The photographer was Mr. JAMES H. POWELL, assigned to Region Two, of the Army Intelligence Corps, at Dallas, Texas. He has stated that he took this picture of this building at approximately 30 seconds after the last shot was fired on 11/22/63, on the occasion of the assassination of President KENNEDY. Mr. POWELL has advised he took the shot of this building because he saw several people pointing up to it. Lieutenant Colonel E. E. BOYD of the Region Two Intelligence Corps, at Dallas, has made this photograph available and has requested it be returned to Mr. POWELL when it is no longer needed.

The FBI Laboratory is requested to examine this photograph to determine if an enlargement reveals anything of pertinent value. Following examination, it is requested it be returned to Dallas.

It was concluded that the typewriting on Q350 through Qc353 was prepared on the typewriter used to prepare specimens Q232 through Q235, previously submitted.

The envelope Q350 is the same kind as the envelopes Q232 and Q234. The envelope Qc352 is similar to the other three envelopes. The paper of Q351 is the same kind as Q235.

No indented handwriting was found on Q350 and Q351.

There is no handwritten signature on Qc353 for comparison with the previous signatures in this case.

Q232 through Q235, Q350 and Q351 were three letters previously submitted, all bearing Cuban postmarks.

The submitted evidence is attached hereto. Translations from the Spanish of Qc353 are also attached.

The evidence listed below was received in the Laboratory on 12/28/63 with a memorandum dated 12/26/63 from W. A. Branigan to W. C. Sullivan.

Item One Envelope (no postmark visible) bearing typewritten address "Mr. J. Edgar Hoover, Director, Federal Bureau of Investigation, (9th & Penn. Ave., N. W., Washington, 1, D. C.)"

Item Two Typewritten letter beginning "President Johnson conspired..." and ending "...President Kennedy's death."

The typewriting on Items One and Two was not identified in the National Security File and in the Anonymous Letter File. A photograph of the typewriting will be added to the Anonymous Letter File..

The typewriting on Items One and Two was prepared on a machine equipped with Corona elite type spaced twelve letters to the inch. The particular style of type involved has been in use since 1939.

The submitted evidence has been photographed and is being forwarded to the Latent Fingerprint Section for latent fingerprint examination. A separate report will be submitted on the latent fingerprint examination.

Result of examination:

It was concluded that the questioned handwriting in Q439, which is on a blank sheet which faces the inside back cover, was written by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case. The remaining brief notations in Q439 are too limited for an adequate handwriting examination.

The various isolated words appearing in Q440 are too limited for an adequate comparison with the known writings of OSWALD, K4 and K5. However, some handwriting and hand printing similarities were noted common to the questioned writings in Q440 and the known writings of OSWALD.

No indented writings of significance were noted in Q439 and Q440.

The submitted evidence is retained.

2. A paperback edition of the Merriam-Webster Pocket Dictionary (of the English language) with torn cover.
3. Six colored picture post cards depicting scenes in Mexico City. These cards are marked on the back "BDO 12-4-63 No. 4" which is the mark of the Agent obtaining the evidence. The FBI Laboratory is requested to make a cryptographic examination of these books and the six post cards. The Laboratory is further requested to examine handwriting and printing in the two dictionaries to determine if same is identical with known handwriting of OSWALD, and to conduct such indented writing examinations as appropriate. It would appear that these books were purchased by OSWALD in Mexico on his trip there from September 26 to October 3, 1963, and the writing in the books was prepared by him.

Each of these books have been marked on the inside front cover by the Agent obtaining them as identification marks, and the University of Chicago dictionary has also been marked on the first page "BDO 12-4-63", which is also the mark of the Agent obtaining the book.

Other markings which appear in the University of Chicago book are as follows:

U. S. Information Agency (USIA) has furnished Bureau with letter dated at Havana, Cuba, 11-27-63 addressed to Voice of America and signed by one Miguel Galban Lopez. Letter alleges that assassination of President by Oswald was undertaken at the direction of a Cuban agent, one Pedro Charles, who gave Oswald \$7,000 for this mission.

The FBI Laboratory has examined letter in question and has concluded that typewriting thereon is identical with typewriting which appeared in two previous letters received by the Bureau which contained similar allegations. (See memorandum Wannall to Sullivan, 12-11-63, same caption.) As noted in prior memorandum of 12-11-63 it seems clear this matter represents an attempted hoax possibly perpetrated by some anti-Castro group or individual seeking to attach blame to the Castro regime in connection with the President's death. State Department and the Central Intelligence Agency as well as Secret Service have previously been advised of these letters.

Bureau files contain no reference identifiable with Miguel Galban Lopez. Letter from USIA does not require acknowledgment.



It is pointed out that hairs do not possess enough individual microscopic characteristics to be positively identified as originating from a particular person to the exclusion of all others.

Several brown limb hair fragments of Caucasian origin were also found in the debris removed from Q350; however, these hairs did not contain enough microscopic characteristics to be of value for comparison purposes.

None of the textile fibers previously removed from the KV gun could be associated with the Q350 jacket.

The jacket, Q350, was microscopically examined and chemically processed to determine if any gunpowder residues were present and no nitrates or nitrites such as would be present in gunpowder residues were found. 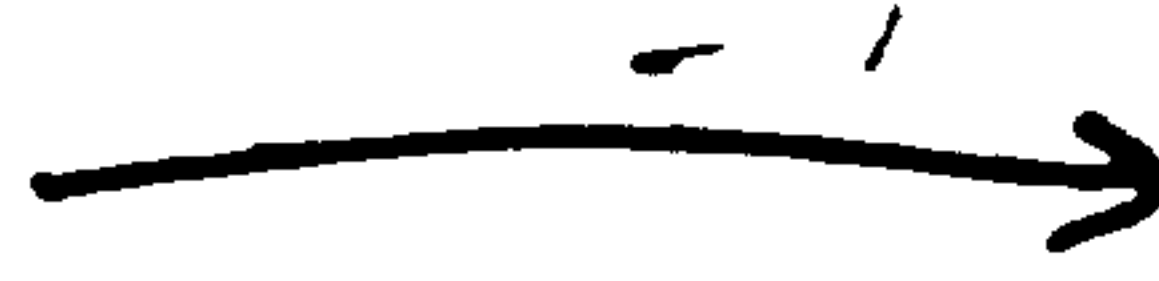

Attached is a letter and envelope received in the Bureau on 12-18-63 from an anonymous person who signed the letter "X Comrade X." The letter alleges that President Johnson conspired with communist agents to assassinate President Kennedy and would aid and abet Russia in subversion of the U.S. The writer implies that he is a Soviet official in the U.S., states that he has relatives in Soviet Russia and laments the fact that he does not have the courage of "Comrade Gizenkho." This apparently refers to Igor Guzenko, Soviet intelligence officer who defected in Canada in 1945.

The letter also alleges that the Baldwin Hills Reservoirs collapse in California was an act of sabotage to divert the people's attention from inquiry into the President's death.

RECOMMENDATION

Although this appears to be a crank-type letter, it is believed it should be given to Secret Service because of the references to President Johnson, and also that it should be examined by the Laboratory. It is recommended, therefore, that the Laboratory examine the typewriting on this letter and envelope and compare it with specimens in the National Security File and specifically against all specimens known to have emanated from Soviet official typewriters. In addition, the Laboratory should examine the letter and envelope for latent fingerprints and again make comparisons with known fingerprints of Soviet officials in the U.S.

Dissemination to Secret Service will be deferred until Laboratory examination has been completed and it is requested that if the Laboratory examination will discolor or mutilate the letter, appropriate photographic copies be made prior to the examination for ultimate dissemination to the Secret Service.
