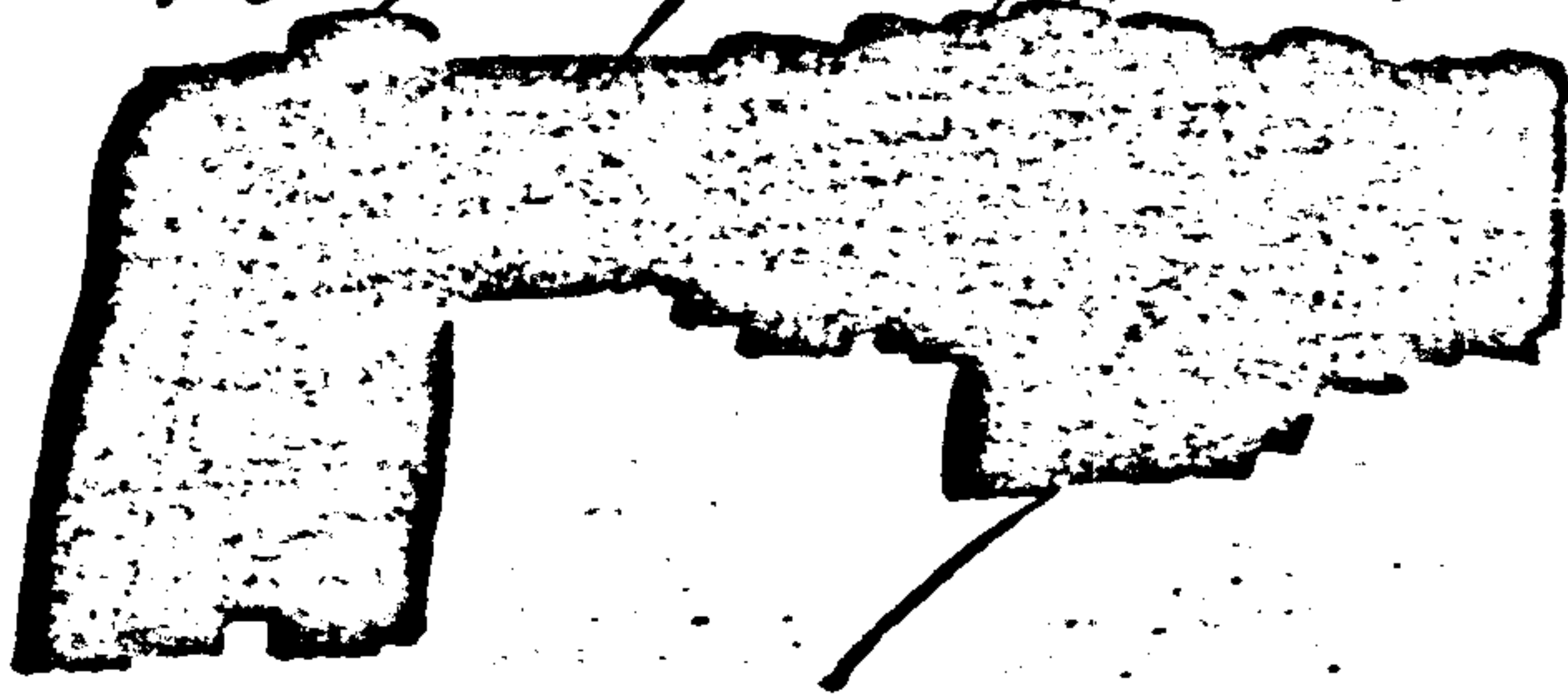

Referenced communications reflect receipt from the Bureau of the assassination rifle with clip and revolver, Commission Exhibits 139 and 143, respectively, and the brown leather holster, Bureau Exhibit B4, Commission Exhibit 144.

On 9-10-65, USM, NDT, served a Warrant of Seizure on the above-mentioned items. This is in connection with the Government's attempted forfeiture of these items. The Marshal advised he, therefore, would have constructive custody of the items which is necessary, and same were left in my custody.

Enclosed is a copy of the Warrant of Seizure and the order granting leave for the Government to file libel, as well as a copy of the libel. USA has advised this is the procedure recommended to him by the Department of Justice.

Special Agent in Charge, J. Gordon Shanklin, of
our Dallas Office has advised that on September 10, 1965,
the U. S. Marshal, Northern District of Texas, served a
Warrant of Seizure on the rifle, with appurtenances, used
to assassinate President Kennedy and the pistol, with
appurtenances, used by Lee Harvey Oswald which caused the
death of Dallas Police Officer, J. D. Tippit. The U. S.
Marshal advised that in serving the Warrant of Seizure, he
would have constructive custody of these items; however,
the weapons have been left in the custody of Mr. Shanklin.

NOTE:

This matter concerns the forfeiture proceedings currently being taken by the Government to retain the rifle used to assassinate President Kennedy and the pistol used to kill Police Officer Tippit. These weapons were previously furnished to our Dallas Office as the Department notified us the weapons must be in the state where the forfeiture proceedings are being handled. This matter comes within the jurisdiction of the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax Division, Internal Revenue Service. We previously advised the Department that the weapons were in the custody of SAC, Dallas and further requested the Department to advise us what disposition was to be made of these weapons upon completion of the forfeiture proceedings. The Department noted that disposition of these weapons would be dependent upon the successful completion of the forfeiture proceedings and the civil action of John J. King v. The Attorney General, U. S. D. C., Denver, Colorado, Civil No. 9168. SAC, Dallas advised by airtel dated 9/11/65, U. S. Marshal, Northern District of Texas, served a Warrant of Seizure on these weapons in connection with the forfeiture proceedings. By doing this, he would have constructive custody of the weapons; however, the weapons remained in custody of SAC, Dallas. The USA, NDT, indicated this is the procedure recommended to him by the Department. The various documents mentioned furnished to us by Dallas are being forwarded to the Department for their information and Xerox copies are being maintained in the file.

This letter is about to convey the zaniest of all zany mail which you ever have or will have received. Nevertheless, as it has not, as yet, been proven that Lee Oswald perpetrated the act which removed our beloved President, I venture to offer you-- not a straw to cling to but only a hair, ever so brittle. Should you consider this at all, I'd suggest saving time by just scouting for the veracity of an item I noticed in our paper, shortly before that fateful Nov. 22. Regarding the enclosed insert showing a summary of basis for inquiry, it is noted that the insert containing the complete basis for inquiry was forwarded to the Bureau by Legat, Mexico City, letter 2-19-65. The lead set forth in this letter at Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, was covered on February 25-26, 1965, but was inadvertently not reported in our subsequent communications because of the negative nature of the investigation. However, to complete all the investigative facets in Mexico, the negative inquiry has been forwarded as an insert.

No leads have been set out to locate and re-interview GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO, and this is being left to the discretion of the Dallas Office.

SUMMARY OF BASIS FOR INQUIRY

On February 4, 1965, [REDACTED] Coahuila State Police, State Building, Saltillo, Coahuila, advised that the Saltillo Police Department had arrested the captioned individual on February 3, 1965, for being drunk and assaulting a woman at a local hotel. Upon arrest, he resisted violently and shouted vulgar expressions at the officers and raved and shouted that he would kill the Governor of Coahuila and then shouted, "I had something to do with President KENNEDY's death."

When interviewed on the same date, the captioned individual when asked to explain his statement wherein he allegedly had something to do with the death of President KENNEDY and had threatened to kill the Governor of Coahuila, GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO stated he did not recall making such statements. He denied that he had anything to do with the death of President KENNEDY and said he would most certainly not kill the Governor of Coahuila.

Regarding his location on November 22, 1963, GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that he was in Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, working for the Benjamin Franklin Library and a Mr. HYMAN SERGIO, 1401 Pedro Moreno Street. He stated that he was acquainted with Attorney LOPEZ MORENO, who knew that he was in Guadalajara at that time. LOPEZ MORENO has offices on Morelos Street in Guadalajara.

GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO stated that he served in the United States Air Force from 1949 to 1952 with Serial Number 5741055. He advised he had been given a medical discharge in 1952 from the Air Force, after having spent a number of weeks in the Air Force general hospital at Mobile, Alabama, name not recalled, where he was recovering from a nervous breakdown.

He advised he receives a pension for this disability and the checks are sent to his mother, ~~LOLL FONDOJA~~, at 1104 Victoria Street, Beaumont, Texas.

GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO stated he had been arrested on a number of occasions for being drunk and fighting, but could not recall the dates or places. The only serious crime with which he was charged was an attempted burglary charge from which he was released.

Dr. SAM SOUTHWELL, Director of the United States Information Service in Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, advised that GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO was not known to him and was not known to have been around the Benjamin Franklin Library in Guadalajara. In order to be more thorough, he contacted the employees at the Benjamin Franklin Library and they all stated that GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO was not known to them.

A confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised as follows:

Attorney MIGUEL LOPEZ MORENO, who has his office at Pedro Moreno 215, Office 110, Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, stated he does not recall anyone by the name of GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO. He consulted his records on clients and could find no one by that name.

Dr. SERGIO JAIME, Director of the "Instituto Psiquiatrico Infantil," Calle Pedro Moreno 1401, Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, advised that he does not remember a GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO either by name or as a patient or employee. He stated that his caretaker at the institute is MIGUEL GONZALEZ, who has worked for over two years for him.

Dr. JAIME resides at 16 de Septiembre 157, Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, where he also has an office. He stated that his mother takes care of this office. A check was made with his mother and she could not remember anyone by the name of GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO.

A FEDERICO LOPEZ GUERRERO, who owns a shoe factory in Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, stated he does not have any relative by the name of GABRIEL LOPEZ GUERRERO.

Report 1127

Information furnished to the Detroit Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) at Jackson, Michigan, on September 17, 1965, reflects that one [redacted], white, male, 38 years of age, 5'9", 170 pounds, black wavy hair, is employed by the Harvey Aluminum Company, Adrian, Michigan. He reportedly operates a 1964 Chevrolet Impala, 1965 Ohio License 565-K. [redacted] is reportedly engaged to a young lady from Toledo, Ohio, not further identified, who has retained a private detective agency at Battle Creek, Michigan, to determine the activities of [redacted]. Inquiries by this detective agency indicate that [redacted] has become a fanatic concerning the assassination of former President JOHN F. KENNEDY and has been making long weekend trips gathering material in this matter. [redacted] reportedly devotes considerable time to gathering material regarding the assassination of President KENNEDY, and when not gathering information is occupied in his apartment reading the material he has gathered.

Information furnished to the FBI, Jackson, Michigan, on October 1, 1965, indicates that [redacted] resides at 2071 Collingwood Avenue, Toledo, Ohio, and the automobile he drives is reported to be a leased vehicle.

Information furnished to the FBI, Jackson, Michigan, on October 18, 1965, indicates that [redacted] father, not identified, recently contacted [redacted] fiancée and inquired as to whether or not she knew what was wrong with [redacted] and indicated that he suspected his son of being mentally deranged. [redacted] fiancée has indicated she believes him to be capable of killing.

RE: ALEX H. GRAYES

Information has also been developed that [redacted] had been a patient at Wayne State University Psychiatric Clinic, Detroit, Michigan, on or about December 14, 1964, and has been in contact with a JOHN WESLEY WILSON, 1710 Lee Place, Detroit, Michigan, who is associated with the Psychiatric Clinic. He is reported to also be in contact with a Doctor SAWYER, Toledo, Ohio, no further identifying data, who is reported to be active in the John Birch Society, Toledo, Ohio.

On October 14, 1965, records of the Credit Bureau of Greater Toledo, the Identification Division of the Toledo, Ohio Police Department, and the Lucas County Sheriff's Office, Toledo, Ohio, were all checked with negative results regarding [redacted].

On the same date records of the Identification Division, Toledo, Ohio Police Department, were checked regarding 1965 Ohio License 565-K, and it was determined that this license is issued to the Car-Go Auto Leasing Corporation, 2826 Monroe Street, Toledo, Ohio, for a 1965 Ford, two door hardtop.

Inquiry at the Car-Go Company on October 29, 1965, reflected that the above 1965 Ford, bearing 1965 Ohio License 565-K, is leased to the Toledo Industrial Company, Toledo, Ohio, operator not indicated. A further check of similar numbers disclosed that 1965 Ohio License 656-K is a license issued to the Car-Go Company and is currently on a 1964 Chevrolet, two door hardtop, maroon in color, which is leased to [redacted], 2701 Collingwood Avenue, Toledo, Ohio. [redacted] has been leasing cars from Car-Go for the past two years and has had the present car in his possession for the past six months. Officials of the Car-Go Company are not aware of [redacted] business association but are of the opinion that his home address and business address are one and the same. No problems have developed in their association with [redacted].

The 1964 City Directory for Toledo, Ohio, lists [redacted] as residing at [redacted] Toledo, Ohio, and his occupation is shown as [redacted] for the Reynolds Aluminum Company, business address not shown.

Neither the above directory nor the current telephone directory for Toledo, Ohio, has a listing for the Reynolds Aluminum Company.

Indices of the FBI, Cleveland, Ohio, reflect that a [REDACTED] MD, 3939 Monroe Street, Toledo, Ohio, directed a letter to the FBI, Washington, D. C., on March 19, 1965, in which he enclosed two newspaper articles, dated March 17, 1965, from "The Toledo Blade", a Toledo, Ohio, newspaper, reporting the results of a discussion presented by the Interfaith Conference on Communism and Extremism held at the University of Toledo, on March 16, 1965. The article related that Dr. NOEL LEATHERS, Chairman of the University of Toledo, History Department, stated that the key world movement today is the development of the individual and not of the Communist international conspiracy. The second article pertained to an announcement that Dr. SCOTT NEARING, former Dean of the University of Toledo, who was ousted during World War I for his pacifist views, would speak at the University of Toledo, on the following Friday, under the sponsorship of the Student Humanist Association.

In his letter accompanying the articles, [REDACTED] inquired as to whether or not NOEL LEATHERS was at one time a member of the FBI. He also inquired as to whether or not Dr. SCOTT NEARING had completely severed his ties with the Communist Party.
