PURPOSE:

The purpose of this memorandum is to recommend procedures for handling material that was furnished to the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence (SCI) and is now being requested by the captioned Committee.

DETAILS:

It should be noted by way of background that captioned Committee requested the SCI to provide it with information previously supplied by the FBI with regard to the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy to the Senate Select Committee to Study Governmental Operations With Respect to Intelligence Activities. This material is now in the custody and control of the SCI. This Committee did not desire to furnish this information directly to the HSCA, but instead had representatives of the Committee deliver to FBIHQ the previously furnished information. These documents were Xeroxed at FBIHQ in the presence of a representative of the SCI. An agreement was reached between the HSCA and the FBI whereby Committee staff members would be allowed access to this information at FBIHQ. The notes that were taken by the staff members were to be properly classified by a document classification officer. PURPOSE: To provide details of a contact at the National Archives

and Records Service (NARS) regarding a document pertaining to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy (Bufile 62-109060).

DETAILS: On March 29, 1978, SA Danny O. Coulson, Legal Liaison and Congressional Affairs Unit, Legal Counsel Division, requested that SA Clark contact NARS regarding an FBI document that HSCA was requesting access to or delivery of.

On March 29, 1978, SA Prew J. Clark met with Miss Trudy Peterson, Assistant to the Archivist, NARS. She located FBI letter to Robert B. Olsen, dated April 21, 1975, captioned "Commission on CIA Activities Within the United States," with attachments, copies of which are attached, which she stated HSCA was requesting that NARS provide. The document, minus attachments, is Serial 58 in Bufile 62-116391 with an unrecorded copy designated to Bufile 62-109060, "Assassination of President John F. Kennedy."

Peterson advised that HSCA claimed it had asked the FBI for the same document but was told that it could not be found. Peterson was advised that no request for this document had been received from HSCA to SA Clark's knowledge. 101.

SA Clark reviewed the document at NARS and furnished a signed note to Peterson which stated that the document had been reviewed and found to be appropriate for access by HSCA. The question of whether or not NARS could deliver the document to HSCA, if requested to do so, was raised. Peterson was advised that SA Clark could grant no authority to NARS to deliver the document to the HSCA since the FBI required the HSCA to furnish written requests for any item to be delivered.

Since no HSCA request for this document could be <u>located in</u> the Congressional Inquity Unit, on 4/17/78, Ms. Jacqueline Hess, HSCA, wasked if HSCA required access to or delivery of this document. She declined, advising that she felt the Committee's needs had been met by viewing the document at NARS. She also advised that she could not recommend that HSCA had requested access to or delivery of this document from the FBI in the past.

Result of examination:

The photographs of E. HOWARD HUNT were compared with the shortest and oldest of the three men arrested in Dallas, Texas, on November 22, 1963, as depicted in photographs previously furnished to the FBI Laboratory with the following results:

- 1. The shortest and oldest man of the three men arrested in Dallas, Texas, on November 22, 1963, compared with photographs of E. HOWARD HUNT, shows a marked and significant age difference, with Mr. Hunt having a much younger appearance.
- 2. The jowl area of the chin of the oldest man has protruding pouches while this area of HUNT's chin is smooth and tightly contoured.

- 3. The nose of the oldest man appears more bulbous while the nose of HUNT is more angular or pointed.
- 4. There appear to be some inconsistencies in the ear contours; however, the known photographs of HUNT show differences in the ear contours between the late 1950 photographs and the mid to late 1960 photographs. The ear contours of the oldest individual in the Dallas photographs are different from the ear contours of HUNT in the mid to late 1960 photographs.

All of the above characteristics are considered sufficient to support the opinion as previously stated that the oldestindividual in the Dallas photographs is not E. HOWARD HUNT.

The tallest of the three men arrested in Dallas, Texas, on November 22, 1963, and shown in the photographs previously furnished to the FBI Laboratory, was compared with the photographs of FRANK STURGIS with the following results:

- 1. The tallest of the three men in the Dallas photographs has the general appearance of a Nordic type and FRANK STURGIS has a very definite appearance of a Latin.
 - 2. FRANK STURGIS has very black wavy hair, and the Nordic individual has light or blonde straighter hair.
 - 3. FRANK STURGIS has a rather round face with square chin lines and the Nordic individual has an oval shaped face with a less square or more rounded chin.
 - the height of the forehead from the bridge of the nose to the hairline shows these measurements approximately equal on STURGIS as compared to a greater forehead height than nose length on the Nordic individual. This is most obvious in the right profile where the nose and forehead of STURGIS measure approximately 7/8 inch. The nose of the Nordic individual measures 7/8 inch, and the forehead approximately 1 3/8 inches.

5. Some differences in ear contours were noted with the right ear of STURGIS being slightly triangular in shape.

- 6. The left ear of STURGIS has a slight projection along the outer edge about one-third down from the top. This projection does not appear in a similar view of the left ear of the Nordic individual.
- 7. The general outer contour of the left ear is more triangular on STURGIS and has a more distinct lobe, while the ear of the Nordic individual is wider at the lower half and has very little lobe.
- 8. Differences were noted in the nose contours and general facial contours between comparable photographs of STURGIS and the tallest individual in the Dallas photographs.

All of the above characteristics strongly support the previously stated conclusions that the tallest of the three individuals arrested in Dallas, Texas, on November 22, 1963, is not FRANK STURGIS.




Your request for a determination of the height of the individuals in the Dallas photographs based on an on-site study is under investigation, and this study will be made as soon as appropriate background information can be obtained.







Height determination for tallest "derelict",


