

to talk too much and eventually "hanged herself to death" in a Dallas jail cell.

- While Tippit was being killed, Oswald ran into the theater to keep his "meet" with Ruby's man. Instead of an accomplice, Ruby sent the police. It was now time to "frame" Oswald as the "lone and unaided killer." Key members of the Dallas police were assigned to make sure the "frame" fit well.

- Contrary to published reports, Oswald was not "silent" during his interrogation. He immediately revealed that he was an FBI informer and said that agency would vouch for him. For this reason, the transcript of Oswald's interrogation was never made public. In the meantime, Oswald was tried and convicted in the press and on television. For the average American the matter was very quickly closed.

- Ruby, making sure that no further slip-ups would occur, undertook the assassination of Oswald himself. He managed to attend each public appearance Oswald made at the jail on Nov. 22-23. He even made remarks during one news conference.

- By November 24 Oswald's newspaper "conviction" had been accomplished. Ruby and the Dallas police needed to wait no longer. The police set the stage so that Ruby could perform the first televised assassination in history. It was the best possible way to convince Americans that Oswald had not been killed by the police themselves.

- Ruby was tried and found guilty of the murder of Oswald. After a suitable "cooling off" period in which the slothful Americans went back to television escapism and forgot all about the assassination, Ruby was found "insane" in a special "sanity hearing." He was removed from the now notorious Dallas County Jail and taken to a mental hospital where he "escaped." He was never heard of again.

O - A mock court of inquiry headed by a well-meaning liberal jurist gave credence to the "official" story although he knew that much of it was untrue. Earl Warren feared that the revelation of even the fact that Oswald was an FBI informer might destroy the public's confidence in the government of which he was a member.

The situation was particularly crucial since 1964, the year of the inquiry, was also an election year. Warren hoped to set matters straight after Kennedy's vice president had been elected to fill the term the Last Great Consul had needed so badly.

Warren's "calculated gamble" failed. With Kennedy out of the way, the enemies of social reform again had the ear of the Empire.

In November, 1964, less than a year after the Kennedy assassination, a fanatical rightist senator from another Western police state much like Texas was elected president.

Shortly before the election Hoover was legally confirmed as the FBI's lifetime dictator.

The assassination gamble had paid off.

With control of the secret police, the administration and the military firmly in their hands, the rightist patricians set out to destroy the Republic.

Within a short time they succeeded.

Atlanta by airtel 2-2-65 advised

[redacted] Atlanta, furnished information relating to the assassination on 2-1-65, which [he] received from an unidentified ADL employee in Miami, Florida. This employee obtained the data on 1-18-65 during a conversation with Dick Gregory, the rabble-rousing Negro comedian. [redacted] stated the charges made by Gregory were so ridiculous [he] was amazed the ADL employee even considered sending the material to [him]; however, [he] furnished it so the Bureau would be aware of Gregory's activities. [Harris] requested that no one outside the Bureau be advised [he] had furnished this information.

DETAILS

In the letter to [redacted], it was reported Gregory stated that the assassination of President Kennedy was master minded by J. Edgar Hoover and H. L. Hunt. Gregory allegedly tried to substantiate these charges by displaying photostatic copies of affidavits and fallacious and misleading press releases and public statements. The ADL employee noted Gregory did not display any concrete facts to support his charges according to employee.

Gregory claimed the Warren Commission had two reports on the assassination and knew of the Director's and Hunt's participation; however [redacted] did not release the true facts as "chaos" would result. Gregory alleged the Director was one of the plotters due to a falling out with the Kennedys and the former Attorney General had been appointed to "watch over him" and slowly "ease him out" of the FBI. Gregory claimed to have positive proof H. L. Hunt financed the Black Muslims but such proof was "confidential." Gregory also alleges the FBI has him under constant surveillance and will some day in the near future put an end to his life. Further, that prior to the assassination President Johnson was aware of the plot but was powerless to stop it because to do so would admit the FBI and the "Intelligence hierarchy" controlled the country.

Gregory reportedly stated there was a document written regarding the true facts of the assassination and that one man in Miami had been killed for having the document in his possession. Gregory refused to furnish a copy of the document to the ADL employee saying it was too dangerous; however, he did furnish three pages of a document depicting what will be written in the year 2505 A.D. about the assassination, which according to the ADL employee, Gregory reluctantly admitted was written by his wife.

Other remarks allegedly made by Gregory include the statement that Mr. Hunt finances the "Minute Men" and most Agents who leave the FBI are engaged in radical right or extreme conservative movements.

GREGORY'S BACKGROUND

Bureau files indicate Gregory has in the past supported the Black Muslims, injected himself into the racial movement and espoused causes and individuals closely associated with the communist movement (100-440423-16).

ENCLOSED DOCUMENT

The three pages reportedly written by Gregory's wife appear to be part of a larger document as the pages are numbered 72, 73 and 74. These pages contain monstrous fabrications even more absurd than the trash put out by the infamous Mark Lane, reported communist sympathizer, [redacted] and former New York assemblyman. The alleged facts of Oswald's participation and flight are so fantastic it does not seem possible that anyone even with a limited knowledge of the assassination could believe the story.

RECOMMENDATIONS

We have long suspected that Gregory is demented. Nevertheless, the comments he has made are utterly ridiculous and we should confront him and tell him in no uncertain terms that he better stop putting out such gutter talk.

On 1/18/65 Dick Gregory the rabble-rousing Negro comedian made some fantastic allegations about the assassination to an employee of the Anti-Defamation League. He endeavors to substantiate these allegations with fallacious and misleading press releases and public statements. Included among the malicious allegations are statements such as the assassination was plotted by the Director and H.L. Hunt. 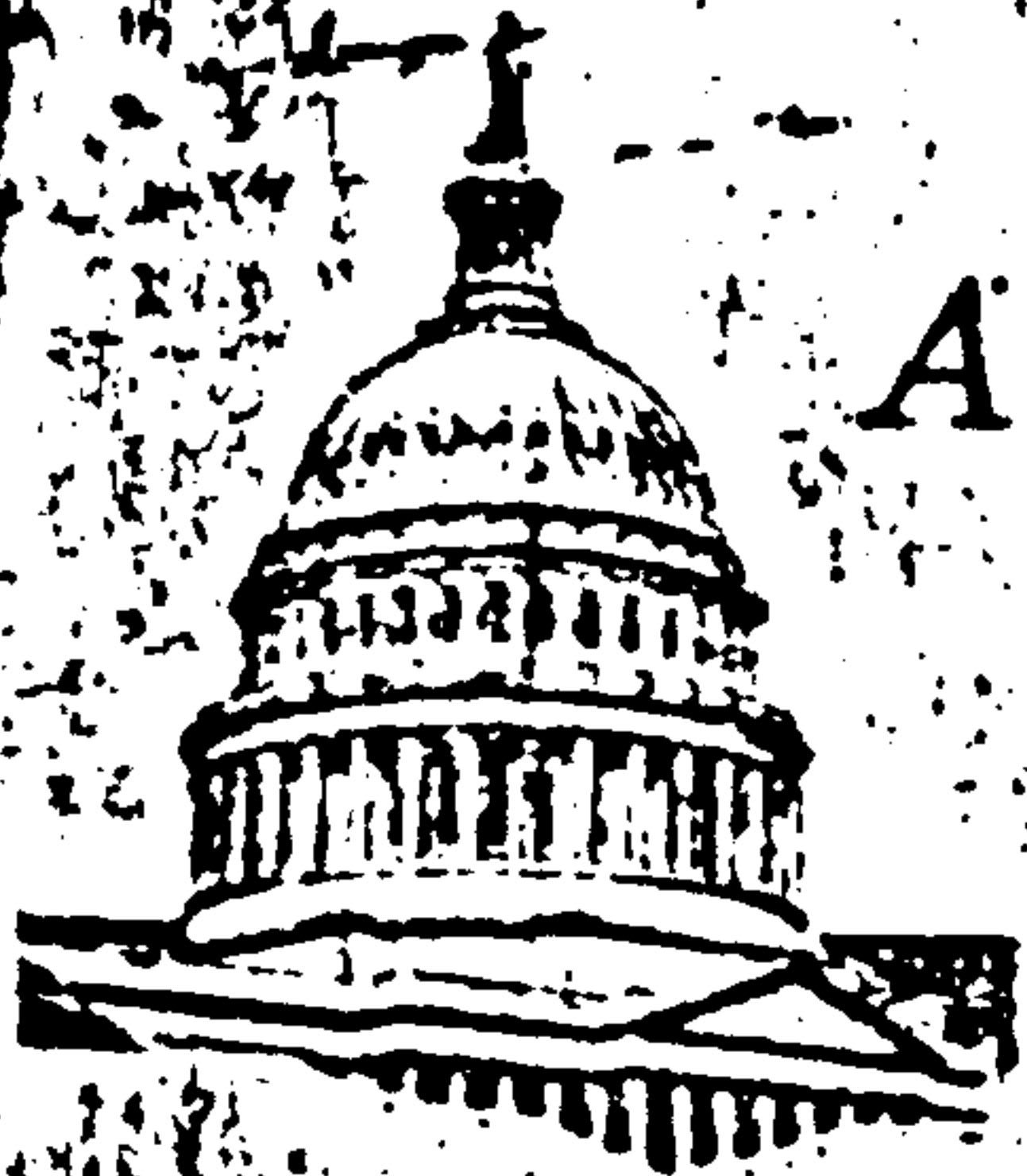

GUARD MOUNT IN THE GOP---Left wingers took over the Republican machinery in the House of Representatives Monday when they mustered enough strength to kick out the Party's colorful leader (Halleck of Indiana) and install the left winger and House of Rockefeller stooge (Ford of Michigan). 1. Will contact officials of the Benjamin Franklin Library to ascertain if LOPEZ GUERRERO did, in fact, work for this Library on 11/22/63.

2. Will locate and interview Attorney LOPEZ MORENO, whose offices are on Morelos Street, and ascertain if LOPEZ GUERRERO is known to him and if LOPEZ GUERRERO was, in fact, in Guadalajara on the date of the President's assassination.

3. Will locate and interview HYMAN SERGIO at 1401 Pedro Moreno, and verify LOPEZ GUERRERO's statement that he worked for him on 11/22/63.

GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO advised that he was physically well and knew what he was saying and understood the questions asked of him. He spoke fluently in both English and Spanish but preferred to speak in English.

He admitted having been drunk the previous day, and while he felt a bit of a hang-over, he again maintained that he was physically well.

LOPEZ GUERRERO advised that he had been arrested for being drunk and assaulting a woman at a local Saltillo hotel. He did not remember the name of the hotel or where it was located. He stated that from 7:00 a.m. on the morning of February 3, 1965, he had consumed a bottle of whisky and two cases of beer, and he could not recall exactly the circumstances of his activities until he found himself in jail that evening.

LOPEZ GUERRERO appeared startled when asked to explain his statements wherein he allegedly had something to do with the death of President KENNEDY and had threatened to kill the Governor of Coahuila. LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that he did not recall making such statements. He denied that he had anything to do with the death of President KENNEDY and said he would most certainly not kill the Governor of Coahuila. He was asked if he knew the Governor of Coahuila, and he replied that he did, but he could not recall his name. He was asked to identify the Governor's photograph from a series of photographs hanging in the office in which he was being interviewed. He selected a photograph of former President of Mexico, ADOLFO LOPEZ MATEOS, and stated the photograph was that of the Governor of Coahuila. He stated that the name, BRAULIO FERNANDEZ AGUIRRE, meant nothing to him, and this is the name of the Governor of Coahuila.

LOPEZ GUERRERO advised that he did not personally know the late President JOHN F. KENNEDY and that he had never actually seen the President. He stated that he held no animosity or hatred for President KENNEDY or any other official of any government. He advised that he did not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD personally. He stated that he knew who OSWALD was from reading the press and knew he was the individual accused of the assassination of President KENNEDY.

LOPEZ GUERRERO viewed a number of photographs, including two of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and without hesitation he

selected a photograph of OSWALD and identified him correctly.

LOPEZ GUERRERO advised that he recalled being in Dallas, Texas, only on two occasions, both times only to change buses. The first time occurred in 1947 and the last early in 1953. He stated he did not stay overnight in Dallas.

LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that he had been to New Orleans on a number of occasions during his tour of duty in the Air Force but then only for short visits. He could not recall any contact with anyone during this time, which was between 1949 and 1951, approximately.

Regarding his location on November 22, 1963, LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that he was in Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, working for the Benjamin Franklin Library and a Mr. HYMAN SERGIO, 1401 Pedro Moreno Street. He stated that he was acquainted with Attorney LOPEZ MORENO, who knew that he was in Guadalajara at that time. LOPEZ MORENO has offices on Morelos Street in Guadalajara. LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that with Mr. SERGIO, he worked with retarded children. He stated the children had mental problems and described their problems as encephalitis. LOPEZ GUERRERO was asked to describe encephalitis and he stated that it was a mental condition, a "brain mass," and insisted that it was not a disease.

LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that he served in the United States Air Force from 1949 to 1952 and repeated his Air Force serial number twice, rapidly, as 5741055.

He advised that he had been given a medical discharge in 1952 from the Air Force, after having spent a number of weeks in the Air Force general hospital at Mobile, Alabama, he did not recall the exact name, where he was recovering from a nervous breakdown. He advised that he receives a pension for this disability amounting to \$250.00 a month. He said the checks are sent to his mother's home at 1104 Victoria Street, Beaumont, Texas, and identified his mother as LOLA PONDOJA.

LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that he had been arrested on a number of occasions for being drunk and fighting but could not recall the dates or places. The only serious crime with

which he was charged was an attempted burglary, which he thought occurred in 1943. He stated, however, that no indictment was returned against him and he was released.

CONFIDENTIAL

LOPEZ GUERRERO upon terminating the interview advised that he held no animosity toward anyone, that he did not think he had enough nerve to kill anyone, and that he did not care for firearms or any other type of weapon. He could not think of what made him make such statements and repeated that he knew nothing about the assassination of President KENNEDY.

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SUMMARY FROM SPANISH

The Mexican Magazine "Politica," Year V, No. 114, January 15, 1965:

In an article commenting on the recent elections in Puerto Rico, the pro-Independence Movement of Puerto Rico is mentioned thusly:

"Electoral Farce: The pro-Independence Movement (MPI), which is made up of the more valiant Puerto Rican patriots, announced that the elections which gave the victory to the Popular Democratic Party were an example of an electoral farce. This announcement has been confirmed, in part, by the national committee of the cited party, which has begun a survey to find out why more than 200,000 Puerto Ricans did not register or vote in the elections.

"The answer is easy: They did not vote because they followed the counsel of MPI, which urged them to participate in an "electoral strike," in spite of the fact that the law prohibits and demands that every citizen vote. If these 200,000 "striking" votes were added to the votes of the opposition parties, we could see that the PPD is in the minority in spite of having control over the electoral machinery.

"The MPI, which has increased in number and strength during 1964, besides denouncing the servilism of the new government to the will of the U. S., underlined the great successes gained by the movement. Among these successes is the release of their glorious independent leader, Pedro Albizu Campos, who was pardoned by Munoz Marin. Another of their successes is the treatment of the matter of Puerto Rican independence by the United Nations.

"The MPI is now preparing for the fight to succeed in the following objectives: prepared themselves

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for the 1968 elections and put an end to the problem of "statehood" so that Puerto Rico can cease being a U. S. colony; cause the failure of Munoz Marin's plans to convert Puerto Rico into a stage for the newly structured neo-colonialism of the United States, which is the objective of the U. S. in their request that the Puerto Rican question be dismissed by the United Nations; strengthen the expansion of the National Liberation Movement; seek the unity of anti-colonial forces upon a broad and highly militant political basis; and, develop diverse and increasing international pressures.

"To succeed in these proposals, the leaders of the MPI are reorganizing their party; this also includes the reorganization of their agencies in other countries, including the U. S."

Title: "United States: Who Killed Kennedy?"
Pp. 36

The famous Warren report on the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, instead of clarifying the facts, it has hung a smoky veil over them. Such is the opinion of one of the more renowned European historians, the Englishman, Hugh Trevor-Roper, Professor of Modern History at Oxford University.

Trevor-Roper (?) has made an extensive study of the report and is writing a book which refutes the assertions which are contained therein, pointing out the incongruities, contradictions and lack of investigative logic.

The English historian has exposed some of his ideas in the "London Sunday Times." These ideas have caused a sensation throughout Europe, even though the American press has given them very little space. According to Trevor-Roper, there are two outstanding points. The first thing is the manner in which they proceeded to arrest

Lee Harvey Oswald, the accused Kennedy assassin, and second, the death of the policeman, D. D. Tippit (sic). The police gave Oswald's description and the order to arrest him, by radio, almost immediately after the President had been killed, without having any proof at all. To explain this anomaly, the Warren report says that a witness, Howard Brennan, saw them (sic) shoot from the window of the Texas School Book Depository Building and he told the police "a few minutes later." Trevor-Roper considers this to be improbable and suspects that the police had other proofs which they did not give to the Warren Commission.

According to the report, the police detained Oswald and Captain Fritz questioned him for 12 hours, without even writing down one line of the questioning, taking shorthand notes or recording anything on tape. This seems impossible; nevertheless, the report claims that it is so. The FBI - Federal Bureau of Investigation - could not have committed the grave error of not recording the questioning process, especially when it concerned the assassination of the President of the United States. Either the record was destroyed, or the FBI is guilty of complete indifference - the Warren Commission has not bothered to find out.

In the first report issued by the doctors who attended Kennedy and made the autopsy, it says that Kennedy was hit from the front, and all of the police investigations were based on this assertion. It was supposed that the President was wounded when he approached the building or when he turned his head toward it. However, the police, not being able to coordinate that which the doctors had said with their affirmations concerning Oswald's supposed responsibility, maintained that Kennedy was shot from behind. The doctors re-examined their opinion and agreed with what the police wanted. The doctors did not save their notes. In spite of all this, the Warren Commission considers everything that happened to be all right. "The police evidence concerning Oswald's arrest and the doctors notes were destroyed," says Trevor-Roper, "and the Warren Commission did not consider these anomalies important."

At the place from where the shots were fired, the police found a paper sack in which - they say - Oswald put the fatal weapon. The sack was too small to hold the weapon; nevertheless, the police analyzed and later destroyed it, however, not without substituting a new sack, "so as to provide an instrumental proof." The police

explained to the Commission that they destroyed the paper sack because it was discolored and rumpled. The Commission conforms with this explanation, since the "replica of the sack was the same as the original."

"After having completely destroyed all of the proof," says Trevor-Roper, sarcastically, "the police destroyed the supreme proof: Lee Harvey Oswald, the most important witness." How could Jack Ruby, Oswald's killer, enter the place where Oswald was in custody - even to the point of being held by two policemen - and kill him with one well-aimed shot from a revolver? He could have only gotten in the basement of the building with the consent or connivance of the police. Nevertheless, he did enter, and this is what the Warren Commission has not been able to clarify. In his initial declarations, Ruby refused to say how he had entered the place where Oswald was held. There appeared three policemen who declared that Ruby could have slipped-in to the place. Ruby then said that what the police reported was true.

The Warren Commission admits that Ruby was well known to the Dallas police and that they were on good terms. While referring to this part of the facts, the Warren Commission employs the word "probably" on various occasions in its report.

"The Commission," says the historian, "has considered valid everything that the Texas (sic) police and the FBI have told them, without ever submitting what they have said to a legal or intellectual investigation. Never has the Commission investigated further the proofs given by the police, and never has it insisted that the police express themselves or answer clearly."

Upon closing, Trevor-Roper criticizes the Commission and says that the confused and turbid report is limited to "criticizing the negligence" of the police. (sic) "The vast and disorderly Warren Commission report," terminates the historian, "has no more authority than the tendentious and defective police reports from which it was compiled."

The historian also refers to the declarations made by Mark Lane, Oswald's attorney, and says that these declarations were very just and well put. The historian adds that the report is a basis for accusation rather than an impartial document which could be used as a defense.

Mark Lane is now finishing a book in which he analyzes the Warren Report step by step.

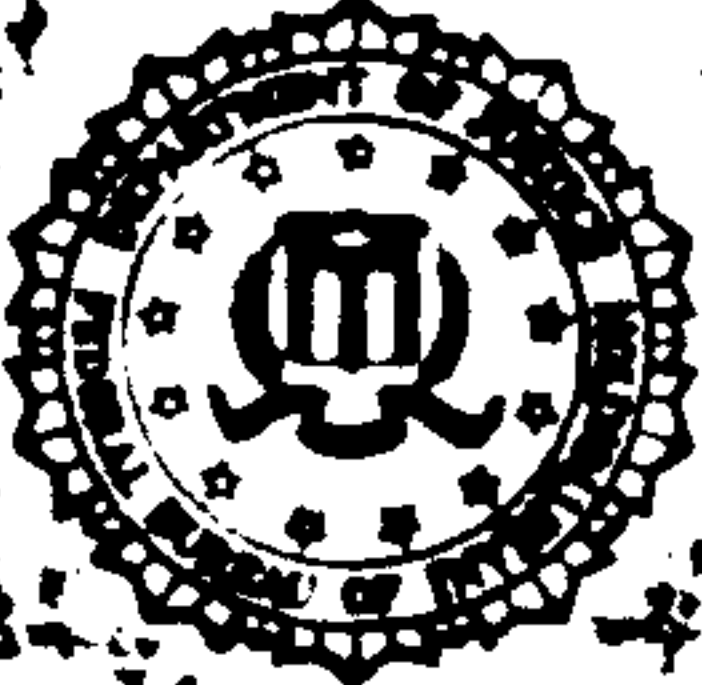

On February 19, 1965, a confidential source abroad, advised that an extensive investigation in Spain by an appropriate official Spanish investigative agency has failed to locate or identify the individual who signed himself "ANTILIN PERIS," in a letter received by the U. S. Ambassador in Spain.

In this letter the writer claimed to have seen a document concerning the assassination of President Kennedy and that the document contained information injurious to President Johnson.
