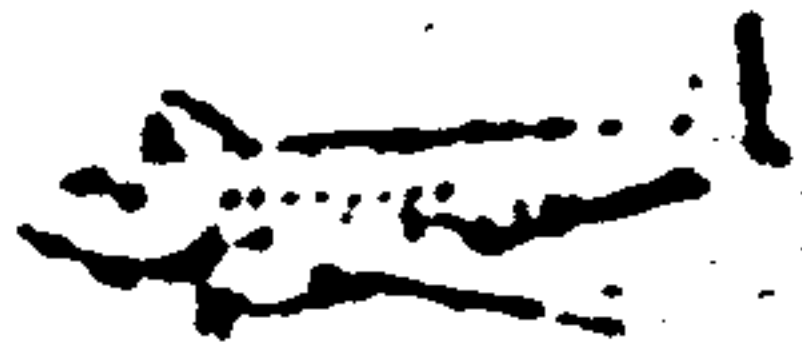

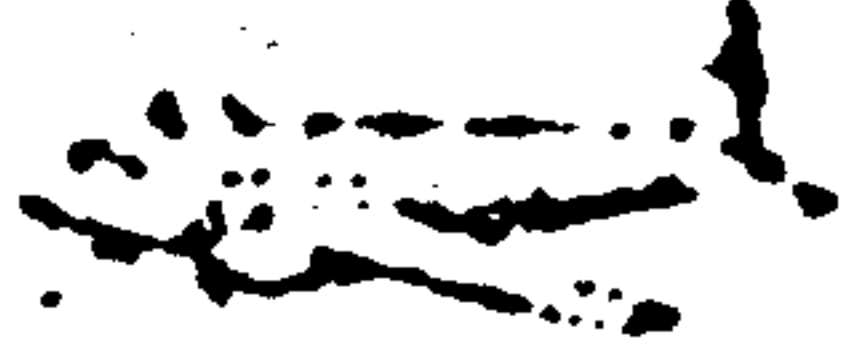

Captioned individual was arrested by the San Antonio, Texas, Police Department on the night of May 10, 1965, on a charge of vagrancy. At the time of his arrest he advised he was born December 6, 1921, in Pittsburgh, Illinois, and stated his FBI number is 1133558.

During the interview he informed the Patrolman who arrested him that he had predicted the date of former President KENNEDY's death and furnished the date to the FBI in Washington thirty days before it occurred.

Subject also had among his effects the White House telephone number, 453-1414, and a diary regarding his activities.

The above information was orally furnished to Special Agent in Charge LUIS BENAVIDES of the Secret Service, San Antonio, Texas, for information purposes and he stated that he believed this individual is identical with the person who had left a napkin inside the office of Secret Service, San Antonio, April 3, 1964, with information re the assassination of former President Kennedy.

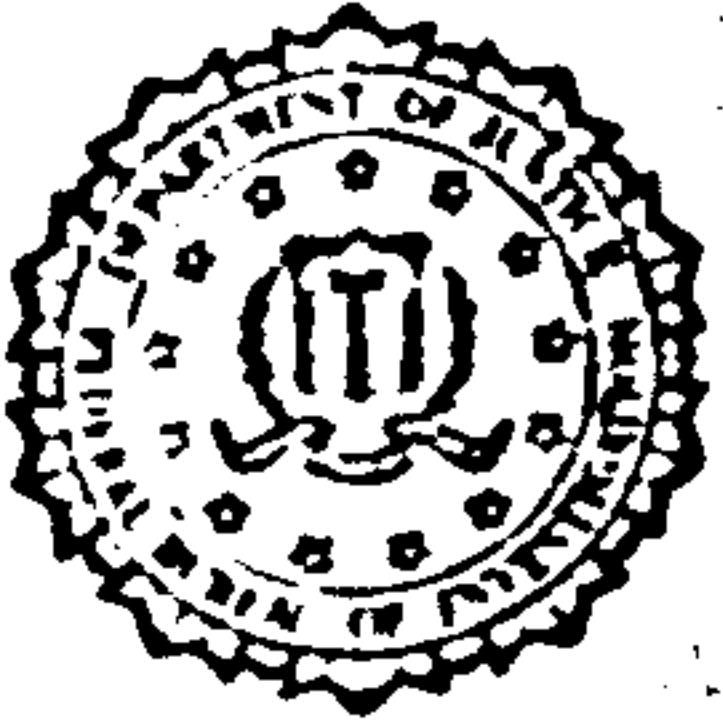

On May 3, 1965, [redacted] Klein's Sporting Goods, Incorporated, 4710 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois, advised the Chicago Division, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), that his firm was in receipt of a firearms order postmarked April 29, 1963, from one "A. J. Hidell", 6401 Pelican Drive South, St. Petersburg, Florida. Also enclosed was a money order in the amount of \$33.28. A handwritten affidavit apparently from A. J. Hidell was also enclosed with the firearms order in which Hidell advised he was of age, was not an alien, fugitive, drug addict, ex-convict or under indictment.

[redacted] advised that the firearms order apparently had been placed as a result of Klein's Sporting Goods, Incorporated, advertisement appearing in a national magazine. Upon receipt of the order, one of Klein's order clerks noticed the name of "A. J. Hidell" and because the Klein's firm had sold the rifle used in the assassination of President John F. Kennedy under that name, the matter was brought to the attention of Mr. Waldman. Because of the unusual aspect of this order, Mr. Waldman stated, he telephonically contacted a "source" of his in St. Petersburg, Florida. He subsequently learned that no one by the name of Hidell was known to reside at the Pelican Drive address. [redacted] "source" identified a resident at 6404 Pelican Drive South, St. Petersburg, Florida, as one Lowell Brandle, an employee of the "St. Petersburg Times".

[redacted] advised that Klein's definitely would not fill the order in question. He added that because of the "bizarre implications" of the order, he felt the matter should be brought to the attention of the FBI.

On May 6, 1965, the original envelope, handwritten order and handwritten affidavit as described by [redacted] were furnished to the Chicago Division, FBI, by [redacted] Klein's Sporting Goods, Incorporated.

Examination of the envelope in question determined that it was postmarked St. Petersburg, Florida, April 29, 1963. It was addressed to "Klein's Sporting Goods, Department 654, 227 W. Washington Street, Chicago, Illinois 60606". The envelope bears the return address "A. J. Hidell, 6404 Pelican Dr. S., St. Petersburg, Florida".

The original order as furnished by [redacted] reads as follows:

"enclosed is a money order for \$33.28, which includes the price of the Enfield rifle with scope, (\$31.78), C23-3213, and the \$1.50 postage."

The affidavit accompanying this order is as follows:

EDWARD GENTRY WILLIAMS

On May 12, 1968, Edward Gentry Williams came to the Salt Lake City Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and stated that he was a participant in the Kennedy assassination. He stated that Premier Nassar of Egypt established a charity group which was the organization responsible for the assassination. He stated that Vice President Humphrey contributed money to this organization. He stated that J. Edgar Hoover had told him that there were two routes in Dallas to be covered for the assassination. He stated that Lee Harvey Oswald covered one route and he covered the other route. He stated that the following named people were among 13 people responsible for the assassination of President Kennedy, to wit: Governor Paul Johnson of Minnesota, Governor George Wallace of Alabama, Premier Nassar of Egypt, the Chief of Police of Dallas, Texas, and Governor John Conley's wife.

In addition, he stated that Flight 126 from New York City had a bomb on it and this bomb was supposed to be for President Kennedy.

He stated that the State Marine Shipping Company, New York City, New York, wanted him to become a Communist, and that this company also wanted him to kill President Johnson, but he did not plan to shoot anyone, especially President Johnson, or Vice President Humphrey.

He stated that the State Marine Shipping Company wanted him to be a body guard for John Foster Dulles, and subsequently wanted to pay him \$35,000 per year to be a junior assistant vice president. Williams could not state who wanted him to kill President Johnson.

He stated that he was a member of the Organization of Sovereign States, and that this could be verified by Cardinal Sheehan.

He stated that he was on the bow of the Magnolia State, a U. S. Coast Guard vessel, during the Cuban Blockade.

Williams states that he was discharged from the military service because he had mental telepathy, and also stated that Vice President Humphrey had mental telepathy.

Williams advised that J. Edgar Hoover also was his Godfather and that Chief J. Edgar Hoover had told him to inform the Salt Lake City Field Division of the above facts.

He stated that he filed an application to go to work as an agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Detroit, Michigan, but did not recall the date which he filed the application. He stated that if accepted by the FBI, there would be nothing to worry about because he had had 25 years of "rocky road."

Williams wanted plane fare to Los Angeles, California, and money for food.

Williams stated that he had been drinking and [admitted] to being an alcoholic. He stated that he was just passing through on his way to his home in Los Angeles.

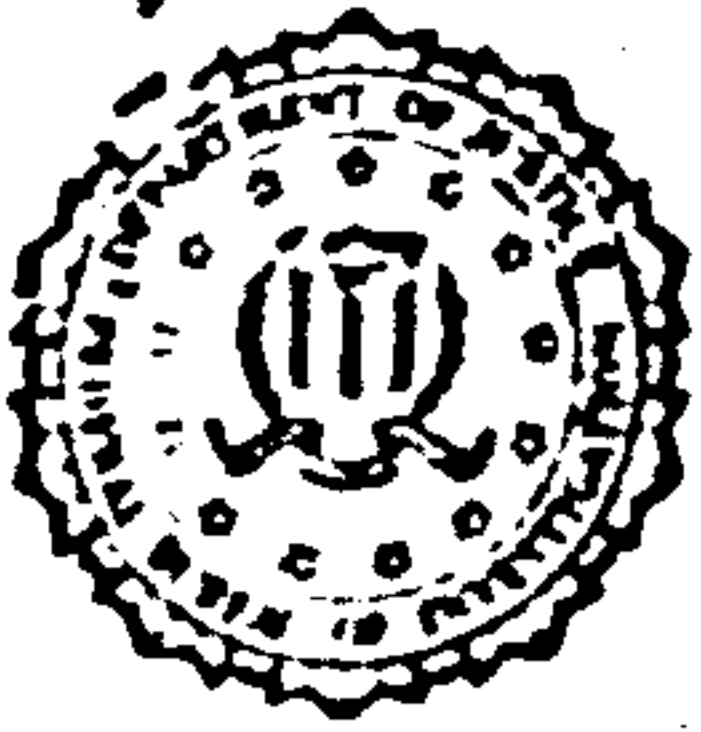

INCORPORATED, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, APRIL 29, 1965

Reference is made to a memorandum dated May 11, 1965,
at Chicago, Illinois, in captioned matter.

On May 12, 1965, Mr. LOWELL BRANDLE, a special writer for the "St. Petersburg Times", St. Petersburg, Florida, telephoned the FBI Office, Tampa, and advised that he had been writing several articles about purchasing guns by mail order. He said he attempted to purchase a gun from Klein's Store in Chicago using a pseudonym "A. J. HIDELE", which is the name used by LEE HARVEY OSWALD when ordering the gun from Klein's which he later used to assassinate President JOHN F. KENNEDY. Mr. BRANDLE stated that he felt if Klein's would accept this order from him under the name of HIDELE, they would accept an order from anyone. He ordered first a catalog from Klein's and later ordered a cheap Enfield rifle using the name HIDELE. Mr. BRANDLE stated that apparently Klein's has been checking into the matter in that they checked city directories and made further inquiries and then advised him that there was no one by the name of HIDELE residing in St. Petersburg, and consequently the rifle he ordered would not be shipped. He added that Klein's was taking the necessary precautionary measures concerning mail order purchases of weapons, and he had directed a communication thereafter to Klein's congratulating them on their alertness.

Mr. BRANDLE continued that he was now attempting the same approach on another arms company by the name of Potomac Arms Corporation, Post Office Box 35SN4, Prince Street, Alexandria, Virginia. He said he received a catalog indicating that the Potomac Arms Corporation have available for sale cannons, Soviet light machine guns, Italian carbines, and the like. He sent one order and requested that a gun be sent to him and he would pay for it on delivery. A reply was received by Mr. BRANDLE instructing him to complete a form which certified

that he was over 21 years of age, had never been convicted, and was not a fugitive. He said that he plans to use the name of HIDEELL and to order a rifle from the Potomac Arms Corporation. He said that the reason for his contact with the FBI at this time was to place himself on record in the event that any inquiries were received concerning his order of the gun from the Potomac Arms Corporation. He added that if he was able to receive the gun from the Potomac firm, he felt that his nine-year-old daughter could do the same thing and that this firm would not be exercising the same sound judgment as the Klein's store.

On May 14, 1965, Mr. William J. Waldman, Vice President, Klein's Sporting Goods, Incorporated, 4540 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois, made available to the Chicago Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) a letter which he received from Lowell Brandle of the "St. Petersburg Times", St. Petersburg, Florida. This letter was as follows:

"Dear Mr. Waldman:

"In reference to your letter of May 5, I am pleased to inform you that--as you suspected--there is no such person as A. J. Hidell living at 6404 Pelican Dr. S., St. Petersburg. That is my home address and I am a special writer on the staff of The St. Petersburg Times.

"I attempted to order the rifle from Klein's in that manner, to see for myself if it was possible for someone else--with a far different motive--to purchase a firearm in a similar manner, using a pseudonym. In the past I've written on the subject of mail-order firearms, and I understand the many problems involved. Also, I know that there is a lot of emotionalism involved, too. This was another reason I sought to purchase the rifle from your firm--to learn facts.

"Well, I am pleased that Klein's has taken whatever precautions are necessary to detect those who might be using a pseudonym on an order. I intend to write an article saying what I attempted, and the result. It would be good if I could include an explanation of the measures your firm takes to avoid selling a firearm to the wrong person. It might help prevent unnecessarily harsh legislation. Would you please give me a brief general statement,

concerning the difficulties involved in operating your business in such a responsible fashion, how you overcame these difficulties, and any remarks you care to make on the matter of ordering firearms by mail.

"I know that there are some small, irresponsible firms which are selling firearms. Personally, I feel they are dangerous, and they must be an embarrassment to Klein's in many ways. Perhaps my article will help inform the public that there is a difference between Klein's operation and that of some others. I suspect that in the public mind--as it was in my own mind--all firms selling firearms are lumped together, more or less. This seems most unfair.

Mr. Waldman also made available a copy of a letter dated May 5, 1965, to Mr. A. J. Hidell, 6404 Pelican Drive South, St. Petersburg, Florida, which letter had been prepared by himself. This letter was as follows:

"Dear Mr. Hidell:

"Please accept our thanks for your order. However . . .

"We cannot fill this order as inquiry by us indicates (1) the resident at 6404 Pelican Dr., So., St. Petersburg, Florida is not A. J. Hidell and (2) we are unable to establish there is such a person as A. J. Hidell residing elsewhere in St. Petersburg.

"While we are anxious to serve you, it is our first concern to conform to the letter as well as the spirit of the law.

EARL WILLIAM GALVIN, 13788 Ida, Warren, Michigan, furnished the following information:

He is acquainted with LOUIS HEREDIA ANCONA, who is the son of JORGE C. HEREDIA, and who resides at Manuel N. Ponce 304, Guadalupe Inn, Mexico 20, D. F. LOUIS HEREDIA ANCONA has a nickname of CHAVETA, which is what his family commonly calls him and he is a nineteen year old student at the University of Mexico, Mexico City.

GALVIN advised that he had first met ANCONA in June, 1963, at the International Institute, Detroit, Michigan, while ANCONA was in Detroit accompanied by a cousin who had formerly been an exchange student here. Later in the summer of 1963, ANCONA had visited for two weeks in GALVIN's home.

GALVIN said that since that time he had corresponded with ANCONA an average of about once or twice a month. He said that in April, 1965, he had visited ANCONA in his residence at the above address in Mexico.

GALVIN said that on his return from Mexico, he had stopped in San Antonio, Texas, and while there he had lost his wallet. He said he believed he had lost his wallet in Brackenridge Park, San Antonio. GALVIN said that he was in San Antonio awaiting the receipt of some money to enable him to continue his trip home. He advised he was broke at the time and his wallet had no money in it although it did have some of his personal papers.

GALVIN said that his wallet also contained a letter from LOUIS HEREDIA ANCONA which had been signed with his nickname CHAVETA. He said this letter had been in an envelope which contained the return of ANCONA's father on the address side although the reverse side of the envelope contained the initials (L.A.H.) of ANCONA and his home address.

GALVIN said he recalled that in this letter ANCONA had added a postscript which stated "I want to make you a question. do you know the true about Kennedy's death?"

GALVIN explained that subsequent to the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY in November, 1963, this matter had been discussed in letters between him and ANCONA. He said ANCONA did not believe that such a crime could have possibly been perpetrated by a single individual acting alone and without any assistance. He said that ANCONA, at that time, believed that there was undoubtedly some type of conspiracy and probably a large organization behind the assassination. He said that even in April, 1965, when he last saw ANCONA, ANCONA still expressed some doubt that all of the facts surrounding the assassination had been made public.

GALVIN said it was in this context of doubt that a single individual could commit the assassination that ANCONA had added the postscript to the letter. He said that ANCONA merely wanted his, GALVIN's, opinion as to whether or not others besides LEE HARVEY OSWALD were involved in the assassination.

GALVIN advised that he had no first hand information concerning the assassination beyond what he had read and is positive that ANCONA has no information concerning it.

From this point on, her conversation was rambling and fanciful. She stated among other things that she was hypnotized and also had a "laying of hands on her." She admitted prior confinement for nine years in the Milledgeville State Hospital, Milledge, Georgia. Local authorities are aware of her nature. 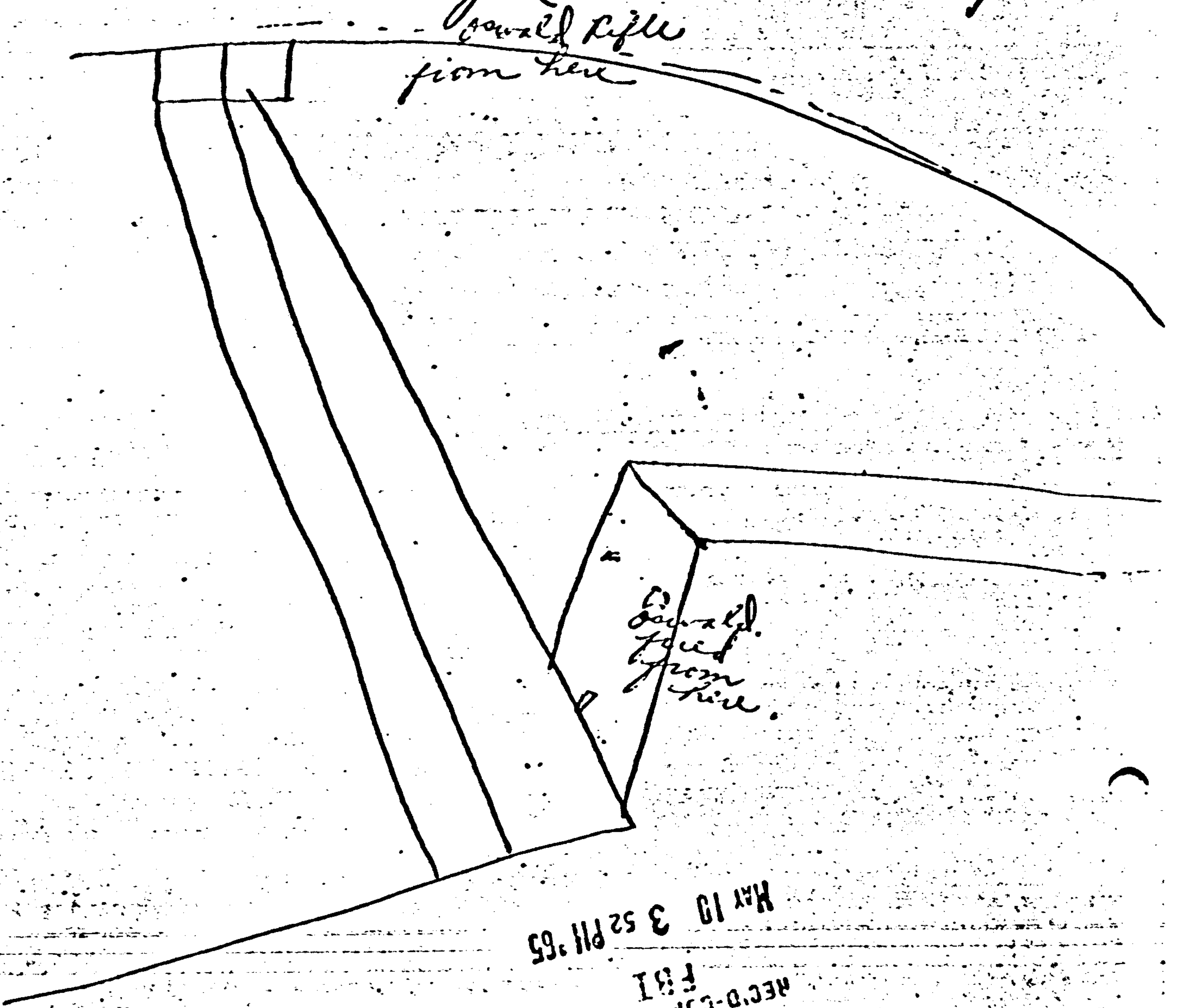

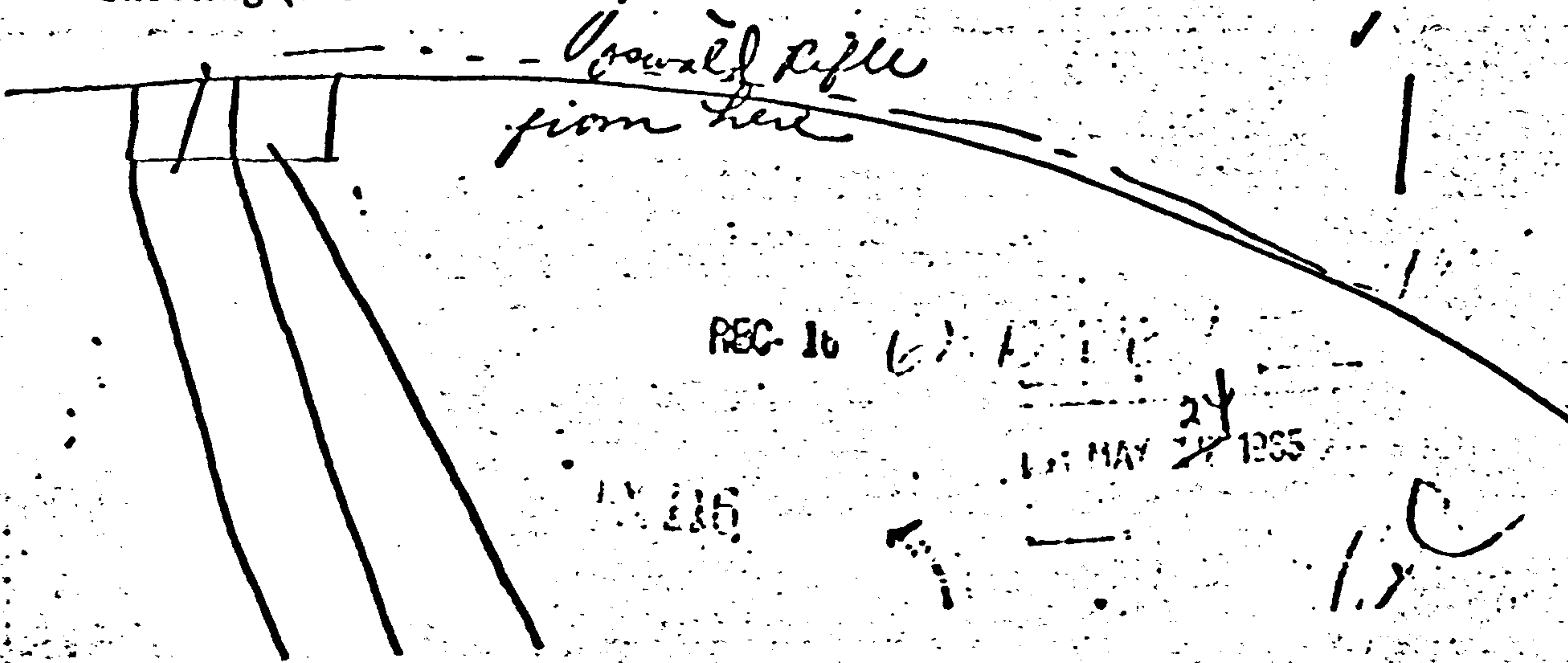

For information of the Bureau, Cincinnati, Cleveland, and Dallas, the following is set forth:

On 5/19/65, information was received from PETE CARTER, Sheriff, Logan County, Arkansas, that he was holding for investigation on charge of breaking and entering one [redacted] of Toledo, Ohio. [redacted] had made some statement to the effect that he was sorry he had killed President KENNEDY.

On 5/19/65, Sheriff CARTER advised that [redacted] near Paris, Arkansas, had advised him that a young man had showed up at the lodge on the previous night, eaten and paid for his meal. About 5:30 a.m. on 5/19/65, the same young man was observed to be walking in the same area. The person told [redacted] he had broken into a cabin the previous night, wanted to pay for the lodging. He paid [redacted] the sum of \$4.00. He said he was lost. [redacted] took the young man to his car, which had no gasoline in it.

The young man then asked [redacted] to take him to a place called BROWN's campsite, which [redacted] did. At this place, the young man got down on his hands and knees, held his hands above his head, and stated, "Mrs. KENNEDY, I want you to forgive me for killing your husband."

Sheriff CARTER stated that [redacted] then brought the young man to the courthouse, where he was placed in the jail for safekeeping.

On 5/19/65, this person was interviewed at the Logan County Jail, Paris, Arkansas, by SA CHARLIE E. GUNTER, JR., and Sgt. BERNARD YOUNG, Arkansas State Police.

It was observed that [redacted] had considerable difficulty in answering questions, taking a considerable time to think over answers to even simple questions.

He indicated he was in the Paris, Arkansas, area looking for work. He had recently worked for Manpower, Inc., in Jacksonville, Arkansas, and lived in Little Rock, Arkansas. He had purchased his car in Little Rock from Rowe Motors. He stated he had recently been on a "vacation" and was going toward Little Rock when he saw a sign indicating there was a Government Park on Magazine Mountain. He went up there and got lost. He broke into a cabin to find a place to sleep and to get "food and shelter."

[redacted] stated he had been in a State Hospital in Columbus, Ohio, at one time. When asked the reason for his confinement, he stated "because I was crazy." He stated, "They couldn't keep me there."

[redacted] was asked if he had been in a military hospital, and he stated he had not. He was then asked if he had been in a Naval Hospital, and he said, "Yes." He was asked the reason and remarked, "I blew my stack while I was in the Marine Corps."

He stated he knew nothing about the death of President KENNEDY. He was asked if he knew who killed the former President and answered, "He was killed by God, wasn't he?"

He denied having any military disability and denied that he was wanted by any law enforcement officials.

It was apparent from conversation with [redacted] that he was mentally disturbed.

is noted in referenced teletype, on 5/5/65, [redacted] Klein's Sporting Goods, Inc., 4540 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois, advised that his firm was in receipt of an order postmarked 4/29/65, from one "A. J. HIDEEL," 6404 Pelican Drive South, St. Petersburg, Florida. This order called for a shipment of one Enfield rifle, sporter model, and a variable three to seven power rifle scope. Enclosed was a money order in the amount of \$33.23. Also enclosed was a handwritten affidavit apparently from HIDEEL, in which he advised he was of age, and was not an alien, fugitive, drug addict, ex-convict or under indictment.

[redacted] advised that the order was apparently placed from an advertisement appearing in a magazine. Upon receipt of the order, one of Klein's clerks noticed the name of HIDEEL in that Klein's sold a rifle to LEE HARVEY OSWALD under the name A. HIDEEL, which rifle was used in the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. [redacted] stated that because of this he had telephonically checked with a "source" in St. Petersburg, Florida, and found that HIDEEL was not known to be a resident of the Pelican Drive address. This "source" identified a resident there as one LOWELL BRANDLE, an employee of the "St. Petersburg Times."
