Совет Народных Комиссаров Союза ССР О порядке Трудовой книжки

В целях упорядочения учета работы и служебных в справках и учредительных, Совет Народных Комиссаров Союза ССР постановляет:

1. Ввести с 15 января 1939 года для рабочих и служащих всех государственных и кооперативных предприятий и учреждений Трудовые книжки, выдаваемые администрацией предприятий (учреждений).
 2. В Трудовой книжке вносить следующие сведения о владельце Трудовой книжки: фамилия, имя и отчество, возраст, образование, профессия и сведения о его работе, о периодах его из одного предприятия (учреждения) в другое, о периодах факторного периода, а также о полученных им наградах и награждениях.
 3. Утвердить форму Трудовой книжки.
 4. Трудовые книжки выдаются по одному для всего Союза ССР образца. Текст Трудовой книжки печатается на русском языке и на языке Аляскинской Республики на аляскинском языке.
 5. Заполнение Трудовой книжки производится на том языке на котором ведется деятельность в данном предприятии (учреждении). В том случае, если деятельность ведется на языке союзной или автономной Республики, то Трудовая книжка заполняется одновременно и на русском языке.
 6. Рабочие и служащие, поступающие на работу, обязаны представлять администрацию предприятия (учреждения) Трудовую книжку. Администрация может принимать на работу рабочих и служащих только при представлении Трудовой книжки. Лица, поступающие на работу впервые, обязаны представить администрацию справку поуправления или другого совета о своем социальном статусе.
 7. Администрация предприятий и учреждений обязана до 15 января 1939 года.
- Лицам, которые в дальнейшем поступают на работу впервые, Трудовая книжка выдается бесплатно по форме в год после ухода на работу.

8. Трудовые книжки выдаются на всю работу и служебную деятельность в предприятиях (учреждениях) с июня 8 год. — в том числе на сезонных и временных работников.

На работающих по совместительству Трудовые книжки выдаются только по месту основной работы.

9. Трудовая книжка хранится у администрации предприятия (учреждения), а при увольнении выдается или служебным лицам по указанию.

10. Трудовые книжки заполняются администрацией предприятий и учреждений с соблюдением следующих правил:
 - а) Для рождения сведений в сведениях образования указывается только на основании документов. Начальное образование может быть указано со слов работника или служащего.
 - б) В графе «Профессия» указывается основная профессия — с соответствием к занятию своего рабочего или служащего.
 - в) В разделе «Сведения о работе» прежде всего вносится служебная запись по графе 3 «Один стаж работы по специальности» в соответствии с Трудовым кодексом, которое выдает Трудовую книжку составляет столько-то лет. В графе 4 «Средственно» указывается «Полтора» столько-то лет. В графе 5 «Средственно» указывается «Полтора» столько-то лет.
 - г) Дальше указывается в виде заголовка — наименование предприятия (учреждения) которое выдает Трудовую книжку.
- Под эти заголовки вносятся данные о времени приема на работу в данное предприятие (учреждение) и о перемещении по предприятию до заполнения Трудовой книжки.
- Запись в разделе «Сведения о работе» оформляется следующим образом: в графе 2 указывается дата приема на работу перемещения или увольнения, в графе 3 пишется «Принят в такой-то нек (отдел) на такую-то должность, или переведен в такой-то нек (отдел) на такую-то должность, или уволен по такой-то причине; причина увольнения должна быть указана в точном соответствии с формулировкой Кодекса Закона о Труде или в виде ссылки на статью (пункт) этого Кодекса; в графе 4 указывается дата или распоряжения или о приеме на работу, перемещении или увольнении.
- Все записи после выдачи Трудовой книжки должны вноситься администрацией предприятия по указанию приказов или распоряжений.
- Такие же образцы оформляются также в соответствующих отделах работы.
- Высказан в Трудовой книжке по указанию.

б) При увольнении все сведения о работе в поощрениях
и награждениях внесенные за время работы в предприятие
(учреждение), записываются в трудовую книжку (или
специально оформленную ее копию) в печатном виде.
в) При увольнении (учреждении)
- ж) Все записи в трудовой книжке производятся чернилами.
з) За выданы трудовую книжку выданы административной
предприятия (учреждения) с указанием имени лица в раз-
мере 50 копеек.
- и) В случае утери трудовой книжки в результате небреж-
ности ее хранения выдана трудовую книжку полагается
административной предприятия (учреждения) в административ-
ном порядке штраф в размере 25 рублей.

об этом администрации (по месту последней работы). Не
более 15 дней после заявления администрации выдает новую
трудовую книжку с надписью «Дубликат».
- к) Все случаи поступления на от бывшего лица на
выданы трудовую книжку так и от бывшего штрафа по
утере трудовой книжки поступают в доверие государства.
- л) Незаконное пользование трудовой книжкой пере-
дана на другие лица, выдана в соответствии с — выдана

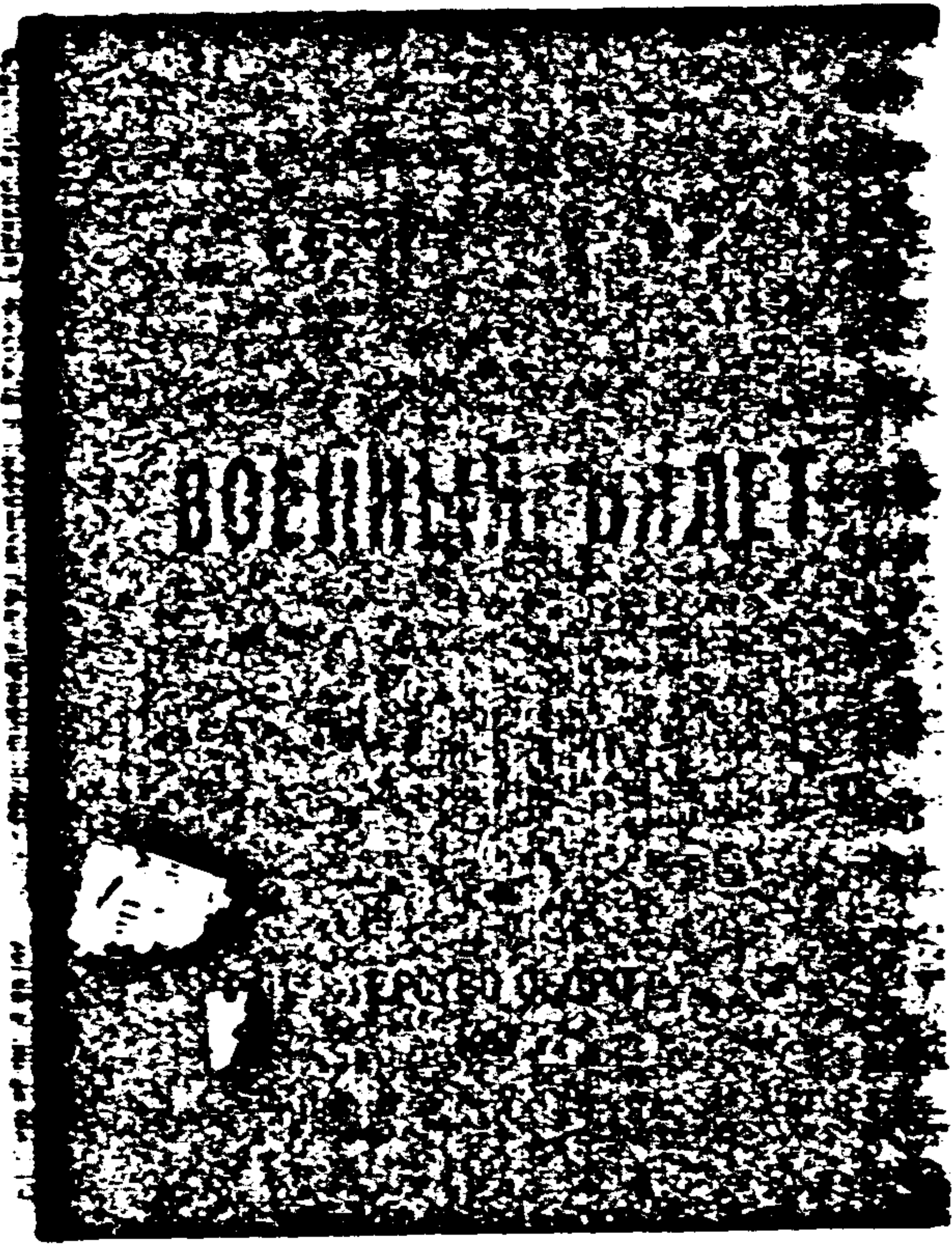

1. Военнообязанный должен:

- а) состоять на воинском учете по месту жительства: в городе — в военном комиссариате, в сельской местности, а также в городе, где нет военного комиссариата, — в военно-учетном столе при исполкоме местного Совета депутатов трудящихся;
- б) бережно хранить свой военный билет и всегда иметь его при себе.

2. Военный билет может быть сдан под расписку:

- а) по прибытию в войсковую часть для прохождения сборов — штабу части;
- б) по требованию военного комиссариата, военно-учетного стола, судебных и следственных органов;
- в) в городах — домоуправлению для приема на учет (одновременно со сдачей паспорта для прописки) и для снятия с учета. Кроме указанных выше органов и лиц никто не имеет права отбирать военный билет.

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3. При переносе постоянного жительства (или временно на срок свыше 1,5 месяцев, а в служебные командировки, на учебу и для лечения — на срок свыше трех месяцев) военнообязанный должен:

- а) по прибытии в город или в район другого военного комиссариата в этом же городе сдать домоуправлению вместе с паспортом и свой военный билет для оформления приема на воинский учет;
- б) при убытии из города или на территорию другого военного комиссариата в том же городе сдать домоуправлению вместе с паспортом и свой военный билет для снятия с воинского учета;
- в) по прибытии в сельскую местность в трехдневный срок лично явиться в сельский (поселковый) совет для принятия на воинский учет;
- г) при убытии из сельской местности в другую местность или на территорию другого сельского совета того же района лично явиться в сельский (поселковый) совет для снятия с воинского учета.

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4. Военнообязанный по получении военного билета в военном комиссариате, после увольнения с военной службы в запас или после зачисления в запас по прохождению очередного призыва, обязан встать на воинский учет не позднее трех дней со дня прибытия к месту избранного им жительства.

5. При временных выездах на срок менее 1,5 месяцев, а в служебные командировки, на учебу и для лечения — на срок до трех месяцев, должен сообщить об этом тому учетному органу, где состоит на учете.

6. При изменении фамилии и имени, образования, партийности, должности, места работы и места жительства должен явиться в пятидневный срок в военно-учетный орган по месту состояния на учете с военным билетом и документами, подтверждающими эти изменения.

7. При получении увечья или тяжелой болезни, нарушающей трудоспособность, должен явиться в военный комиссариат по месту жительства для назначения на переосвидетельствование.

Nov. 3. I am miserable about the whole thing. I have been thinking about it for a year and I cannot get the satisfaction I want. One year over I received the satisfaction I wanted. I called in to the passport office and asked for a passport (Russian) I saw no sign of it. I was told to go back and my document is returned with a stamp. Nov. 4-31 I am starting to reconsider my entire situation. The work is dead the money I get has nowhere to go. No adventures or exciting days no traces of excitement. The trade union dances I love have gone too. I have made my first request to American Embassy for reconsidering my position, I state I would like to go to the States. Feb. 28th receive letter from Embassy. Richard D. [Name] states I could come in for an interview any time. March 1-15 I am live in a state of expectation. I am going back to the U.S. I confided with people but my judgment but I cannot see out to tell my Russian friends my desire to return. I understand now.

March 17 - I and [Name] went to the [Name] dance. But at the last hour I am introduced to a girl [Name] a French girl - Dr. and Red - [Name] with [Name] [Name] with her. Then ask to show her home I do not want to. Over [Name] her name is [Name]. We like each other. Right away she tells me her name [Name] and [Name].
