"We have been requested to secure copies of the following documents of LEE HARVEY OSWALD for the purpose of Social Security claims on behalf of his widow and children:

"It is our understanding that these papers were removed from OSWALD's residence by Dallas Police and turned over to the FBI for review."

Pages 22336-22337. Congressman Cunningham, (R) Nebraska, extended his remarks concerning the assassination of President Kennedy. He pointed out that "There is also much concern over the fact that it is not a Federal crime to assault or kill the President or Vice President, yet it is a Federal crime to kill an FBI agent or Federal marshal, U. S. judge or U. S. attorney,

Secret Service agent, or certain employees of the Interior and Agriculture Departments. Many feel that the same provision should be extended to an assault on or assassination of a President or Vice President."


