On 12/9/63, [redacted] Farwell, Texas, advised that a short time back he had been in the WJ Auction, Clovis, New Mexico, and that Old Man PRIEST, who runs the auction, said to him, "How did you all get out?" [redacted] stated he felt that PRIEST was referring to how he got out of Texas, after the shooting of the President. [redacted] stated that he did not take kindly to that remark and that he was terribly upset over the death of the President. [redacted] further stated that a friend of his told him that he overheard PRIEST say that a cousin of PRIEST's had mentioned that the President would be killed if he came to Texas. [redacted] stated that his friend overheard this remark about two weeks ago.

[redacted] advised that he did not want to become involved in this matter and did not want anyone to know that he had mentioned PRIEST making this remark. He also did not desire to have his friend become involved since his friend was very ill with a heart condition and contact with him may cause another heart attack.

It is noted that with much reluctance [redacted] identified his friend who overheard PRIEST make this statement as [redacted] who resides east of Bovina, Texas.

[redacted] stated that he has been thinking about the statement made by PRIEST for quite some time and finally discussed the matter with [redacted] his attorney. [redacted] reiterated that he desired his identity and the identity of [redacted] to be concealed.

Approximately three to four months prior to the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY, W. A. PRIEST, Clovis, New Mexico, was talking with his cousin, DALLAS VAUGHN, O'Donnell, Texas, at a cattle sale barn in Lubbock, Texas. PRIEST was "bulling" VAUGHN concerning the KENNEDY - JOHNSON Administration, and asked VAUGHN how Texas took to KENNEDY. VAUGHN replied something to the effect that "Piddle Paddle, I believe they'd get killed if they came to Texas now". PRIEST advised that this was merely an offhand remark expressing dislike for Administration practices and that VAUGHN meant nothing by this remark. PRIEST stated that since President KENNEDY's assassination he had repeated this statement. PRIEST stated that VAUGHN had no idea President KENNEDY would be assassinated and is sure he feels badly over President KENNEDY's assassination.

DETAILS:

On December 9, 1963, Mr. W. A. PRIEST, W&J Auction, 108 Pile, Clovis, New Mexico, advised that approximately three to four months before the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY, he was on a walkway of a cattle sale barn in Lubbock, Texas, with his cousin, DALLAS VAUGHN, who is a

big cotton farmer who resides at O'Donnell, Texas. PRIEST stated that they were sitting there just talking and he was "bulling" and "razzing" VAUGHN for being a Democrat and concerning the KENNEDY - JOHNSON Administration. PRIEST stated that he asked VAUGHN how Texas took to the KENNEDY Administration, to which VAUGHN replied something to the effect, "Piddle Paddle, I believe they'd get killed if they came to Texas now". PRIEST advised that this was merely an offhand remark made by VAUGHN and that he did not mean anything by it. He stated that he felt this was VAUGHN's way of expressing the feeling in Texas of dislike for the Administration practices. PRIEST stated that both he and VAUGHN would "have a fit" if they thought that it would have actually happened. PRIEST advised that he had repeated the comment made by VAUGHN several times since the assassination of the President. PRIEST advised that VAUGHN was a very religious man and he is sure that VAUGHN had no idea that the President would be assassinated. He stated that he feels sure that VAUGHN feels very badly over the assassination of the President, as does he. PRIEST advised that this remark was made by VAUGHN and that it was merely to show that he felt the people in Texas were unhappy with the KENNEDY - JOHNSON Administration and that he meant nothing by this remark.

*England*  
At 5:40 P.M. 11/29/63 an individual telephonically contacted the Security Office, U.S. Embassy, London. The man identified himself as HASSAN, residing at 7 Florence Road, N. 4, London. The man said, "we have information that the United Arab Republic was behind President Kennedy's death." When asked who "we" was, he said "Me and my family." The man was asked to come to the Embassy but refused to and said he should be contacted at the address he gave. U



At 5:47 PM 11/29/63 a man, who did not identify himself, telephonically contacted the Security Office, American Embassy, London. He asked the secretary if she was in a position to take some information and then said to her, "Take this down, I haven't time. I am going to go very fast and repeat it only once." He then said, "I just arrived from New York today. Well, it doesn't really matter what my name is, does it?" He then continued, "The people that had RUBY killed (he actually said "Ruby killed" although the secretary assumed he meant "had Ruby to kill") are the same people that directed (some organization or somebody of which the secretary couldn't catch the name) to

Dear Mr. McCray,

Assassination of President Kennedy.

I was deeply shocked by the news of the assassination of the President of the United States and I hope you will not consider it too presumptuous on my part to express my opinion, on the facts so far published in the local English press.

When it was stated that the assassin used a telescopic rifle I had no doubt that it was not a work of a madman but a specially trained executioner. When it was announced that Oswald admitted being a communist and before the further investigation could have taken place he was shot by Rubinstein I have no doubt in my mind that:

1. The assassination was organised by Soviet secret service's department "Smerch", and further

2. That there is a network of such executioners in the U.S.A.

The speed with which the execution of Oswald was carried out has convinced of the Soviet work and also the existence of the network in your country.

I am not an intelligence man but since, as an advocate, I was consulted on the Soviet espionage cases in England I have come to this opinion and I feel it my duty, as a friend of United States to communicate this opinion to you. I only know you in the Embassy this I am writing to you.

This is only an opinion which U.S.A. authorities may take into consideration in their investigation if they so wish.

My wife and son join me in expressing our heartfelt sympathy at so tragic loss of your Great President.

Your Excellency:

Please do not disagree by letter as the work of a crank or (as you Americans say) - nut-case for what I have to say is absolutely true and now, suffering from hindsight, I am grieving to think I ought to have taken some action earlier. But I just could not interpret the dream as I think it was meant to be. But let me explain more fully ...

On the night of the 21st November I went to bed as usual about 11 p.m. but at 1.30 am. I awoke - wide awake so I got up and stood at my window watching the stars and thinking - perhaps rather deep thoughts - then I made myself a cup of tea and went back to bed. I read until 2a.m. and turned out my light and went to sleep only to have one of the most terrible dreams of my life.

In this dream I was looking across the Atlantic and I could see the coast of America very clearly indeed where to my horror a huge ship was foundering - half under the water and half above. I watched in horrified silence as one side appeared in my dream and then suddenly a man appeared from beneath the waves and asked me to look after two wretched and shivering puppets. I refused but he repeated his request and warned me that they must be saved from the men whose names were Valerian and Andy.

I was so upset by this dream that I mentioned it to a friend and said I must be going to get some bad news from America but I could not understand it for I do not know anyone in America, nor have I ever been there (although it has always been an ambition of mine to do so).

You must wonder why I am writing to you now after all the tragic events of the past few days but the fact is that I am still troubled and although I could not interpret the meaning of the dream, I am now wondering whether the two names Valerian and Andy are really children and if so...

Let me assure you Sir, that I am an ordinary housewife, living a very quiet life down in Sussex and that I am not in the habit of having such distressing and troubled dreams. Only once before in my life a similar experience happened when I was living in Spain. I was warned to get out of Spain and on the day I landed in England, the Moors were quarreling over the ground on which I had been standing when I received the warning.

Naturally, my only reason for writing is to ask you to warn the FBI. to seek out any questionable people whose names are Valentin or Andry ( or something like that) and that double precautions are taken to guard the Kennedy children.

Sir, I hope this letter will be treated as secret and not as the raving of some wild person for I am very deeply grieved to think that (if some spiritual power) or in the words of Shakespeare -

"there are more things in Heaven and Earth than are dreamed of"

that I could not have been of assistance or help in saving the life of that most noble and brilliant young man, John Fitzgerald Kennedy. Believe me Sir, I have spent many years over my own impotence.

I hope you will respect my wish and see that no one can make capital or publicity out of this most disturbing experience which I had on the morning of the 22nd. November, 1963...

Synopsis: REGARDING G. M. "MIKE" GOODRICH

JOHN CZUDEK, El Paso, Texas, an acquaintance, advised GOODRICH reportedly retired as Capt. or Sgt. from U.S. Army after 30 years service, claimed to be expert with rifle, well read, brag a great deal, talk incessantly, appears to stretch the truth, leaves the impression of being a little "off" mentally. GOODRICH volunteered information that he had 135 Colonels and 5 Generals in his ancestry, 7 of whom fought in the Battle of Hattin. He criticized LINCOLN B. JOHNSON, HARRY TRUMAN and FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT for putting politics before country and said JOHN F. KENNEDY put country before political considerations, was brilliant, probably ahead of his time, could not be controlled by any group, including the Pope. GOODRICH'S presence in El Paso on November 22, 1963 verified.

## DETAILS

AT EL PASO, TEXAS

Due to the receipt of a complaint from an anonymous individual, the following investigation was conducted to identify a retired Army Sgt., gray hair, medium build, about 65 years of age, who reportedly lives the barber across the street from the

Greyhound Bus Depot in El Paso and patronized two bars across from the Depot. This retired Army Sgt. reportedly roomed in an upstairs hotel on San Francisco Street, 3 blocks from the Greyhound Bus Depot when in El Paso. "must be regarded as highly dangerous if crossed, very fearless", claimed to be an expert on guns and should be considered as "a possible suspect" who may have been "the real perpetrator of this heinous deed", meaning the assassination of JOHN F. KENNEDY.

Date December 5, 1963

Mr. JOHN CZUDEK, Owner and Manager, Depot Military Supply, 205 West San Francisco Street, El Paso, advised as follows:

A retired Master Sgt. by the name of MIKE GOODRICH has patronized a number of the business establishments in the neighborhood for about the past 6 years. Mr. CZUDEK has known GOODRICH during this period of time. Mr. CZUDEK's business establishment is located directly across the street from the Greyhound Bus Depot in El Paso and next door to a barber shop. GOODRICH is quite well acquainted with the barber in the barber shop and has been a constant visitor of Mr. CZUDEK's business establishment for the past few years. GOODRICH is known to the people in the neighborhood as "Sarge". He served for a period of time at Fort Bliss in El Paso, Texas, went overseas for a period of time and then returned to El Paso. GOODRICH has been retired from the Army for a period of about 3 or 4 years. GOODRICH appears to be a man of about 60 to 65 years of age and reportedly served for a period of 30 years in the United States Army prior to his discharge.

GOODRICH has been separated from his wife for a period of time and his wife presently resides in San Antonio, Texas. GOODRICH resided in San Antonio at one time with his wife. It is believed that someone is the guardian for GOODRICH's money at the present time. Based on the conversations that Mr. CZUDEK has had with GOODRICH, he has formed the opinion that GOODRICH is a little "off" mentally.

GOODRICH is a very well read man and reads good books. GOODRICH likes to hear himself talk and goes on and on in his conversations with Mr. CZUDEK, talking about any and all subjects. GOODRICH likes to leave the impression that he has knowledge regarding a wide variety of subjects. He was connected with the Medical Corps during the time that he was in the United States Army and he can talk for hours about matters in the field of medicine.

GOODRICH has also indicated that he was an expert with a rifle when he was in the United States Army. Mr. CZUDEK has not seen GOODRICH with any guns and GOODRICH is not known to have any guns in his possession in El Paso.

GOODRICH does a great deal of bragging. He also drinks considerably but has never been seen drunk and goes home prior to getting drunk. He frequents the neighborhood and has done so for a number of years.

In talking about a variety of subjects it has become apparent that GOODRICH has the tendency to stretch the truth. During his visits with Mr. CZUDEK he has talked incessantly but has never said anything to indicate that he was other than a good citizen. Mr. CZUDEK did not believe that GOODRICH was the kind of person who would get involved in the assassination of the President. GOODRICH has an apparent short temper but Mr. CZUDEK did not believe that GOODRICH would do anything to harm anyone else.

GOODRICH used to live in the Southern Hotel located about 3 blocks west of the Greyhound Bus Depot in El Paso. He moved from that address several months ago and his present place of residence is not known. GOODRICH currently resides with a retired railroad man by the name of MIKE.

Mr. CZUDEK did not discuss the assassination of President KENNEDY with GOODRICH. He did not know if GOODRICH was in El Paso, Texas on the day of the assassination, although he had seen GOODRICH on an almost daily basis during the past month. In making his rounds, GOODRICH drops into the business establishment of Mr. CZUDEK and enters into long drawn out conversations with him.

Mr. CZUDEK described GOODRICH as follows:

During the course of an interview with Mr. JOHN GZUDEK, 205 West San Francisco Street, regarding MIKE GOODRICH, GOODRICH entered the business establishment of GZUDEK, interrupted the interview, introduced himself as Mr. GOODRICH and then began to talk at a rapid pace regarding a variety of subjects. Among other things, he stated as follows:

He is 71 years of age. His mother was born in Cork, Ireland and his father was born in Scotland. There are 135 Colonels and 5 Generals in his ancestry. Seven of these officers fought in the Battle of Hasting-. He holds at least three degrees, one being in Pharmacology. He is an atheist and has no religion.

Men are born equal but that is as far as it goes. It doesn't make any difference whether a person is white or black. The important thing is how much "gray matter" he has. If a person doesn't have the ability to think, GOODRICH is not interested in them.

He might disagree with a woman completely but would defend a man's right to believe as he sees fit. He would not infringe on any other man's rights and no man had better infringe on his rights.

President LYNDON B. JOHNSON is too much of a politician. JOHNSON, HARRY TRUMAN and FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT put their political party before the country. In spite of some of HARRY TRUMAN's failings, one has to admire him for some of the good things that he did for the country.

JOHN F. KENNEDY was one who put his country before political considerations. He was a brilliant man, possibly ahead of his time. KENNEDY was not one who could be controlled by any group. Not even the Pope could tell KENNEDY what to do. KENNEDY had the welfare of the American people at heart. KENNEDY was a great man.

GOODRICH was neither a Democrat nor a Republican. GOODRICH was very much opposed to political appointments. He was one of the four individuals who succeeded in getting the Office of Veterans Administration moved from El Paso and that this was done to eliminate political considerations as far as the office was concerned.

GOODRICH was retired from the United States Army and the Federal Government had not been sending his pension checks to the correct address. If the Federal Government continues in its sloppy ways, GOODRICH intends to contact four generals that he knows in Washington D.C. and will get the matter straightened out quickly.

GOODRICH is not a member of the JOHN BIRCH Society but is interested in getting political appointees out of office.

Mr. E.G. TRAISTER, Manager, Southern Hotel, 406 $\frac{1}{2}$  West San Francisco Street, El Paso, advised that Mr. G.M. GOODRICH, also known as MIKE and SARGE, has resided at the Southern Hotel on several occasions. He noted that the hotel is on the second floor of a building in which a business establishment is located and that GOODRICH moved to 1021 East Myrtle Street, in El Paso, Texas several months ago because he objected to climbing the stairs to reach the Southern Hotel. Mr. TRAISTER has known GOODRICH for about 5 or 6 years and said that the subject talks continuously and knows something about all subjects, being a self styled expert on all matters. GOODRICH has not been known to make any statements against former President JOHN F. KENNEDY and Mr. TRAISTER had no reason to believe that GOODRICH would have been involved in any way in any action to harm the President.

On December 2, 1963, Miss CORINA GARCIA, El Paso Police Department, El Paso, and on December 2 and December 5, 1963, Mrs. LENA INGRAM, Credit Bureau of El Paso, advised that there is no information contained in their files of their respective offices identifiable with G. M. GOODRICH.

On December 5, 1963, Mrs. MARTA GARCIA, 1020 East Myrtle Street, second floor-rear apartment, advised that MIKE GOODRICH and his friend have resided in the second floor-front apartment at this address for the past several months. She said that MIKE GOODRICH has been at home for at least the past three weeks and has not been known to have been outside of El Paso during that period of time. She said he does not work and spends part of his time at home each day.

GELSTON, Maryland National Guard, who is in charge of the National Guard Troops assigned to Cambridge, Maryland, scene of previous racial disturbances, telephoned the Baltimore Office. General GELSTON advised that Mrs. GLORIA RICHARDSON, integrationist leader in Cambridge, desired a representative of the FBI to contact her residence as she had a gentleman there who had a postcard depicting three grave stones with the names of President KENNEDY, Attorney General KENNEDY and MARTIN LUTHER KING on them, and this gentleman would only be there a few minutes. U.S.A.

ASAC GEORGE W. HALL immediately contacted the RICHARDSON residence in Cambridge, telephone Academy 8-4366, and after identifying himself to Mrs. RICHARDSON, talked to an individual giving his name as R. W. POWELL, Post Office Box 961, Nashville, Tennessee. Md.

Mr. POWELL stated that these cards were found before 11/22/63 but were not turned over to him until after that date, as he was in Birmingham, Alabama, at the time they were found. He stated that he had asked his office to send one of these cards to the FBI in Washington, D.C., and it should have been received by this time from the Nashville Association for the Promotion of Community Services. He stated that Mrs. RICHARDSON had requested him to furnish this information to the FBI while at her home in the event the first card might have been delayed in the mail.

NASHVILLE, TENN.

Mr. POWELL stated that he is currently on a tour but will return to Nashville in about a week. If the first card was not received, he will, upon request, turn the second card over to the FBI.

The following letter dated December 3, 1963 was received at the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Washington, D. C. on December 9, 1963:

"Dear Sir,

"You're doing just what I knew you'd do - blame it on a dead man that can't defend himself. Whoever got the President was a hired killer that I do know for a fact. The one that ordered it done will go scot free as usual. You'r men were probably sent on wild goose chases and came up with no evidence. After reading books on criminology for 15 years I came to the conclusion there is no perfect crime.

"Were Oswald's fingerprints on the gun?

"Don't you think the one that ordered it done is more than guilty?

"I have conclusive evidence and all clues lead to shall we say "a higher up?"

"But if you think I'm going to give you the proof while I'm still living in this town why, you're out of your mind. Amen.

However, representatives of the Harris County, Texas Sheriff's Office, according to Mrs. Donnelly, have prevented these individuals from helping her. She further advised she spends every penny she can on postage stamps in order to write various organizations in Washington, D. C. requesting help which will enable her to get out of Houston, Texas.

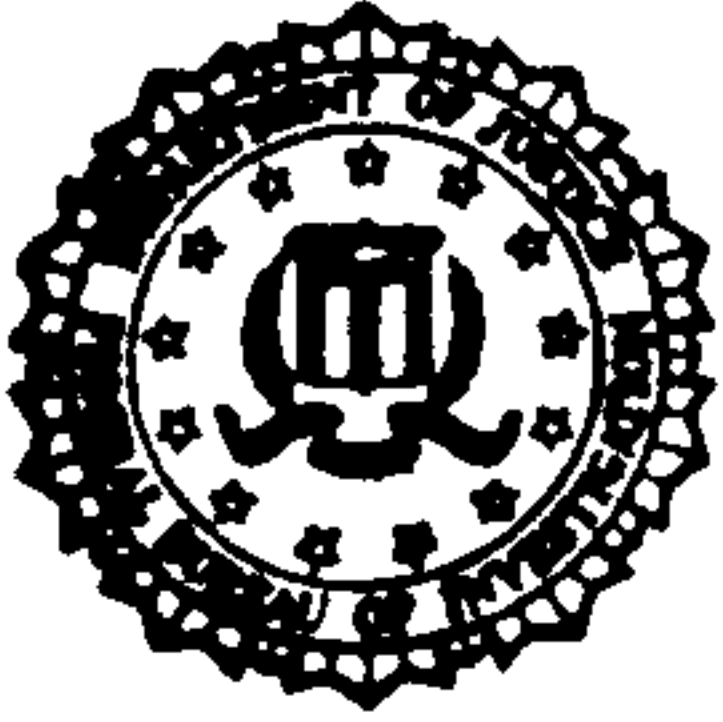

"MINUTEMEN"

A source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, on December 11, 1963 advised that on December 9, 1963, he received from the "Minutemen", [Post Office Box 68, Norborne, Missouri] a one page mimeographed leaflet captioned "KENNEDY ASSASSINATION". The contents of this leaflet are set forth in verbatim as follows:

"Ex-President Kennedy once said, 'right-wing extremists are a greater threat than the communists'. It is too bad that he couldn't have lived long enough to know who it was that shot him.

"Immediately after his death a full propaganda campaign was immediately started to blame his death on these 'right-wing extremists'. Only the quick capture of Lee H. Oswald, a 24 year old communist, put a temporary halt to this campaign. Even so, the news media of this country could hardly restrain themselves in their talk about 'hate groups' and the 'lunatic fringe'.

"Ironically enough, if Attorney General, Robert F. Kennedy had kept current the list of subversive organizations and had vigorously enforced the Smith Act and the McCarran Act to clamp down on the hundreds of communist organizations functioning in the United States the death of his brother may have been averted.

"Prior to the arrival of President Kennedy in Dallas, the city police maintained close surveillance on anti-communist organizations and individuals, but they failed to effectively check Marxist groups and individuals. Had the Dallas police maintained an equally close check of left-wing extremists, the assassination may again have been averted. Two weeks prior to President Kennedy's murder, the FBI questioned Oswald in Dallas. Earlier, the ex-marine

"turncoat was fined for disturbing the peace when he was involved in a melee while distributing communist propaganda for the Fair Play for Cuba Committee.

"That Oswald was a communist is an absolute fact. He was a subscriber to both the 'Worker' and the 'Militant'. He was (contrary to published reports) chairman of the New Orleans Chapter of Fair Play for Cuba. Oswald was in a position to maintain close liaison with the 22 other 'Fair Play' chapters throughout the United States. There is every reason to believe that he had advance knowledge of the President's route of travel and that he came to Dallas for the specific purpose of performing this assassination.

"Now, that Oswald's lips are silenced forever, the campaign to blame this whole thing on the right-wing is rolling once again. Leaders of various conservative movements are being systematically questioned by the FBI regarding their movements before, during and after the time of Kennedy's assassination. The National Coordinator of the Minutemen Organization was quizzed by the FBI in this regard at Norborne, Missouri at 11:00 A.M., November 29, 1963.

"Although the Dallas Police Department stated that the evidence against Oswald was conclusive, others are not willing to let it go so easily. President Johnson has appointed Earl Warren (of all people) to head a 'Board of Inquiry' to re-hash this investigation. It would not surprise us a bit if this Board of Inquiry 'discovers' that Oswald was not actually the assassin, but that he was a right-winger in disguise or something else equally fantastic.

"WHY WAS KENNEDY KILLED? The thing that mystified most American patriots is why the communists would want Kennedy dead. It would require pages and pages to list all of the things which President Kennedy did while in office that directly aided the communist cause.

"There are several possibilities: (1) It is possible that Oswald was simply carried away with his own propaganda. (2) Like Stalin, Beria and others, Kennedy may have simply outlived his usefulness. (3) His assassination could have simply been a by-product of a reported plot to set up a coalition government in Cuba timed to re-assure Kennedy's re-election. (4) It may have been part of the current conflict between the Stalinist and Trotskyite branches of the communist party. The reasoning and evidence behind these possibilities will be dealt with in detail in our January issue of On Target.

"Regardless of the reason for his assassination the results are becoming quickly evident. (1) Congress is being pressured to rush through the Kennedy Program in tribute to the fallen martyr. (2) By far the biggest drive yet to outlaw firearms is quickly going into high gear.

"To help combat this anti-firearm frenzy to some degree we have rushed through a new gun sticker suitable for putting on the back of envelopes or for putting up in public places such as phone booths, etc. 250 labels for \$1.00.

"These gummed labels are one inch high by two and one-half inches wide. They read:

"A gun did NOT  
kill Kennedy--  
A communist did."

"The Worker" is an East Coast Communist publication.

"The Militant" is a newspaper published periodically by the Socialist Workers Party (SWP).

The SWP has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA COMMITTEE

The April 6, 1960, edition of "The New York Times" newspaper contained a full-page advertisement captioned "What Is Really Happening In Cuba," placed by the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FPCC). This advertisement announced the formation of the FPCC in New York City and declared the FPCC intended to promulgate "the truth about revolutionary Cuba" to neutralize the distorted American press.

"The New York Times" edition of January 11, 1961, reported that at a hearing conducted before the United States Senate Internal Security Subcommittee on January 10, 1961, Dr. CHARLES A. SANTOS-BUCH identified himself and ROBERT TABER as organizers of the FPCC. He also testified he and TABER obtained funds from the Cuban Government which were applied toward the cost of the afore-mentioned advertisement.

On May 16, 1963, a source advised that during the first two years of the FPCC's existence there was a struggle between Communist Party (CP) and Socialist Workers Party (SWP) elements to exert their power within the FPCC and thereby influence FPCC policy. However, during the past year this source observed there has been a successful effort by FPCC leadership to minimize the role of these and other organizations in the FPCC so that today their influence is negligible.

On May 20, 1963, a second source advised that the National Headquarters of the FPCC is located in Room 329 at 799 Broadway, New York City. According to this source, the position of National Office Director was created in the Fall of 1962 and was filled by VINCENT "TED" LEE, who now formulates FPCC policy. This source observed LEE has followed a course of entertaining and accepting the cooperation of many other organizations including the CP and the SWP when he has felt it would be to his personal benefit as well as the FPCC's. However, LEE has indicated to this source he has no intention of permitting FPCC policy to be determined by any other organization. LEE feels the

FPCC should advocate resumption of diplomatic relations between Cuba and the United States and support the right of Cubans to manage their revolution without interference from other nations, but not support the Cuban revolution per se.

The CP and the SWP have been designated pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

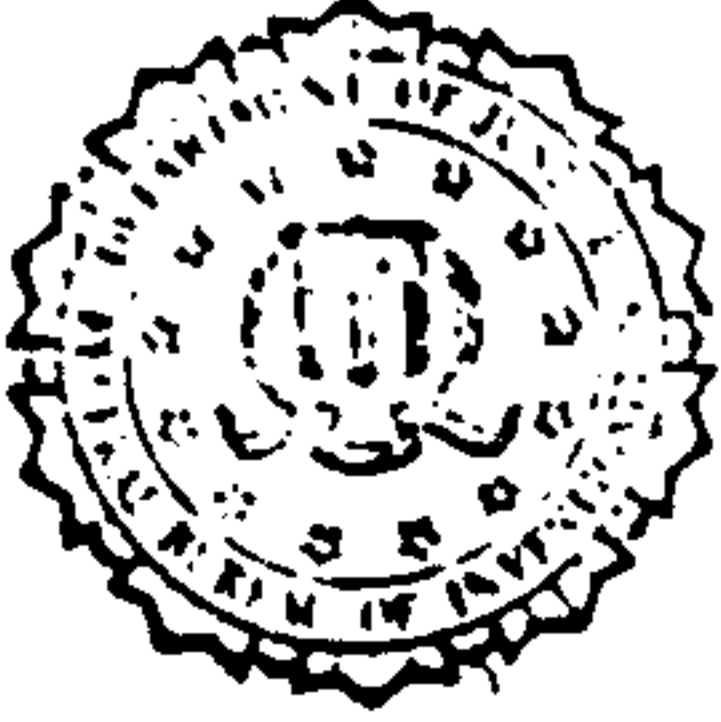

On November 26, 1963, Dr. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Kentucky,  
telephonically advised Special Agent George W. Hutchison  
that he wished to report for whatever it was worth the fol-  
lowing:

A patient of his, Leo McClure, white, 54, a  
painter, residence 4027 Taylor Boulevard, Louisville, Kentucky,  
on November 5, 1963, Election Day, was "railing against Govern-  
mental authority and loss of freedoms". McClure went on to  
say "we are organizing all over the country and are going  
to pick them off one by one" or "...pick them off a few at a  
time". Hart said McClure complained bitterly about President  
Roosevelt but about no other specific President. He did not  
comment concerning President Kennedy. He urged Doctor [REDACTED]  
to vote Republican in the current election. Dr. [REDACTED] said  
that prior to the assassination of President Kennedy, he  
regarded McClure as merely a harmless crackpot and still had  
no specific reason to believe that McClure had anything  
to do with the assassination of President Kennedy.

On July 1, 1959, a source furnished a copy of  
a letterhead of the Citizens National Law Enforcement  
Committee (CNLEC), 1427 South 6th Street, Louisville,  
Kentucky. This letterhead lists Millard D. Grubbs as  
Chairman of this organization and one Leo McClure of  
Kentucky as a member of the National Committee of the CNLEC.
