Mr. JOSEPH B. TONER, Manager, New Orleans Retailers' Credit Bureau, Masonic Temple Building, advised that a review of their records reflect the following on FRANK J. CARACCI.

In a report dated June 7, 1963, FRANK J. CARACCI, white male, age 39 and wife, ROSEMARY, was shown as residing at 994 Topaz Street, New Orleans, Louisiana, as of October, 1963. His occupation was listed as Court of Two Sisters as partner. Eleven credit accounts were listed as satisfactory and two accounts were listed as very slow. There are numerous suits and tax liens against CARACCI dated from 1941 through 1961. Under remarks column the following was listed:

CARACCI is a native of this city and is the son of VINCENT CARACCI who operated a retail grocery at 444 Elba Street for 15 years. CARACCI was practically reared in the business and in 1946 the business was turned over to him. He continued until 1951 when he sold out and became connected with the J. and C. Amusement Company. He is also a partner with NICK KARNO in the Old French Opera House night club and is also a partner at the 500 Club.
