

evening two closely related subjects: first, the principal forces that the Conspiracy had at its disposal to excite national hysteria on the occasion of the assassination last November of John F. Kennedy, who was at that time President of the United States, and second, the essential facts that the Conspiracy is trying to cover up.

Now for our first point, we need not consider at all the personal character of the late John F. Kennedy, for it does not really matter whether he was as noble or as vile an individual as our race has produced. The only important thing is that, whatever his character, he was at the time that he was assassinated the President of the United States. And let us be sure that we understand precisely what that means.

I have not seen the evening papers, so I cannot be sure that the Warren Gang has not at last dared to decree that our Constitution is, like God, unconstitutional. But assuming that Earl and his confederates have not yet dared to take the final step, we are still living -- in legal terms, at least -- under the Constitution that our forefathers devised in the hope that they could found a nation of free men sufficiently intelligent and courageous to retain the freedom that they won by expending their fortunes, their blood, and often their lives.

If this is still America, let's remember what the late Jack Kennedy was in terms of the American Constitution. He was a public servant; he was your servant. If we overlook the flagrant falsification of election returns in three states that really put him in office, he was a man whom you hired in the autumn of 1960. He induced you to employ him by making certain specific and many vague promises that he certainly did not keep. But that is a minor matter. The important thing is that he was your employee, whom you hired and whom -- according to the Constitution, at least -- you could have discharged at any time through the Constitutional procedure of impeachment and trial before your elected representatives in Congress.

A public servant. That, ladies and gentle-

men, is what president is under the Constitution that your forefathers designed, on the basis of human experience and particularly the tragic history of Rome, with the conscious purpose of averting the fatal decay that destroyed the Roman Republic, and with the conscious hope of assuring to their descendants a freedom and dignity greater than men had ever known before.

The murder of a public servant as such is, of course, a blow against the law and order that is the first requisite of all civilized society, and it is an insult and a threat to your dignity and freedom, especially when it is the work of a gang or a conspiracy. You should be shocked and indignant whenever that happens. You should, for example, be aroused and alarmed whenever a police officer is while on duty killed or assaulted by any one of the gangs of hoodlums and other scum that the Conspiracy is now using your taxes to incite and finance for obvious purpose of creating a domestic anarchy in which no decent American can feel reasonably secure in his own home or on the streets of his own city.

ON THE PRESIDENCY - AND THEATRICS

Now a President is obviously an officer of higher rank than the rookie policeman who may be directing traffic in the next block, just as a general is of higher rank than a sergeant or private in the army, but, if we are to be rational about such things, we must remember that they are all officers of the same kind, that is to say, public servants.

That, of course, is the fact that Communist-directed propaganda was designed to conceal. It was not a President as such, but Jack Kennedy as a person who was the subject of the hysteria they excited and augmented to the best of their ability.

It behooves us to understand clearly what weaknesses in our population they were able to exploit and use. They are significant weaknesses that we must take into account in our consideration of all political questions, if we are to approach them realistically and rational-

Woodrow Wilson said that he could not remember having ever read the document, much less having signed it, and a public investigation was imminent, the Frankfurter promptly disappeared down a hole called Harvard University in which he became, believe it or not, Professor of Law. In more recent times, Owen Lattimore, when publicly identified by the Senate Subcommittee as "a conscious, articulate instrument of the Soviet conspiracy," immediately popped into the Johns Hopkins University. Robert Oppenheimer, when identified as a liar, and a knowing associate of Soviet spies and other criminals, dodged into a whole series of academic burrows, from the Institute for Advanced Study at Princeton to Harvard University. And here is the most recent example, of which you may not have heard. One of the two creatures in the State Department identified as directly responsible for the installation of the Communist Conspiracy in Cuba is an individual named Roy R. Rubottom. Now I don't know whether your local papers have given you the glad tidings as yet or not, but Rubottom has just ducked into Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas, where he will be the "Vice President of the University in Charge of University Life."

I have mentioned these few examples just to show how easy it would have been in 1933 to transfer the loose-tongued traitors temporarily to academic hide-outs and so stop the scandal before it even began. Had that been done, there would have been no Congressional hearings. The decision not to use that facile expedient, it seems to me, must have been made by the supreme directorate of International Communist Conspiracy, which must have judged, therefore, that the time had come for some open terrorism in the United States. And, as the result proved, they were correct. A simple signal brought the rats swarming from the sewers of society; those perennial nuisances, the self-styled "Liberal intellectuals," actuated by a conscious or subconscious awareness of their own inferiority, gladly joined the pack; and unlimited funds from the U. S. Treasury and other sources were available to hire such more intelligent accomplices as were needed. By this con-

certed effort, international criminals succeeded in kidnapping Dr. Wirt and finally procuring his death in 1938.

THOUSANDS OF CASES OF VILIFICATION

That was the first in a long series of Bolshevik victories in this field, and I believe that former Congressman Dies does not exaggerate at all when he speaks of a "thousand other such cases of vilification and personal attack" carried out by the Conspiracy. Our enemies, although they undoubtedly share Harry Hopkins' opinion that Americans "are just too damn dumb" to understand what is being done to them, rely on their working control of our communications to prevent the general public from perceiving the monotonous uniformity of all the campaigns of defamation; but, on the other hand, they take care to make Communist instigation and control obvious to every observer who has studied the methods of the Conspiracy. When the vermin conduct such campaigns to destroy their active opponents, they have a second and far more important objective: to intimidate and terrorize potential opponents. For every Dr. Wirt they destroy, they silence a hundred or two hundred other men, who might otherwise have spoken out against treason.

This Communist technique has been brilliantly successful in the past, but like any tool it can be worn out by overuse. I am inclined to believe that the Conspiracy made a mistake when, on December 5, 1960, it issued from Moscow orders for spitting-campaigns against all effective patriotic organizations in the United States, and particularly and specifically against the John Birch Society. We have now reached the point, I think, where attacks on the John Birch Society and other American opponents of the Conspiracy in the press or radio do the Conspirators more harm, by exposing to all thoughtful people the extent of their control, than they profit the Conspiracy by exciting the irrational emotions of the unthinking.

INDUCED HYSTERIA

However that may be, let us consider this

and specifically counter to Soviet policy objectives will become the target for a massive campaign of defamation that will go on until he is politically-- and often physically--silent. Such campaigns originating in the secret chambers of the Communist apparatus, are commonly triggered by the words of an open or concealed Communist agent. They are carried on for the most part, however, not by the Communists themselves but by the massive exertions of the slavish Liberal left.

"In our own nation as in all nations the honor roll of victims is long and varied: Charles Lindbergh, Pat McCarran, Jan Valtin, Robert Vogeler, William C. Bullitt, Joseph McCarthy, Louis Budenz, Arthur Coleman, George Stratemeyer, Whittaker Chambers, Martin Dies, Douglas McArthur, William Jenner and a hundred and one others."

Although the Conspiracy naturally tries not to use the technique of systematic defamation so frequently that the inattentive public would have to recognize the monotonous pattern, it is not a technique that the Conspiracy tries to conceal from attentive observers. On the contrary, it wants them to recognize it. That has been the policy for decades in the United States, and if, as a matter of some slight historical interest, you would like to know the date at which the High Command of the Bolsheviks adopted that policy, I think I can give it to you.

WILLIAM A. WIRT, AMERICAN

In September, 1933, a number of traitors established in several departments of the Federal government foregathered with an official representative of the Soviet on a social occasion at which Dr. William W. Wirt, Superintendent of Schools in Gary, Indiana, was also present. Now the criminals probably assumed that, given the Conspiracy's deep penetration of American colleges and especially "Colleges of Education" during the preceding twenty

years, a successful professional "educator," if not himself an enlisted agent of the Conspiracy, would be either a fathead, with his brain stuffed with unintelligible verbiage, or a racketeer, interested only in shaking bucks out of books. It is even possible that through some faulty identification, they mistook Dr. Wirt for a comrade. At all events, the termites were so indiscreet as to allude, in the presence of Dr. Wirt, to their plans for subverting and capturing the United States, and to boast that Franklin Roosevelt was the American counterpart of Kerensky, the ambiguous Russian Socialist who was a knowing or unwitting tool of the Bolsheviks and prepared the way for the capture of Russia by Lenin, Trotsky, and associated degenerates in 1917. The conspirators were mistaken about Dr. Wirt; he was a loyal American, and he recognized the moral duty that is incumbent on all of us, if we are fit to live in our country. He therefore testified before a committee of Congress.

Now Communist agents are not supermen; like ordinary bandits and murderers they make mistakes all the time, and it was doubtless a mere blunder that led those creatures to expose themselves in the presence of Dr. Wirt. But the situation thus accidentally created called for a policy decision on the highest level, and I, for one, feel certain that the decision was made by the supreme directorate of the Conspiracy, whoever they may be. You see, it would have been extremely simple and easy to have the heads of the governmental departments involved simulate shocked astonishment, and immediately to retire the blabber-mouthed traitors from the public payroll to the sanctuary of universities, foundations "for the advancement of learning," and other convenient hide-outs. Such retirement to prepared academic nests is, of course, just standard procedure, like the disappearance of a prairie dog down its hole. That procedure has been used a thousand times. In the days of Woodrow Wilson, for example, when a malignant alien named Felix Frankfurter was identified as the author of a document that was published over the signature of the President to extricate the murderers and terrorists of a Communist subsidiary from their difficulties, and when

COMMUNICATIONS AND PRECONCEPTIONS

... Fellow members of the John Birch Society, with whom I am proud to be associated and on whom, I firmly believe, the future of the United States and the American people now very largely depends. Ladies and gentlemen.

A Hindu prince while attending Oxford University, met and became engaged to an English girl. "Your brow is of ivory", he told her, "your cheeks are like damask roses, your lips like rubies. All my life I have dreamed of finding twenty or thirty girls like you."

That, of course, is just a story, ladies and gentlemen, but it could be true. The only thing that makes it improbable, and hence amusing, is the assumption that the young princeling would be so tactless as to say in that situation what he was really thinking. If I had time this evening to discuss the subject briefly -- say in four or five hours -- I should take my point of departure from that story and try to show you in all earnestness how very large a part of any one human being's understanding of a situation or even of a statement in words depends on the preconceptions in his own mind, that is to say, the things that he takes for granted as a result of racial or other hereditary instincts deep within him, or of the tradition or lack of tradition in which he was nurtured, or of the religious faith or lack of faith given him by his parents or schools, or of the statements implanted in his mind as factual by his teachers.

From this basic consideration, it would be easy to show that the principal cause of our present plight must be found in the patient, gradual, and systematic poisoning of the American mind that has been in progress for more than half a century under the direction of our hidden enemies, the concealed agents of the International Communist Conspiracy. Although most of the work was done by educators, journa-

lists, and the like who were quite unaware that they were joining the Bolsheviks, and who knew only that if they peddled certain kinds of hokum, they were rewarded with quick promotions and sudden prosperity, it is clear that their venal efforts were directed and coordinated by a secret conspiracy as part of a plan gradually to subvert and ultimately to destroy the United States. So each year for more than fifty years, by a hundred subtle devices that range from the perversion of words and sabotage of the English language to arrant lying and the cultivation of morbid and irrational sentimentality, alien ideas have been injected gradually into our national mind for the purpose of inducing complete paralysis.

One of the grimmest facts that we Americans must confront today is that a large number of voting inhabitants of our country either never knew what it means to be an American or have consciously repudiated the American tradition.

THE ART OF SMEARING

As most of you, ladies and gentlemen, may know, an article concerning the assassination of the late Jack Kennedy, which was published in two parts in the February and March issues of American Opinion, provoked a concerted campaign of hysterical screeching and frantic puking in the press and over the radio throughout the United States. Of course, there was nothing particularly remarkable about that. A man would have to be almost totally ignorant of the methods of the International Communist Conspiracy not to foresee the probable consequences of any serious interference with its operations in our country. Campaigns of defamation through the Communist-controlled press and radio have been a standard technique and virtually routine for many years. Perhaps the most concise statement of that fact was made by the Board of Editors of National Review back in 1953 before that periodical underwent a series of acute financial crises. They said:

We were literally overwhelmed and have gone into several printings since that time. Mind you, this was an address before the Daughters of the American Revolution, back in 1959! Of course the principal strength of the article is found in the fact that what he anticipated happening did materialize. Then, in due course, a Soviet trained communist assassinated the President. Doctor Oliver made some comments that were deserving of national attention. They received it. That is an understatement. Those who make a living by smearing descended en masse upon the good Doctor, and the public was led to believe that his career at the University of Illinois was in the balance. This of course was not accurate. Honorable Sir:

Since I saw a group of three people with guns try to fire at the Presidential car as it passed from the Rice Hotel garage in Houston, Texas in Sept. 1962, I have been very conscious of circumstances surrounding the death of the late John F. Kennedy.

I am convinced it was the work of a combination of Fascist, Communist, and Lodgeite groups of subversive people who are well organized and operate after a fashion of a narcotic ring, and employ Fascist types of psychiatry to gain their position and information.

On the day the newspaper reported the assassination in Dallas, I was in the home of a woman who I thought was Mrs. Ben Jackson, who's husband was said to be on the government staff. I was there as a saleswoman and we were interrupted with a telephone conversation in which she talked of

not having enough money to buy a new
dress for the dinner that evening, much less
advance any more for the "cause", she added
she knew she would not be going any place
if things went as planned. This woman
was a blue eyed blond. I called at the house
again and was met by a blue eyed
brunet. They later married.

I just recently went to work as a
bookkeeper's helper for Fluorocraft, a
big sub-contracting industry, on West 41st St
in Austin. The young woman who is the
bookkeeper looks enough like the woman
I saw in Houston who tried to fire on the
presidential car to be a sister or daughter.

I managed to get the gun from the
woman in Houston and turn it over to
a policeman on the street in uniform before
I was stopped by my office associate
who I worked with in the State Dept. of Public Works.
A comment was made in this group that they
had missed.

When I got back to the S.D. office I tried to call Mr. Gungler who I had met of the F.B.I. in Houston, and the call was intercepted by a call from a man who said he was U.S. Marshall Mason. I was about to tell him what happened when some people came in, one with a gun, and took the phone from me. I was either hit in the head or had a stroke, because I forgot what had happened and the only report that was published was of a young man in the crowd at Rice Stadium trying to attack the president with a gun.

Since that time a woman, stationer, named Miss Pierce, Psychiatrist, seemed to fit the description of the woman in Houston with the gun also. She was associated with one of the doctors who called Jack Ruby insane. I turned this information over to Mr. Burt of the F.B.I. in Austin.

If the Policemen I gave the gun to in Houston could be found, and the gun, and the fingerprints compared with Miss Pierce or Tracy Malone's double, the question could be proved one way or other.

I typed five pages of history and information I had heard from the Veterans Administration Hospital in Houston, Texas and left with Mrs. Spangler of the FBI in Houston. In this the name of Lee was mentioned. At that time Mr. Cady had been asked to be removed as manager of that VA Hospital by the VFW.

I also left eight or nine pages (typed) of a report of subversive activities that happened in 1952, with Mr. Beck of the FBI in Houston. Here also, the name of Lee was mentioned.

I have written two letters to Mr. Bertrand of U.S. Secret Service in Houston and four pages of a report about what happened in Houston to the Homicide Dept. of the Houston Police Department.

I also married a man called Calvin Lee who I divorced after two weeks. He was an RCAF pilot in the second world war and known to James J. Shown, Atty. in Houston, Texas. Mr. Shown knows Mr. Bertrand and both Shown and this Lee claim to be friends of President Johnson.

Once I found a man in a (low booth) at West 6th and Lerner here in Austin who looked about like the picture I have seen of Lee Oswald, only blond, say to someone on the phone he was Lee Oswald and he was not dead. At that time I was talking to Mr. Trammell of the V. A. Regional Office in Waco, Texas and tried to get him to interrupt the call, but later could not find Mr. Trammell to verify I had heard this.

One more thing I would like to add to this. There is an F Y Herring who lives on Academy Dr. in Austin and claims to be a cousin of Senator Herring of Texas. The one time I saw him, he later reminded me of a man - "Bon Horv" who was accused by a group of Trammells in a little town in Arizona in November 1950, of blowing up Red Rock Arsenal. We had just either spotted or atomic bomb or get hit by one. I tried to tell Bon Horv, as a relative over to the US Marshal in Phoenix but in the process had to check him in the post as he lunged for me as he had shot me in the back. I believe he is here and passing as there

F. Y. Herring is supposed to be a
millionaire oil man who was a deep
creeper and brick mason before he struck
oil.

And too, Earl Chandler, Atty at Law in
Houston used to have an office next to a
Don Jackson who he told me at the time was
assumed to be subversive. Mr. Chandler and
I spotted a man with a rifle in a building
window on Main Street in Houston in 1961
who they managed to intercept just before
Governor Price Danville passed in parade.

Sir, please forgive me for taking your
time here, but in view of all this, I am left
with the impression that the real assassin
is still running loose and these people
have deliberately disclosed the truth.

Enclosed for San Antonio, Dallas, and Houston is one copy of a letter bearing the signature [redacted] of Austin, Texas. This letter was addressed to "Robert Kennedy, Attorney General, Washington, D. C." and furnished to the Bureau by letter dated March 12, 1965 from Mr. Herbert J. Miller, Jr. Assistant Attorney General, Criminal Division, Department of Justice.

Bureau files reveal several references concerning [redacted] and her background; refer to Houston airtel dated 6/16/64 captioned "TROPUS", Houston File 62-2121 and San Antonio File 62-2919. It is noted Dallas did not receive a copy of this communication which enclosed a letterhead memorandum concerning [redacted] in which she was diagnosed by [redacted] of the Veterans Administration Hospital as a "chronic paranoid schizophrenic."

In view of the fact U. S. Secret Service has had previous interest in this individual, upon receipt of this communication Secret Service should be immediately advised of the receipt of the enclosed letter.

The address furnished by [redacted] is noted to be a Post Office Box; however, the Bureau is not aware whether this

address is the mailing address for an institution or whether, in fact [redacted] at the present time may be institutionalized.

San Antonio is instructed to conduct a limited inquiry to determine [redacted] present location. Thereafter, a letterhead memorandum should be prepared and the predication should be based on the letter received from the Department. A true copy of [redacted] letter is to be incorporated in your letterhead memorandum followed by the results of your inquiry as to her present location. The letterhead memorandum should also contain a brief synopsis of her psychiatric background to enable the Bureau to disseminate this information both to Secret Service and to the Department.

Due to Secret Service's previous interest in [redacted] your letterhead memorandum should be furnished to Secret Service covering the areas of San Antonio, Houston and Dallas.

For the completion of Dallas files, Houston should furnish Dallas a copy of Houston airtel and letterhead memorandum previously referred to. It will not be necessary to interview [redacted] however, this matter should receive your immediate investigative attention.

NOTE:

By letter dated March 12, 1965, the Department furnished copies of a handwritten letter by [redacted] in which she made claim she had observed a group of people with guns trying to fire at the Presidential car as it passed a hotel in Houston, Texas, during September, 1962. She makes other allegations which leads one to immediately question her mental stability. However, our files have indicated Secret Service has been interested in her location and it appears pertinent Secret Service be immediately advised of the receipt of our incoming communication revealing the address and her present location. She is a former Veteran who has been in and out of state institutions and the Veterans Administration Hospitals. She has been diagnosed as a "chronic paranoid schizophrenic" and on one previous occasion during May of 1964, Secret Service, Dallas advised [redacted] had checked into the

On 3/15/65, Miss DIANE STODDARD, Secretary, Boston Office of Senator EDWARD M. KENNEDY, called the Boston Office of the FBI. She advised that she had just received a call from [REDACTED] who described himself as being from Sacramento, California. [REDACTED] was in Boston and desired to see either Senator EDWARD M. KENNEDY or Senator ROBERT KENNEDY as he had important information bearing on the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. Inasmuch as the man appeared to be under emotional stress, Miss STODDARD requested that a representative of the FBI interview him.

On the same date, [REDACTED] was interviewed by SA RICHARD W. KRANT of the Boston Office. He appeared to be mentally disturbed and he produced 53 pages of notations as set forth in the enclosed letterhead memorandum.

[REDACTED] stated he desired that this material be furnished to the appropriate authorities and that he could not "trust" Government agencies on the West Coast. He was informed that the material would be appropriately handled.

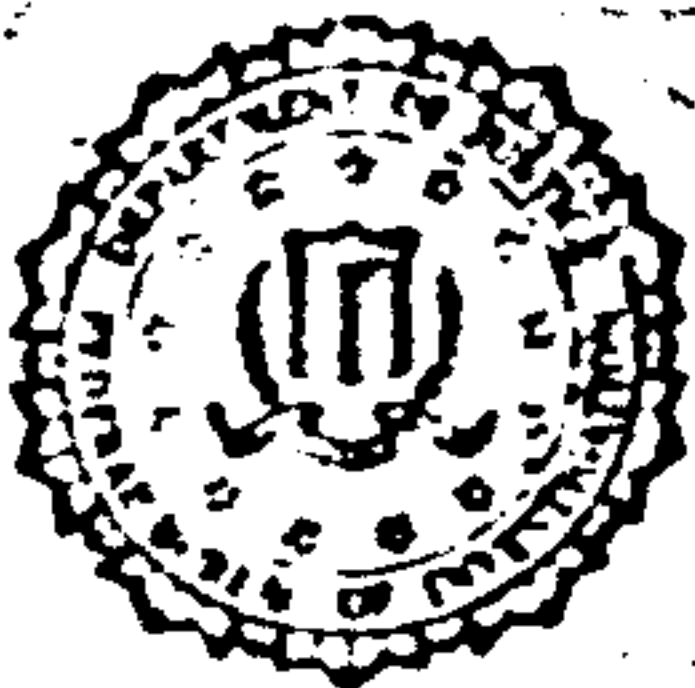

On March 15, 1965, [REDACTED] contacted the Boston Office of Senator Edward M. Kennedy. He requested an immediate personal interview with Senator Kennedy or Senator Robert Kennedy and advised he had important information bearing on the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

At the request of a representative of Senator Kennedy's Office, [REDACTED] was interviewed by a representative of the Boston Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation on March 15, 1965. He produced fifty-three pages of carefully detailed notations both numerical and alphabetical which material he had obtained for the past year and a half while watching and listening to Channel 10, Station KXTV, Sacramento, California.

[REDACTED] alleged that a Bingo game, which was televised by this station, had used these numbers in the game. [REDACTED] had devised what he described as a "hidden code" as a result of recording these numbers. He alleged that this code pertained to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

[REDACTED] who appeared to be under emotional strain, could not logically explain the derivation of this code or its connection with the President's assassination.

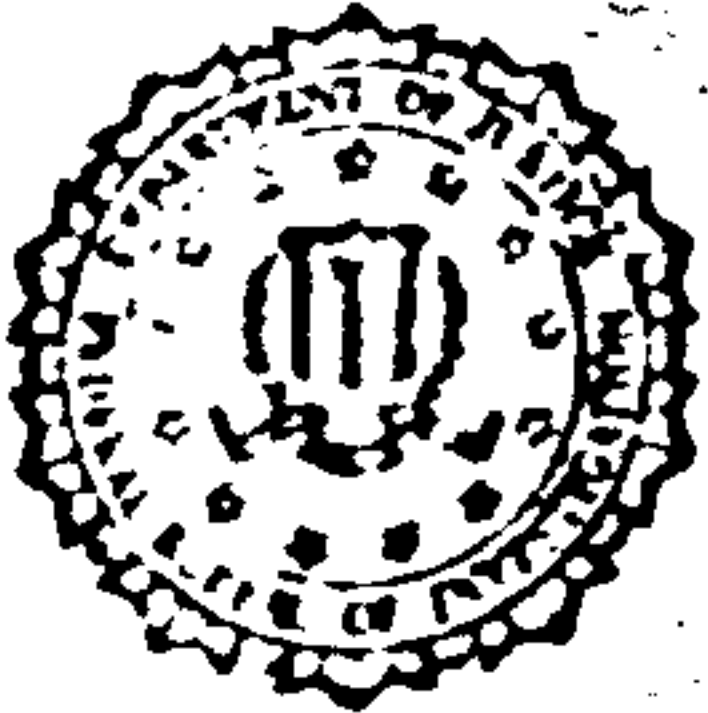

This memorandum supplements investigation contained in memorandum dated October 23, 1964, and December 16, 1964 at Cleveland, Ohio, December 19, 1964 at Buffalo, New York, and at Dallas, Texas, dated January 20, 1965 and February 2, 1965, and at Buffalo dated February 25, 1965.

[REDACTED] on March 29, 1965, was interviewed by Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and furnished the following information:

[REDACTED] was born [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] New York. On November 22, 1963, he was visiting in the upstairs apartment of Mr. and Mrs. ROBERT QUINLAN, 81 Fernwood Avenue, Rochester, New York. He had gone to the QUINLAN apartment to visit ROBERT QUINLAN, whose wife is GERALDINE QUINLAN.

ROBERT QUINLAN was at work at this time, but [REDACTED] remained at the apartment. Also in the apartment at this time was JERRY QUINLAN, ROBERT QUINLAN's brother. [REDACTED] also believes that JERRY TAYLOR was in the apartment but is not positive of this.

[REDACTED] first heard of the assassination of President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY through television news coverage. He said he remained at the apartment for the remainder of the afternoon for the purpose of listening to the news of the assassination.

ROBERT QUINLAN was employed as manager of a Woolworth Store located on Main Street in Rochester at this time.

Dear Mr. Deily:

Since I talked to you last, I have accumulated a large amount of information on the Kennedy assassination which I would like to discuss with you at your convenience. I do not wish to put it in memorandum form, as you suggested at our last meeting, because a lot of it is based upon material of a speculative nature but in my judgement, it is extremely important as far as the welfare of the United States is concerned.

You are possibly in full knowledge of the material I might give to you. However in conformity with my past practice, I offer it to you for your consideration.

One disturbing piece of information has come to me recently which indicates that the disclosures of some of the details of the Kennedy assassination and the refutation of the conclusion of the Warren Commission Report are going to be revealed in Europe, possibly in the near future.

I personally feel that it would present a more honorable position before the world if these details came from the United States prior to the European action.

Mr. Deily, I have had many people ask me the identity of the men standing at the curb, who I pointed out to you in my initial interview of October 7, 1964. Recently a man came into my office and gave me the information that the identity of the man standing to the left of the man in question was established in Warren Report testimony. It is logical to conclude that since this mans' identity has been established, that perhaps the F.B.I. knows the identity of the man to whom I referred to in our initial interview. To avoid any further misunderstanding of my position, will you please furnish me the identity of this man, if such information is available?

On March 27, 1965, the Reverend Mr. DAVID BELZER, Pastor of the Church of the Nazarene, 1223 Southwest Fourth Avenue, Aberdeen, South Dakota was interviewed.

He made available a letter, which is quoted below, then recently received by him, together with the envelope in which the letter was sent. The envelope bears postmark [redacted] March 24, 1965; a return address -

[redacted] It is directed to the Church of the Nazarene, 1223 Southwest Fourth Avenue, Aberdeen, South Dakota.

He, Reverend BELZER, is totally unacquainted with any of the individuals mentioned in the letter or with [redacted] except President KENNEDY, of course. He has no knowledge as to how the address of his church was obtained or as to how his church was selected as a recipient of the letter.

The letter as received by him, Reverend BELZER, is set out verbatim below:

"To all Protestants who dare to call themselves Christians"

"LEE OSWALD was framed by the F.B.I. and the Dallas Police Department. It was GEORGE ANDREWS who shot J. F. KENNEDY and wounded the Texas Governor. His brother JIM ANDREWS shot the Dallas Policeman. They are a part of a gang of ten murderers belonging to the same family by marriage and birth. Six DAVIDSON brothers (two of them twins) and two INGERSOLL brothers are the other members of this gang. KARL and GEORGE DAVIDSON killed W. SPENCER, HAROLD and ROBERT INGERSOLL killed Mrs. PARKER. RICHARD M. NIXON paid 500 dollars for each of these murders. The DAVIDSON brothers also killed CHUCK SPENCER and many many other people. They live in [redacted]"

"The bankers wanted a war with Russia (over the Cuban issue) but KENNEDY did not want war so their leader ALDRED I. DUFONT requested his death. KENNEDY's murder was carried out by DUFONT's two loyal servants J. EDGAR HOOVER and RICHARD M. NIXON."

"Our freedom demands are as follows;

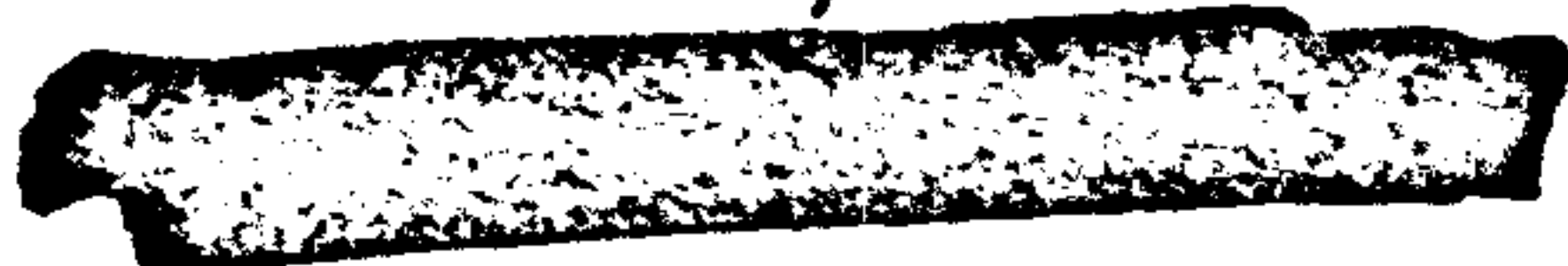
- (1) Cancel the National Debt to the private banks. It has been obtained dishonestly.

On the afternoon of 3/23/65, GERALD STUEVE, Rt. 1, Box 433, Corvallis, Ore., self-identified as a mail carrier employed at the U. S. Post Office (USPO), Corvallis, telephonically advised the Portland Office that with the majority of his deliveries being made in the outlying rural areas it is necessary to obtain such mail from the post office in Corvallis in large canvas bags which are official USPO property; that upon emptying a canvas bag containing the mail on that date he had observed the following handwritten note on the inside of the bag:

"I killed a president - not Lee Oswald."

Mr. STUEVE stated that this note was written by an unknown individual using a red grease pencil. He knew of no one who might be playing a practical joke on him and explained that judging from a stamped impression on the inside of the bag such bag had been used only since January, 1965. Mr. STUEVE stated that he would leave the mail bag with the superintendent of the USPO at Corvallis.

On 3/29/65, WILLIAM D. HEATHERINGTON, Assistant Postmaster, Corvallis, stated that the bag in question, #2 in size, was turned over to him 3/23/65, by rural carrier GERALD STUEVE. Mr. HEATHERINGTON pointed out that such bags are received daily by the USPO at Corvallis from all parts of the U. S. on an average of about 140 per day. On

3/23/65, only about 110 bags were received. The largest number of such bags received is from Portland, Ore., and Council Bluffs, Iowa, but some are received from all parts of the U. S. He went on to note that such bags are also used by carriers for delivery of mail, there being 27 regular and nine substitute carriers, anyone of whom could have had the bag on previous days. He further pointed out that such bags are also sent over-night to the three sub stations in Corvallis to the six men's dormitories and six women's dormitories at Oregon State University, Corvallis, all of which are left over night and exchanged with others on the following day. Access thereto would be available to every student and visitor in these dormitories, each of which houses hundreds of students. In addition such bags are also sent to the library at the University and may also be sent to various departments in that institution although generally smaller ones are preferred. He noted that about 20 to 30 bags are sent daily to each sub station and in addition additional bags are sent daily to the "Corvallis-Gazette Times", a Corvallis daily newspaper, where they remain over night.

Mr. HEATHERINGTON further pointed out that bags received by the USPO are used and reused again with no individual record or accounting thereof being maintained. He stated it is not unusual for the insides of bags to have printing on them apparently because of a desire on the part of some postal employees all over the U. S. to have their names appearing on bags which are sent to other parts of the country. He pointed out that employees pay no particular attention to this printing. He went on to note that there is no way of knowing how many days or weeks the bag referred to here and before may have been in Corvallis and he further pointed out that the date January, 1965, which was stamped on the bag could refer to the date of manufacture or possibly the date of postal use. He further pointed out that red crayon grease pencils such as was observed to have been used in printing the message set forth above are standard equipment in all

post offices and such a pencil could well have been used in instant handprinting. He also noted that the red crayon pencil similar to those used by post offices is a common commercial item available in book stores on college campuses, etc. Mr. HEATHERINGTON could provide no information which might be of assistance in determining the identity of the individual responsible for the handwritten note appearing in the mail bag.

GERALD STUEVE upon personal contact 3/29/65, stated that he could provide no additional information other than to note that the bag in question had been obtained by him from a row of such bags at the USPO in Corvallis during the morning hours and he had not become aware of the printing contained inside of the bag until about noon. He stated that no one else had access to the bag in question during the period it was in his possession.

Inasmuch as no specific leads are apparent which might reasonably result in identifying the person responsible for placing the note inside the bag mentioned above no further action is contemplated in this matter. The mail bag in question was made available temporarily by Assistant Postmaster HEATHERINGTON with the request it be returned to the USP at Corvallis when its purpose has been served.

UACB in 10 days the above bag will be returned to Mr. HEATHERINGTON.

On March 30, 1965, Dr. I. A. SKLAR, M.D., Mental Health Clinic, Veterans Administration Hospital, Seventh Street and Indian School Road, Phoenix, Arizona, furnished the following information:

On March 12, 1965, [REDACTED] came to the Mental Health Clinic of the Veterans Administration Hospital, Phoenix, and requested that she be allowed to spend the weekend and be treated. [REDACTED] claimed to have been injured in Arizona in an atomic bomb blast and when she awakened she was surrounded with Indians. She further claimed that she had been shot by Communists during the period of her military service during World War II.

Dr. SKLAR diagnosed her condition as "schizophrenic reaction - paranoia type". She appeared to be in an extreme delusional condition. She admitted having had considerable insulin shock treatments and also electric shock treatments. She also stated that she was out of funds and did borrow some money from one of the patients.

Dr. SKLAR stated that her condition was not service connected. She was released on March 17, 1965 after having received "maximum hospital benefit" that could be given in her case under the conditions. When she left she indicated that she was going to Oakland, California. Dr. SKLAR recommended that she seek treatment at the Mental Health Clinic in Oakland.

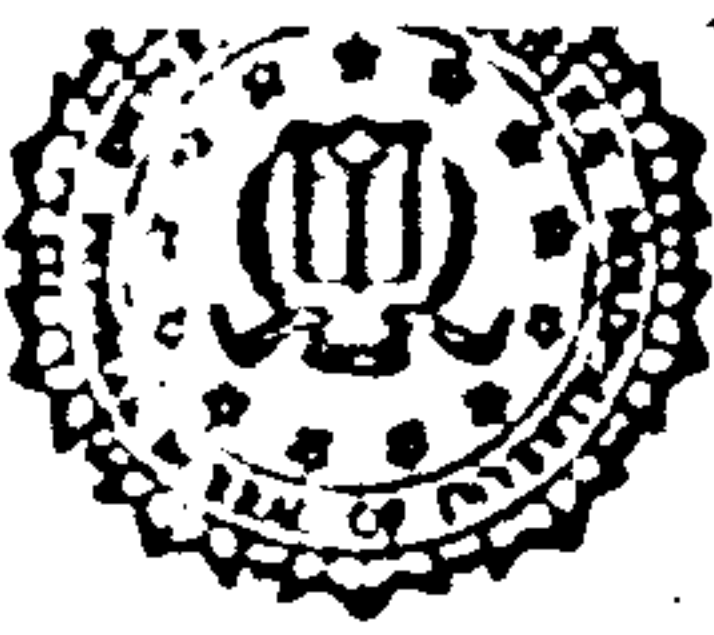

There is set forth below a six page handwritten letter addressed to "ROBERT KENNEDY, Attorney General, Washington, D. C.," signed [REDACTED] Austin, Texas".

March 3, 1965

"Robert Kennedy, Attorney General
Washington, D.C.

"Honorable Sir:

"Since I saw a group of three people with guns try to fire at the Presidential car as it passed from the Rice Hotel garage in Houston, Texas in Sept. 1962, I have been very conscious of circumstances surrounding the death of the late John F. Kennedy.

"I am convinced it was the work of a combination of Fascist, Communist, and Confederate group of subversive people who are well organized and operate after a fashion of a narcotic ring and employ Fascist types of psychiatry to gain their positions and information.

"On the day the newspapers reported the assassination in Dallas, I was in the home of a woman who I thought was Mrs. Don Jackson, who's husband was said to be on the governors staff. I was there as a saleswoman and we were interrupted with a telephone conversation in which she talked of not having enough money

"to buy a new dress for the dinner that evening, much less advance any more for the 'cause', she added she knew she would not be going anyplace if things went as planned. This woman was a blue eyed blond. I called at the house again and was met by a blue eyed brunette. They later moved.

"I just recently went to work as a book-keeper's helper for Floorcraft. A rug subcontracting industry, on West 41st St here in Austin. The young woman who is the bookkeeper looks enough like the woman I saw in Houston who tried to fire on the presidential car to be a sister or daughter.

"I managed to get the gun from the woman in Houston and turn it over to a policeman on the street in uniform before I was stopped by my office associates who I worked with in the State Dept. of Public Welfare. A comment was made in this group that they had missed.

"When I got back to the SDW office I tried to call Mr. Spangler who I had met of the FBI in Houston, and the call was interrupted by a call from a man who said he was U. S. Marshall Manic. I was about to tell him what happened when some people came in, one with a gun, and took the phone from me. I was either hit in the head or had a stroke, because I forgot what had happened and the only report that was published was of a young man in the crowd at Rice Stadium trying to attack the president with a zuc.

"Since that time a woman, Italian, named Miss Pierce, Psychiatrist, seemed to fit the description of the woman in Houston with the gun also. She was associated with one of the Doctors who ruled Jack Ruby insane. I turned

"this information over to Mr. Burk of the FBI in Austin. If the Policeman I gave the gun to in Houston could be found, and the gun, and the fingerprints compared with Miss Pierce or Tracy Malone's double, the question could be proven one way or other. I typed five pages of here-say and information I had heard from the Veterans Administration Hospital in Houston, Texas and left with Mr. Spangler of the FBI in Houston. In this the name of Lee was mentioned. At that time Dr. Cady had been asked to be removed as manager of that VA Hospital by the VFW.

"I also left eight or nine pages (typed) of a report of subversive activities that happened in 1952, with Mr. Burk of the FBI in Austin. Here also, the name of Lee was mentioned.

"I have written two letters to Mr. Bertrand of U. S. Secret Service in Houston and four pages of a report about what happened in Houston to the Homicide Dept. of the Austin Police Department.

"I also married a man called Calvin Lee who I divorced after two weeks. He was an RCAF pilot in the second World War and known to James J. Shawn, Atty. at Houston, Texas. Mr. Shawn knows Mr. Bertrand and both Shawn and this Lee claim to be friends of President Johnson. I thing "Cal Lee" shot my sister to death Dec. 10, 1964.

"Once I heard a man in a phone booth at West 6th and Lamar here in Austin who looked about like the pictures I have seen of Lee Oswell, only blond, say to someone on the phone he was Lee Oswell and he was not dead.

"At that time I was talking to Mr. Townsend of the V. A. Regional Offices in Waco, Texas and tried to get him to interrupt the call, but later could not find Mr. Townsend to verify I had heard this.

"One more thing I would like to add to this. There is an IY Herrin who lives on Academy Dr. in Austin and claims to be a cousin of Senator Herring of Texas. The one time I saw him, he later reminded me of a man - "Bon Hour" who was accused by a group of townsmen in a little town in Arizona in November 1950, of blowing up Red Rock Arsenal. We had just either exploded at atomic bomb or get hit by one. I tried to turn Ben Hour, an Italian over to the US Marshal in Phoenix but in the process had to shoot him in the foot as he lunged for me as he had shot me in the back. I believe he is loose and posing as Heroin F. Y. Herrin is supposed to be a millionaire oil man who was a sheep rancher and brick mason before he struck oil.

"And too, Bill Chancellor, Atty at Law in Houston used to have an office next to a Don Jackson who he told me at the time was assumed to be subversive. Mr. Chancellor and I spotted a man with a rifle in a building window on Main Street in Houston in 1961 who they managed to intercept just before Governor Price Daniels passed in parade.

"Sir, please forgive me for taking your time here, but in view of all this, I am left with the impression that the real assassinate is still running loose and three people have deliberately disclosed the truth.

On November 7, 1951, [REDACTED] appeared at the Los Angeles, California, Office of the FBI and advised that she was employed by the [REDACTED] Military District of the U. S. Army as a civil employee, GS-3. She related that she had been employed by the Army for a very short time and she felt that someone was trying to undermine her position with the Army. [REDACTED] stated that women with whom she worked were always gossiping about her and stated that someone was paying her rent and she was a "kept woman". [REDACTED] stated that she was born [REDACTED], 1921, at [REDACTED] Texas, and that she had been married three times. She stated that she had served ten months in the U. S. Army as a Wac. She stated that the officers at the military establishment were continually bothering her for dates and she repeatedly turned them down. She stated that from June to December, 1950, she was continually under the influence of alcohol. At this time [REDACTED] had no specific information to give to the FBI nor did she have any specific questions she wanted to ask. Her exact reason for coming to the FBI could not be determined.

[redacted] appeared at the Austin, Texas, Resident Agency of the FBI on December 5, 1951, and alleged that individuals in Austin were conspiring to send subversive information to persons unknown by means of small fuses (use of the fuse was not explained). She indicated that she had on or about November 7, 1951, visited two psychiatrists, a Catholic priest and a doctor. However, she was quite confident that she was not psychoneurotic. She related that at this time she was employed by the Texas Military District in the Incoming Records Section, Austin, Texas.

On August 19, 1963, she appeared at the Austin, Texas, FBI Resident Agency in quest of a "good civil attorney" to prosecute a veteran's compensation claim for her. She claimed to have been a psychiatric patient in the past and stated that she had been hit by an atomic blast in Arizona and that a piece of shrapnel had gone through her left cheek and into the roof of her mouth, causing her emotional problem.

Numerous letters have been received from [redacted] beginning in 1959 wherein she complained about matters not within the jurisdiction of the FBI.

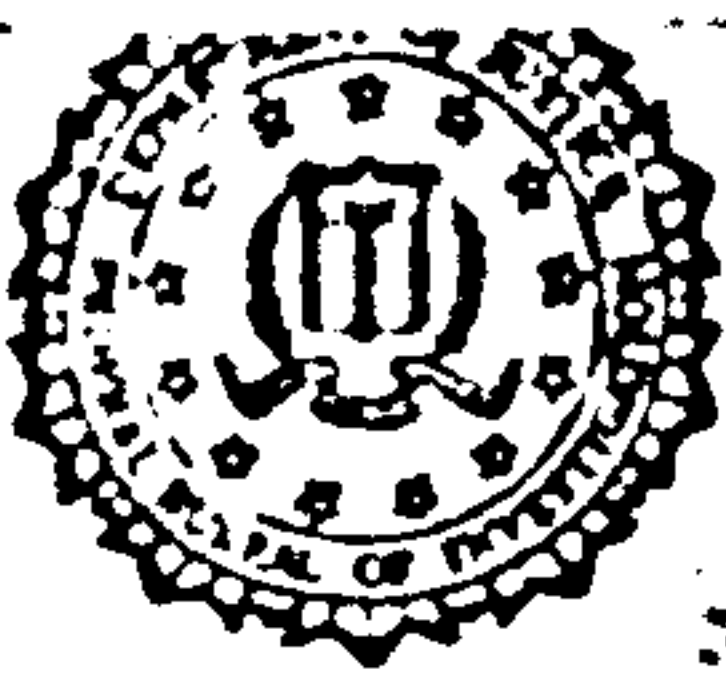
On March 22, 1965, SA T-1 advised that Post Office Box [redacted] Texas was rented in the name of [redacted] and [redacted] on [redacted] 1964. SA T-1 advised that on March 13, 1965 a forwarding order was received that all mail to [redacted] should be sent to the Veterans Administration Hospital, Ward 3B, 7th and Indian School Road, Phoenix, Arizona.

On March 22, 1965, Mr. KENNETH WIESMAN, U. S. Secret Service, Austin, Texas, advised that on March 24, 1965, when he attempted to interview [redacted] in Austin she pulled a gun on him. WIESMAN stated that he was successful in obtaining the gun from her and she was then committed to the Veterans Administration Hospital in May of 1964. He related that on April 9, 1964, her personal physician

stated that [REDACTED] was a paranoid schizophrenic. Mr. WIESMAN advised that [REDACTED] Street, [REDACTED] Texas, committed suicide in 1963. He related that [REDACTED] in January of 1952 was committed to the U. S. Public Health Service, Fort Worth, Texas; in approximately [REDACTED] committed to the Austin State Hospital, Austin, Texas; in February, [REDACTED] Veterans Administration Hospital, Downey, Illinois; in December of [REDACTED] Veterans Administration Hospital in Houston, Texas, where she remained until [REDACTED] In August of [REDACTED] she was in the Glenwood Home and Hospital, Webster Grove, Missouri, as a schizophrenic paranoid type. She was also committed to the Veterans Administration Hospital in Big Springs, Texas, as a schizophrenic reaction type.
