DRAIN THIS DATE THAT HE HAD TALKED WITH CHIEF OF POLICE JESSE E. CURRY ON THIS DATE AND CURRY HAD RELATED FOLLOWING TO HIM.

ROBERT STOREY, FORMER DEAN OF SMU LAW SCHOOL, AND PAST PRESIDENT, AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION, AS WELL AS FORMER MEMBER OF PRESIDENT/S CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION, HAD TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED CURRY ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER EIGHTEEN. STOREY RELATED THAT HE HAD JUST RETURNED FROM WASHINGTON, DC., WITH TEXAS ATTORNEY GENERAL WAGGONER CARR, WHERE THEY HAD CONFERRED WITH PRESIDENT/S COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

STOREY REQUESTED A MEETING WITH CHIEF OF POLICE CURRY, MAYOR EARL CABELL OF CITY OF DALLAS, CITY MANAGER ELGIN CRULL OF DALLAS, AND USA BAREFOOT SANDERS FOR MONDAY, DECEMBER TWENTYTHREE.

STOREY STATED MEETING NECESSARY TO APPRISE THEM OF WHAT WOULD BE REQUESTED OF THE DALLAS PD BY PRESIDENT/S COMMISSION AND WHAT INFORMATION GENERALLY WOULD BE EXPECTED TO BE PRODUCED BY DALLAS PD TO COMMISSION.

CURRY RELATED TO [REDACTED] THAT AFTER CONFERRING WITH CITY MANAGER CRULL AND MAYOR CABELL, IT WAS DETERMINED DECEMBER TWENTYTHREE WAS DAY ON WHICH CITY COUNCIL USUALLY MEETS. CURRY CALLED STOREY AND TOLD HIM THAT MEETING WOULD HAVE TO BE POSTPONED UNTIL TUESDAY, DECEMBER TWENTYFOUR. THAT WAS AGREED UPON WITH STOREY AND ACCORDING TO [REDACTED] MEETING WILL BE HELD NEXT TUESDAY BETWEEN STOREY, CURRY, CRULL, CABELL AND USA SANDERS.

STOREY HAS BEEN APPOINTED BY CARR TO REPRESENT ATTORNEY GENERAL/S OFFICE IN ASSISTING COMMISSION. IT IS NOT KNOWN WHETHER OR NOT COMMISSION HAD REQUESTED STOREY TO OBTAIN COPY OF REPORTS FROM DALLAS PD OR OTHER DATA, OR WHETHER STOREY IS DOING THIS ON HIS OWN.

CHIEF CURRY HAS ADVISED THAT COPY OF DALLAS POLICE REPORT

INVESTIGATING SHOOTING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD BY JACK RUBY WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THIS OFFICE MONDAY, DECEMBER TWENTYTHREE. HE STATED HE IS ALSO GOING TO MAKE A COPY AVAILABLE TO TEXAS ATTORNEY GENERAL, THE PRESIDENT/S COMMISSION, THE DALLAS DISTRICT ATTORNEY, AND CITY MANAGER OF DALLAS. CURRY STATED THAT REPORT WAS NEGATIVE AS TO HOW RUBY GAINED ENTRANCE TO BASEMENT OF POLICE BUILDING ON NOVEMBER TWENTYFOUR, AND ONLY THING THAT PD HAD BEEN ABLE TO DETERMINE WAS FACT HE SLIPPED PAST OFFICER WHO WAS GUARDING ENTRANCE TO BASEMENT ON MAIN STREET SIDE AT MOMENT THE OFFICER WAS MOMENTARILY DIVERTED FROM HIS POST TO LET A SQUAD CAR OUT OF BUILDING.
