government.
The far-out neo-Nazi precepts and platform might have been funny if they weren't terrifying. Goetz's script warned that the platform was fantastic in Germany, too, and that the existence of the new Nazis in the U.S. is something to be pondered since it is active and growing. The program con-demned as often as it informed, and Goetz was perhaps overly careful lest his audio documentary benefit George Lincoln Rockwell & Co. in any way as publicity. Along with the running denunciations of the movement, there was a thrice-expressed station argument for giving air time to the subject, namely, "the placers be-let that in knowing about it."
