



Marina Asks Peace Bond Against Mate

By JOHN GEDDIE!

The widow of Lee Harvey Oswald asked a Dallas justice of the peace Wednesday for a peace bond against her husband of almost three months.

Mrs. Marina Oswald Porter told Judge W. E. (Bill) Richburg that Kenneth Jess Porter whom she married June 1, had slapped her and threatened to kill himself.

The 27-year-old husband was placed in county jail after he refused to come before Judge Richburg for a hearing.

In a signed affidavit to Judge Richburg, the <u>24-year-old Mrs.</u> Porter said Porter had threatened to kill himself several times.

"We got in an argument today," she said. "He slapped me in the face and tried to get me to put the children outside so that he could be alone with the gun he carried.

"I am afraid that he might try to do me bodily harm," she added.

She said she had called the Federal Bureau of Investigation when he made threats Wednesday, and they sent the police to her home.

She and the children were in the judge's jury room when newsmen arrived. She requested through Judge Richburg that no pictures be taken of her children.

Porter was released from the Dallas County Jail about 11:25 p.m. Wednesday after a \$1,500 peace bond set by Judge Richburg was posteriously his attorneys, Charles Tocsmer and J. M. Davenport.
