This is to confirm that the FBI has agreed to provide access to additional documents pertaining to Yuri Ivanovich Nosenko.

This is also to advise that such retrievable documents found in the FBI's Nosenko file relating to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy are available for HSCA access in Room 8988 at FBI Headquarters (FBIHQ).

On February 17, 1978, G. Robert Blakey, Chief Counsel and Staff Director, HSCA, and two of his associates were afforded a briefing on Nosenko at FBIHQ. As a result of this meeting and a second meeting on March 3, 1978, between Mr. Blakey and representatives of the FBI's Intelligence Division, it was agreed that retrievable documents relating to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy in the FBI's Nosenko file would be prepared for Committee access.

Pursuant to Mr. Blakey's subsequent request on March 16, 1978, for access to [REDACTED] HSCA [REDACTED] personnel of the FBI's Intelligence Division have identified a working paper dated September 20, 1968, which reviewed and analyzed material in an earlier Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) study dealing with Nosenko's bona fides. Copies of the working paper were furnished to CIA as enclosures to an FBI memorandum dated October 1, 1968, under the Nosenko title. A copy of the October 1, 1968, memorandum, which summarizes the FBI's observations on the CIA study, is being included in the aforementioned documents compiled for HSCA review. Since the working paper itself almost solely addresses CIA observations, the FBI will have to effect coordination with CIA relative to your request for access to it. If the CIA interposes no objection to HSCA access, the FBI will, of course, grant same.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this memorandum is to advise of the possibility that agents who are interviewed by captioned Committee may be placed under oath.

DETAILS:

On 3/30/78, Michael Eberhardt, Staff Counsel for captioned Committee advised that the Committee had decided that in view of the large number of agents that will be called as witnesses by this Committee, a decision had been made to place certain agents under oath at the time of interview. This will be done in order to avoid the necessity of a large number of agents appearing before the Committee itself. Certain agents will be placed under oath pursuant to rule 4.1 of the Committee which provides, "Pursuant to House Resolution 222, counsel on the committee staff may be designated to obtain statements from a witness who is placed under oath by an authority who is authorized to administer oaths in accordance with the applicable laws of the United States or of any State."

It should be noted in dealing with other Committees of Congress, notably the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, agents have been placed under oath by Committee Members and subsequently interviewed by staff personnel. This procedure on the part of the House Select Committee on Assassinations does not depart from procedures of other
