

**K61 Keystone Auto Zoom, Model K-310, 8 mm movie camera
#50947 in black leather carrying case**

Result of examination:

It was determined that the average film speed of the K61 camera is approximately 18.5 frames per second. This average does not include the last 5 seconds of running time of the camera, since the camera slows down during the last 5 seconds. When the last portion is considered, the average running time of the camera is 17.825 frames per second. Since the pertinent portions of Mr. Nix's assassination film were exposed prior to the last 5 seconds of running time, the 18.5 frames per second average film speed is the most realistic figure to use in relation to the assassination portion of this film.

The K61 camera is being temporarily retained for such additional tests as may be needed.

Re telephone call to Dallas from Assistant Director IVAN CONRAD at 5:40 PM, C.S.T., 1/28/64, requesting the movie camera used by ORVILLE O. NIX be obtained and forwarded to the Laboratory.

Enclosed under separate cover is one Keystone Auto Zoom, Model K-810, 8-mm movie camera in a black leather carrying case, Keystone No. 702.

NIX advised the camera is presently loaded with a new roll of colored film of the same type with which the pictures of the Presidential Motorcade were taken, which NIX said it would be satisfactory for the Bureau to use as long as the film was replaced. He said the setting was at 40 and he was using the Zoom lens with Type A film.

He recalled that the first series were made at the corner of Main and Houston just as the Motorcade turned north on Houston and he was at a position near the curb on the southwest corner of the intersection and made the pictures of the left side of the Presidential car.

After the car got by, he then proceeded to a point about 20 feet west of Houston Street on the south side of Main Street and made the latter series across an open area which was in view of his position, using the zoom lens completely open.

As to whether or not the camera was wound tightly, he pointed out that he could not recall specifically, but his

his experience had been that it would only run at a slow speed when the spring was almost run down.

Mr. NIX advised that the Bureau is welcome to use the camera for experimental purposes and that he would be available as a witness in the event his services were needed in the future.

The evidence listed below was received in the Laboratory today with a memorandum dated January 31, 1964, to Mr. Sullivan from W. A. Branigan.

Q475 Envelope postmarked "17 KHE. 64-17" "Mexico D.F. 8:00 PM" addressed: "Mr. Robert Kennedy, Ministro de Justicia Washington, Estados Unidos"

Q476 Accompanying letter beginning: "Mexico D.F. Dic de 1963..." and signed, "Ernesto Flores Luna," followed by an illegible handwritten flourish resembling a capital "J"

Results:

It was found that the typewriter used to type specimens Q475 and Q476 was not used to type the pertinent previous typed specimens in this case, specimens Q232 through Q235 and Q350A through Qc353, which is correspondence signed "Pedro Charles," "Mare del Rosario Molina," and "Miguel Caban Lopez."

The typing on specimens Q475 and Q476, except the numerals (which are sometimes varied on special order), most closely matches Underwood Small Victoria, spaced ten letters to the inch.

The envelope Q475 and the sheet of paper of Q476 differ from the envelopes and paper of Q232 through Q235 and Q350A and Q351 previously submitted in this case. Specimens Qc352 and Qc353 are photocopies. However, from such examination as can be made from these copies, physical differences between Qc352 and Qc353 on the one hand and the current specimens Q475 and Q476 on the other hand were noted. Specimens Q475 and Q476 are retained in the Laboratory.

RECOMMENDATION: For information and appropriate action of the Domestic Intelligence Division.
