Attached is a copy of a bus passenger list for a bus company called Transportes Frontera covering a trip made by bus No. 340 of this company from Mexico City to Laredo, Texas, on 10/2-3/63.

It is noted that the name "OSWALD" is listed in the space for seat No. 4 with a destination of "Laredo." As was pointed out in aytel of reference, extensive investigation at the offices of the bus company in Monterrey failed to disclose a ticket which could have been used for OSWALD on this trip. Interviews of the two drivers of the bus on this particular trip have also been negative.

Because of the failure to discover a ticket for OSWALD and the fact that there possibly could be some variation in the writing of this name as compared with the writing of other names, it is requested that the following handwriting examination be made:

1. It is requested that the handwriting of the name "OSWALD" and "Laredo" be compared with the known handwriting of the subject to determine whether the name was written by him.

2. That the handwriting also be compared with the handwriting of the other names appearing on the list in an effort to determine whether the name "OSWALD" was written by the same person entering some or all of the other names appearing on the list.

The bus passenger list was made available to this office by Lic. RAFAEL HERNANDEZ OCHOA, Sub-Director of the

On 12/12/63 U. S. Post Office Inspector HARRY HOLMES, Terminal Annex, U. S. Post Office, Dallas, Texas, furnished a Dallas Agent the attached parcel which was located in the "nixie" section of the Irving, Texas Post Office by a Post Office employee. The parcel was made available to Mr. HOLMES by C. S. TWILLEY, Postmaster, Irving, Texas. TWILLEY told HOLMES the parcel was discovered at the Irving Post Office on 12/4/63. There was no indication on the parcel that it had ever been mailed because of the address placed on the parcel which had been placed in the "nixie" section by some unidentified postal employee. This section receives items containing addresses which cannot be located. The parcel when discovered had been half opened at one end. The opening was completed by Inspector HOLMES after he received the package at which time Inspector HOLMES examined the contents. It is to be noted the outer wrapping of the parcel covers a long brown bag open at both ends.

FBI Laboratory is requested to examine the paper contents of both items to determine whether these items may have any connection with or similarity to the paper bag previously submitted to the FBI Laboratory for examination in this case. The paper bag previously submitted to the FBI Laboratory was believed to be the one in which the rifle used to assassinate President KENNEDY was wrapped. Although numerous persons have handled the

attached items the FBI Laboratory may desire to have the Latent Fingerprint Section of the Bureau examine these items for the presence of fingerprints of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

U. S. Post Office Inspector HOLMES advised it will not be necessary to return these items to the Post Office. The Bureau Laboratory may make such disposal of these items as desired when examination has been completed. Inspector HOLMES stated Postmaster C. G. TWILLEY questioned numerous employees of the Irving, Texas Post Office with negative results for any information concerning the origin of this material.

On 12/5/63, JOHN J. [redacted], 320 Broadway, NYC, identifying himself as attorney for the Gus Hall-Benjamin B. Davis Defense Committee, made available to SA JOSEPH B. WATERS an undated letter from [redacted] on a 3" by 3" piece of paper which enclosed examples of his photographic work. In his letter OSWALD explained that he would be "honored" to do such work without charge and suggested that material might be sent to him in any size for reproduction in the form of positive or negative prints. His letter enclosed two photographic copies of a poster entitled "The Gus Hall - Benjamin B. Davis Defense Committee - END Mc CARRANISM". He also enclosed the negative prints used to create this poster.

A letter of acknowledgement dated 12/13/62, was sent to OSWALD over the signature, Hall-Davis Defense Committee, James J. Tormey, Executive Secretary, and a copy of this letter was also made available by ABT.

A request was made by ABT that the material be returned to him when it had served its purpose and he was informed that his request would be made a matter of record. He also stated that any question in connection with this material might be referred to him.

The text of OSWALD's letter is set out below as well as the reply of the Dallas Defense Committee.

It is noted that OSWALD apparently directed his letter to "third fl. 23 West 25th Street, New York, NY," with this being referred to the Hall-Davis Committee because of the text. It is noted that the third floor at the above address is utilized as the National Office of the CP, USA.

Enclosed for the Bureau with copies to Dallas is the material described above consisting of the undated letter written by OSWALD, the reply, the two photographic posters and the photographic negatives apparently used in the reproduction. The text of the OSWALD letter follows:

New York, NY

"L. H. Oswald

Dear Sirs:

"Enclosed a small example of my modest skill, If you may happen to need any head-line-photo-work on a small scale, I will be honored to do it, of course, there will be no charge.

"Lee H. Oswald

"Instructions;

"Just send me any size, small reproduction of what you want done. for instance, the below size reproduction was also used on the prints enclosed.

"I can make black on white (positive print), or white on black (negative print), any size you desire."

The example used by OSWALD is a cut out of the name GUS HALL in small print and taped to the letter. The acknowledgement reads as follows:

"December 13, 1962

"Mr. Lee H. Oswald
Box 2915
Dallas, Texas

"Dear Friend:

We are in receipt of the samples of photographic work you sent us.

We deeply appreciate your offer to do this type of work for us as your contribution to our activity. We are putting this material on file so that we can make reference to it in the event that any such need arises.

Enclosed is a handwritten communication addressed to MRS. GWYNNE GASSAWAY, 3708 Armstrong, Dallas, Texas, with the envelope in which this was received through the mails by MRS. GASSAWAY.

On 12/7/63, HARRY MC CORMICK of the "Dallas Morning News", advised the Dallas Office, that in February, 1963, a friend of his, GWYNNE GASSAWAY, 3708 Armstrong, had written a letter to the editor which letter had been published in his paper. As a result of this letter being published, MRS. GASSAWAY received an anonymous communication signed "A Worker".

MC CORMICK said on 11/24/63, the "Dallas Morning News" carried a facsimile of LEE HARVEY OSWALD's letter to JOHN CONNALLY "Secretary of the Navy". MC CORMICK said MRS. GASSAWAY saw this facsimile letter of OSWALD's in the paper and has told him she believes the handwriting in the facsimile and the handwriting in the anonymous communication she received are the same. MC CORMICK was advised by MRS. GASSAWAY that the original anonymous letter which she received had been turned over to the FBI by her.

MC CORMICK said he had a reproduction of this anonymous letter which MRS. GASSAWAY had turned over to the Bureau and it was his intention on the basis of her information to run a story in his paper setting forth a facsimile of CONNALLY's letter to OSWALD alongside the reproduction of the anonymous letter received by MRS. GASSAWAY. MC CORMICK did not ask for any information but said he was merely notifying the Dallas Office of his intention in this regard, so that we would not learn of

it first by seeing it in the paper. When asked whether he intended referring to the FBI in any way in his article, he said he probably would mention that MRS. GASSAWAY had turned the letter over to the FBI when she received it.

MR. MC CORMICK again got in touch with the Dallas Office later on 12/7/63, and said he had decided against publishing the article concerning the two letters.

The anonymous communication signed "A Worker" which was turned over to the Dallas Office, by MRS. GASSAWAY, was located in Dallas files and is the enclosure hereto.

It is requested a comparison be made between the handwriting in the enclosed anonymous communication and the known handwriting of LEE HARVEY OSWALD already in possession of the Bureau Laboratory, for the purpose of determining whether the anonymous communication was or was not written by him. Results should be made available to the Dallas Office.
