Enclosed for Oklahoma City, Dallas and Legal Attache Tokyo is a copy of the afore-mentioned communication bearing Martin's name dated 7-17-64.

Atsuyuki Sassa is a Japanese Police Superintendent who visited FBI Headquarters on 3-5-64, and was afforded a special tour of the Bureau. The article written by Troelstrup in the "U. S. News and World Report" contained numerous inaccuracies and incorrectly implied that Sassa participated in our investigation of the assassination. The article, while quite favorable to the Bureau, was prepared after Troelstrup participated in an informal group discussion in Japanese attended by Sassa and other Japanese police officers. The Bureau has received signed statements in which Troelstrup admits there were errors in his article and that he was wrong in saying that Sassa was assigned to our investigation. The President's Commission has been furnished details of this matter.

NOTE: This is the 21st letter to the Commission on Martin. SAC Letter 64-23B dated 4-28-64, alerted the field to her continuing campaign of vilification of the Director and the FBI.

In Martin's most recent letter, which was directed to Mr. Sassa and a copy furnished to the Bureau, Martin comments on the article appearing in the magazine and starts out with "I am sorry you don't understand the questions raised concerning the investigation of the assassination..." Martin endeavors to show where her "superior" understanding negates Sassa's opinions on the time it took to fire the assassination weapon and other matters. She concludes by stating that Sassa should not put too much faith in the FBI.

There are other points, other issues, in this case too detailed for examination here. Once the Warren report is in, they will be attended. In the meantime, we suggest you not put too much faith in the American FBI. The FBI has manipulated evidence and intimidated witnesses before (unfortunately, we have proof in this regard), and, unless stopped, it will do it again.

Enclosed for Cleveland and Dallas are copies of a letter received from Edw. W. Tweddell dated 7/15/64, which is self-explanatory.

You are instructed to promptly contact Tweddell, acknowledge receipt of his letter to the Director and specifically interview him concerning his statement that he knows there is more than one person involved in the assassination.

You should not endeavor to answer the other provocative questions raised by Tweddell, however, you should insure that he is advised this matter has received intensive investigation by the FBI and that the results are furnished to the President's Commission inquiring into the facts of the assassination.

No information identifiable with Tweddell could be located in Bureau files.

The results of interview and any other necessary investigation should be incorporated in appropriate inserts for transmittal to Dallas the office of origin. Furnish one copy of results to the Bureau and 25 copies of inserts to Dallas.

Handle promptly as President's Commission may terminate inquiry at early date.

It appears Tweddell wrote this letter impulsively after reading an article on the assassination in a local Akron, Ohio, newspaper. It is very doubtful he has any information of value, however, in view of his statement it is felt we have the responsibility to interview him in line with interviews conducted in similar matters. The results of this investigation will be appropriately reported by Dallas and furnished to the President's Commission.

ReBairtel and enclosed letterhead memorandum dated 7-17-64, relating to [redacted]

Review of Baltimore's letterhead memorandum reveals numerous inaccuracies relating primarily to punctuation and possible typographical errors.

It was noted that communications allegedly written by [redacted] and incorporated in the letterhead memorandum were not appropriately quoted as required. Further, quotations within the quoted communication were improperly set out. In addition to this general observation, the following possible errors were noted:

Baltimore is instructed to thoroughly review the letterhead memorandum and inserts furnished to Dallas to resolve the questions raised above. You are reminded in quoting communications from outside sources, it is permissible to use quotation marks prior to each paragraph and incorporate any and all errors made by the outside source without correction. However, since none of the communications set out in your letterhead memorandum were appropriately quoted, the Bureau has no way of knowing whether the errors were made by [REDACTED] or by your office.

This matter must be immediately handled and any necessary corrections should be immediately furnished to Dallas and the Bureau. It will not be necessary for Baltimore to submit an additional letterhead memorandum, as this matter will be appropriately reported by the Dallas Office inasmuch as inserts have been furnished to Dallas.

Baltimore is reminded that when submitting inserts to Dallas in this particular investigation, it is not necessary to also submit a letterhead memorandum unless the nature of the particular situation warrants or might

require immediate dissemination by the Bureau to the President's Commission or other Federal agencies. In this particular case it was not necessary to submit a letterhead memorandum to the Bureau. A copy of the inserts furnished to Dallas would have sufficed.

Baltimore must insure that when submitting communications to the Bureau, that extreme care is taken in their preparation. Baltimore will be held strictly accountable for the accuracy of the inserts subsequently reported by Dallas in this matter.

For your assistance, no information identifiable with [REDACTED] could be located in Bureau files.

NOTE:

ReBAairtel furnished the Bureau with a 15 page letterhead memorandum relating to communications sent by [REDACTED] to the Governor of Texas. The letters make some mention of the hate [REDACTED] has for President Kennedy and the assassination, but it is obviously the work of an emotionally unstable individual. Baltimore's investigation has established that [REDACTED] currently works for the National Institutes of Health at Bethesda, Maryland, but is being discharged from her employment in view of a medical disability which has existed for approximately two years and probably related to her emotional instability. Since Dallas has been furnished inserts, there is no need for the letterhead memorandum and when the corrections are made, Dallas will be advised and it will be subsequently reported and furnished to the President's Commission and any other interested Federal agencies in line with similar situations.

Dear Governor Connolly:

I sincerely am not just an emotional grandmother of fifty-three years, I have been listening to a radio program from New York this evening. It comes over WNBC, 630 on dial begins at 7:45 P. M. Monday thru Friday and runs thru 12:00 midnight. It is the Brad Crandall program people call in to him and they talk about any and everything, but it is usually centered on the states of the South.

My fear for the people of the South and all America is not unfounded. One man called in on this program tonight and even suggested getting a crowd together and going down to Mississippi and this would be the spark that would set off the revolution that JOHN KENNEDY, JOHNSON, the Roman Catholics (hierarchy), the pope, and the Communists have planned since 1960.

Kennedy and Johnson have been disarming our country, bankrupting, giving our tax money to Roman Catholic-Communists countries to build up their war arms, using our tax money by the millions to set up so-called Peace Corps that are nothing more than gangsters and murders trained on honest American money and sent out all over the world to murder and start the wars and now they have come up with the obnoxious Poverty Bill to set-up Hitler Youth Camps and train our innocent youth as hardended killers and prostitutes.

They carried out a well planned scheme and slandered Dallas, Texas to begin with about six months ago. JOHN KENNEDY is no more dead than I am. I haven't read that any one admitted seeing the corps.

"The following has been copied from 'MY DELIVERANCE FROM THE HERESIES OF ROME' by Harry Hampel, former Roman Catholic, Chapter XV, page 97.

'It was the Pope Pius XII and the strong Italian vote that put Mussolini in final control of Italy, and from the very beginning the pope demanded and received many favors from him. One of Mussolini's first acts was to rescue the financial standing of the Vatican by saving from bankruptcy the Banco di Roma in which most of the Vatican's funds were invested. When the Lateran Pact was signed, Mussolini paid the Pope 750,000,000 liras in cash and one billion liras in Fascist State bonds.

'NO further elaboration is necessary to see that it was not until Hitler's Third Reich and Mussolini's Fascist party had both secured the blessings of the pope that they began their long bloody march against Europe and Africa.'

her that she is attempting to obtain medical retirement because of this illness. Mrs. [redacted] said that she has heard Mrs. [redacted] name the physician who is attending her; however, Mrs. [redacted] could not recall this name.

On July 16, 1964, [redacted], Staff Accountant, Accounting and Auditing Section, National Institutes of Health (NIH), Bethesda, Maryland, advised that he is the immediate supervisor of Mrs. [redacted] of [redacted], Rockville, Maryland. Mr. [redacted] said that according to his records, Mrs. [redacted] has been employed at NIH as a payroll clerk since January, 1957. He said that he is aware she had prior government service; however, the time served and exact nature of her former employment is not reflected in records immediately available to him.

Mr. [redacted] stated that during the past two years, Mrs. [redacted] has been on extended sick leave and leave without pay, after she used all of her accrued sick leave. He said that she has been on leave without pay since April, 1964, and will shortly be retired because of medical disability. He stated he has not had an opportunity to review medical records pertaining to the exact nature of Mrs. [redacted] medical disability and that he probably will not be permitted to review these records. However, he is aware that her disability appears to be a definite emotional problem. He commented that about two years ago he began to notice that she appeared to be displeased with many things that occurred in her particular area of work and constantly complained to him and other of her superiors, indicating that she believed she was being discriminated against because of her religious convictions. He said he is also aware that Mrs. [redacted] has written many letters to various political figures throughout the United States charging that a religious order is attempting to undermine the Government of the United States in an effort to eventually take over the control of the United States Government.

Mr. [redacted] said that he has seen Mrs. [redacted] read a number of books, which, from casual perusal by him, indicate the authors of these books are castigating a particular religious sect.

Last week the Director approved alerting the SAC at Dallas to a visit by American Bar Association (ABA) President Walter E. Craig, and an associate, Charles Murray, who desired to look over the assassination scene and conduct certain other inquiries in connection with Craig's responsibility for collaborating with the Warren Commission in its inquiry into the assassination of President Kennedy. Craig had requested permission to be in contact with our Dallas Office to facilitate the completion of his business in Dallas.

SAC Shanklin reported that Craig and Murray were met on their arrival at Dallas the evening of 7-15-64. They were extended courtesies and on the following two days assistance was provided them in locating and visiting the various points and individuals in connection with their inquiry. SAC Shanklin stated that no problem whatever arose; there was no involvement of the Bureau in Craig's inquiries. To the contrary, Craig was extremely profuse in his gratitude to the Director for the assistance extended during the Dallas visit, and he was quite complimentary concerning the FBI. Craig stated that he expected to be in Mexico City in connection with the International Bar Conference scheduled there 7/25 - 31/64, and, incidental to that, he hopes to check an item or two in connection with the Mexico angle of the Oswald case. Mexico City Legat Clark Anderson has been alerted.

Craig called me from his home in Phoenix this week and personally reiterated his gratitude for the help given him in Dallas and asked that I extend his appreciation to the Director. He said that the assistance of the Dallas Office enabled him to cover everything with efficiency and dispatch and he is not at all concerned with any apprehension as to what the Warren Report might say because he is convinced the Bureau has done its usual outstanding job. He did indicate that if the Warren Report makes any recommendations it will possibly be to make more suggestions as to improving the protection of the President and might want the FBI to assume more responsibilities in this regard. He said he has no specific knowledge that such will be their recommendation and he is only basing this on speculation as a result of some general comments he has heard at the Commission. He indicated that in his best judgment, the Report of the Commission might be anticipated around 8-7-64, but this date is only tentative.

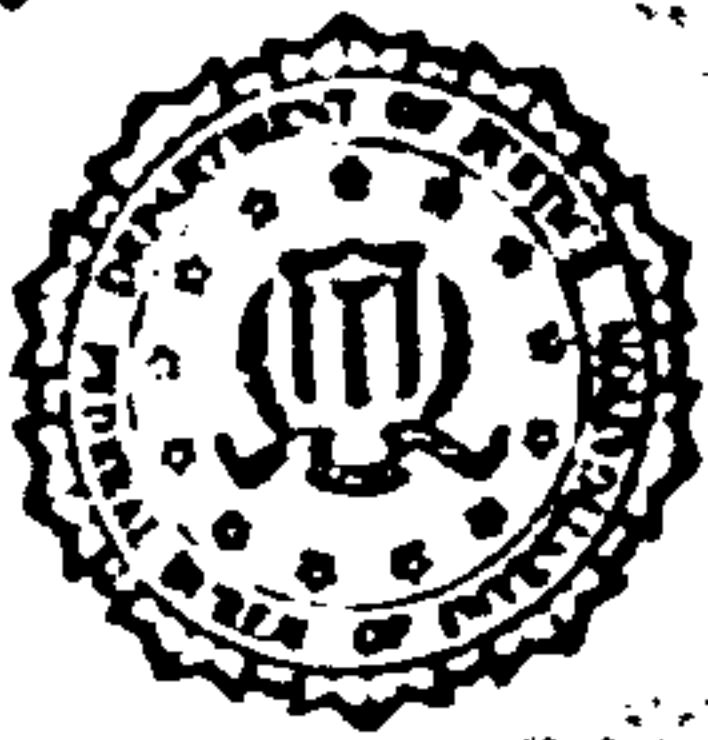

"Mr. Thompson declines to explain to the Commission exactly WHY State Department authorities have ruled that Oswald did NOT renounce his citizenship when it is a matter of historical record that he DID.

"Nor will Abba Schwartz explain to the Commission the rapid clearance (24 hours) given by his department of a passport to a former defector.

"Yet, the reason for the dilemma in which these two career men find themselves is obvious. Mr. Warren is aware of it because he has been privately informed. Other members of the Commission surmise it; while a few others are completely in the dark.

"Honesty from the beginning would have been the best national policy. Now the sadness is becoming unbearable.

Pursuant to referenced telephone request, WALTER E. CRAIG, President of the American Bar Association, and CHARLES MURRAY, Director of the Legal Aid Agency, of the District of Columbia, were met at Love Field, Dallas, Texas, on their arrival, 8:14 P.M., July 15, 1964, by SAC SHANKLIN. They were quartered in the Sheraton-Dallas Hotel through arrangements made by SAC SHANKLIN.

On July 16, 1964, per Mr. CRAIG's request, he and Mr. MURRAY were taken over the Presidential Motorcade route from Love Field, Dallas, up to Parkland Hospital; over the route used by LEE HARVEY OSWALD from the Texas

School Book Depository building to the Texas Theatre following the shooting of President KENNEDY; over the route used by LEE HARVEY OSWALD on the morning of November 22, 1963, from the residence of RUTH PAINE, 2515 West 5th Street, Irving, Texas, to the Texas School Book Depository building; and, over the route believed to have been used by LEE HARVEY OSWALD from the sixth floor of the Texas School Book Depository building to the front exit of the building via the second floor lunch room.

They also inspected the Texas School Book Depository building sixth floor in the area of the window from which the shots were fired, and where the empty rifle cases were found, the site where the rifle was recovered on the sixth floor, the stairs along the west side of the building down to the second floor, the lunch room, the office area toward the south side of the second floor, and the front steps from the second floor to the first floor.

They also inspected the immediate area along Elm Street in front of and west of the Texas School Book Depository building where the shots hit which killed President JOHN F. KENNEDY, and inspected the approximate locations where these shots were believed to have hit.

They also inspected the emergency entrance and room at Parkland Hospital where the President was taken following the firing of the shots, and examined the corridor near the emergency elevator where the slug was found on a hospital carrier.

They also inspected the interior of the PAINE home at 2515 West 5th, Irving, Texas, including the attached garage, the bedroom where MARINA OSWALD resided, the living room, and the kitchen-den.

They also inspected the area where BUELL WESLEY FRAZIER had parked his car at 2439 West 5th, Irving, Texas, on the morning of November 22, 1963, and the area where he parked it on arriving at work on that same morning.

They also inspected the interior of the Texas Theatre, and the seat in which LEE HARVEY OSWALD was sitting just prior to his apprehension on November 22, 1963, was observed by them.

They also examined the foyer of the Hardy Shoe Store, 213 West Jefferson, where OSWALD was observed just prior to entering the Texas Theatre.

They also looked at Parking Space 17 in the lot behind the Ballew's Texaco Service Station, 401 East Jefferson, where a jacket was found under a car on November 22, 1963.

They also proceeded from the point of the killing of Officer J. D. TIPPIT to the residence address of JACK RUBY, 223 South Ewing, noting the relation between these two locations.

Mr. CRAIG and Mr. MURRAY also observed the location of "The Dallas Morning News" building, where JACK RUBY was reported to be at the time of the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY; the location of the Vegas Club, 3508 Oak Lawn; and, the former location of the Carousel Club, 1312½ Commerce.

On July 16, 1964, during the inspection of the areas indicated, Mr. CRAIG and Mr. MURRAY interviewed Mrs. RUTH PAINE, BUELL WESLEY FRAZIER, ROY S. TRULY, O. V. CAMPBELL and Mrs. ROBERT A. REID, Texas School Book Depository, and O. P. WRIGHT, Parkland Hospital.

On July 17, 1964, Mr. CRAIG and Mr. MURRAY observed the parking lot directly across the street from Western Union where JACK RUBY left his car on the morning of November 24, 1963; the location of Western Union, 2034 Main Street; and, examined the City Hall, third floor area, fourth floor and fifth floor jail areas, basement area, ramp area, and rode the elevator on which LEE HARVEY OSWALD was taken from the third floor to the basement on November 24, 1963, just prior to the time he was shot.

They also examined the living quarters of OSWALD at 621 North Marsalis (October 7 to 14, 1963).

On this same date, Mr. CRAIG and Mr. MURRAY also interviewed MARY BLEDSOE, 621 North Marsalis, who was on the bus which OSWALD boarded in downtown Dallas after the shooting of President JOHN F. KENNEDY; Chief of Police JESSE CURRY, and MARINA OSWALD.

Both Mr. CRAIG and Mr. MURRAY were quite complimentary concerning the Federal Bureau of Investigation and expressed their gratitude to the Director for the assistance given to them by the FBI and Dallas during their visit.

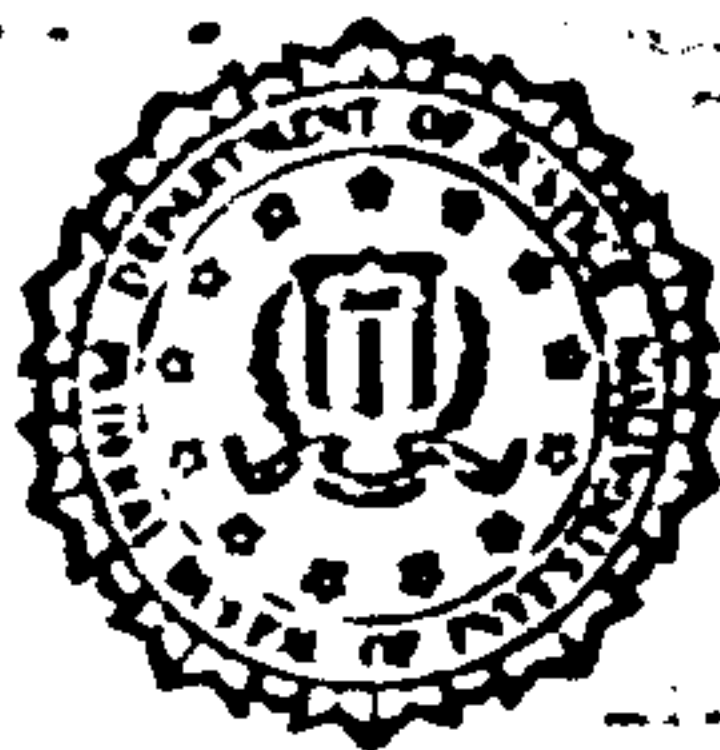

On July 27, 1964, an individual telephonically contacted the Chicago Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and identified herself as a supervisor of the Illinois Bell Telephone Company, Chicago, Illinois. This individual stated that a Mrs. Wernick stated she had some information concerning the assassination of the President; that her 13-year-old child is in danger; and that she is not mentally disturbed. This Telephone Company supervisor stated she had determined Mrs. Wernick's telephone number was CO 7-7344, located at 5005 North Lawndale, Chicago. The telephone is listed to Rabbi Moshe Wernick.

Mrs. Moshe (Goldie I.) Wernick, 5005 North Lawndale, Chicago, Illinois, was interviewed on July 27, 1964. Mrs. Wernick, at the time of this interview, was very upset and appeared to be in a rather confused state inasmuch as she talked very incoherent. Mrs. Wernick stated she was very worried and in fear for her 13-year-old son. She stated that her mother had recently passed away, and she is presently in a state of mourning in connection with this death. Mrs. Wernick stated her husband is Rabbi Moshe Wernick, and that he is aware of what is "happening" to

her son, but he feels that she, Mrs. Wernick, is "insane." Mrs. Wernick stated that she has been in mental institutions in the past and has suffered from mental disorders. She stated, however, she did not consider herself mentally insane, and believes that many people are plotting against her and her son.

Mrs. Wernick stated that Mr. Melvin Goodman, Administrator at the Jewish University of America, Skokie, Illinois, is trying to poison her son by causing employees at the cafeteria where her son attends school to place poison in her son's food. According to Mrs. Wernick, the Jewish University of America is located at 7135 Carpenter, Skokie, Illinois, and Mr. Goodman's home address is 5444 Brummel, Chicago, Illinois.

Mrs. Wernick stated that Mr. Goodman came to the Chicago area from Texas, place unknown, but she felt it must have been Dallas since she believes most of the Jewish people in Texas reside in Dallas. She stated that since Mr. Goodman was from Texas, and since he is involved in efforts to poison her son, she feels that he is possibly connected in some way with the assassination of the President. Mrs. Wernick, when asked her reasons in connection with this allegation, stated that she could comment no further concerning this.

At this point in the interview, Mrs. Wernick became very emotional in her conversation and kept commenting that many people were trying to do away with her and her son. These comments were incoherent.
