SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT

D.C. W.P. ...

Mr. J. Lee Rankin advised on 12/20/63 that he would be out of the city on the coming week end and would return to Washington on Monday, 12/23/63. He said he would probably leave Washington sometime on Tuesday, 12/24/63, and would more than likely remain in New York until Monday, 12/30/63. He stated he could be reached at his office, phone Murray Hill 7-2924, 36 West 44th Street, New York City; or his home, phone Plaza 3-5922, 35 Sutton Place, New York City.

Mr. Rankin requested that if the Bureau had any items which it was felt necessary to discuss with him he would appreciate receiving a call at any time. He requested that in the event he was not in his office and the Bureau had any additional material concerning the assassination matter to deliver to him, he would like for it to be given to his secretary, Mrs. Julie Eide.
