PRESIDENT'S COMMISSION  
ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY

ReBulet 12/20/63, instructing that the enclosures to referenced letter be delivered to Mr. ALBERT JENNER, Chicago lawyer, presently confined to Room 4126, Evanston Hospital, Evanston, Illinois.

At 10:15 a.m., 12/23/63, I personally delivered to Mr. JENNER, at Room 4126, Evanston Hospital, Evanston, Illinois, one copy of the report on the "Investigation of Assassination of President John F. Kennedy, November 22, 1963" report covering the "Investigation of Killing of Lee Harvey Oswald, Dallas, Texas, November 24, 1963", along with 3 volumes of exhibits.

Mr. JENNER appeared most appreciative and indicated that he is serving on this Commission upon the direct request of Chief Justice EARL WARREN. He expressed his very high regard for the Director and the FBI and stated that he became acquainted firsthand with the reports of the FBI when serving on a loyalty commission in Washington several years ago. He stated that he always noted that the FBI reports were completely impartial and factual. He advised that he hopes to be sufficiently recovered to proceed to Washington in approximately a week for a conference with J. LEE RANKIN, Counsel for the President's Commission. He advised that should he have any questions for referral to the Bureau, he will contact me personally. He was furnished with both his office phone number and my residence phone number.
